The forum, held on 18-19 November 2024 at the Bahrain International Exhibition Centre, brought together chefs, experts, and industry leaders for a packed programme of events.


Topics included marketing destinations through food and using culinary diplomacy to promote culture.

UNEP Advocate on Food Waste Leyla Fathallah praised Bahrain’s efforts to reduce food waste through initiatives like the ‘Recipe of Change’ campaign, which achieved a 65% reduction during Ramadhan.

“Food connects us, reflecting both culture and identity, while

Mary Hayrapetyan of the World Intellectual Property Or-

ganisation underscored the importance of intellectual property in preserving culinary traditions, advocating for geographical in-

ed the need for cross-sector collaboration, calling gastronomy “a powerful tool for fostering human connections and preserving intangible heritage.”

Bahrain’s Tourism Strategy for 2022-2026 places gastronomy tourism at its heart, aligning with broader goals of sustainability and global competitiveness. Buhiji welcomed attendees to explore Bahrain’s unique culinary experiences, saying, “Let this event inspire us to build a sustainable and inclusive global tourism industry that honours our shared heritage and creates opportunities for growth.”

Safeguarding workers’ rights



Expat drivers under fire

MPs debate Bahrain's growing traffic congestion woes but remain divided over solutions

The Parliament debated Bahrain's worsening traffic congestion yesterday, with some MPs blaming expat drivers for clogging roads while others called for urgent infrastructure upgrades and stricter planning.

The session, chaired by Abdulnabi Salman, the First Deputy Speaker, saw a range of proposals addressing the long-term challenges of urban growth and daily gridlock.

The Speaker, Ahmed Al Musallam, stepped down to participate directly in the debate.

MP Hassan Ebrahim warned of the economic toll caused by congestion.

Productivity

"The daily gridlock is eroding productivity in both public and private sectors while also harming Bahrain's economy and tourism," he said.

He proposed measures including flexible working hours, remote working arrangements, road expansions, and improvements to public transport.

"We must act decisively to ease the congestion choking our roads," he urged.

MP Jalal Kadhem, however, drew attention to expat drivers, suggesting that their licences be linked to residency permits to prevent misuse of the roads.

Better oversight

"We need rules that work for everyone and ensure better oversight," he said, adding that unregulated access to driving licences by expatriates contributes to congestion.

He also called for a ban on the personal use of government vehicles outside work hours.

Hassan Bu Khammas pointed to the poor planning of roads in areas like northern Hidd and Qalali, describing Shaikh Khalifa bridge as a "bottleneck."

He criticised the unregulated use of vehicles for delivery services, which he argued worsens the issue.

Immediate remedies

heavy vehicles," he said, calling for stricter enforcement and immediate remedies.

MP Dr Hesham Al Ashiri demanded clarity from the Ministry of Works on the opening of Muharrag's ring road, questioning delays despite visible progress.

"We see fences, lights, and a road that looks ready, yet there's no official announcement. The Minister must give us a firm date," he said, speculating the project might coincide with National Day celebrations.

His Excellency Ebrahim Al Hawaj, Minister of Works, assured MPs of the government's focus on maintaining high standards in infrastructure development, aligning with Vision 2030 and preparations for Vision 2050.

Continuous improvement

"The government prioritises continuous improvement of infrastructure to meet global standards, enhancing Bahrain's investment appeal," he said.

He added that the Traffic Council, chaired by the Minister of Interior, coordinates with stakeholders to address mobility issues through traffic studies and consultancy work.

"These studies help prioritise and execute projects, whether it's improving traffic signal systems, enhancing public transport, or managing road networks more effectively," he explained.

Al Hawaj also noted that "urgent solutions" packages are being implemented to resolve congestion hotspots while longer-term plans are developed.

Lack of foresight

MP Mohsen Al Asbool criticised the lack of foresight in infrastructure planning, citing East Sitra City as an example.

"We're opening massive housing developments without proper traffic solutions. This is short-sighted planning at its worst," he said, pressing for strategies that span decades rather than quick fixes.

Mahmood Fardan called for solutions that address the root causes of congestion rather than shifting the problem from one

area to another.

National issue

"Traffic congestion isn't confined to a single governorate — it's a national issue," he said, calling for a coordinated and sustainable approach.

MPs broadly agreed on the need for clear priorities, coordinated planning, and quicker execution of solutions.

Proposals included redistributing schools, creating dedicated lanes for buses and bicycles, and modernising public transport systems.

"Effective planning and bold measures are what's needed if we're to free Bahrain's roads from the grip of congestion," Kadhem concluded.

MP faints amid tense immunity debate

The Parliament's closed-door session yesterday took an unexpected turn when MP Mohammed Al Olaiwi fainted just before voting on the motion to lift immunity from MP Hamad Al Doy.

Sources within Parliament reported that Al Olaiwi experienced sudden dizziness during the session, leading to his collapse.

The on-site medical team rushed to provide first aid, successfully reviving him shortly thereafter.

An ambulance arrived at the Parliament gates to assess his condition further and transport him to the hospital if needed.

The incident occurred amid tense proceedings, as MPs were gearing up to vote on the controversial immunity issue — a matter that has sparked heated debates over recent days.

Concerned colleagues expressed their wishes for Al Olaiwi's swift recovery, emphasising their hope for his health and well-being.

Bahraini husband claims legal win

Freed from child, spousal support after wife's four-year absence

A Bahraini man has successfully sued his wife, securing a court ruling that absolves him of his financial obligations for child and spousal support.

The case, detailed by lawyer Abdulatheem Hubail, centers on the wife's departure from the marital home four years ago and her subsequent refusal to return, despite two court orders mandating her return. The husband's legal action followed unsuccessful attempts at reconciliation through family mediation. He argued that his wife, with whom he has children, initially received a temporary court order for child and spousal support ten years ago, which was duly executed.

However, a year later, he obtained a court order compelling his wife's return to the marital home. She left again in 2020, prompting a second court order for her return.

Return

By 2024, the wife explicitly stated her unwillingness to return.

A subsequent court ruling declared her in a state of nushuz (disobedience/rebellion in an Islamic marital context)



and deemed her ineligible for support since 2020.

The husband then filed his lawsuit to discharge his accumulated financial obligations, arguing that the lack of spousal cohabitation rendered the support payments unwarranted.

The court, in its deliberations, considered the legal principle that a wife forfeits her right to support if she leaves the marital home without justifiable cause.

Absent

Since the wife had been absent since 2020 without such cause, the court ruled in the husband's favour.

The Sharia court's final decision discharged the husband from all financial obligations for child and spousal support from 2020 until the date of the ruling.

This effectively clears the husband's debt related to these payments.

20% Bahrainisation rule for tenders approved

The Parliament has approved a proposal requiring companies bidding for government tenders to ensure at least 20 per cent of their workforce is Bahraini.

The measure, designed to tackle unemployment and prevent misuse of Bahrainisation certificates, passed by majority vote, though MP Muneer Seroor opposed it, calling for a more ambitious target of 50 per cent.

The move seeks to give more jobs to Bahrainis in service contracts, with compliance overseen by the Ministry of Labour or other relevant bodies.

Backers said it is a step towards reducing reliance on foreign workers in common roles such as consultancy and

accounting.

Worry

MP Mohammed Al Rafai voiced worry about companies abusing the system to appear compliant.

"Investigations showed firms gaining Bahrainisation certificates just to win tenders. This

undermines the purpose of the rule, and the Ministry of Labour must ensure proper enforcement," he said.

Dr Hisham Al Ashiri, one of the proposal's backers, pointed to a growing trend of contracts going to foreign firms.

"Many of these deals involve general services that Bahrainis

could easily handle. By setting a minimum 20 per cent Bahrainisation rate, we can create more chances for our workforce," he said.

While noting the challenges faced by sectors like construction, he pressed for higher rates in less labour-heavy fields.

Starting point

MP Mohammed Al Ma'arafi described the 20 per cent figure as 'a starting point', urging steady increases over time.

However, MP Muneer Seroor dismissed the threshold as too low.

"This doesn't give Bahrainis their due. A 50 per cent minimum would better reflect their worth and skills," he said, praising the strength and talent of the local workforce.

Woman accused of forced labour

A woman is facing charges of human trafficking and forced labour after allegedly exploiting her domestic worker for a year and a half without pay or leave.

The worker escaped and reported the abuse to authorities.

According to the victim's account, she came to Bahrain to work as a domestic helper for the accused.

While she received wag-

es for the first year and a half of her three-year employment, she was not paid for the subsequent 18 months.

She eventually fled and reported the incident.

Investigations revealed that the accused failed to pay the worker's wages for several months, paying only BD50 per month instead of the agreed-upon BD70.

Furthermore, a criminal record check revealed that the accused has faced similar charges in the past.

The Parliament has approved a proposal to achieve full Bahrainisation in nursing roles at Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC) and health centres, despite concerns it targets an already accomplished goal.

The Ministry of Health had previously announced that all nursing positions in health centres were filled by Bahrainis.

MP Dr Muneer Seroor, who put forward the proposal, argued for its importance, saying: “Nurses in Bahrain should be Bahraini. Nursing is a humanitarian profession, and cultural understanding is essential.”

However, MP Khalid Buanaq dismissed the proposal as unnecessary.

Resources

“The Ministry of Health confirmed last year that Bahrainisation in health centres had already reached 100 per cent.

Resources would be better spent addressing the employment of Bahraini doctors and increasing medical scholarships,” he said.

Buanaq also called on the Ministry of Education to increase funding for medical studies, echoing calls for more support for aspiring healthcare workers.

MP Zainab Abdulameer suggested the proposal should focus on increasing scholarships for nursing, particularly for high-achieving students eager to pursue the profession.

Names

MP Mamdouh Al Saleh questioned the need for the proposal altogether, stating: “There are no unemployed Bahraini nurses. If anyone claims otherwise, they should provide names to clarify the situation.”

The Services Committee, which reviewed the proposal, unanimously recommended its approval.

They cited the importance of ensuring national employment

in the healthcare sector, even if Bahrainisation targets in some areas had already been met.

Hiring policy

In its response, the Ministry of Health reiterated its hiring policy: “Bahrainis are always the first choice for medical and nursing roles. We aim to fill vacancies with qualified nationals while ensuring the continuity of healthcare services.”

The Civil Service Bureau also weighed in, referencing regulations under Law No. 23 of 2018 and Decision No. 52 of 2021, which govern employment in public healthcare facilities.

Both frameworks aim to ensure Bahrainis have priority in hiring decisions, as long as there are sufficient resources and suitable candidates.

Achievements

Dr Seroor said the proposal was inspired by the achievements of Bahraini healthcare workers during the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as the steady

stream of graduates from the College of Health & Sport Sciences.

He argued the move could create additional opportunities for Bahraini jobseekers in the sector.

Buanaq, however, remained sceptical, reiterating that the proposal addressed an issue already resolved.

Real gaps

“We should focus on the real gaps, such as employing Bahraini doctors and providing more scholarships for medical studies,” he said.

The Ministry of Health provided data to Parliament outlining the current composition of nursing staff at public facilities, showing the dominance of Bahraini workers in these roles.

The debate over the proposal has shone a light on broader questions about how resources should be allocated in Bahrain's healthcare system to best serve both its workforce and its patients.

Off the hook

MP retains immunity amid claims of ‘unethical practices’ in Amwaj

MP Hamad Al Doy has escaped prosecution for labelling Amwaj Island's shores as “rife with prostitution” last May.

During a fiery closed-door session yesterday, 30 MPs voted to shield him with parliamentary immunity, sparking outrage from critics who claim the decision sets a dangerous precedent.

The accusations, brought by fellow MPs Ahmed Al Salloom and Khalid Buanaq, were dismissed by Al Doy as politically motivated attacks designed to silence his scrutiny of the area.

The controversy erupted during a parliamentary session when Al Doy accused Amwaj's shores of inappropriate behaviour, sparking accusations from MPs Ahmed Al Salloom and Khalid Buanaq that his comments insulted the island's residents and tarnished their reputation.

Matters escalated when Al Doy reinforced his stance on X (formerly Twitter), challenging the complainants to consult the public on whether they condoned the behaviours he criticised, while reaffirming his principles and values.

Before the vote, the Council opted to hold the debate behind closed doors, ejecting journalists and media staff to allow a more discreet discussion.

Public scrutiny

Sources said the decision to close the session was made to address the sensitive matter away from public scrutiny.

Parliamentary rules permit private sessions if the majority agrees they are needed.

During the session, Al Doy presented his defence, arguing that the complaint was politically driven.

He claimed it was an attempt to block his efforts to scrutinise issues in Amwaj, particularly as one of the complainants heads the homeowners' association for the area.

Conflict of interest

Al Doy suggested this created a conflict of interest and said the complaint would not have been filed had he not spoken out about alleged failings in the area.

30

MPs voted to shield Al Doy with parliamentary immunity.

While Al Doy expressed a willingness to reconcile, he noted that attempts to resolve the matter had failed because the complainants demanded he issue a public apology and refrain from raising issues related to Amwaj in future.

Al Doy said these demands were evidence of the complainant's personal and political nature.

He also defended his choice of words, saying that ‘prostitution’ had been used in earlier parliamentary discussions without issue.

Comments

He clarified that his comments were not aimed at Amwaj residents, many of whom he said he holds in high regard, but were instead intended to protect Bahraini families.

He also highlighted his decision not to share images or videos of alleged incidents to protect Bahrain's standing.

Al Doy said his post on X was a natural extension of his parliamentary remarks and argued that he was exercising his right to speak freely.

The post included a call for the complainants to consult

the public on whether they supported the behaviours Al Doy criticised.

Vote

Efforts to mediate between the MPs, led by the Speaker and others, failed to resolve the issue, leading to yesterday's vote.

Reports from inside the closed session described a tense atmosphere, with MPs sharply divided on how to handle the matter.

The decision to uphold Al Doy's immunity may close this chapter, but the dispute over Amwaj's shores and the political rifts it has exposed are likely to rumble on.

Muharraq Council pushes for key projects

The Muharraq Municipal Council has issued a series of recommendations in its weekly meeting aimed at improving infrastructure and addressing resident concerns.

Key decisions include plans for coastal development, building regulation reform, and re-

solving a dispute over the removal of landscaping in Diyar Al Muharraq.

The council strongly advocated for the development of Halat Bu Maher's coastline into a public beach, benefiting residents of the fourth constituency and the wider Muharraq governorate.

They have called for immediate budgetary allocation and the commencement of preliminary

design work.

To ease development restrictions, the council proposed increasing the building-to-land ratio in Diyar Al Muharraq from 120% to 180%.

This adjustment is intended to simplify building expansions and facade renovations for residents.

A proposal for a dedicated hotline for reporting emergency

service issues to the Ministry of Works was also submitted.

Landscaping

In a separate but significant matter, the council is addressing the Minister of Municipalities regarding complaints from Diyar Al Muharraq residents concerning the removal of landscaping from in front of their homes.

Sorcery scam lands fraudster in court

Sorcery-fuelled trickery and money-laundering have brought a man to court, accused of obtaining cash, a house, and two cars through deceptive spells.

His trial is set to begin on 24 November at the First High Criminal Court, according to a statement by Public Prosecution yesterday.

The case arose from a complaint by the victim's legal representative, who claimed the accused used sorcery and

deceit to coerce his client into handing over substantial belongings.

These included cash, a house, and vehicles, which the defendant later tried to pass off as lawfully gained.

The Public Prosecution ordered an inquiry into the man's accounts and belongings.

The Financial Intelligence National Centre (FINC) traced how the accused handled the stolen wealth, uncovering dealings aimed at hiding its true source. This led to an order freezing his assets.



News in brief

◆ **The US will urge a judge to make Google-parent company Alphabet sell its widely used Chrome browser in a major antitrust crackdown on the internet giant, according to a media report Monday.** Antitrust officials with the US Department of Justice declined to comment on a Bloomberg report that they will ask for a sell-off of Chrome and a shake-up of other aspects of Google's business in court Wednesday. Justice officials in October said they would demand that Google make profound changes to how it does business -- even considering the possibility of a breakup -- after the tech juggernaut was found to be running an illegal monopoly. The government said in a court filing that it was considering options that included "structural" changes, which could see them asking for a divestment of its smartphone Android operating system or its Chrome browser.

◆ **Brazil arrests G20 guards over alleged 2022 Lula assassination plot**

◆ **Brazilian police** on Tuesday arrested four soldiers guarding the G20 summit over an alleged plot to assassinate then President-elect Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva in a 2022 "coup," a federal police source told AFP. The four "were arrested in Rio, where they were participating in the security operation for the G20 leaders' meeting," said the source, who added that a police officer was also taken into custody. A statement by Brazil's federal police said the suspects were "mostly soldiers with special forces training" but made no mention of them being part of the G20 summit security deployment. They were arrested on the second day of the G20 gathering, in an operation to "dismantle a criminal organization responsible for planning a coup d'etat to prevent the government legitimately elected in 2022 elections taking office," the police said.

◆ **Two telecommunications cables cut in the Baltic Sea in 48 hours**

have prompted Nordic and German officials to say they suspect "sabotage" and "hybrid warfare" stemming from Russia. On Monday, Finnish operator Cinia reported that the "C-Lion1 submarine cable" connecting Helsinki and the German port of Rostock had been cut for unknown reasons. The break was traced to a location south of the island of Oland in Swedish waters, some 700 kilometres (435 miles) from Helsinki. "These kinds of breaks don't happen in these waters without an outside impact," a Cinia spokesperson said. Meeting in Brussels, the foreign ministers of Germany, Annalena Baerbock, and Finland, Elina Valtonen, said it hinted at foul play.

UK and India to resume stalled free trade talks

London, United Kingdom

Britain and India will resume stalled talks to agree a free-trade deal, the two countries said after their leaders met at the G20 summit in Brazil.

Prime Minister Keir Starmer, who took power in London in July, hailed his meeting with Indian counterpart Narendra Modi as "very productive" and vowed that a trade pact with Delhi would boost UK growth.

"A new trade deal will support jobs and prosperity in the UK -- and represent a step forward in our mission to deliver growth and opportunity across the country," he posted on X late Monday.

Hours earlier, Starmer's office confirmed the two countries would relaunch the talks "in the new year" as Britain sought "a new strategic partnership with India".

That will include "deepening cooperation in areas like security, education, technology, and climate change," Downing Street said in a statement summarising the meeting of the two leaders.

India's foreign ministry said both leaders had "underlined the importance of resuming the Free Trade Agreement negotiations at an early date".

It added they had "expressed confidence in the ability of the negotiating teams, to address the remaining issues to mutual satisfaction, leading to a balanced, mutually beneficial and forward looking Free Trade Agreement".

The two countries have spent nearly three years negotiating what would be a milestone for Britain as it continues to seek alternative markets after its departure from the European Union.

Ukraine fires first US long-range missiles into Russia

Ukraine said Tuesday it had fired US-supplied long-range missiles into Russian territory in the first such strike, as Russia declared a "new phase" in the conflict and eased its protocol for nuclear strikes.

A senior official told AFP that a strike on Russia's Bryansk region earlier on Tuesday "was carried out by ATACMS missiles" -- a reference to the US-supplied Army Tactical Missile System.

Speaking 1,000 days since Russia invaded Ukraine, Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov

criticised Washington's decision to authorise Kyiv to use such missiles, which have a range of up to 300 kilometres (186 miles).

"We will be taking this as a qualitatively new phase of the Western war against Russia. And we will react accordingly," Lavrov told a press conference at the G20 summit in Brazil.

The grim milestone opened with a Russian strike in the eastern Ukrainian region of Sumy that gutted a Soviet-era residential building and killed at least 12 people, including a child.

President Volodymyr Zelen-

sky published images of rescue workers hauling bodies from the debris and called on Kyiv's allies to "force" the Kremlin into peace.

The foreign ministry said Ukraine "will never submit to the occupiers" and called for "peace through strength, not appeasement," referring to growing calls for Ukraine to negotiate with Russia to end the war.

US president-elect Donald Trump has vowed to cut US assistance to Ukraine and bring about a swift end to the war, without detailing how he would do so.

COP29 negotiators strive for deal after G20 'marching orders'

Negotiators toiled Tuesday to break a deadlock at UN climate talks after G20 leaders acknowledged the need for trillions of dollars for poorer nations but left key sticking points unresolved.

With three days left in the COP29 conference, ministers haggling in Azerbaijan had been waiting for the G20 meeting in Rio de Janeiro to issue a declaration that might jumpstart the stalled negotiations.

Activists and diplomats gave the text a mixed verdict, saying the statement lacked enough direction on climate finance and failed to explicitly mention the need to transition away from fossil fuels.

The lead negotiator of COP29 hosts Azerbaijan, Yalchin Rafiyev, said the G20 statement sent "positive signals" to the efforts in Baku.

"G20 delegations now have their marching orders for here in Baku," UN climate chief Simon Stiell said in a statement.

"We urgently need all nations to bypass the posturing and move swiftly towards common ground, across all issues," he said.

Rich nations are being urged to significantly raise their pledge of \$100 billion a year to help developing countries adapt to climate change and transition to clean energy.

But efforts to finalise the deal in Baku are hampered by disputes over how much the deal should entail, who should pay for it, and what types of financing should be included.

Those key questions were not answered in the G20 statement. "We were waiting for a boost. Our expectations were maybe too high," a European negotiator told AFP.

The declaration, however, recognises "the need for rapidly and substantially scaling up climate finance from billions to trillions from all sources". It also states the need to increase international collaboration "with a view to scaling up public and private climate finance and investment for developing countries".



A new draft deal on climate finance is expected by Wednesday night. Some developing countries, which are the least responsible for global greenhouse gas emissions, want an annual commitment of \$1.3 trillion.

Roasted turkey breast recipe


Ingredients:

Turkey:

- 1.5-1.8 kg bone-in turkey breast
- 4 tbsp unsalted butter, softened
- 1 tsp brown sugar
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp black pepper
- 1/2 tsp smoked paprika
- 1/2 tsp dried oregano
- 1/4 tsp dried thyme
- A pinch of dried rosemary
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- Fresh parsley, for garnish

Gravy:

- Drippings from the turkey - anywhere from 1/4 cup to cup
- 475 ml chicken or turkey stock
- 3 heaping tablespoons of all-purpose flour



Instructions (Turkey):

- Preheat the oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. Place a wire rack on a baking sheet or inside a roasting pan.
- Bring turkey to room temperature for 30 minutes. In a bowl, mixture together the butter, brown sugar, salt, pepper, smoked paprika, oregano, thyme, rosemary and garlic to form a well-combined paste.
- Place the turkey breast on the rack. Rub the butter mixture all over the turkey breast. Lift the skin gently (Do not tear it) and generously rub some butter underneath the skin.
- Roast the turkey breast for about 90 minutes, rotating the pan once during cook time. The internal temperature should read 165 degrees F. Remove the turkey and let it rest for 30 minutes before slicing. Use the resting time to make the gravy.

Instructions (Gravy):

- Pour the drippings from the turkey through a fine mesh sieve into a bowl.
- Heat the drippings in a saucepan over medium heat.
- In a cup, make a slurry with the stock and flour by mixing with a fork until fully combined.
- Pour the slurry into the drippings in the pan, whisking the entire time. Continue to whisk to avoid any lumps and stir until the gravy has thickened. This process can take anywhere between 10 to 20 minutes. Make sure you are scraping the bottom of the pan.
- Taste the gravy and season it with salt and pepper to your liking.
- Serve over turkey and enjoy with your favourite sides.

The tempura battered-fried rolls have a filling of imitation crab that tastes great with the spicy mayonnaise drizzle.

Plenty of appetising delights were found at the main course buffet and the live counters were a treat to the senses. I loved the oxtail with mashed potatoes and au jus and savoured the mouthfeel of the fall-apart-tender, fatty meat against the creamy mashed potatoes.

I could not resist having a portion of mac and cheese, and it brought a smile to my face. The melted cheese with soft macaroni and golden mozzarella topping was very comforting. The chicken parmesan in lemon

butter sauce was tasty. Tender seared chicken paired with the lemon butter sauce was light and creamy with a lemony touch. With a similar flavour profile, the salmon with lemon butter dill sauce was equally delicious. The salmon was tender and its distinct flavour along with the creamy sauce was an ideal

match. Speaking of ideal matches, I found culinary treasures such as roast chicken with aromatic thyme sauce at the live stations. The juicy chicken with luscious sauce was warm and comforting. Another interesting combination was hot chicken and waffles - deep fried chicken bites served on top of fluffy waffles and drizzled with sweet maple syrup. Now that is a nice contrast between savoury and sweet. For seafood lovers, they have hot and freshly prepared fish and chips with tartar sauce. They also serve pork ribs with BBQ sauce and crispy pork belly. The crispiness of the crackling was sending sound waves across the hall!



For dessert, I opted for one of my own creations - Chocolate ice cream with a chocolate shell and feuilletine. Here is how you can create it at Hilton's brunch: Ask the server for a scoop of chocolate ice cream, then head over to the chocolate fountain and spoon a generous helping of chocolate to cover the scoop of ice cream. Wait for a minute to see the magic. The chocolate will transform into a shell over the ice cream. Now add some feuilletine from the ice cream counter and enjoy!

The well-prepared and presented crème brûlée won my heart. It had the perfect golden crackly caramel topping revealing a luxuriously creamy custard. Hamas negotiators 'not in Doha' but political office not closed: Qatar

● A senior Hamas member said that a delegation led by the group's chief negotiator Khalil Al-Hayya was "on a mission outside Qatar"

Hamas negotiators are not in Doha but their office has not been permanently closed, Qatar said on Tuesday following speculation that the Palestinian group had been ordered out of the Qatari capital.

"The leaders of Hamas that are within the negotiating team are now not in Doha," foreign ministry spokesperson Majed Al-Ansari said, adding: "The decision to... close down the office permanently, is a decision that you will hear about from us directly."

Qatar, along with the United States and Egypt, had led months of fruitless negotiations for a truce in the Gaza war, but the Gulf state announced earlier this month it was pausing its mediation efforts.

The announcement followed reports Qatar had warned Hamas that its political bureau, which the Gulf state has hosted since 2012 with the blessing of the United States, was no longer welcome.

"The mediation process right now... is suspended unless we take a decision to reverse that which is based on the positions of both sides," Ansari said on Tuesday.

"The office of Hamas in Doha was created for the sake of the mediation process. Obviously, when there is no mediation process, the office itself doesn't have any function," he added, declining to confirm whether Qatar had asked Hamas officials to leave.

A senior Hamas member told AFP on Tuesday that a delegation led by the group's chief negotiator Khalil Al-Hayya was "on a mission outside Qatar" and had not returned to the emirate.

Israel army says soldier killed in combat in Lebanon

Jerusalem, Undefined

The Israeli army said Tuesday that a soldier was killed in south Lebanon, where its troops have battled Hezbollah since late September after a year of cross-border exchanges of fire.

"Sergeant First Class (Reserve) Omer Moshe Gaeldor, aged 30, from Jerusalem, a soldier from the 5,111 Battalion, Golani Brigade, was killed during combat in southern Lebanon," the army said, adding

Speaking on condition of anonymity, the member refuted reports the Palestinian group had been asked to leave, saying "no party asked Hamas to leave any country where Hamas leaders

ing three other soldiers were wounded. The death brings to 49 the military's losses in Lebanon since the start of ground operations.

Earlier Tuesday, the army said another unit had begun targeted raids against "a central Hezbollah terror stronghold" in southern Lebanon on Monday.

In coordination with the air force, its troops "struck dozens of targets" in the stronghold which it said were used to fire rockets towards Israel.

Earlier in November, Hamas rejected a proposal from Egypt and Qatar for a short-term truce, as it did not offer a lasting ceasefire.

Israel has repeatedly vowed it will not stop fighting until it achieves its war objectives -- namely to crush Hamas and bring the hostages home.

US envoy says end to Israel-Hezbollah war 'within grasp'

US special envoy Amos Hochstein said during a visit to Beirut

on Tuesday that an end to the Israel-Hezbollah war was "now within our grasp" as he met with officials to discuss a truce plan largely endorsed by Lebanon.

The United States and France have spearheaded efforts for a ceasefire in the war, which escalated in late September after nearly a year of deadly exchanges of fire between Hezbollah and Israeli troops.



The health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza said the death toll from the resulting war had reached 43,972 people, the majority civilians. The United Nations considers the figures reliable.

Yemen's Huthis say targeted cargo ship in Red Sea

Sanaa, Yemen

Yemen's Huthi rebels announced Tuesday they had targeted a cargo ship in the Red Sea, while a multinational naval task force said two missiles had struck near the Panama-flagged vessel.

Huthi spokesman Yahya Saree said the rebels "carried out an operation targeting the ship 'Anadolu S' in the Red Sea with a number of appropriate ballistic and naval missiles", adding that the "hit was accurate and direct".

But the Bahrain-based Combined Task Force later said two missiles had hit near the Anadolu S on Sunday and Monday without causing any damage.

It said that on Monday, the ship was "ordered to alter course to the north", adding that the "vessel did not comply with the order and continued its transit".

It later "reported a missile splashed" about three metres (yards) away from the vessel's stern but caused no casualties or damage, noting that the ship continued on its path.

The following day, another missile hit one nautical mile from the vessel, the CTF's Joint Maritime Information Center said, also without causing damage.

"Vessel and crew are reported safe and continuing to next port of call," it said.

"The JMIC has investigated and found an indirect association to Israel."

Saree had said that the rebels had targeted the ship "because it did not respond to the warnings of the naval forces and because the company that owns it violated the ban decision on entry to the ports of occupied Palestine (Israel)".

NATO names North Macedonia's Shekerinska as deputy head

NATO on Tuesday announced that North Macedonia's Rada Shekerinska has been appointed as the alliance's deputy secretary general.

Shekerinska, 52, will take up the post later this year, replacing Romania's Mircea Geoana. "She is a true believer in NATO, knows the work it takes to join the Alliance, and what it means to be a full member," NATO chief Mark Rutte said.

Putin broadens rules on Russia's use of nuclear arms

Russian President Vladimir Putin on Tuesday signed a decree broadening the scope of when Moscow can use nuclear weapons in a clear message to the West and Ukraine.

The move comes on the 1,000th day of Russia's offensive on Ukraine and after the United States gave Kyiv permission to use long-range missiles to strike military targets inside Russia.

The new doctrine outlines that Russia will consider using nuclear weapons against a non-nuclear state if they are supported by nuclear powers.

"Aggression by a non-nuclear state with the participation of a nuclear state is considered as a joint attack," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters on Tuesday -- a clear refer-

Russia's nuclear threats 'irresponsible': EU's Borrell

EU top diplomat Josep Borrell accused Russia on Tuesday of issuing "completely irresponsible" nuclear threats, after President Vladimir Putin broadened the scope for Moscow's use of atomic weapons.

"It is not the first time that Putin plays the nuclear gamble," the outgoing foreign policy chief told reporters following defence minister talks in







Kane hoping to extend England career beyond 2026 World Cup

England captain Harry Kane says he is performing at his highest ever level as he dismissed suggestions the 2026 World Cup should be his international swansong.

Thomas Tuchel will take over as England manager in January with his first matches not until World Cup qualifiers start in March's international break.

Interim boss Lee Carsley guided the Three Lions to promotion from the second tier of the Nations League with five wins from his six games in charge.

That included a 3-0 win away at Greece last week, where Carsley took dropped Kane to the bench.

The 31-year-old striker admitted he had been shocked by that call, but scored in Sunday's 5-0 thrashing of the Republic of Ireland on

his return to the starting line-up.

At of Euro 2024 last summer, Kane often looked laboured and was substituted in all four knockout

games as England reached the final.

But the Bayern Munich striker has scored 20 times for club and country in 21 appearances this season.

"I think there's a perception when you get to your thirties that you're coming to an end but for me I'm performing at the highest level I've ever performed and feel as good as I've ever felt," Kane told the Press Association.

"I don't like to look too far ahead and in my career I never have, the World Cup is going to be exciting.

"In America it will be an incredible occasion and ultimately it's about trying to win that, looking at where you are, where to improve and it will be no different in a couple of years."

Kane was speaking at the unveiling of a statue of him at the home of his former youth team Ridgeway Rovers in east London.

Already England's all-time record goalscorer with 69 goals in 102 games, Kane could easily also surpass Peter Shilton's re-

cord of 125 caps.

But he believes he must help end his nation's wait for a major tournament victory since 1966 to emulate World Cup winning captain Bobby Moore and be honoured with a statue at Wembley.

Kane previously worked with Tuchel at Bayern and is positive about the impact the German can make when he becomes the third foreign manager to take charge of England.

"I think we need to win a major tournament," he added. "We've come close on a couple of occasions and the next step is for me and the other boys to win."

Federer hails 'historic' Nadal

Tennis great Roger Federer hailed his former rival Rafael Nadal yesterday ahead of the Spaniard's imminent retirement from tennis at the Davis Cup.

"Rafa, I have to say: What an incredible run you've had. Including 14 French Opens -- historic!" Federer wrote on social media platform X.

"You made Spain proud... you made the whole tennis world proud."

Nadal, a 22-time Grand Slam winner, will bow out from professional tennis after competing with Spain in Malaga this week.

David Ferrer's team face the Netherlands in the quarter-finals yesterday, although it is unknown if Nadal will participate in the tie.

Spanish media reported the 38-year-old has been chosen to play the first singles rubber, with the captain's selection decisions to be officially announced by organisers around 1500 GMT.

Nadal has struggled badly with injury in the last few years, leading him to the decision to quit professional tennis.

Retired Swiss star Federer and Nadal faced each other 14 times at Grand Slam tournaments with Nadal holding a 6-3 advantage in finals.

The Spaniard also had a 24-16 winning record overall in their 40 head-to-head meetings.

"I keep thinking about the

Federer won 20 Grand Slams, a tally only beaten in the men's game by Nadal on 22 and Novak Djokovic, who holds the record at 24.

"It meant everything to me that you were there by my side -- not as my rival but as my doubles partner," added Federer.

"Sharing the court with you that night, and sharing those tears, will forever be one of the most special moments of my career."

The pair met for the first time in 2004 at the Miami Open, shortly after Federer had become world number one and Nadal was just 17.

"I thought I was on top of the world. And I was -- until two months later, when you walked on the court in Miami in your red sleeveless shirt, showing off those biceps, and you beat me convincingly," said the 43-year-old.

"I am not here for retiring. I'm here to try to help the team," Nadal explained.

"It's of course going to be my last week on the professional tour, but at the end, we are here in a teams competition.

"The emotions are going to be for the end."

Former Chelsea and Bayern Munich boss Tuchel takes up his new role on January 1 after being given an 18-month contract by the Football Association.

The German's primary mission is to win the tournament in the United States, Canada and Mexico in 2026 and end England's long and painful wait for a major trophy.

Carsley, who took over on a temporary basis after Gareth Southgate resigned in July, secured promotion to the top tier of the Nations League with five wins from his six games.

He believes England have the talent to win the World Cup for the first time since

1966 after several agonising near misses under Southgate.

"We have got all of the tools," he said. "We just need to play them in the (right) order."

Carsley hands over to Tuchel after Sunday's 5-0 send-off against Ireland at Wembley, having given debuts to eight players during his temporary spell in charge.

"Thomas's pool of players has increased so we have left the squad in a fantastic position," he said.

"We will collate our thoughts, along with the rest of the players in terms of handing over something he can read and look through that's valuable. And then we'll step back to support him."

Carsley, who returns to his role as England Under-21s manager, said the challenge is achieving balance using the best talent, with fierce competition for places.

Heartbreak in Riffa: Bahrain Let It Slip Against Australia

Another late twist leaves Bahrain frustrated on the road to World Cup 2026

On another frustrating night at the Bahrain National Stadium, the national team once again fell short of securing a vital 3 points in their FIFA World Cup Qualifier campaign, settling for a 2-2 draw with Australia. The result, their second consecutive late collapse, leaves Bahrain with a challenging



path ahead, as they prepare to face group leaders Japan on March 20.

Match Recap

Australia, who had looked largely untroubled for most of the match, struck early—Yengi found the back of the net just 38 seconds into the first half. For the next 70 minutes, Australia controlled the game, leaving Bahrain with little room to maneuver.

But then, Bahrain's never-say-die attitude came to the fore. Substitute Mahdi Abduljabbar delivered an extraordinary moment, curling a shot from 45 yards over the head of Maty Ryan to equalize. The stadium erupted as Abduljabbar, who had already injected a spark into the game, struck again just two minutes later. In a bizarre twist, Australian debutant Hayden

Matthews, under no pressure, accidentally headed the ball against his own post, setting up Abduljabbar's second. Bahrain had turned the game on its head and were on the brink of a famous win.

With Bahrain temporarily climbing to second in the group, the joy was short-lived. As the clock ticked into the 96th minute, Australia capitalized on a defensive lapse to snatch an equalizer. Yengi, ever the danger man, was there again to bundle the ball in and deny Bahrain a much-needed win.

The state of play in Group C now leaves Bahrain with an uphill battle to qualify, as they sit 5th with 5 points after 5 matches, a single point behind Australia, Indonesia, and Saudi Arabia—who all have 6 points. Japan remain firmly in control with 16 points after 6 matches.

What's Next?

Bahrain's hopes now hinge on a series of tough upcoming matches. They must regroup

Leaving Lebanon behind: Jad El Hajj's brave leap to Bahrain

For Jad El Hajj, leaving Lebanon wasn't just a career move; it was a leap toward growth and new possibilities. The 35-year-old coach, who has made a name for himself in international basketball, made headlines earlier this year with his decision to take on dual roles in Bahrain: head coach of the men's national basketball team and technical director for the national program.

El Hajj's departure from Lebanon—a country with a rich basketball heritage—came as a shock to fans and pundits alike, especially given his recent successes with the Cedars. But for El Hajj, the decision was rooted in a desire to embrace fresh challenges.

"I felt that I needed a new challenge outside," said El Hajj, who hails from Beirut. "Bahrain contacted me, and it was a big challenge for me, to get more experience outside of Lebanon and to have a new opportunity."

A Legacy in Lebanon

El Hajj's time with Lebanon was marked by big achievements. Appointed head coach of the Cedars in 2022, he led the team to a silver medal in the FIBA Asia Cup that same year—their first runner-up finish in the tournament in 15 years. Under his guidance, Lebanon qualified for the FIBA Basketball World Cup for the first time since 2010 and secured two wins in Jakarta during the 2023 edition.

At the club level, El Hajj enjoyed success with Sagesse SC, guiding the storied team to the finals of both the Lebanese Basketball Championship and the FIBA West Asia Super League (WASL) Final 8 in Doha. Despite these accomplishments, El Hajj felt it was time to move on.

"I felt like I gave everything for the national team," he said. "It was a tough decision, but I felt it was time for new blood in Lebanon and a different challenge for me."

Building a New Chapter in Bahrain

Since joining Bahrain in June, El Hajj has already left his mark. In September, he led the national team to their first-ever Gulf Basketball Association (GBA) Championship title, defeating

Qatar 73-68 in the final. The win was a landmark moment for Bahrain, ending decades of frustration and signaling a new era for the program.

"I came here with two goals: winning the GBA Championship, which we achieved, and qualifying for the FIBA Asia Cup 2025," said El Hajj.

As Bahrain prepares for the next window of Asia Cup qualifiers, El Hajj is focused on maintaining momentum. The team sits at 1-1 and faces important games against Syria and the UAE.

"We need a couple more wins to qualify," he said. "Hopefully, we'll have a good camp and friendly games to build chemistry fast."

A Vision for Bahrain Basketball





Beyond results, El Hajj is committed to understanding the players' mentality and the country's basketball culture. His involvement extends to the domestic league, where he's leading Al Ahli Club in the WASL-Gulf League. For him, the journey is as much about building a foundation as it is about achieving immediate success.

"My personal goal is to achieve great things for Bahrain, like I did with Lebanon," he said. "Bahrain suffered a lot in the last 30, 40 years without winning any championship. Now, the guys believe we can achieve good results. Hopefully, we can build on this."

El Hajj's impact is already being felt, and his arrival has reinvigorated Bahraini basketball. With a winning mindset and a track record of success, he is poised to usher in a new chapter for the sport in the Gulf nation.
