Israeli strikes kill **20 Palestinians**

 ${f I}$ sraeli missiles and air strikes on the Rafah area in southern Gaza hit three houses killing at least 20 Palestinians, Gaza health officials said yesterday.

Tens of thousands of displaced Palestinians have crammed into Rafah on Gaza's border with Egypt to escape Israeli bombardments further north, despite fears that they will also not be safe there.

Early yesterday residents in Khan Younis, a city also in southern Gaza, reported fierce gunbattles between militant Hamas fighters and Israeli forces. Israeli tanks and planes bombed areas near the city center, residents said.

This explosive statement fuelled a proposal to increase fees for hiring foreign workers, aiming to boost employment opportunities for Bahrainis. But is this picture reality, or a mirage?

Government data tells a different story, one where the average Bahraini in the private sector walks away with a paycheck three times fatter than their foreign counterpart.

The official figures paint a stark contrast: BD815 for Bahrainis versus BD260 for non-Bahrainis. The data was released by Social Insurance Organization in its 'Statistical Report 2023 -Ouarter 3'.

The Prime Minister and ministers, each in their capacity, shall implement the provisions of the decrees, which come into effect the day following their issuance, and will be published in the Official Gazette.




