
## UEFA launch probe into Barcelona refereeing scandal

E uropean football's governing body UEFA said yesterday it was launching an investigation into claims Barcelona paid for favourable refereeing

UEFA said its ethics and disciplinary inspectors would probe "a potential violation of UEFA's legal framework by FC Bar-celona in connection with the so-called 'Caso Negreira", referring to the Spanish league's former refereeing chief Jose Maria Enriquez Negreira.
