**Cabinet Greenlights Crucial North-South Corridor**

The Cabinet, chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Shaikh Khalid bin Abdulla Al Khalifa, approved financing for the Shaikh Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah Highway Development Project during its Monday meeting at Gudaibiya

Palace. This decision, following a memorandum by the Ministerial Committee for Financial and Economic Affairs and Fiscal Balance, reflects Bahrain's focus on enhancing infrastructure to meet the needs of its growing population and economy.

The project aims to alleviate traffic congestion and reduce

peak-hour delays by upgrading the highway to motorway standards. With Bahrain's population expected to increase from 1.4 million to 2.1 million by 2030, the highway will be a crucial North-South link connecting Manama, Sitra Industrial Area, the Alba Plant, and the Southern Governorate. It is also envisioned as part

of an international network tied to the proposed Bahrain-Qatar Causeway. Key features include replacing Alba Roundabout with a three-level interchange and upgrading Nuwaidrat Roundabout to a two-level interchange. Enhancements will extend to King Hamad Highway, Estiqlal Highway, and Refinery Avenue. The

project also involves relocating utilities such as power cables, water pipelines, telecommunications, and gas pipelines.

This initiative marks a significant milestone in Bahrain's infrastructure development, strengthening connectivity, reducing travel delays, and supporting sustainable economic growth.

**'Culinomics'**

Bahrain hosts Middle East's first gastronomy forum, showcasing culinary tourism leadership

Manama witnessed a transformative moment as Bahrain inaugurated the first-ever Middle East edition of the World Forum on Gastronomy Tourism, reinforcing its status as a global hub for innovative tourism strategies.

The forum, hosted at Exhibition World Bahrain, was opened by Bahrain's Tourism Minister H.E. Fatima bint Jaffer Al Sairafi, who framed the event as a pivotal milestone in Bahrain's Tourism Strategy 2022-2026.

Addressing an audience of over 600 participants from 50 countries, Al Sairafi emphasized Bahrain's commitment to leveraging gastronomy tourism as a bridge to connect cultures, empower communities, and drive sustainable growth.

# Gastronomy Fuels Growth

Experts highlight culinary tourism as a driver of culture and economy at Bahrain forum

A high-level panel at the 9th UN World Forum on Gastronomy Tourism in Bahrain concluded that gastronomy tourism is not just a cultural bridge but also a significant economic driver.

Emphasizing the importance of sustainability, collaboration, and innovation, the panellists highlighted how well-structured policies can empower local communities, promote cultural heritage, and drive economic diversification.

Moderated by Sandra Carvao, Director of Market Intelligence, Policies, and Competitiveness at the UNWTO, the panel featured Bahrain's Minister of Tourism, H.E. Fatima Al Sairafi; the Philippines' Tourism Secretary, H.E. Christina Garcia Frasco; and Saudi Arabia's Deputy Minister of International Affairs, H.E. Sultan AlMusallam.

## Empowering local communities in Bahrain

Al Sairafi underscored the role of gastronomy in Bahrain's cultural identity and economic landscape.

"Gastronomy tourism connects the public and private sectors while empowering local communities through sustainable practices and supply chain integration," she said.

The Minister pointed to Bahrain's 10% growth in accommodations and food services, emphasizing the country's unique

culinary offerings and the talents of its local chefs.

"Our chefs are not only skilled but are also champions of sustainability, engaging with local, regional, and international communities," Al Sairafi added.

## Regional collaboration in the Philippines

Frasco shared the Philippines' approach, which integrates gastronomy tourism into its National Tourism Development Plan.

She spotlighted the Cebu Call to Action, a framework developed during the UNWTO Regional Gastronomy Forum, which prioritizes sustainability, public-private partnerships, and support for local farmers and chefs.

"Gastronomy tourism increases the value proposition of destinations, uplifting local economies while ensuring sustainable practices," Frasco noted, adding that over 54% of travellers consider gastronomy a key reason for their journeys.

## Saudi Arabia's holistic vision

AlMusallam highlighted Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 strategy, which incorporates gastronomy to offer holistic tourism experiences.

"Gastronomy is not only a representation of culture but also a \$1 trillion global industry, projected to grow to \$4 trillion by 2032," AlMusallam said.

He showcased Saudi Arabia's

integration of cultural heritage sites like UNESCO-listed Diriyah with traditional culinary offerings to provide tourists with an immersive experience.

The Deputy Minister also discussed the role of the Saudi Culinary Commission in enhancing the country's gastronomic identity, focusing on collaboration between culture and tourism sectors.

## A collective vision for the future

The panel concluded with a shared vision of gastronomy tourism as a vital element of sustainable and inclusive growth.

Addressing challenges like food waste and the need for stronger policy frameworks, the discussion reaffirmed the sector's potential to drive innovation, foster cultural exchange, and support local economies.

This session reinforced Bahrain's leadership in global gastronomy tourism, positioning the Middle East as a rising force on the international culinary stage.

## Chef Lulwa showcases rich Bahraini cuisine

## When trust is broken

Stolen chequebook scheme nearly ruins Bahraini businessman's life

**B**etrayed by years of misplaced trust, a Bahraini businessman found himself at the centre of a fraud scandal after his signed blank chequebook was stolen and used to drain his finances, leaving him facing mounting debts and legal battles.

The trouble began when the businessman, relying on an Asian manager to handle his dealings with various companies, left a signed chequebook in his desk drawer.

What he thought was a practical move for convenience turned into his downfall when the manager betrayed him, stealing the chequebook to set a conspiracy in motion.

### Scheme

The manager, working with the owner of a rival company, carefully forged a scheme.

They filled out cheques with large, convincing sums and channelled the money into the accomplice's business.

This went unnoticed for a while, with the victim oblivious to the financial haemorrhage taking place under his nose.

### Flurry of demands

The businessman was eventually blindsided by a flurry of demands from creditors and legal notices.

Struggling to comprehend what had happened, he discovered his chequebook had been weaponised against him.

Court rulings soon followed,

threatening to wipe out his business entirely.

Efforts to prove the chequebook had been stolen fell flat, as the schemers had not only exploited his trust but also leveraged their prior business ties with his competitors to create an air of legitimacy around their fraud.

### Uphill battle

This left the businessman fighting an uphill battle against mounting claims, as the stolen cheques were cashed repeatedly.

Desperate for help, he turned to lawyer Fatima Al Khayat.

With lawyer Aisha Ahmed and their team, they painstakingly combed through every piece of evidence and witness statement.

Their persistence paid off when they managed to prove that the manager and his accomplice had misused the cheques for unlawful gain.

### Hard-won victory

The court cleared the businessman of wrongdoing, marking a hard-won victory.

But Al Khayat and her team didn't stop there.

They filed a civil suit against the fraudsters to recover the stolen money and seek damages for the financial and emotional harm inflicted on their client.

The High Civil Court ruled in their favour, ordering the culprits to repay the stolen funds, provide additional compensation, and cover all legal costs and fees.

## Father fined BD300 for child abuse

**A** Bahraini father has been fined BD300 after being convicted of physically and emotionally abusing his seven children.

The Court of Cassation upheld the conviction.

The Public Prosecution charged the father with child abuse, alleging he physically and emotionally mistreated his children, aged 4 to 16, who were under his care.

The prosecution argued that his actions – including physical assault, threats, and a failure to provide proper care and upbringing – posed a significant risk to the children's

safety and well-being.

The incident came to light when the children's mother filed a police report.

### Distressed

She stated that on the day of the incident, around 5pm, her children arrived at her home, visibly distressed.

They reported that their father had physically and emotionally abused them, including threats of violence and accusations of theft if they went to their mother's home.

The court found the father guilty based on the evidence presented, including the children's testimony and their mother's report.

## Court overturns two Asians' embezzlement conviction

**T**he High Appeals Court has overturned a previous one-year prison sentence for two Asian defendants who were convicted of embezzling over BD45,000 from a food supply company.

The case was brought to light by their partner in the business, who alleged that the two men had misappropriated goods intended for a restaurant they owned, ultimately harming the company's finances.

# Family betrayal

University student sentenced to six months in prison for robbing grandmother

**A** Bahraini university student has been sentenced to six months in prison for robbing his grandmother, in addition to a previous six-month sentence for defrauding his aunts of over BD24,000.

The student is accused of exploiting his grandmother by allegedly stealing BD4,000 through unauthorised transfers using the BenefitPay mobile banking application, all while living with her.

His earlier conviction stemmed from a series of fraudulent transactions between 2020 and 2023, where he used his aunts' electronic signatures and PINs to access their BenefitPay accounts and systematically



transferred significant sums to his own account.

### Financial hardship

The court recognised the severity of his actions and the financial hardship inflicted on his victims, ordering an interim

compensation of BD450 to the aunts while further legal proceedings were pending.

The new charges relate to similar allegations against his grandmother.

The Public Prosecution asserts that the student illicitly accessed her BenefitPay account, transferring BD4,000 to his personal account, which left her financially vulnerable.

The prosecution's case is supported by bank statements that clearly document the unauthorised transfers, providing strong evidence of the fraudulent activity.

### Routine check

The theft was discovered by the victim's son, who noticed a significant depletion in his mother's bank account during a routine check.

Upon further investigation, the full extent of the discrepancies was revealed.

Initially, the student admitted to withdrawing only BD800, but a thorough police investigation uncovered the total theft of BD4,000.

### Testimony

The situation is further aggravated by testimony from the victim's son, who stated that the student had previously used similar tactics to defraud his sisters, illustrating a troubling pattern of predatory behaviour.

One of the aunts corroborated this, confirming the student's previous actions against her and her sister, which led them to file a police report.

Investigations conducted across two different banks revealed further evidence of the student's fraudulent activities during the same period, reinforcing the prosecution's case and painting a clear picture of calculated financial exploitation.

## Building permit approval made simple

**B**ahrain is making it easier to secure building permits with the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture rolling out measures such as 'Welcome, Let's Get You Licensed' and 'Act to Correct'.

The aim is to reduce rule-breaking, speed up approvals, and assist over 12,000 applicants recorded this year.

Responding to a question from MP Jalal Kadhem Hassan, the ministry outlined a series of campaigns designed to simplify applications and ensure compliance before construction begins.

These include 'License Your Building,' 'A Day with the Building Permit Section,' and the 'Stage-Based Building Monitoring Form.'

From January to September, the Capital Municipality and

the municipalities of Muharraq, Northern, and Southern regions issued 12,205 permits for projects ranging from new builds and extensions to demolitions, fencing, and excavation.

At the same time, 2,375 violations were identified.

To improve the process, the ministry is working with other government bodies to update construction rules and approvals.

It is also using aerial imagery to detect breaches early, ensuring greater transparency.

### Violations

Inspection teams continue to act on violations, prioritising complaints raised through 'Tawasul,' Bahrain's national system for suggestions and grievances.

This approach has helped



address issues more quickly and improved services for residents.

The ministry says these

changes will reduce breaches, ease the process for applicants, and enhance Bahrain's urban appeal.

## Asian drug ring leader receives life sentence

**A** life sentence for the ring-leader of a drug-smuggling gang and 10-year prison terms for two Asian expats have marked the downfall of a brazen attempt to bring 5.3kg of methamphetamine and 1.55kg of heroin into Bahrain, stashed in suitcases and smuggled through the airport.

The First High Criminal Court also ordered the two expats to pay fines of BD3,000 each and deported them after serving their sentences.

In a surprising twist, a sixty-year-old accomplice, though convicted of involvement, was spared punishment.



All confiscated items were ordered to be destroyed.

The case came to light when the first defendant arrived at Bahrain International Airport from her home country.

Customs officials, suspicious of her luggage, discovered 5.3 kilograms of meth and 1.55 kilo-

grams of heroin hidden within.

Investigations revealed she was working under the orders of the gang's ringleader, the fourth defendant, with the help of another network member.

Police, acting on a warrant, arrested the second defendant

at her home, where 180 dinars were recovered.

During questioning, she admitted liaising with the first defendant before her arrival, assisting her in smuggling the drugs under the fourth defendant's direction.

### Trap

Officers set a trap for the fourth defendant by persuading the second defendant to make contact.

Acting on his instructions, the fourth defendant sent the third defendant to collect the drugs at a pre-arranged spot.

Police arrested him upon arrival.

# New features and fresh vibes ahead

Al Duraz Park to close today for major four-month renovation

Rubber playground floors, brighter lights, and new sports equipment are on the way as Al Duraz Park shuts its gates today for an extensive four-month refurbishment.

The closure follows approval from the Northern Municipal Council for a plan to breathe new life into the park.

Engineer Lamya Yousif Al Fadhala, Director General of the Northern Municipality, backed the proposal during a recent site visit, where she emphasised the need for urgent improvements.

The overhaul will bring rubber flooring, artificial grass, upgraded lighting, and a variety of new equipment for children and sports enthusiasts.

Councillor Basim Abu Idrees, representing the second constituency in the Northern Governorate, expressed his thanks to the government for backing local projects and driving progress in the area.

He particularly recognised the leadership of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin

Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, in supporting community developments.

The renovation work is expected to take four months.

Abu Idrees apologised for any disruption caused by the closure and urged residents to avoid the surrounding area during the work for their own safety.

Al Duraz village itself is undergoing wider improvements.

## First phase

Sixteen streets have been resurfaced as part of a first phase, with additional roads set to follow in the coming days.

A recent inspection with engineers from the Ministry of Works and the Northern Municipality, along with feedback gathered through social media, also revealed areas in need of better street lighting, which are

## Expanded benefits for senior citizens on track

Changes

The Shura Council’s Services Committee, chaired by Dr Jameela Salman, has forwarded two significant draft laws to the Council’s bureau.

These bills propose key changes to the allocation of Tamkeen funding and expansion of benefits for senior citizens.

The first draft focuses on amending Article 4 of Law No. (57) of 2006, which established the Labour Fund (Tamkeen).

This amendment, built upon a revised proposal from the House of Representatives, aims to redirect Tamkeen’s support for projects, programmes, and financial and consulting services.

The proposed changes would prioritise companies and institutions with Bahraini ownership, excluding those wholly owned by non-Bahraini nationals from receiving Tamkeen funding.

The goal is to ensure that Tamkeen resources are primarily directed towards benefiting Bahraini businesses and entrepreneurs.

The second draft law addresses amendments to Article 9 of Law No. (58) of 2009, concerning the rights of senior citizens.

This bill, also based on a revised proposal from the House of Representatives, seeks to significantly increase benefits for Bahrain’s elderly population.

The High Civil Court has ruled in favour of a plaintiff in an eight-year-old property dispute, annulling a sale agreement and restoring full ownership of a house.

The court’s decision, detailed by lawyer Hussain Salem, hinges on the defendant’s failure to provide proof of payment for the agreed-upon purchase price of BD 100,000.

The court has ordered the Land and Survey Department to amend the property title

deed, transferring complete ownership back to the plaintiff.

According to Mr Hussain, the plaintiff’s lawyer, the case arose when the defendant, the plaintiff’s former spouse, filed a lawsuit seeking to claim half-ownership of the property.

The defendant based his claim on a sale agreement allegedly made through a power of attorney granted to their children for the management and disposal of the property.

However, Mr Hussain argued that this power of attorney was exceeded, constituting misuse without the plaintiff’s knowledge or consent.

## UN treaty to protect elderly from abuse and neglect

Older people are increasingly vulnerable to violence, neglect, and abuse, particularly in areas struck by wars and disasters.

This alarming reality has sparked a call for a United Nations treaty to ensure their protection.

Dr Jehad Al Fadhel, Second Deputy Chairperson of the Shura Council, appealed for global action during the Arab Parliamentary Dialogue Session on Elderly Protection, hosted by ESCWA.

Dr Al Fadhel pressed for a shared Arab database to pool expertise and practical examples in elderly care.

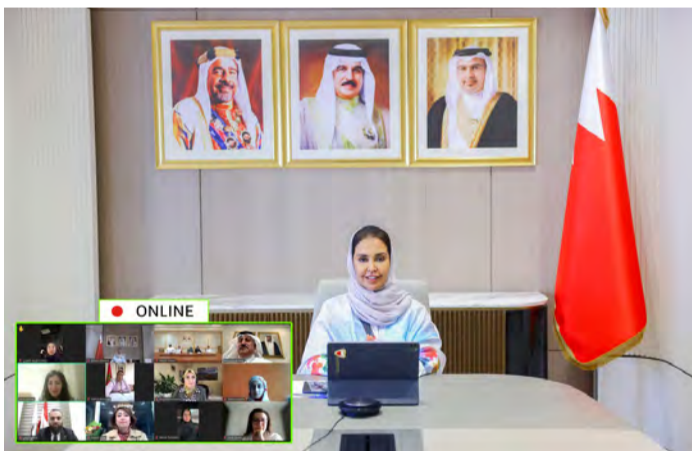
She also urged parliamentarians to spearhead efforts for a UN convention, akin to those for women, children, and people with disabilities.

### Social support

In her address, she drew attention to Bahrain’s example,

citing Article 5 of the Constitution, which guarantees social support for the elderly, alongside state-provided healthcare and insurance.

She also noted Bahrain’s pioneering step in creating a National Committee for the Elderly in 1984, a body that continues to function under the Ministry of Social Development.

Dr Al Fadhel described the 2009 Elderly Rights Law as a landmark achievement, ensur-

ing care services and strict penalties for neglect or abuse.

Additional legal measures, such as the 2006 Social Security Law, provide financial aid to seniors without family support.

### Retirees

Bahrain has allocated BD43 million for social security in 2023–2024 and BD355 million to improve the living standards of retirees — steps she said reflect

Bahrain’s dedication to its older population.

She called on Arab and global lawmakers to step up protections, particularly for those caught in conflicts or crises, where the plight of the elderly is often overlooked.

By working together, she argued, countries can establish a meaningful framework to protect the dignity and rights of older people worldwide.

## Proposal to curb annoying marketing calls

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee of the Shura Council met to discuss a proposed law aimed at reducing the nuisance of unsolicited marketing and advertising calls.

The meeting, chaired by Khalid Almaskati, focused on a proposal to amend certain provisions of Law No. (35) of 2012

concerning consumer protection. The proposal, submitted by Shura Council members Lina Habib Qasim, Dr Jehad Abdullah Al Fadhel, Dalal Jasim Al Zayed, Hala Ramzi Fayezi, and Hisham Hashim Al Qassab, was thoroughly reviewed.

Ms. Qasim and Ms. Fayezi, two of the proposal’s authors, were present to address the committee’s questions and concerns.

The committee engaged in a detailed discussion of the proposal’s objectives and principles, along with several inquiries regarding the proposed amendments to the Consumer Protection Law. The aim is to ensure the amendments effectively achieve the proposal’s goals upon implementation. The proposed law includes adding a clause to the Consumer Protection Law.

This clause would mandate that providers and advertisers avoid disturbing consumers during marketing calls and refrain from manipulating consumer behaviour to purchase unnecessary goods or services.

The proposal also empowers the relevant minister to issue a decision outlining rules and regulations for marketing communications.

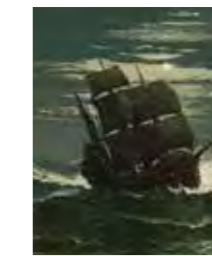

News in brief

Germany yesterday said that it was delivering 4,000 AI-guided drones to Ukraine, even as it has refused to send Kyiv the long-range Taurus missile system. Berlin has been the second-biggest supplier of military aid to Ukraine in its fight against Russia's invasion. Defence Minister Boris Pistorius told reporters at an event in Bavaria that the drones being provided "were directed and supported by artificial intelligence" and that they could "take out the enemy's electronic drone defences". The drones "can be delivered very quickly" and could be "deployed 30-40 kilometres (19-25 miles) behind the front line and hit combat posts, logistics hubs among other targets", Pistorius said. Along some parts of the front line in Ukraine, such a distance would reach into Russian territory.

US, Philippines sign deal on sharing military information

US and Philippine defence chiefs signed an agreement yesterday on sharing classified military information and technology, as the long-time treaty allies deepen cooperation in a bid to counter Chinese influence in the region. US Defence Secretary Lloyd Austin signed the deal with his Philippine counterpart Gilberto Teodoro at the start of a visit to Manila that will also include a meeting with President Ferdinand Marcos. The General Security of Military Information Agreement allows for the sharing of classified information that could benefit a US ally's national defence, and streamlines the sale of certain classified technologies, officials said.

Iran said yesterday it hoped talks on its nuclear programme would be conducted "away from political pressure and considerations" ahead of a UN nuclear agency board meeting this week. "All our efforts and our emphasis in our talks were to allow the International Atomic Energy Agency to do its technical work away from the destructive and evil pressures of some parties," Iran's foreign ministry spokesman Esmael Baghaei told reporters in his weekly press conference. Agency chief Rafael Grossi travelled on Wednesday to Iran for talks with top officials, including President Masoud Pezeshkian. The visit came ahead of a meeting of the IAEA's board of governors this week in Vienna, in which the UK, Germany and France are expected to pass a new resolution critical of Iran. Baghaei expressed hopes that the parties would "allow the issues between Iran and the agency to continue in a technical way and away from political pressures and considerations". He hailed Grossi's visit as "beneficial and positive", saying it brought "good understandings" between Tehran and the agency.

Trump taps big tech critic Carr to lead US communications agency

US President-elect Donald Trump tapped Republican Brendan Carr, an Elon Musk-backed critic of big tech, to lead the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), calling him a "warrior for Free Speech" in a statement on Sunday.

Carr has "fought against the regulatory Lawfare that has stifled Americans' freedoms" and will "end the regulatory onslaught that has been crippling America's Job Creators and Innovators, and ensure that the FCC delivers for rural America," Trump said in the statement. Carr said on Musk's social platform X that he was "humbled and honored" to take on the role of FCC chairman.

"We must dismantle the censorship cartel and restore free speech rights for everyday Americans," he wrote in another post Sunday. It is a phrase he has used repeatedly, posting on Friday: "Facebook, Google, Apple, Microsoft & others have played central roles in the censorship cartel," adding that it "must be dismantled."

Carr was already the senior Republican on the FCC, an independent agency that regulates licenses for television and radio, pricing of home internet, and other communications issues in the United States. Long rumored as a contender for FCC chair, he has built an alliance with billionaire Musk -- Trump's wealthiest backer, whose Starlink satellite internet service could benefit from access to federal cash.

# G20 wrestles with wars, climate in run-up to Trump

Chinese President Xi Jinping warned yesterday the world faces "a new period of major changes" as G20 leaders met in Brazil two months before Donald Trump returns to the White House. US President Joe Biden was attending his last summit of the world's leading economies, but as a lame duck eclipsed by Xi who has cast himself as a protector of the international order in the Trump 2.0 era.

World leaders are meeting for two days to try to jumpstart stalled UN climate talks and overcome their differences on wars in the Middle East and Ukraine, and extracting more tax from the super-rich.

In a nod to the return of China hawk Trump, Xi told British Prime Minister Keir Starmer the world was "entering a new period of major changes."

As leaders lined up to meet the most powerful man in Rio, Xi added that Britain and China would "shoulder the important task of... responding to global challenges."

Feeding the hungry

Brazil's President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva was using his hosting duties to promote left-wing issues close to his heart, including fighting hunger and climate change.

At the opening of the summit he launched the centerpiece of his G20 presidency: a Global Alliance against Poverty and Hunger, backed by 81 countries, which aims to feed half a million people by 2030.

Before the summit, the 79-year-old host, who is attempting to chart a non-aligned course in international affairs, said he would try to steer discussions away from the wars in Ukraine and the Middle East.

"Because if not, we will not discuss other things which are more important for people that are not

at war," he said. But Biden's decision on the eve of the summit to allow Ukraine to use long-range US missiles to strike inside Russia threatens to escalate a war Trump has vowed to quickly end.

Pressure for a climate deal

G20 leaders are under pressure to try to rescue UN climate talks in Azerbaijan, which have stalled on the issue of greater climate finance for developing countries.

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres has called on the world's biggest economies, who account

for 80 percent of global emissions, to show "leadership" on the issue in Rio. The UN is seeking \$1 trillion a year for developing countries to cope with global warming.

But rich countries are stalling, say they want fast-developing economies like China and the Gulf states to also put their hands in their pockets.

The meeting comes in a year marked by another grim litany of extreme weather events, including Brazil's worst wildfire season in over a decade, fuelled by a record drought blamed at least partly on climate change.

The get-together caps a farewell diplomatic tour by Biden which took him to Lima for a meeting of Asia-Pacific trading partners, and then to the Amazon in the first such visit for a sitting US president.

Conspicuously absent from the summit is Russian President Vladimir Putin, whose arrest is sought by the International Criminal Court over the Ukraine war.

## Trump confirms plan to use military for mass deportation

President-elect Donald Trump confirmed yesterday that he plans to declare a national emergency on border security and use the US military to carry out a mass deportation of undocumented migrants.

Immigration was a top issue in the election campaign, and Trump has promised to deport millions and stabilize the border with Mexico after record numbers of migrants crossed illegally during President Joe Biden's administration.

On his social media platform Truth Social, Trump amplified a recent post by a conservative activist that said the president-elect was "prepared to declare a national emergency and will use military assets to reverse the Biden invasion through a mass deportation program."

Alongside the repost, Trump commented, "True!"

Trump sealed a remarkable comeback to the presidency in

his November 5 defeat of Democratic Vice President Kamala Harris.

He has been announcing a cabinet featuring immigration hardliners, naming former Immigration and Customs Enforcement acting chief Tom Homan as his "border czar."

Homan appeared at the Republican National Convention in July, telling supporters: "I got a message to the millions of illegal immigrants that Joe Biden's released in our country:

You better start packing now." Authorities estimate that some 11 million people are living in the United States illegally. Trump's deportation plan is expected directly to impact around 20 million families.

While the US government has struggled for years to manage its southern border with Mexico, Trump has super-charged concerns by claiming an "invasion" is underway by migrants he says will rape and murder Americans.

## US permission to fire missiles on Russia no game-changer: experts

Permission from Washington for Ukraine to strike Russian territory with American-supplied long-range missiles may have come too late and hedged with too many restrictions to slow Moscow's advance, experts warn.

US President Joe Biden did not grant Ukrainian leader Volodymyr Zelensky's request for deep strike capability until two months before he hands the keys to the White House to Ukraine aid sceptic Donald Trump.

The shift comes as Russian forces press their advance through eastern Ukraine, claiming on Monday they had captured a new village south of Pokrovsk -- a crucial logistics hub for the defenders.

Moscow's troops took a further 60 square kilometres (23 square miles) over the weekend, according to an AFP analysis based on data from the US-based Institute for the Study of War (ISW).

That brought the figure for November so far to 458 square kilometres -- on track to beat October's total of 610, a record since Russia invaded Ukraine in February 2022.

## EU widens sanctions on Iran over support for Russia

The European Union on Monday widened sanctions against Iran over its support for Russia's war on Ukraine, including targeting vessels and ports used to transfer drones and missiles.

In a move decried by Tehran, the 27-nation bloc said it prohibited the export, transfer, supply or sale from the EU to Iran of components used to make missiles and unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs).

It also banned any transaction with ports "owned, operated or controlled" by sanctioned individuals and entities -- or otherwise used to supply Russia with drones, missiles, related technology and components.

"This measure includes the access to facilities of the ports and locks, such as Amira-

bad and Anzali, and the provision of any services to vessels," the EU said in a statement as the bloc's foreign ministers met in Brussels.

Amirabad and Anzali are two Iranian ports on the Caspian Sea.

Assistance could still be provided to vessels in need under certain circumstances such as for reasons of maritime safety, the EU added.

The bloc also adopted restrictive measures against Iran's state-run shipping company IRISL, its director Mohammad Reza Khia-bani, and three Russian shipping firms accused of ferrying weapons across the Caspian Sea.

Brussels had already imposed sanctions on prominent Iranian officials and entities, including airlines, accused of aiding Russia's war effort.

## 'No plan B' to aid Palestinian refugees: UNRWA chief

There is no alternative to the UN agency supporting Palestinian refugees, its chief said yesterday, following Israel's order to ban the organisation that coordinates nearly all aid in war-ravaged Gaza.

"There is no plan B," the head of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees, Philippe Lazzarini, told reporters in Geneva.

Within the UN "there is no other agency geared to provide the same activities", providing not only aid in Gaza but also primary health care and ed-

ucation to hundreds of thousands of children, he said.

He has called on the UN, which created UNRWA in 1949, to prevent the implementation of a ban on the organisation in Israel and occupied East Jerusalem, which was approved by the Israeli parliament last month.

The ban, which is due to take effect in January, sparked global condemnation, including from key Israeli backer the United States.

UNRWA provides assistance to nearly six million Palestinian refugees across Gaza, the West Bank, Lebanon, Jordan and Syria.

## Telecom cable linking Finland, Germany cut

An undersea telecommunications cable linking Finland and Germany has been cut for unknown reasons, Finnish network operator Cinia said yesterday. The fault was detected in the undersea cable C-Lion1, Cinia said.

"Due to the fault, the services provided over the C-Lion1 cable are down. The cause of the fault is being investigated," the company said. A Cinia

spokesman quoted by Finnish media added that "all the fibre connections in it are cut".

But internet traffic had not suffered any disruptions, said Samuli Bergstrom, head of the Cybersecurity Centre at the Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (Trafi-com).

The 1,172-kilometre (730-mile) fibre-optic cable has carried communications between Helsinki and Germany's Rostock since 2016.

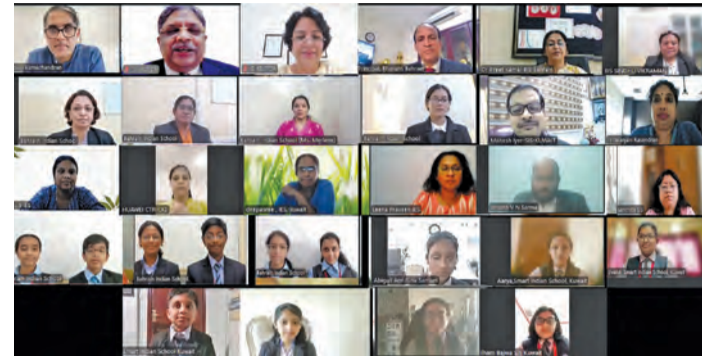
## BIS hosts SDG Student Exchange Program

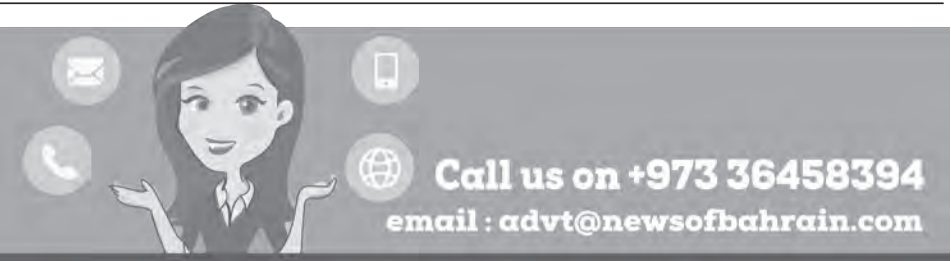

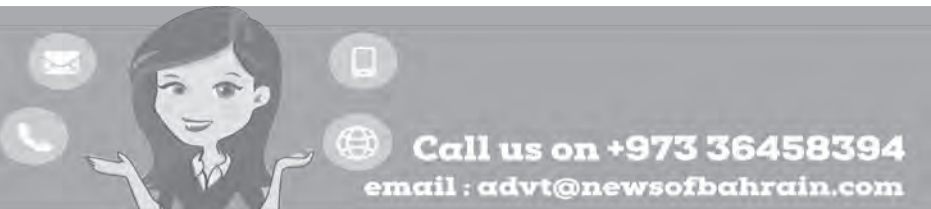

Coach Dragan Talajic led Bahrain's final training session last night at the Bahrain Football Association (BFA) grounds in Riffa.

Injuries have slightly disrupted both camps. For Australia, winger Nishan Velupillay is out after suffering an ankle injury last week against Saudi Arabia, a blow to Popovic's plans. Bahrain, meanwhile, continues to rely on a core squad that has shown tenacity throughout the qualifiers.

The stakes couldn't be higher. Bahrain sits fourth in the group

with five points, trailing Australia, Saudi Arabia, and China, all tied with six points each. Japan tops the table with 13 points, making them favorites to clinch one of the two automatic qualification spots.

With just five matches left in this stage, tonight's result will significantly influence Bahrain's chances of finishing in the top two.

### Key battles

The matchup promises intriguing duels. Bahrain's midfield, led by Mohammed Marhoon, will look to control the tempo against Australia's physical and disciplined style. Defensively, the hosts must neutralize the aerial threat posed by

Australia's towering forwards, while captain Sayed Dhiya Saed will aim to inspire the attack and find the net.

Ticket sales remain brisk, with supporters eager to back the national team in their quest for glory. VIP seats are priced at BD20, while Category 1 tickets are available for BD10, purchasable at the BFA headquarters in Riffa until kickoff.

Beyond tonight, Bahrain's path to qualification features key fixtures in 2025, including a critical away clash with Japan in March. But for now, all eyes are on the National Stadium, where Bahrain hopes to seize the moment and keep their World Cup dream alive.

# Bahrain drag racing roars back

Top international drag racers kick off 2024/2025 season at Bahrain International Circuit

● **First of five rounds begins at Bahrain International Circuit this week**

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), 'The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East', is bringing back the region's biggest and most competitive drag racing series this week for another action-packed campaign that will be lighting up the strip.

The first of five rounds in the 2024/2025 Bahrain Drag Racing Championship takes place from today until Friday in Sakhir, with top drag racing teams and drivers from around the world set to compete.

They will be going head-to-head along BIC's world-class quarter-mile drag strip – part of the Worldwide Network of the U.S.-based National Hot Rod Association (NHRA).

Test and Tune on Tuesday and Wednesday from 6pm to 12midnight. Qualifying will then be held on Thursday, which will set the elimination ladders for race day on Friday. Action on both days is scheduled to be held from 4pm onwards.

Fans looking to attend the season-opener can watch all the excitement on the strip from BIC's Beyon Grandstand. Tickets

for each night of Test and Tune are BD2 apiece, while tickets for qualifying and race day are BD3 per person for each day.

Tickets can be purchased online at bahraingp.com, by calling the BIC Hotline on +973-17450000, or at the gate.

Racing this season will be held in 14 categories for both cars and motorbikes. The cars classes include the Index 7.5, Pro 29.5 V8, Outlaw 4 Cylinder, Outlaw 6 Cylinder, Index 10.00, Index 9.00, Index 8.50, Competition 4.5, and Pro Mod; while the motorbike classes are Pro Street Bike, Street Fight 9.5, Index 8.5 Bike, Outlaw Bike, and Street Fight.

The cars classes will be headlined by the ultra-competitive Pro Mod category, which is set to feature heated battles between top crews and their drivers – among whom are recently crowned NHRA world champions Bahrain1 Racing, owned by His Majesty the King's Personal Representative and Supreme Council for Environment Chairman His Highness Shaikh Abdullah bin Hamad Al Khalifa.

Bahrain1 are perennial title contenders in the kingdom, and they are expected to once again be in the hunt for their category's crown.

Also available to fans attending on each night of the drag races is the Dragster Experience – BIC's most adrenaline-pumping passenger activity.

Known as 'the Fastest Ride

The 2024/2025 calendar of the Bahrain Drag Racing Championship is set to feature five rounds.

Round two will be held from 10 to 13 December, and then round three will take place next year from 21 to 24 January. The season's fourth and penultimate round is then scheduled for 11 to 14 February, setting the stage for the grand finale the very next weekend on 18 to 21 February.
