

### **Western powers** voice 'serious concern' over Iran nuke plan

**AFP** | Washington

The US, Britain, France and Germany yesterday expressed "serious concern" over Iran's plans to launch a series of new centrifuges for its nuclear program, urging Tehran to reengage with the UN nuclear watchdog.

Iran's announcement came after the four Western powers brought a censure motion targeting the Islamic republic at the 35-nation board of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). The resolution was adopted on Thursday.

"We note with serious concern Iran's announcement... that, instead of responding to the resolution with cooperation, it plans to respond with further expansion of its nuclear program in ways that have no credible peaceful rationale," the four nations said in a joint statement released by the US State Department.

# Israeli air strike kills 15 in Beirut

City residents left in shock after residential building reduced to rubble

AFP | Beirut

ebanon said an Israeli air strike in the heart of Beirut that brought down a residential building and jolted residents across the city killed at least 15 people yesterday.

A Lebanese security source told AFP that the strike had "targeted a leading Hezbollah figure", but a Hezbollah lawmaker denied any official of the Iranbacked group was present.

The attack in the capital was followed by others in the city's southern suburbs after calls by the Israeli military to evacuate.

Israel has not commented on the strike in central Beirut.

MP proposes to cut criminal record delays and expedite clearances for former offenders

ormer offenders in Bahrain could soon have their criminal records cleared far more quickly under a proposed change to the law.

MP Jalal Kadhem has tabled a plan to reduce the waiting period for record clearance to just three months for misdemeanours and one month for felonies down from the current one year and two years, respectively.

The proposal aims to help individuals rebuild their lives and return to society more quickly after serving their sentences or receiving a pardon.



# What forcing Google to sell Chrome could mean

Selling Chrome would also deprive Google of a rich source of information used to train its algorithms and promote its other services like Maps.

s antitrust lawyers are calling on a judge to force the sale of Google's Chrome browser to limit the company's market clout in a move that would shake up the internet giant.

On Wednesday, the US Department of Justice submitted its recommendation for the Judge Amit Mehta, who is set to impose steps next year to address Google's monopoly power in online search.

### **Blow to Google?**

"This would be a huge gut punch to Google," said Wedbush Securities analyst Dan Ives.

Google provides free search, making money off targeting ads and features that promote online commerce.

"It would greatly alter (Google's) business model," said Syracuse University professor of advertising Beth Egan.

Selling Chrome would also deprive Google of a rich source of information used to train its algorithms and promote its other services like Maps.

Launched in 2008, Chrome dominates the browser market, dwarfing rivals Edge and Safari, developed by Microsoft and Apple, respectively.

## Ferdinand Marcos' security detail

has been put on alert over what his office is calling an "active threat" against his life by Vice President Sara Duterte, the palace said Saturday. The statement followed an expletive-laced press conference in which Duterte alleged she was the subject of an assassination plot and said

she ordered a member of her security team to kill the president should it succeed. The Duterte and Marcos families have seen their alliance unravel in spectacular fashion

in recent months, trading accusations of drug addiction and increasingly extreme rhetoric ahead of next year's mid-term elections and presidential polls in 2028. "I already talked to a person in my security. I told him if I get killed, kill BBM (Ferdinand Marcos), (first lady) Liza Araneta and (the president's cousin) Martin Romualdez. No joke," Duterte said at a press conference that began after midnight. "I said, if I die, don't stop until you

NATO chief discusses 'global

◆ NATO chief Mark Rutte held talks with US President-elect Donald Trump in Florida on the "global security issues facing the alliance", a spokeswoman said Saturday. The meeting took place on Friday in Palm Beach, NATO's Farah Dakhlallah said in a statement. In his first term Trump aggressively pushed

Europe to step up defence spending and questioned the fairness of the NATO transatlantic alliance. The former Dutch prime minister had said he wanted to meet Trump two days after Trump was elected on November 5, and discuss the threat of increasingly warming ties between North Korea and Russia.

◆ **Sweden's coast guard** said Saturday it had joined Denmark in monitoring a Chinese ship anchored off their coasts, after two undersea cables

were severed in a suspected sabotage case. Sections of the two telecom cables were cut on Danes guarding November 17 and 18 in Swedish territorial waters Chinese ship in of the Baltic Sea. Swedish and Finnish police have cable probe opened investigations and European officials have said they suspect "sabotage" linked to Russia's invasion of Ukraine. The Kremlin has rejected the comments as "absurd" and "laughable". The Yi Peng 3 sailed over the cables around the time they were severed, according to ship tracking sites, though there is nothing to indicate that it was involved in the incidents. The ship has remained anchored in the

narrow Kattegat strait between Sweden and Denmark since Tuesday. China's foreign ministry has denied any responsibility in the matter. "China is currently working with relevant parties including Denmark to maintain smooth communication through diplomatic channels," a Chinese foreign ministry spokesperson said Friday.


