

Police Department forwarded the case to the D.A. The local police department had been investigating the crash since March, The Hollywood Reporter reported.

The mishap occurred on March 4. Davidson was allegedly in a Mercedes and traveling at a high speed in a residential area when the vehicle jumped the curb while he was driving. The accident allegedly involved the car knocking over a fire hydrant and clipping the corner of a house. Neither Davidson nor any of the home's residents were injured.


