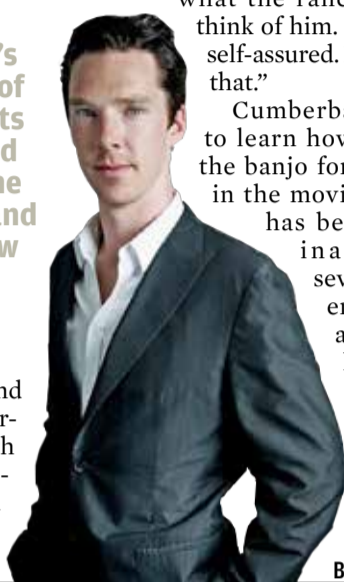
know he has. "But he can also stand behind his back and survey all these scenes with a sort of calm acceptance and knowing. And not be taken in with

A bit of Radiohead. It's very meditative. I'm not gonna sing on a stage any time soon; it's just for my own enjoyment. But I really do love it."
