**BD5,000 fine for late business registrations**

Businesses that delay renewing their commercial registrations could now face fines of up to BD5,000, as the government cracks down on delays.

The Ministry of Industry and Commerce has introduced new penalties that charge companies BD500 for each year, or part of a year, that they delay beyond the third year.

However, the total fine will be capped at BD5,000.

These new rules replace the old system from 2016, which has been scrapped in favour of a more stringent approach, aimed at ensuring companies renew their registrations on time.

**Growth-boosting drugs in farming banned in Bahrain**

Growth-boosting drugs like Colistin are now off-limits for Bahrain's farmers, as a new ban on veterinary products shakes up the poultry and livestock trades, announced by H.E. Minister Wael Al Mubarak.

The ban, laid out in Decision No. (115) of 2024 and published in the latest Official Gazette, sets out clear rules on the use of these products.

## MPs unite to defend Bahrain's Arab roots

A senior Iranian official's recent assertion that Bahrain is not an Arab nation has sparked a storm of outrage in the Kingdom.

Members of the Council of Representatives staunchly defended Bahrain's Arab heritage, condemning the remarks by Kamal Kharazi, President of the Strategic Council on Foreign Relations, as a reckless attempt to distort history and interfere in Bahrain's internal affairs.

They highlighted Bahrain's centuries-old Arab roots, the UN-supervised referendum affirming its Arab status, and the Kingdom's establishment as an Arab Islamic state in 1783.

This exchange threatens to heighten tensions in the Gulf and may complicate ongoing efforts to improve relations between the two nations.

"These are blatant falsehoods meant to cause division," said MP Ahmed Al Salloom, expressing the shared sentiments of his colleagues.

**Anger**

Several MPs expressed their anger at Kharazi's statements, accusing him of attempting to distract from Iran's internal issues. MP Dr Maryam Al Dhaen, Deputy Chair of the Foreign Affairs, Defence, and National Security Committee, criticised the remarks as an unacceptable breach of international norms and an unwarranted interfer-

ence in Bahrain's affairs. She called on both regional and international bodies to respond strongly, warning that such provocations could have serious repercussions in the already fragile Gulf region.

MP Khalid Saleh Buanaq reminded Iran that Bahrain has always been Arab, citing the overwhelming result of the 1970 Bahraini independence survey that reaffirmed the Kingdom's position in the Arab world.

He also referenced the Kingdom's founding under Ahmed Al Fateh in 1783 as further proof of its long-standing Arab identity.

Kharazi's claims, he said, were simply an attempt to shift attention from Iran's domestic troubles. Other MPs echoed these sentiments.

MP Jaleela Alawi remarked that Tehran's comments would only serve to strengthen national unity, while MP Mohammed Jannahi commended Bahrain's enduring peace and stability in the face of external interference.

MP Jamil Mulla Hassan accused Iran of seeking to deflect attention from its internal challenges, urging Gulf and Arab nations to adopt a unified response to such provocations.

**Unity urged**

They stressed the need for the international community to stand by Bahrain and reject any attempts to stir up discord in the region.

As relations between Bahrain and Iran remain tense, the Council of Representatives remains united in rejecting what it sees as Tehran's efforts to undermine the Kingdom's position in the Arab world.

The MPs urged collective action to prevent further interference and maintain regional stability.

## Urgent curriculum reform bill rejected

The government has rejected an urgent bill proposed by MP Abdulla Al Rumaishi and four other MPs aimed at reforming the country's school curriculum.

The proposal cited concerns about the recent curriculum changes implemented by the Ministry of Education, arguing they are overly theoretical and difficult for teachers and students to understand, leading to a decline in academic achievement.

The MPs advocated for a fundamental overhaul of science curricula to align with the ease of modern information access, emphasising that the goal is not simplification, but rather a more effective and relevant curriculum.

The government, however, countered that the curriculum undergoes regular review and

The government also emphasised the alignment of the curriculum with Bahrain's Economic Vision 2030.

The government further explained that the national curriculum framework provides the theoretical foundation for any curriculum development, incorporating educational objectives, characteristics, and components, as well as the rationale and goals of curriculum development and contemporary pedagogical approaches.

"This framework guides the derivation of educational objectives, competencies, and the structure of curriculum content, linking them to factors influencing their acquisition and development among learners," the government stressed.

The government emphasised that curriculum development must be a careful and considered process, taking into account local, regional, and global developments.

## Proposal for food security authority

Bahrain may soon create a new organisation to handle food security, with a proposal now being evaluated by the Council of Representatives.

MP Hamad Al Doy, who introduced the idea, emphasised the importance of strengthening Bahrain's food supplies due to growing global concerns and the leadership's long-term objectives.

Al Doy noted that the current situation demands cooperation between lawmakers and the government to meet royal objectives, particularly in ensuring food security and expanding local farming.

The plan seeks to raise Bahrain's food production to its highest level, contributing to greater self-sufficiency.

## Risks

The proposal, grounded in

the Constitution and the Council's rules, addresses risks to food supplies from conflicts, transportation issues, and natural disasters.

Al Doy mentioned that the world has changed since the Covid-19 outbreak, with governments increasingly prioritising this issue.

The Bahrain Chamber of

Commerce and Industry has already provided recommendations on strengthening food security and boosting self-reliance, which the Council is considering.

Al Doy told The Daily Tribune that "turning Bahrain into a key player in food industries by leveraging the kingdom's transport links is crucial."

## Responsible

If approved, the new organisation would be responsible for managing food and health supplies and ensuring the stock of essential goods, such as food and medicine.

"This organisation would play a crucial role in ensuring Bahrain has adequate food supplies, preventing hunger, and reducing health risks linked to shortages," Al Doy explained.

The proposal also calls for a clear strategy to protect the country from supply chain disruptions.



## Shura Council push to drive Kingdom's growth

Other appointments included Khalid Al Maskati staying on as head of the Economic and Financial Affairs Committee while Dr Mohammed Ali kept his role as leader of the Public Utilities and Environment Committee.

Dr Mohammed Al Khuzai was chosen to lead the Human Rights Committee, and Redha Monfaradi remains chair of the Youth Affairs Committee.

# Acquisition alert

Lands set to be acquired in Northern Governorate for Bahrain Metro project

New urban planning proposals for the Northern Governorate are poised to significantly impact land ownership in the region, according to sources within the Northern Governorate Municipal Council.

These updated plans are expected to necessitate the acquisition of numerous land plots to facilitate the construction of the Bahrain Metro.

The information emerged following a large-scale meeting last week.

Over one hundred representatives from a wide array of governmental bodies attended, including key figures from the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, various municipalities, urban planning departments, civil defense, and the Northern Governorate Municipal Council itself.

### Detailed plan

The meeting's focus on the updated detailed plan for the Northern Governorate strongly suggests that the land acquisitions are a crucial component of the upcoming development.

The scale of the gathering and the diverse range of authorities represented underscores the significant impact these planning changes will have on the Northern Governorate.

It's worth noting that the Bah-

rain Metro project is a major initiative aimed at transforming the public transportation landscape in the Kingdom.

Announced as part of Bahrain's broader economic development strategy, the metro system is designed to alleviate traffic congestion, reduce travel times, and promote sustainable urban mobility.

### Multiple lines

The project plans to consist of multiple lines connecting key areas across Bahrain, including commercial districts, residential neighbourhoods, and major transportation hubs.

hancing urban infrastructure in the Northern Governorate, aligning with Bahrain's goals for sustainable urban growth.

The Bahrain Metro project is planned to be integrated with the Gulf Railway network.

### Connection

This connection aims to enhance regional connectivity across the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries.

By linking Bahrain's metro system with the Gulf Railway, the project will facilitate seamless travel for both residents and visitors, improving access to neighbouring countries and

promoting economic growth in the region.

This integration is expected to provide a more efficient and sustainable transportation option, contributing to the broader goals of enhancing infrastructure and mobility across the GCC.

### Operational plan study

The Daily Tribune reported this month that the Gulf Railway project, expected to be operational by 2030, is currently in the final stages of awarding a contract for a comprehensive operational plan study.

This follows substantial progress on various segments of the project, including the completion of the UAE's section to the Saudi Arabian border, and the successful completion of the 200-kilometer Ras Al Khair-Dammam rail line in Saudi Arabia.

Preparations are also underway for the Bahrain-Saudi Arabia causeway link.

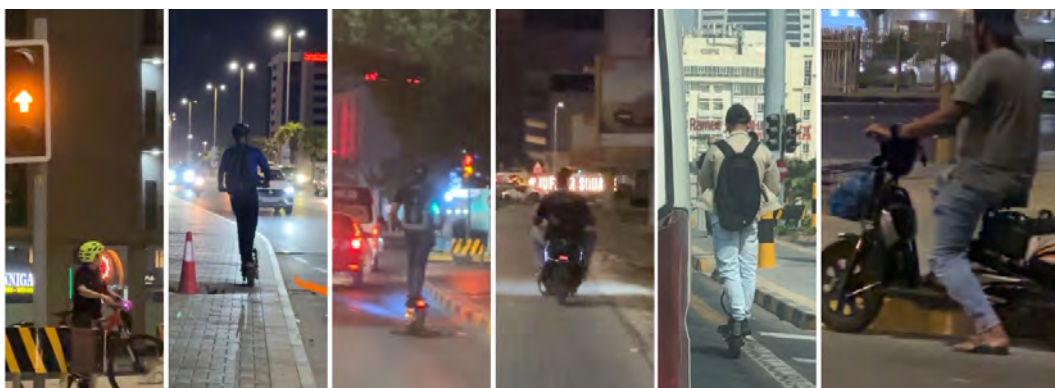
# Can Bahrain's roads handle e-scooter boom?

● Spark safety concerns and calls for regulation

● Advocates urge responsible riding

● Infrastructure needed to ensure safety

The number of electric scooters, or e-scooters, on Bahrain's roads is steadily increasing, with growing concerns among drivers about the safety of riders.

E-scooters have become a common sight in areas like Juffair, Manama, Tubli, and Muharraq, particularly during the evening when many residents use them for transportation.

This trend is driven by affordability, with prices ranging from BD100 to BD 300, depending on quality, and readily available in major supermarkets.

While e-scooters offer an affordable and eco-friendly mode of transport, the increasing number of riders has raised concerns about road safety and pedestrian walkways being dominated by

e-scooters.

Jeremy Clavero, founder of the Bahrain Electric Scooter Team, emphasised the need for dedicated lanes but acknowledged the challenges.

"Sharing the road with cars is inevitable in the absence of proper infrastructure," Clavero told The Daily Tribune.

It's not a question whether e-scooters are a traffic solution; it is clear that they are not. However, they can help alleviate traffic congestion and offer a convenient, environmentally friendly alternative to cars. With regards to the question if they are a safety risk, like any other mode of transportation, including cars, motorcycles, bikes, and even trains, electric-scooters involve risks. Accidents can occur, especially when riders do not follow traffic rules or ride recklessly. Unfortunately, some riders lack common sense, but we should not generalize. There are groups with strict policies, such as 'no helmet, no ride', and all riders are required to follow Bahrain's traffic rules. Unfortunately, sometimes, people only see these irresponsible electric scooter riders and not the responsible ones.

To mitigate risks, Clavero advocates for clear protocols, traffic calming measures, and promoting shared paths with cyclists and pedestrians as temporary solutions.

"Late-night riding can also significantly reduce the risk of accidents, as traffic is much lighter," he added.

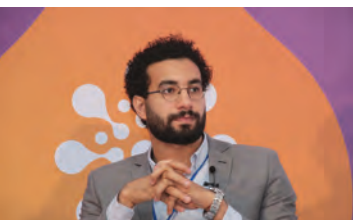

E-scooters are becoming increasingly popular among expatriates in Bahrain, and their environmental benefits are being recognised.

Clavero highlighted that his team supports Bahrain's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), and SDG 13 (Climate Action).

"E-scooters reduce carbon footprints and help lower the number of cars on the road," he said.

Environmental initiatives Bahrain Electric Scooter Team has also been actively involved

in environmental initiatives like tree planting and beach clean-ups, demonstrating their commitment to SDG 13 (Climate Action).

When asked about safety measures for e-scooter riders, Clavero emphasised the importance of wearing helmets and safety gear, especially at night.

"Promoting responsible riding habits can significantly reduce accidents," he stressed, adding that the group enforces strict rules for its members, with penalties for rule violations.

With increasing popularity, there is also discussion about adapting European-style regulations for e-scooters in Bahrain. However, Clavero noted that any regulations must consider Bahrain's unique infrastructure and driving habits.

Supporting Bahrain's SDGs Kareem Hassan, Executive Director of the United Nations

ESCWA Technology Centre, also weighed in on the potential of e-scooters to support Bahrain's SDGs.

"The rise of e-scooters aligns with SDG 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities, and SDG 13: Climate Action," Hassan said.

He added that they promote healthier lifestyles, reduce carbon emissions, and alleviate urban congestion.

For Bahrain to fully capitalise on the benefits of e-scooters, infrastructure development — such as dedicated lanes and safety measures — will be crucial.

"By supporting this trend and implementing appropriate infrastructure, Bahrain can continue to work towards achieving its environmental and urban development goals," Hassan added.



# Hidd's leap forward

Government infrastructure projects giving residents better quality of life

A bridge, a power station, and \$100 million – Hidd's transformation has not gone unnoticed, says Mohammed Al Moqahwi, the area's representative in the Muharraq Municipal Council.

## Backing

Key projects include the power station and water distribution site in East Hidd City, costing BD85 million, with backing from the Saudi Development Fund.

September by Deputy Prime Minister Shaikh Khalid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa.

Al Moqahwi also pointed to earlier repairs on the Khalifa bin Salman Bridge, which links Hidd to Manama, done for \$10 million.

## Bridge

"These repairs were need-

ed to keep the bridge in good shape," he said.

The Dry Dock Road was also upgraded, costing \$1 million, while work on infrastructure, sewage, and roadworks was finished in Blocks 109 and 113.

Plans for Block 111 have been given the go-ahead once the funds are ready.

Al Moqahwi praised govern-

ment plans for further work in Muharraq, including road projects meant to ease traffic, such as the Bahrain Ring Road, the Muharraq Ring Road, the Fourth Muharraq-Manama Bridge, and upgrades to Riya Street.

## Needs

"Hidd deserves these projects, which match the council's aims and meet the community's needs," Al Moqahwi said.

He also thanked residents for voicing their concerns, pledging to keep track of projects in both older and newer areas.

In closing, Al Moqahwi thanked His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, for leading plans that push the economy forward and make sure the Kingdom keeps offering top services to its people.

## A disturbing trend

433 child abuse reports received by Bahrain center in four months

The Ministry of Social Development in Bahrain has released its report on social services provided between May and August.

The report details a range of services for various vulnerable groups, including children, the elderly, and women.

A key finding highlights the work of the Child Protection Center, which received 433 reports during this period.

In addition to the 433 reports, the centre enforced 20 judgments during the same period, highlighting the active pursuit of justice for abused children.

## Proactive approach

The centre's proactive approach is further demonstrated by the organisation of 76 workshops and events, along with the launch of 22 initiatives and partnerships aimed at preventing and addressing

child abuse.

These efforts underscore the commitment to providing comprehensive support and protection to vulnerable children.

The report also details other social services provided by the Ministry of Social Development.

## Entities

Around 190 government and private subsidised services for senior citizens were offered through 61 different entities.

Thirteen day-care centres provided care for 2013 elderly individuals, and one residential care centre supported 26 seniors. Furthermore, 41 seniors received assistive devices.

Meanwhile, the Dar Al Karama social care facility assisted 41 men and 54 women, while Dar Al Aman, a shelter for abused women, provided refuge for 16 women during the reporting period. Both facilities also conducted several lectures and events.

## BD230,000 penalty for tax evader

### Court of Cassation upholds hefty total fine

The Court of Cassation has upheld a ruling against an individual found guilty of evading selective taxes, imposing a total penalty of BD230,000.

The defendant, who operated a business importing and selling tobacco products, including 67,000 units of e-cigarette liquid, was found to have underpaid taxes and will now be required to pay both the outstanding tax and an equal amount in fines.



The case originated with a report from the National Bureau for Revenue to the Public Prosecution's Tax Evasion Crimes Unit.

The agency discovered the business had failed to comply

with the Selective Tax Law and its executive regulations, specifically regarding the registration and taxation of tobacco products and e-cigarettes.

The investigation revealed that the defendant had under-

reported the sale price of the goods to the National Bureau for Revenue, claiming a retail price of BD1.25 per unit while actually selling them for over BD3.

This resulted in a significantly lower tax payment than was legally required.

Auditors from the National Bureau for Revenue conducted an inspection of the business premises, examining import documents and inventory to determine the quantity, value, and outstanding selective tax on the 67,850 units of e-cigarette liquid.

The investigation confirmed an unpaid tax amount of BD 116,000.

## Tender launched for Al Malkiya Coast enhancement

The Northern Governorate Municipality has announced a tender for a significant upgrade to Al Malkiya Coast, as published on the Bahrain Tender Board's official website.

The project encompasses the construction of a new café, public restrooms, and a service building.

Furthermore, the existing walkway and other structures will undergo improvements, encompassing all associated works.

## Contract duration

The contract duration is set at 10 months, with the project site located at Al Malkiya Beach.

This development follows numerous requests from the Northern Municipal Council to enhance the coastal area.

These requests, aimed at im-

proving the public experience, included expanding the children's play area, upgrading and regularly maintaining the playground equipment, installing security cameras for enhanced safety and monitoring, improving lighting with a focus on sustainable solar energy solutions, and creating investment opportunities for local citizens to further develop the area and expand green spaces.

## Two Gulf nationals charged with murder

### Hit-and-run case

Two Gulf nationals, aged 24, are facing murder charges following a fatal hit-and-run incident outside a nightclub in the Al Hooraa area.

The Public Prosecution alleges that on August 2nd, 2024, the defendants intentionally and premeditatedly killed one security guard and injured two others.

According to the nightclub manager's testimony, the incident stemmed from a dispute on August 1st, around 10PM.

The two defendants, exhibiting signs of intoxication, attempted to bring alcohol into

the nightclub, violating hotel regulations.

After being refused entry and subsequently ejected by security, a verbal altercation ensued, escalating into a physical fight.

Approximately three hours later, at 1AM, a vehicle driven by one of the defendants, speeding recklessly, struck the security guards standing outside the nightclub.

One guard was thrown over 10 meters onto a dirt area, resulting in fatal injuries. The other two guards sustained various injuries.

Witnesses, including the nightclub manager and other employees, identified the driver and passenger as the same individuals involved in the earlier altercation.

## Man acquitted in aluminium theft case

A Bahraini man has been acquitted of charges of theft after a court ruled there was insufficient evidence to link him to the crime.

The man, who was a motorbike rider, was accused of participating in the theft of aluminium scraps.

According to the lawyer, Dr Mohammed Al Kooheji, his client was accused by the prosecution of attempting theft alongside another individual.

The attempt failed due to unforeseen circumstances – their actions being witnessed before the crime could be completed.

The client, he explained, was riding his motorbike when the other man, the primary accused, asked for a lift.

The client obliged, dropping the other man off at the end of the street.

The client noticed the other man collecting aluminium pieces from the roadside.

News in brief

Former general Prabowo Subianto was sworn in Sunday as president of Indonesia, seeking a more prominent position on the global stage for the world's fourth most populous nation. The 73-year-old fiery nationalist -- accused of rights abuses during his time in the military -- took the oath at parliament to officially succeed outgoing leader Joko Widodo. "We will lead the Indonesian government... by prioritising the interests of all Indonesian people, including those who did not vote for us," he said, pledging to tackle corruption and protect democracy. Prabowo has committed himself to Indonesia's non-aligned foreign policy, but has signalled that he will be bolder on the world stage. He made China his first foreign visit after his election eight months ago, before embarking on trips to a dozen other countries including Russia and Australia, where he signed a key security deal.



Ex-general Prabowo takes office as Indonesia president

Serbian President Aleksandar Vucic spoke on Sunday by phone with the Russian President Vladimir Putin for the first time in two and a half years, as a decision is expected regarding Vucic's participation in the BRICS summit next week. Serbia, a European Union candidate, has refused to impose sanctions on Russia, maintaining close and friendly relations. However, since the invasion of Ukraine, Serbia has condemned the violation of Kyiv's territorial integrity, and Vucic has had limited bilateral talks with Putin. "I particularly thanked President Putin for ensuring that Russia will provide sufficient quantities of gas for Serbia this winter," Vucic said in a social media video message. Serbia was completely dependent on Russian gas when Moscow's forces invaded Ukraine in February 2022.



Egypt was certified as malaria-free on Sunday, with the World Health Organization calling the achievement "truly historic" and the culmination of nearly a century of work to stamp out the disease. "Malaria is as old as Egyptian civilisation itself, but the disease that plagued pharaohs now belongs to its history and not its future," WHO chief Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said in a statement. "This certification of Egypt as malaria-free is truly historic, and a testament to the commitment of the people and government of Egypt to rid themselves of this ancient scourge." Globally, 44 countries and one territory have now been certified as malaria-free. Certification is granted by the WHO when a country has proven that the chain of indigenous malaria transmission by Anopheles mosquitoes has been interrupted nationwide for at least the previous three consecutive years.

Putin seeks to rival Western power with high-profile summit

Moscow, Russia

Two dozen world leaders will meet in Russia next week for a summit of the BRICS group, an alliance of emerging economies that the Kremlin hopes will challenge Western "hegemony". The summit will be the biggest in Russia since the Ukraine conflict began and comes as Russian President Vladimir Putin seeks to show Western attempts to isolate Moscow over the two-and-a-half-year offensive have failed.



UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres, Chinese leader Xi Jinping, Brazilian President Luis Inacio Lula da Silva and Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan are scheduled to join the event in the city of Kazan from October 22 to 24. Russia has said it is expecting Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi as well. Moscow has made expanding the BRICS group -- an acronym for core members Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Korea -- three of Washington's adversaries.

By gathering BRICS in Kazan, the Kremlin "aims to show that not only is Russia not isolated, it has partners and allies," Moscow-based political analyst Konstantin Kalachev told AFP. All BRICS members will be represented in Kazan by their leaders, except Saudi Arabia, which will send its foreign minister.

Israel escalates Beirut bombing, accused of killing 73 in Gaza strike

Fighting raged on two fronts yesterday as Israel targeted what it said was a Hezbollah "command centre" in the Lebanese capital, while in Gaza rescuers reported 73 people killed in a single air strike.

The strikes on Hezbollah's south Beirut stronghold came after Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu accused the Iran-backed group of attempting to assassinate him by targeting his residence.

It also came as Israelis marked the week-long Jewish holiday of Sukkot.

Lebanon's official National News Agency (NNA) said Israel's strikes on Beirut hit a residential building in Haret Hreik near a mosque and a hospital.

The Israeli military said it hit the "command centre of Hezbollah's intelligence headquarters" and underground weapons facility in Beirut and that it killed three Hezbollah militants in other strikes.

It later said about 70 projectiles fired from Lebanon crossed into Israel within a matter of minutes, and that it intercepted some of them.

Gaza's civil defence agency meanwhile said an Israeli air strike on a residential area killed at least 73 Palestinians in Beit Lahia in the territory's north.

"Our civil defence crews recovered 73 martyrs and a large number of wounded as a result of the Israeli air force targeting a residential area... in Beit Lahia in northern Gaza," said civil defence agency spokesman Mahmud Basal.

The Israeli military said it

Health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza says war death toll at 42,603

Palestinian Territories

The health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza said yesterday that at least 42,603 people have been killed in the war between Israel and Palestinian militants, although the toll did not incorporate a

strike that killed dozens overnight according to rescuers. The toll includes 84 deaths in the previous 24 hours, according to the ministry, which said 99,795 people have been wounded in the Gaza Strip since the war began when Hamas militants attacked Israel on October 7, 2023.

Lebanon, where it said its forces "struck approximately 175" targets.

The military said it continued to operate in northern, central and southern parts of Gaza.

"The troops eliminated dozens of terrorists during close-quarter encounters on the ground and aerial strikes" across Gaza, it said.

Hezbollah says fired rockets at 3 military bases in Israel

Hezbollah on Sunday said it fired rockets at three military bases in northern Israel, hours after Israel said it was stepping up its strikes targeting the Iran-backed group in southern Lebanon.

Israel says 'destroying' Hezbollah in south Lebanon

Israel's Defence Minister Yoav Gallant said on Sunday that the military was stepping up its strikes targeting Hezbollah militants in southern Lebanon, near the Israeli border. "Not only are we defeating the enemy, but we are destroying them in all the villages along the border, in the places that Hezbollah planned to use as launchpads for attacks against Israel," Gallant told troops during a visit to the border, adding that Israeli military presence in that area was "overwhelming the terrorists".

Charles expresses 'great joy' at being back in Australia

King Charles' antipodean admirers got a first glimpse of their reigning monarch Sunday, as the British royal attended a church service and expressed his "great joy" at returning Down Under.

The 75-year-old sovereign arrived in Sydney late on Friday evening, but had kept a low profile as he balances cancer recovery with royal duties.

His first official public appearance was a Sunday morning service at St Thomas' Anglican Church, a stone edifice built as a place of worship for British colonial settlers.

A few hundred people gathered around the building, cheering, holding flowers and waving flags. Two women held up a sign saying "G'day your majesties".

Lynton Martin, 22, drove nine hours from Melbourne and donned a union flag print jacket

and nine royal lapel pins before trying to catch a glimpse of the royals.

"I wanted to show that we are supportive and welcoming of the king," he told AFP, expecting an "aura" to Sunday's service.

Last year Martin travelled to London for Charles' coronation, which he described as a "spectacular" event.

During the church service Bishop Christopher Edwards prayed for peace and an end to wars, and asked that Charles' upcoming Commonwealth summit in Samoa be prosperous.

Later Sunday, Charles made a brief remarks at the New South Wales legislative council, where he hailed the "promise and power of representative democracy" and cracked a joke about his advancing age.

"I first came to Australia nearly 60 years ago, which is slightly worrying," he said to laughter.

"It just remains for me to say

what a great joy it is to come to Australia for the first time as sovereign and to renew a love of this country and its people which I have cherished for so long".

Charles will spend the balance of Sunday at Admiralty House a harbourside mansion that is the Sydney residence of Australia's governor-general, the monarch's representative in the country.

Royal watchers eager to glimpse the king will have another chance on Monday, when he arrives in the capital Canberra alongside Queen Camilla for the busiest stretch of his slimmed-down schedule.

Charles -- who received the

life-changing cancer diagnosis just eight months ago -- is embarking on a nine-day visit to Australia and Samoa, the first major foreign tour since he was crowned.

Visiting British royals have typically carried out weeks-long visits to stoke support, parading through streets packed with thrilled, flag-waving subjects.

But the king's fragile health this time around has seen much of the typical grandeur scaled back.

Intentional or not, the more modest schedule should also help stave off republican concerns about out-of-touch spending and lavish royal banquets.



King Charles III, who ascended to the British throne in 2022, holds the distinction of being the longest-serving heir apparent in British history. He was the Prince of Wales for over 64 years, from 1958 until his accession, a record-breaking tenure as the next in line to the throne.

LEGAL VIEWPOINT

Governance and shareholders

The shareholders are the owners of the company and they are the first party to gain and benefit from the success and profits earned. In fact, it is really hurting to mention that many shareholders are not aware of the rights and duties they are supposed to learn and undertake. Members of the Board of Directors, are mainly from the shareholders and, by virtue of this, all shareholders are supposed to be conversant and likewise vigilant for their benefit, the company & the community.

A valid question arises, what are the duties of the shareholders according to the law & governance principles? Generally, current policy matters, future plans and far-end strategies are to be under their care, this comes as part of their prime duty to assist the Board of Directors of the company in going forward to achieve all such objectives needed for the sustainability of the company.

To achieve this goal, the law \ governance principles explain and give the Board of Directors the duty to call the shareholders, of public joint stock company, who shall attend the meetings \ assemblies and participate actively in the agenda. Herein, we mention that there are two kinds of meetings \ assemblies. These meetings are different in character and in shape because there is a special task to be undertaken by each of them.

The first type of assemblies is the Ordinary General Assembly (OGA), while the second is the Extra Ordinary General Assembly (EOGA). In most cases, there is some confusion or, we could say, some misunderstanding regarding the two assemblies, particularly, in relation to the functions of each one. In fact, in some discussions with executives in Ministries and shareholders, all were of the opinion that such classification and terminology cause big confusion.

The law, provides for the two types of assemblies and explains the difference between the OGA and the EOGA. We have to mention that for each of the assemblies there are certain requirements and statutory conditions such as: Who calls for the required assembly and why this right is given? Who chairs the assembly and who attends? What is the required quorum for each assembly? What are the issues or agenda to be discussed in each of them? In addition to certain specific legal duties stipulated in the law, the shareholders normally discuss & outline the policies to be resolved by the Board of Directors and implemented by the management of the company. Such parameters, we could say, are normally orchestrated during the OGA. This means the general policy matters are taken care of by the OGA.

However, in all cases the agenda for each meeting should be given by the Board of Directors to the shareholders prior to the meeting. The authority to call for the OGA is vested, according to the law, with the Board of Directors. In some instances, the law gives the authority to the shareholders and other competent authorities, however, the law makes it mandatory that the Board shall call for at least one OGA each year. The law also gives the power to the Board to call for additional meetings at any time in case there is a need.

In practice, we have noticed that Boards of Directors in certain companies appear to suffer from a kind of phobia and therefore they do not want to meet or face the shareholders. While some others may be either egoistic, indifferent or naive. Hence, they sever the link between the Board and the management on one hand and the shareholders on the other hand. This approach is totally against the law and against the principles of corporate governance. It should not be forgotten that shareholders jointly own and hold the company and this is why they are -- holders. From this point comes the importance of the link between the management and the shareholders and this link should always be maintained under the eyes of the Board of Directors.

Good management will do its homework and also ensures the shareholders do theirs. However, neither the executive management of the company nor the Board should take matters of routine administration work to the shareholders because this is not their duty.

On the other hand, the EOGA, shall convene to discuss certain issues as amendments in the Memorandum of Understanding or the Articles of Association, the new objects of the company as and when duly elected, increase in tenure of the company, issues regarding dissolution or liquidation or merger or acquisition, decisions related to sale, or any other similar transaction, of the project for which the company has been established. These issues are reserved by the law to the EOGA. In other words, any decision related to the above issues will be deemed void, ab initio, and contrary to the law if they are not taken by this particular assembly.

Above shows the important role of the shareholders through assemblies called by the Board of Directors and all are advised to fulfil their duties for the sake of the company & likewise their own sake. Shareholders and to the same degree, the Board of Directors, shall be vigilant & careful to fully preserve their duties and legal rights.

Jennifer hinted at retiring from music ahead of its release, saying: "The truth is I don't even know if I'll ever make another album after this."

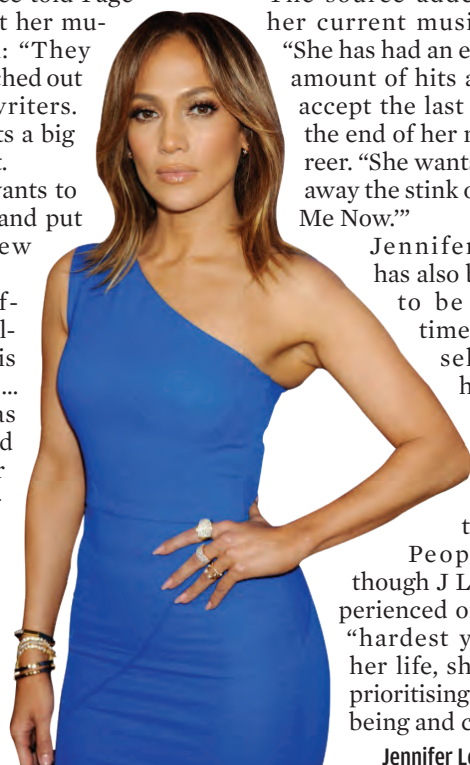
"Don't tell Benny (Medina, her long-term manager) that that's what I'm thinking - this might be my last album ever."

During a press conference at the Cannes Film Festival, he said: "Do I feel boycotted now? No, Johnny Depp

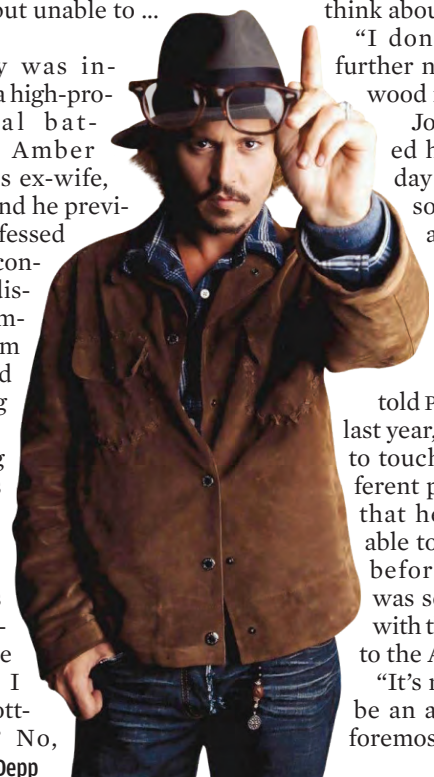
not at all. But I don't feel boycotted by Hollywood because I don't think about it. I don't think about Hollywood."

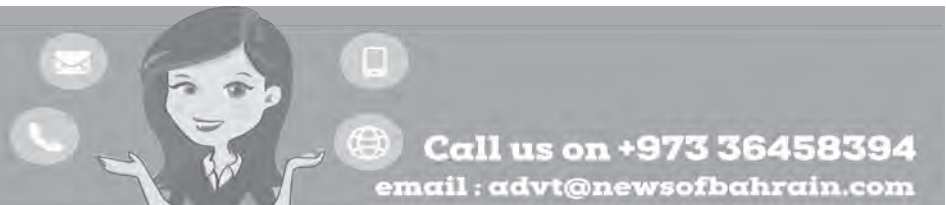

# Cado dethrones Magomedov

Brazilian fighter wins Super Welterweight title after Magomedov's disqualification at BRAVE CF 89

● **Luiz Cado** crowned BRAVE CF Super Welterweight champion in Spain

● **Richie Smullen** wins co-main event with 29-second submission

Bahrain's own BRAVE CF 89 is in the books and the historic event delivered big time as advertised, with the Bahraini company changing the landscape of mixed martial arts in Spain through its partnership with leading local organization Fight2One.

The event was headlined by the first-ever MMA World Title fight on Spanish soil as BRAVE CF Super Welterweight champion Kamal Magomedov put his title on the line against Brazilian contender Luiz Cado in the main event.

The historic title fight ended dramatically, with Luiz Cado becoming the new Super Welterweight champion of BRAVE Combat Federation due to a disqualification after illegal strikes by Kamal Magomedov.

In the first round, Cado set the pace for the fight and managed to wobble Magomedov midway, but the champion remained calm and survived the exchange. Cado continued to press forward with leg kicks and strikes, finishing the round strongly and as a clear winner.

Early in the second round, Magomedov responded with a huge takedown and then landed strikes to the back of Cado's head, causing a cut. This prompted the referee to step in and stop the fight, awarding Cado the victory by disqualification.

With the title win, Cado became the sixth Brazilian world champion in BRAVE Combat Federation, while Kamal Magomedov faced the first defeat of his MMA career.

The quickest finish of the night came in the co-main event as Richie Smullen secured a victory over Spanish MMA veteran Jose Sanchez within seconds. Smullen locked in a guillotine choke during the initial exchange, forcing Sanchez to submit in just 29 seconds, silencing the Spanish crowd. The win extended Smullen's winning streak to four fights.

Former Kickboxing World champion Ilias Bulaid made quick work of Swiss MMA veteran Anthony Riggio and finished the fight in the first-round. Bulaid's striking prowess kept Riggio on the defensive, eventually pinning him against the cage. A series of elbows and knees cut Riggio open, and Bulaid finished the bout with a powerful leg kick, maintaining his unbeaten MMA record.

Anuar Bensayid and Sino Sabzaliev delivered an instant classic which went down into the books as a potential Fight of the Year contender. The fighters started slowly in the first round with Bensayid dominating in striking and Sino on the ground. The pace of the fight picked up in the second round as the fighters delivered non-stop action for five minutes throwing

strikes from all angles. In the only women's fight of the card, Andrea Meneses Garcia secured the biggest win of her career by submitting Adriana Fusini in the second round via rear-naked choke.

Gerard Burns delivered another strong performance in BRAVE CF, outclassing Santiago Paiva over three rounds to extend his winning streak to five and remain undefeated in the organization.

The opening fight saw Spain's Oscar Mendez earn a third consecutive victory with a dominant decision win over Tony Sipos, out grappling the proven submission specialist. Elsewhere, the fight between Daan Duijs and Abdelmoumen Msaate was cancelled shortly before the event, as Duijs withdrew due to illness.

## Norris takes US pole after Russell crash, Hamilton 19th

Lando Norris resisted pace and pressure from Max Verstappen to take pole position for the United States Grand Prix ahead of the three-time champion and series leader in dramatic circumstances.

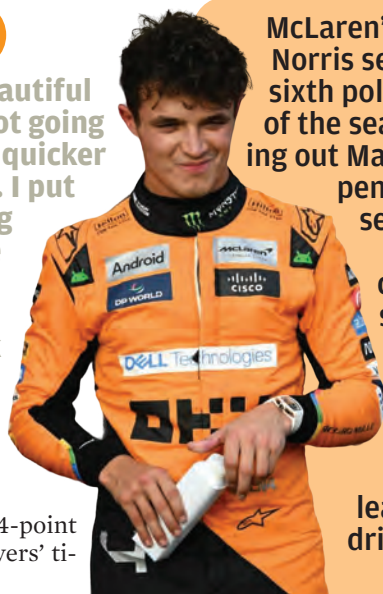
A last minute crash involving Mercedes' George Russell, who skidded off-track into the barriers at Turn 19, brought a tense qualifying session to a premature end as Red Bull's Verstappen was attempting to improve his lap time.

He aborted his lap as the session ended, leaving him second behind McLaren's Norris, Verstappen's main title rival as

he defends a 54-point lead in the drivers' title race.

Russell was unhurt and climbed from his car.

For Norris it was a fourth pole position in five races and his sixth this year as he chases Verstappen in pursuit of the championship.

Norris ended the session on pole with a fastest lap of one minute and 32.330 seconds to beat Verstappen by 0.031 ahead of Ferrari's Carlos Sainz and Charles Leclerc.

Oscar Piastri was fifth in the second McLaren ahead of Russell, Alpine's Pierre Gasly, two-time champion Fernando Alonso of Aston Martin, Haas's Kevin Magnussen and Sergio Perez in the second Red Bull.

"It was a beautiful lap," Norris said. "I was not going to go much quicker than I did. I put everything out on the line. We have been on the back foot, so I had to do something!"

Verstappen said: "Unfortunately, I couldn't finish my lap because I think I had a pretty good shot, but that's how it goes."

The session began in warm sunshine with a track temperature of 39 degrees Celsius and the air at 28, near-perfect for most teams, but too hot for the tyre-munching Mercedes cars as demonstrated in the morning sprint race won by Verstappen.

## Isa Mohamed, Saud Al Toura, and Ali Boushahri Claim Victories in Season Opener

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), 'The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East', hosted an action-packed first round of National Race Day (NRD) over the weekend, featuring three of the Kingdom's leading local championships that were each kicking off their 2024/2025 campaigns.

Isa Mohamed claimed a sensational double in the all-new Bahrain Touring Car Challenge (BTCC), while Saud Al Toura and Ali Boushahri were both winners in their respective classes in the Bahrain Motorcycle Championship (BMC).

A number of competitors also emerged triumphant in the various Time Attack heats, including Ahmed Algaidy, Abdullah Khojah, Salman Mahmood Abdulla, Yazeed Alsaheel, Mohamed Aldoseri, Fares Almutairi, and Sultan Alsaud.

National Race Day's curtain-raising event was organised and run by BIC, in cooperation with the Bahrain Motor Federation, the Circuit Racing Commission, the Bahrain Motorcycle Commission, the Bahrain Autocross and Drift Commission, and the Motorsport Marshals Club.

All the action took place along BIC's 2.55-kilometre In-

ner Track.

In the BTCC, Mohamed set the pace from the start, capturing pole position with a fastest lap time of one minute 19.112 seconds in qualifying.

He went on to win the weekend's first 15-lap race behind the wheel of his Honda Civic contender in 21:25.040, enjoying a 6.480 seconds gap ahead of runner-up Ali Baqer, also driving a Civic and securing first place in the Juniors class. The Radio Bahrain entry, a Honda Integra, took the final podium step in third 20.577s behind Mohamed, while Hamad Mohamed, also in a Civic, was classified fourth.

In race two, Mohamed secured back-to-back victories in dominant fashion, completing

the 15 laps in 21:50.315 - 10.837s ahead of Moaaz Elzahrawi, who was the runner-up in another Civic. The Radio Bahrain entry joined them on the podium in third 13.808s behind the winner. Baqer was fourth and Hamad Mohamed fifth.

In the BMC, Al Toura was the victor in the series' 1,000cc class while Boushahri clinched first place amongst the 600cc participants.

Nawaf Alshuaibi riding a Honda CBR1000 pipped Al Toura on his BMW S 1000 RR for pole position by 0.197s in qualifying. But Al Toura turned the tables in the 14-lap event, winning in 16:45.162 with an 11.771s gap from Alshuaibi. Hassan Alawadhi in a Yamaha R1 finished third

1,000cc classification were Bandar Bahlul on a BMW 10004R, Bradley Stewart on a Ducati 848 Evo, and Abdelrahman Hasan on an S 1000 RR.

In the 600cc category, Boushahri, riding a Honda CBR600 RR, grabbed pole with a best lap of 1:12.634 in qualifying. He went on to win his category in 17:01.936, beating out Saif

Albuainain on a Yamaha R6 by 3.524s. Achraf Hamoud on a Suzuki GSXR600 came third 19.314s adrift, while Abdulrahman Ahmed and Nasser Al Khadra, both also on R6 bikes, rounded out the race rankings.

In Time Attack, competitors battled it out to set the quickest laps in the series' various competition categories.

Algaidy won in the SU class in his GTR AMG in a time of 1:12.869. Khojah triumphed in the MA class, which attracted a packed 14-car field, in 1:16.449 driving an Audi RS3. Abdulla won the ULB class in a Toyota Corolla AE86 with a time of 1:25.837, while Alsaheel claimed the ULA category in his Porsche GT3RS in 1:11.407.

Aldoseri secured first place in the SA class in his RS3, setting a fastest time of 1:19.247. Almutairi triumphed in the MB category in his Subaru BRZ with a best lap of 1:22.673, and Alsaud completed the group of winners, taking the SB class win in his Toyota GR86 in 1:27.164.

Seven rounds of National Race Day are scheduled to take place this 2024/2025 season, to be held all the way through to May.

## Young, Ravindra guide New Zealand to first win in India for 36 years

Will Young and Rachin Ravindra put on an unbroken 75 to guide New Zealand to a first Test win in India for 36 years on day five of the rain-hit match in Bengaluru.

Chasing a tricky 107 on a rain-delayed day, New Zealand lost captain Tom Latham without scoring and Devon Conway for 17.

But Young and Ravindra guided the visitors to 110-2 in the first session and a 1-0 lead in the three-match series.

First-innings centurion Ravindra, a wristy left-hander, looked comfortable as he hit six fours in his 46-ball stay and was

named player of the match after the eight-wicket victory.

Young struck the winning boundary, one of his seven fours, as his New Zealand teammates exchanged hugs in the pavilion. He also hit one six, while facing 76 balls.

It was New Zealand's third Test victory in India after their wins in 1969 at Nagpur and at Mumbai in 1988.

"It was extremely difficult. There have been a lot of teams that have come here over that long period of time, so obviously it's a special feeling," Latham told reporters.

"To be in this position, I think the work we did in that first and second innings with the ball and

with the bat set up the game for us. A proud moment for this group."

Latham, who took over from Tim Southee after New Zealand were swept 2-0 in Sri Lanka, marked his first Test as full-time captain with a resounding victory. Fast bowlers Matt Henry and Will O'Rourke set up the win with 15 wickets in the match as India, having chosen to bat after the first day was lost to the weather, were skittled for 46 in their first innings, their lowest home Test score.

"We didn't think we'll be 46 all out but due credit to New Zealand. It set us back and games like this will happen," said India captain Rohit Sharma.

## Man City survive Wolves scare

Manchester City snatched a controversial 2-1 win at Wolves as John Stones' last-gasp goal was given after a VAR review to send the champions to the top of the Premier League on Sunday.
