**Competition drives down
 school bus transport rates**

As the new academic year ap-
 proaches, school transport
 services in Bahrain are gear-
 ing up for a busy season, with in-
 creased competition and a focus
 on online advertising.

Bus drivers interviewed by
 our sister newspaper Al Ayam
 reported a surge in registrations
 for school transport services
 since the beginning of August.

Prices vary depending on the
 distance to the school and the
 grade level, ranging from BD15
 for elementary schools located
 close to residential areas to
 BD40 for secondary schools.

The intense competition has led
 to a slight decrease in prices, par-
 ticularly with the influx of retired
 individuals joining the sector.

Nour Al Ghadir Transporta-
 tion and Tourism driver, who
 preferred to remain anonym-
 ous, highlighted his reliance
 on online advertising since the
 beginning of August, posting
 numerous advertisements on
 social media platforms.

He confirmed that his prices
 are based on distance, with a

maximum of BD20 for second-
 ary schools and BD15 for ele-
 mentary and kindergarten.

He also acknowledged the
 challenges posed by parents
 requesting separate drop-off
 and pick-up times during final
 exams, which can be financially
 taxing for drivers.

Elias Ibrahim, another driver,
 confirmed that his prices range
 from BD15 to BD35, depending

on the distance to the school.

He attributed the price de-
 crease to the increased competi-
 tion in the past two years, with
 many retirees entering the field.

Jasem Abduli echoed this sen-
 timent, emphasising the signif-
 icant influx of retired individu-
 als, including women, particu-
 larly from the private sector,
 who are under 50 years old.

He believes this influx has

created fierce competition, sta-
 bilising prices that were on the
 rise before the COVID-19 pan-
 demic.

Overall, the school transport
 sector in Bahrain is experienc-
 ing a competitive landscape,
 with drivers adapting to new
 trends in advertising and pric-
 ing strategies to cater to the
 needs of parents and students as
 the new academic year begins.

Two young men rob store, threaten worker with gas cylinder

Two young men in their 20s robbed a cold store in Bahrain, threatening the worker with a gas cylinder.

The incident took place over two consecutive days, with the men stealing cigarettes and juice.

According to the worker, the two men, aged 23 and 26, entered the store on May 28th, 2024, at 10pm.

They threatened the worker by setting fire to a gas cylinder and spraying him with the gas. This intimidation allowed them to steal a pack of cigarettes.

The following day, the two men returned to the store at 2pm and repeated the same act of intimidation, stealing seven packs of cigarettes. The worker then reported the incident to the police.

Upon reviewing security camera footage, the worker discovered that the men had broken into the store's refrigerator and stolen juice boxes on the night of May 29th.

Dispute

The first defendant confessed to the charges during his court appearance, claiming that they stole the items due to a previous dispute with the worker.

He also stated that the refrigerator's lock was already broken when they opened it

and that they paid for the stolen items afterward.

The defendants also confessed to the incident during their investigation with the Public Prosecution.

The security footage confirmed the defendants' threats against the worker, using the gas cylinder and stealing cigarettes.

Investigation

The police investigation also confirmed the defendants' involvement in the incident.

The Public Prosecution charged the defendants with theft by coercion, accusing them of threatening the worker with fire by igniting a gas cylinder and spraying him with the gas.

This coercive act allowed them to steal the goods and flee. The court has scheduled a hearing for August 26th to consider the case.

Civil Court rejects disqualification appeal against candidates in Muharraq by-election

The High Appeals Civil Court has rejected an appeal filed by candidate Saleh Al Sada against his opponents, Hamad Al Kooheji and businessman Ebrahim Al Shaikh, in the upcoming by-election for the first constituency in Muharraq Governorate.

Al Sada had alleged that Al Kooheji and Al Shaikh were not residents of the constituency, but the court dismissed his claim and ordered him to pay BD50 in legal fees.

During the appeal hearing, Al Sada demanded the disqualification of his opponents and



their removal from the candidate list.

He also requested information about the investigations conducted by the state regarding his appeal, claiming that Al Kooheji and Al Shaikh had 25 different addresses and were not resi-

dents of the constituency.

He further stated that Al Kooheji resides in the Al Hala area and Al Shaikh lives in Riffa.

Al Kooheji refuted Al Sada's claims, stating that he has been a resident of the Busaiteen area for 12 years and has approximately 3,000 witnesses to support his claim.

He also presented electronic evidence and electricity bill documents to prove his residency.

Documents

The court had previously presented the documents that Al Sada appealed against to him, giving him the opportunity to review them.

Al-Qahtani set to withdraw

Malallah Al-Qahtani has announced that he will step away from the race for the parliamentary seat in the upcoming 2024 by-elections in Muharraq Governorate's first constituency.

He explained that there isn't sufficient time to put together a thorough electoral programme or plan for his parliamentary work, should he secure a seat in the Council of Representatives.

Al-Qahtani said that his decision followed discussions with his family and those close to him. He added that this withdrawal will serve as a turning point, allowing him to gear up for the 2026 parliamentary elections.

He will formally submit his withdrawal papers in the coming days.

Four Asians arrested for drugs

Bahraini authorities have apprehended four Asian nationals suspected of engaging in drug trafficking and possession within the country.

The arrests were made following a carefully planned sting operation by the Ministry of Interior's Anti-Narcotics Directorate.

The operation stemmed from intelligence gathered from confidential sources, revealing a drug trafficking network operating in Bahrain.

The network, allegedly led by the third suspect and his female accomplice, the fourth suspect, was believed to be involved in both the sale and consumption of drugs obtained from unknown sources.

The investigation led to a

confidential informant establishing a relationship with the first suspect, a 35-year-old laborer, and gaining his trust.

The informant then requested to purchase a quantity of heroin for BD30.

The suspects agreed to a meeting point for the transaction.

On the day of the operation,

the informant, accompanied by undercover police officers, met the first suspect at the designated location.

After the informant handed over the agreed-upon sum, the first suspect left briefly and returned with the second suspect, a 24-year-old mechanic, and the third suspect, a 26-year-old labourer.



Promoting fair labour practices

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA), in collaboration with the International Organisation for Migration (IOM), conducted a two-day awareness-raising programme on August 8-9. The programme, a key component of the Working Together initiative, aimed to strengthen partnerships and empower leaders and focal points from 20 different expatriate communities, promoting the shared responsibility in promoting fair labour practices. The initiative reflects LMRA's commitment to forging strong partnerships that further enhance the protection and support of expatriate workers in Bahrain. Participants were provided with firsthand insights into LMRA's extensive support services during a guided tour of the LMRA's Expat Protection Centre (EPC) in North Seha.

New girls' school planned for Qalali

A primary and secondary school for girls is planned for construction in Qalali, funded by the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development (KFAED).

The design, crafted by the Ministry of Works and overseen by the Ministry of Education, includes two buildings with a total of 44 classrooms and facilities for students with special needs.

The project aims to address the increasing student population and offer a modern and sustainable learning environment, as reported by MP Khalid Buanaq.

Buanaq noted that the Ministry of Works worked in conjunction with the Ministry of Education on the design, which has now been handed over to the Ministry of Education for the tender and construction phases.

He explained that the Ministry of Education, alongside the Ministry of Works, prepared the necessary plans for the schools.

The design is intended to accommodate the growing number of students and meet current educational standards.

The government has allocated a 12,007 square metre plot in Qalali, with construction set to cover 13,003.6 square

The school will feature two educational buildings, one for each stage (primary and secondary), each with four floors.

Each building will contain 22 classrooms, bringing the total to 44, plus two classrooms dedicated to special needs students.

The school will accommodate approximately 1,320 students, with 30 students per class.

Friendship fallout

Bahraini businessman sued by friend over unpaid BD3,300 personal loan

In a case of betrayal of trust, a Bahraini man has filed a lawsuit against his friend for failing to repay a personal loan.

The plaintiff, represented by lawyer Eman Hassan, is seeking BD3,300 from the defendant.

The defendant had borrowed the money from the plaintiff to fund his business venture, promising to repay the loan once his business was established.

However, despite the business's success and even the opening of a second branch, the defendant failed to repay the loan, despite repeated requests from the plaintiff.

According to lawyer Hassan, the defendant had initially signed a promissory note

acknowledging the debt and promising repayment.

Lawsuit

However, he later ignored the plaintiff's calls and blocked him on social media platforms, prompting the plaintiff to file the lawsuit.

he took advantage of that trust. He promised to repay the loan, but he broke his word,” the victim said before the court.

“It's not just about the money, it's about the principle. He treated our friendship like a business transaction and then abandoned me. I never imagined that someone I considered a friend would

betray me like this.”

The court, after reviewing the evidence presented by lawyer Hassan, ruled in favour of the plaintiff.

The court cited Article 487 of the Civil Code, which defines a loan as an agreement where the borrower is obligated to return the borrowed amount, and Articles 128 and 129, which emphasise the binding nature of contracts and the need for good faith and ethical conduct in business dealings.

The court found that the defendant had indeed received the BD3,300 and failed to repay it despite the plaintiff's repeated requests. The court therefore ordered the defendant to repay the loan amount and cover the plaintiff's legal fees.

Bahrain airport records robust traffic and flights surge in July

Bahrain International Airport experienced robust passenger traffic and flight activity during July 2024, according to statistics released by the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

A total of 873,549 passengers traveled through the airport last month, with 424,517 arriving and 449,032 departing.

The number of arriving aircraft reached 4,498, while departing flights totaled 4,513.

This resulted in a combined total of 9,011 aircraft movements at Bahrain International Airport

in July. Additionally, 41,391 transit flights passed through the airport.

Notable destinations saw significant passenger numbers in

July. 55,743 passengers traveled to Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. 45,715 passengers traveled to Doha, Qatar. 27,968 passengers traveled to Mumbai, India, and 11,642

passengers traveled to Islamabad, Pakistan.

The total volume of air cargo and mail handled in July amounted to 31,804 tons. This included 12,140 tons of transit cargo, 11,870 tons of inbound cargo, and 7,794 tons of outbound cargo.

The strong performance of Bahrain International Airport in July reflects the growing popularity of the country as a regional hub for travel and trade.

This positive trend is expected to continue in the coming months, further boosting Bahrain's economy and tourism sector.

The bills, carrying maturity of 182 days, are issued by the CBB, on behalf of the Kingdom of Bahrain.

The issue date of the bills is August 25, and the maturity date is February 23, 2025.

The weighted average rate of interest is 5.94% compared to 6.29% of the previous issue on July 28.

The approximate average price for the issue was 97.086%, with the lowest accepted price being 97.033%.

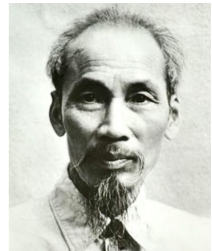
Gold prices were trading below record high levels yesterday after a rally fuelled by Western fund inflows and U.S. rate-cut optimism.

Spot gold was unchanged at \$2,514.03 per ounce, as of 0710 GMT, after hitting an all-time

high of \$2,531.60 on Tuesday. U.S. gold futures rose 0.1% to \$2,551.80, Reuters reported.

Gold has gained nearly \$470 or 22% so far this year.

Spot silver edged 0.4% higher to \$29.53 per ounce, platinum gained 0.5% to \$951.10 and palladium fell 0.3% to \$923.30.



News in brief

Authorities in central Iran executed a male fortune-teller for raping and sexually assaulting his clients, the judiciary said yesterday. "A fortune-teller, who assaulted women and girls was executed in Yazd prison," said Hossein Tahmasebi, chief justice of the central province, according to the Iranian judiciary's Mizan Online website. "The sentence of this rapist fortune-teller was carried out after being issued by the Revolutionary Court of Yazd and confirmed by the supreme judicial authority". According to Tahmasebi, the man had "assaulted and raped women and girls under false pretences", using his fortune-telling services to deceive his clients. Mizan reported that the convict was arrested sometime between March 2020 and March 2021 and that his request for amnesty was rejected because of "the number of complaints" against him.



Iran executes fortune-teller over rapes

Divers searching for six missing people following the sinking of a superyacht off Sicily have found four bodies, a source close to the search told AFP yesterday. The discovery brings the confirmed death toll from the disaster off the Italian island to five, after the body of a man believed to be the yacht's chef was recovered hours after the sinking on Monday. There were no immediate details about the bodies found. UK tech tycoon Mike Lynch and his teenage daughter Hannah are among the six people missing. The 56-metre (185 feet) British-flagged "Bayesian" had been anchored some 700 metres off Porticello when it was struck by a waterspout -- akin to a mini-tornado -- during a pre-dawn storm.

Gaza's civil defence agency said yesterday two people were killed and 10 children injured in the latest Israeli strike on a school-turned-shelter, while the Israeli military reported it hit a Hamas command centre. "Two martyrs were recovered and 15 injured, including 10 children" after Israeli planes struck the Salah al-Din school in Gaza City, agency spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP. The Israeli military said in a statement that the air force "conducted a precise strike on Hamas who were operating inside a command and control centre" located in the school compound. "Hamas operatives used the compound as a hideout and a base to plan and execute attacks against IDF (Israel Defense Forces) troops and the State of Israel," a statement said.

Barack Obama told fellow Democrats in Chicago Tuesday that "the torch has been passed" to Kamala Harris and that the United States was ready for her to become president.



Former president Obama, who was greeted with rapturous applause and cheers at the packed arena hosting the party's nominating convention, said Vice President Harris would fight for Americans, and called her November poll rival Donald Trump "dangerous." Obama called Harris "someone who sees you and hears you and will get up every single day and fight for you." "Yes she can," Obama said of Harris, prompting the boisterous crowd to repeatedly chant the phrase, recalling Obama's own "Yes we can" campaign slogan.

Before his stardust performance, his wife and former US first lady Michelle Obama told convention goers "something magically wonderful is in the air." "It's the contagious power of hope," she said, calling Harris "my girl" and saying that hope -- another rallying cry of her husband's successful 2008 campaign -- "is making a comeback." His turn amped up the already buoyant mood in Chic-

India's Narendra Modi launched yesterday his historic trip to Poland and Ukraine, where the premier has pledged to campaign for a peaceful resolution of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

Modi will be the first Indian prime minister to make a Ukraine trip and first in 45 years to travel to Poland, Kyiv's staunch ally

Tusk and President Andrzej Duda on Thursday, as well as with Indian nationals living in the Central European country. "This visit will add momentum

to the India-Poland friendship and benefit the people of our nations," Modi said on X upon landing in Warsaw.

Modi will commemorate an Indian maharaja who sheltered Polish children during World War II, before laying flowers at a war memorial and delivering a speech to the Indian community in Poland.

Poland "needs a lasting partnership with India," deputy Pol-

ish Prime Minister Wladyslaw Kosiniak-Kamysz told reporters before Modi's visit, adding that economic ties would also be on the agenda.

Meeting with Zelensky

"As a friend and partner, we hope for an early return of peace and stability in the region," Modi said in a statement published Wednesday before his departure for Poland.

In Kyiv, Modi will hold talks with President Volodymyr Zelensky and "share perspectives on peaceful resolution of the ongoing Ukraine conflict," the statement added.

"India has consistently advocated for diplomacy and dialogue to reach a negotiated settlement," Indian foreign ministry official Tanmaya Lal said before the visit. Zelensky announced on Mon-

New Delhi has pushed Moscow to return several of its citizens who signed up for "support jobs" with the Russian military but were later sent to fight on the frontlines in Ukraine.

At least five Indian soldiers have been killed in the conflict.

Russia-China partnership 'yielding results', Putin says

President Vladimir Putin said yesterday that Russia's economic and trade links with China are "yielding results" as he welcomed Chinese Premier Li Qiang to the Kremlin. Moscow has looked to Beijing as an economic lifeline since the Ukraine conflict began, with the two boosting trade to record highs as Russia faces heavy economic sanctions from the West. "Our trade relations are developing successfully... The

In May, Putin visited his Chinese counterpart Xi Jinping in Beijing. The Russian leader framed the partnership as a "stabilising" force in a chaotic world.

Pakistan man faces cyber terror charge over false posts linked to UK riots

A Pakistani man appeared in court yesterday to face charges of cyber terrorism after allegedly spreading disinformation on his clickbait website thought to have fuelled anti-immigration riots in Britain. Farhan Asif was accused of publishing an article on his Channel3Now website falsely claiming that a Muslim asylum seeker was suspected in a deadly knife attack on children in the

United Kingdom. UK authorities have blamed online misinformation for sparking days of riots which targeted mosques and hotels housing asylum seekers as well as police officers and other properties. "He is a 31-year-old software engineer with no journalism credentials, apart from running the Channel3Now website, which served as a source of income for him," a senior official at Pakistan's Federal Investigation Agency told AFP on condition of anonymity. "Initial investigations indicate that his sole intent was to make money through clickbait content." Asif appeared at a Lahore district court on Wednesday charged with cyber terrorism and was remanded to custody for one day, the official added. The article with the false information was published on Channel3Now just hours after the attack and was widely cited

in viral social media posts. More than a dozen English towns and cities saw unrest and riots after the July 29 knife attack that killed three girls during a dance class in Southport. The man charged with murder and attempted murder over the stabbing spree, Axel Ruda-kubana, was born in Britain to parents who hail from Rwanda, an overwhelmingly Christian country. Officials have blamed far-right elements for helping to stir up the disorder.

28 killed as bus carrying Pakistan pilgrims crashes in Iran

At least 28 Pakistani pilgrims travelling to Iraq for a Shiite Muslim ritual were killed as their bus crashed in central Iran, state media reported early yesterday. "A bus carrying 51 Pakistani pilgrims overturned and caught fire in front of Dehshir-Taft checkpoint in the central province of Yazd on Tuesday night," Iranian state television reported. It said "28 people have been killed and 23 injured so far with the possibility of the death toll increasing."

Yazd province crisis management chief Ali Malek-zadeh told the broadcaster that some of the injured were in critical condition. "Of the 23 injured, six have already been discharged from hospital, while the condition of seven others is critical," Malek-zadeh said. "The dead consisted of 11 women and 17 men," he added. Head of Iran traffic police, Teymour Hosseini, cited "technical failure in the brake system" and

the "high inclination of the road" as the reasons for the crash. The Iranian and Pakistani foreign ministries expressed their condolences and sympathies to the families of the bereaved. Most of the victims are residents of Pakistan's southeastern Sindh province where the bus journey began. Syed Sultan Ali, the brother of the tour operator, told AFP: "My older brother Syed Shamsi has been running this service since

2010, and it has always gone so well. We have been deeply upset since last night." He added that his brother is "unhurt" because he was travelling in a separate vehicle. The Pakistani pilgrims were headed through Iran to Iraq to attend the Arbaeen commemoration, one of the biggest events of the Shiite calendar which marks the 40th day of mourning for Imam Hussein, the grandson of the Prophet Mohammed.

UK to build military test site to combat GPS jamming

London, United Kingdom

The UK is to build a new facility to help protect military equipment against foreign GPS jamming, the defence ministry announced yesterday amid a

rise in hostile threats. The so-called silent hangar site will aim to protect equipment from "attempts to jam GPS devices" and develop kit that can "perform in the harshest electromagnetic environ-

ment on operations", the MoD said. The facility, which is due to open in 2026 and will be one of the largest in Europe, will be used to test military equipment including Protector drones, Chi-

nook helicopters, armoured vehicles and fast jets. The tests will be conducted in a specialist hangar, which will "reduce reflections, echoes or the escape of radio-frequency waves".

Ship catches fire after attack off Yemen: UK agency

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

Three projectiles hit a merchant vessel off Yemen's rebel-held port city of Hodeida on Wednesday, causing a fire onboard and leaving the ship without engine power, a British maritime security agency said. The ship initially exchanged fire with two small vessels, one with three to five people onboard while the second carried around 10, the United Kingdom Maritime Trade Operations (UKMTO) said. The ship was later "struck by two unidentified projectiles

before being hit by a third," the agency, which is run by Britain's Royal Navy, said. "There is a fire onboard and the vessel has lost engine power," it said, adding that there were no reports of casualties. "The vessel is drifting and not under command," UKMTO said. A spokesperson for the Greek port authority identified the vessel as the Greek-flagged Sounion, an oil products tanker owned by Delta Tankers, a Greek shipping company. The ship, which carried a crew of 25 people, mostly Filipinos,

departed from Iraq and was destined for a port near Athens where many refineries are based, the Greek port authority said. No injuries have been reported so far, according to the port authority, which said the ship could have been hit either by missiles or drones. In a separate incident south of the Yemeni port city of Aden on Wednesday, another ship reported two explosions in the water in close proximity, UKMTO said. The crew are reported safe and vessel is proceeding to the next port of call, the agency added.

Jennifer Lopez has filed for divorce from Ben Affleck, US media reported Tuesday, two years after the Hollywood power couple officially gave love a second chance by tying the knot.

The pair, who were nicknamed "Bennifer" when they first dated in the frenzied tabloid celebrity days of the early 2000s, had rekindled their relationship almost two decades later.

But Lopez on Tuesday filed divorce papers at a Los Angeles court, Hollywood trade outlet Variety and celebrity gossip website TMZ said.

A representative for Lopez declined comment. Affleck's Jennifer Lopez and Ben Affleck

publicist did not immediately respond to an AFP request for comment.

It was the fourth marriage for pop singer-turned-actress Lopez, 55, and the second for Oscar-winning movie star and director Affleck, 52.

The pair first met in 2002 on the set of the widely panned movie "Gigli."

They became a media sensation as they started dating and announced their engagement.

But they postponed their planned 2003 nuptials, and announced their relationship was over in early 2004.

"Bennifer" set the internet alight again in 2021 when photos of them together again began circulating.

"It's a beautiful love story that we got a second chance," Lopez said in an interview around that time.

Lopez and Affleck announced their engagement in April 2022, and the A-list lovebirds wed in Las Vegas in July.

They made it official again the following month in a lavish ceremony at the "Good Will Hunting" star's 87-acre (35-hectare) estate in the southeastern US state of Georgia.

Among the Hollywood types in attendance at the three-day affair were longtime Affleck pal Matt Damon and director

Kevin Smith. The couple reportedly bought a \$60 million home together in Los Angeles last year.

But rumors of marital troubles emerged in the entertainment press and on social media earlier this year.

Fans noted that Lopez celebrated her 55th birthday without her husband last month, and TMZ said they had sold their joint home, with Affleck moving into a luxury bachelor pad.

People magazine said relations became strained because of their different approaches to celebrity.

"She likes to open her heart to her fans and to the world," the magazine quoted an unnamed source saying.

"He is more introspective and private. This has been difficult day-to-day."

Divorce papers listed the couple's date of separation as April 26, 2024, according to TMZ, which said the pair are no longer on speaking terms.

Lopez was previously married to actor Ojani Noa, dancer Cris Judd and singer Marc Anthony, with whom she shares twins Max and Emme.

Affleck was married to actress Jennifer Garner and they are the parents of Violet, Seraphina, and Samuel.

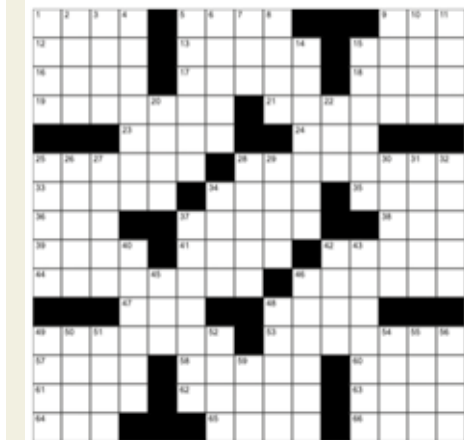

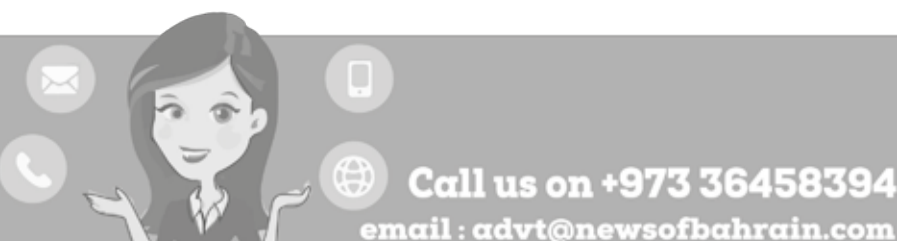

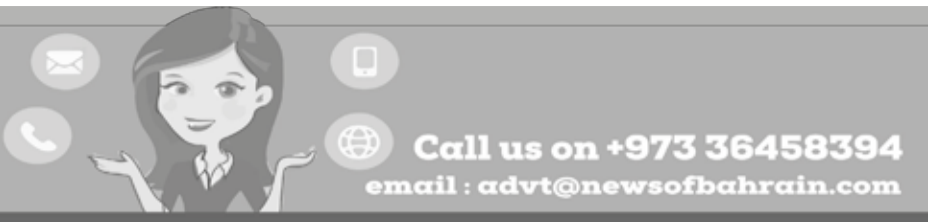

Maresca defends Chelsea's transfer moves

Chelsea manager dismisses squad criticism, highlights Joao Felix's return

● Joao Felix returns to Chelsea on a seven-year contract

● Conor Gallagher moves to Atletico Madrid in a permanent deal

● Maresca downplays "mess" claims, focuses on 21-player squad

Chelsea boss Enzo Maresca insisted yesterday he was not presiding over a "mess" of a squad after the London club were involved in yet more transfer activity.

Joao Felix signed a seven-year contract at Stamford Bridge, with his return from Atletico Madrid to the club where he spent an underwhelming spell on loan in the 2022/23 season helping facilitate Conor Gallagher's move in the opposite direction.

Maresca now has one of the

largest squads in the Premier League at his disposal, although he has made it clear Raheem Sterling and Ben Chilwell are not part of his plans.

But speaking ahead of Chelsea's Conference League play-off against Servette, Maresca said criticism of the club's transfer policy had been unfair.

"I am not working with 42 players, I am working with 21

players (in first-team training)," the Italian said.

"It's not a mess like it looks from outside. The other players can even have 20 years contract, it is not my point. I don't care."

'Impossible to give everyone minutes'

As for the position of Sterling and Chilwell, he added: "In this moment, they are training apart

(from the squad). As I said, the situation with both of them is quite clear.

"We have a big squad, for me it's impossible to give everyone minutes so if they're looking for minutes, probably it is better to leave. And in case they don't leave, they have a contract here, they are Chelsea players."

But he was understandably more upbeat about Joao

Felix, with Maresca -- whose side started the new Premier League season with a 2-0 defeat by champions Manchester City last weekend, saying: "He is a good player, a talent. The club already knows him from two years ago.

"He can play different positions with us, inside, as a nine, outside."

No transfer fee was revealed for the former Benfica star, who made two appearances for Portugal at Euro 2024, but UK press reports earlier stated Chelsea had agreed to pay £40 million

(\$51 million) to Atletico.

Joao Felix joined Atletico in 2019 and made 131 appearances for Diego Simeone's side, although he spent last season on loan at Barcelona.

He previously made 20 appearances in all competitions during a six-month loan spell with Chelsea, scoring four goals.

"I loved my time here before and I told my friends and family that I'd love to return to the Premier League one day," the player told Chelsea's official website.

"To do that with Chelsea is a great feeling and I'm excited to be back."

Earlier, Gallagher completed his permanent transfer after an intended move to the Spanish side collapsed last week when Chelsea were unable to agree a deal for Atletico striker Samu Omorodion.

Gallagher had trained alone since returning to Chelsea last week after being pictured in Spain ahead of his proposed £33 million transfer.

The 24-year-old won the 2019 Europa League with Chelsea and leaves the London side after 95 appearances and 10 goals.

Germany goalkeeper Neuer retires from international duty

Germany goalkeeper Manuel Neuer, a 2014 World Cup winner, announced his retirement from international football yesterday at the age of 38.

Bayern Munich veteran Neuer played 124 matches for Germany, captaining his country 61 times. His final appearance came in the quarter-final loss to eventual champions Spain at Euro 2024.

Neuer wrote on social media that although he was tempted to play until the 2026 World Cup, he was "convinced that now is the right time to take this step".

He shone at the 2014 World Cup in Brazil and was named as the tournament's best goalkeeper as Germany won the trophy for the fourth time.

Known as the archetypal 'sweeper-keeper' of the modern era, Neuer revolutionised the position, often venturing far from his penalty box to snuff out attacks while possessing skills with his

feet usually reserved for outfield players.

Neuer revealed he had made the announcement after discussions with his family, as well as a comprehensive conversation with Germany coach Julian Nagelsmann yesterday morning.

He said he planned to "concentrate fully" on playing for Bayern, with whom he has won two Champions Leagues and 11 Bundesliga titles.

This season's Champions League final will take place at Munich's Allianz Arena.

Neuer broke his leg in a skiing accident in December 2022 and only returned to the Germany

squad just ahead of Euro 2024 on home soil, reclaiming his role as first choice.

He was criticised before Euro 2024 after a series of mistakes at club and international level, but impressed at the tournament.

"It was a great time which shaped me and of

which I am very proud," he said.

"Winning the World Cup title in 2014 and the special atmosphere during the European Championship at home this year are highlights for which I am extremely grateful.

"It was an honour for me to be captain of our national team until 2023. I loved wearing the Germany jersey."

From 2010 until 2016, Neuer and Germany made it to the final four of every major tournament.

After disappointing group-stage exits at the 2018 and 2022 World Cups and a last-16 elimination by England at Euro 2020, Germany won their first knockout match in eight years at Euro 2024.

Neuer follows fellow 2014 World Cup winners Thomas Mueller and Toni Kroos, who both played at Euro 2024, into international retirement.

On Monday, current Germany captain Ilkay Gundogan, who missed the 2014 World Cup campaign through injury, also announced he had played his last game at international level.

Left-handers Saud Shakeel and Saim Ayub hit fighting half-centuries to help Pakistan recover to 158-4 on a rain-hit opening day of the first Test against Bangladesh in Rawalpindi yesterday.

Shakeel was unbeaten on 57 at the close while Ayub scored 56 for his maiden fifty during an innings-building stand of 98 for the fourth wicket after Pakistan were tottering at 16-3.

Shakeel brought up 1,000 runs in his 11th Test when he reached 33 and hit five boundaries in his

seventh half-century. He added a further 44 for the fifth wicket with Mohammad Rizwan, who

was unbeaten on 24.

Ayub, who hit four boundaries and a six, fell late in the day, driving wildly off Hasan Mahmud and was caught at third slip.

The new-ball pairing of Shoriful Islam (2-30) and Mahmud (2-33) jolted Pakistan after a delayed start of 230 minutes due to a wet outfield after overnight rain.

Shoriful removed the home team's skipper Shan Masood for

six and then star batter Babar Azam for a two-ball duck before Pakistan launched their recovery on a greenish pitch.

Mahmud hoped Bangladesh would dismiss Pakistan early on Thursday.

“We tried to bowl in the right areas and got early success,” he said. “We will come up with a plan to get early wickets on this pitch tomorrow.”

Ayub said the partnership with Shakeel was crucial.

“We lost early wickets so it was important to build partnerships and we did that and I am sure the good work will continue tomorrow,” he said.

Bangladesh skipper Najmul Hossain Shanto wasted no time in sending Pakistan in to bat after winning the toss and had them on 81-3 at tea.

Mahmud gave the visitors the first breakthrough when Abdullah Shafique was smartly caught at gully by Zakir Hasan for two in the fourth over.

Shoriful then had Masood caught behind off a sharp delivery, with Bangladesh successfully reviewing a not out decision by South African umpire Adrian Holdstock.

Azam nicked a leg-side delivery in Shoriful's next over and was caught by wicketkeeper Liton Das for his first home-ground duck in 14 Tests.

Pakistan entered the Test with four fast bowlers in an all-pace attack with no frontline spinner, while Bangladesh included three pacers and two spinners.

The two-match series is part of the nine-team World Test championship, with Pakistan currently sixth in the standings and Bangladesh eighth.
