Russia: Bahrain raises concern

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs yesterday raised concerns over the developments in the Russian Federation, stating that it is closely observing the evolving situation.

Bahrain stressed the utmost importance of upholding stability within the Russian Federation, a Permanent Member of the UN Security Council with a significant role in international peace and security, under the leadership of President Vladimir Putin.

In an official statement, the Kingdom also urged the significance of adhering to laws in Russia, as this is crucial for preserving the security and stability that the Russian people.

Bahrain yesterday strongly condemned the attacks carried out by Israeli settlers in the West Bank, which resulted in casualties and injuries.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in a statement, reiterated the Kingdom's unwavering stance, urging for peace and tranquility in the Palestinian territories, cessation of violence and escalation, and the safeguarding of civilian lives.

Additionally, the ministry reaffirmed Bahrain's call for the resumption of the peace process and stressed the importance of establishing an independent Palestinian state, with East Jerusalem serving as its capital, in accordance with the principles of the two-state solution.

The rebel Wagner mercenary force threatened to march on Moscow yesterday before announcing a stunning pull-back, as Kyiv seized on the chaos to launch new assaults against Russian positions in Ukraine.

The Wagner private army captured a key military headquarters in southern Russia, and sent a force north to threaten the capital, defying Kremlin chief Vladimir Putin's warning of civil war. But amid Russia's most serious security crisis in decades, Wagner chief Yevgeny Prigozhin delivered a surprise announce-

Harsh measures on way

"Any internal turmoil is a deadly threat to our statehood and to us as a nation. This is a blow to Russia and to our people," Putin said, demanding national unity.

"Extravagant ambitions and personal interests led to treason," Putin said, referring to Prigozhin, who began building

his powerbase as a catering contractor. "All those who consciously stood on the path of betrayal, who prepared an armed rebellion, stood on the path of blackmail and terrorist methods, will suffer inevitable punishment, before the law and before our people," Putin vowed.

ment, saying his troops were turning back to avoid bloodshed in the Russian capital.

"We are turning our columns around and going back to field camps," Prigozhin announced

after previously vowing to march on Moscow to topple the military leadership.

He said understood the importance of the moment and did not want to "spill Russian blood." Belarusian leader Alexander Lukashenko said he had negotiated a truce with Prigozhin "on stopping the movement of armed individuals from the Wagner group on Russian territory and further steps on deescalating tensions."

Kyiv revelled in the chaos, as Putin's former mercenary ally Prigozhin turned his Wagner force away from the offensive against Ukraine and made threats to topple the chiefs of Russia's military.

"The man from the Kremlin is obviously very scared and is probably hiding somewhere," Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelensky said in his daily address, adding that Putin has "created this threat himself."

Separately, Ukraine's deputy defence minister Ganna Mal'yar announced that Ukrainian forces had gained more ground in the eastern region of the Donbas, launching new counteroffensives in several areas.

Putin's spokesman insisted the Russian leader was still at work in the Kremlin and had not fled Moscow.



Putin accused Prigozhin -- whose private army provided shock troops for Moscow's offensive in Ukraine -- of a "stab in the back" that posed a threat to Russia's very survival.

Russian regular forces had launched what one regional governor called a "counter-terrorist operation" to halt the Wagner advance northwards up a main highway towards Moscow.

The governor of the Lipetsk region, whose capital is just 420 kilometres (260 miles) south of Moscow, said Wagner's private military force was "moving across" the territory and urged civilians not to leave their homes.

In the capital, the mayor urged Muscovites to stay indoors and declared Monday a day off work. Prigozhin said his troops had taken control of the military command centre and airbase in the southern city of Rostov-on-Don, the nerve centre of Russia's offensive in Ukraine.



Outdoor work ban begins on July 1; pledges zero tolerance for violations

● **Summer work ban effective from 1st of July to 31st of August**

● **Ongoing projects will not be affected by the ban: minister**

Bahrain will enforce a two-month summer outdoor work ban starting on the 1st of next month, announced Labour Minister Jameel Humaidan.

The minister also pledged a zero-tolerance policy towards those who violate the ban.

According to Article (192) of Law 36 of 2012, violators may face a jail term of up to three months and/or a fine ranging from BD500 to BD1000.

The ban, effective during July and August, will apply to work conducted under direct sunlight and in open areas from midday until 4 pm, as specified by the Ministry of Labour.

The objective is to safeguard workers, ensuring their safety by protecting them from heat stress, sunstroke, summer diseases, and reducing occupational accidents during the hottest months of the year.

The ministry urged everyone

to comply with the ban and has initiated an awareness-raising campaign. It has distributed brochures, multilingual leaflets, and informative posts highlighting the impact of high temperatures on workers' health and safety.

The ministry said it has also provided guidance to health

and safety supervisors in private sector institutions regarding the necessary measures to protect workers from summer-related illnesses and occupational accidents.

The minister also called upon private institutions to intensify efforts in raising awareness among workers about summer

diseases, highlighting the risks of excessive work in hot weather. He also stressed the importance of providing healthcare, first aid, and exploring ways to minimise exposure to heat and humidity.

The minister commended private sector companies for their past compliance with the ban, recognising their commitment to creating a safe and suitable work environment for employees.

The minister also assured that ongoing projects will not be affected by the ban and will be completed within the specified timelines.

Companies are expected to adjust work schedules during the ban period, as stated by Minister Humaidan.

EWA plans five fast charging stations for EVs

This announcement came during a meeting with the Chairman and members of the Board of Directors of the Bahrain Car Dealers Association.

The minister Sid the initiative aligns with Bahrain's goal of achieving carbon neutrality by the year 2060.

The meeting highlighted various endeavours to support renewable energy initiatives, including the adoption of EVs. It also underscored the importance of developing new renewable energy projects and establishing the necessary infrastructure for EVs, all aimed at raising public awareness and fostering a sustainable lifestyle.

SMC reports 69% surge in surgical procedures

Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC) yesterday announced a 69% increase in the number of surgical operations performed compared to previous years.

In May alone, the Operations Department at SMC successfully conducted 1,913 surgeries as part of their strategic efforts to reduce waiting lists and enhance patient care.

Dr Ahmed Muhammad Al-Ansari, the CEO of government hospitals, further provided a breakdown of the surgeries performed. These include 32 dental and maxillofacial surgeries, 389 general surgeries, 309 orthopaedic surgeries, 43 vascular surgeries, 24 neurosurgery operations, 198 ENT surgeries, 185 obstetrics and gynaecology surgeries, 141 urology surgeries, 107 children surgeries. Additionally, the hospital performed 61 burn and plastic surgeries,

276 laparoscopic procedures, 16 anaesthesia procedures, and 130 eye surgeries. To accommodate the growing demand, the medical staff's working hours have been extended from 7 am to 7 pm, and the working week expanded to six days, compared to the previous five days.

Dr Al Ansari said, as part of ongoing development initiatives, the governmental hospitals have launched a project to expand the operating rooms. He said this expansion will increase the number of operating rooms from 13 to 17, resulting in a 33% increase in their capacity to cater to over 13 medical specialities.



Urban Planning okays 11 new zoning maps

The Urban Planning and Development Authority (UPDA) has granted approval for 11 new zoning maps.

Now in its third phase, the initiative aligns with the UPDA's commitment to strategically plan and re-plan lands in the Kingdom to fulfil the requirements outlined in the National Strategic Master Plan 2030. The UPDA has called upon all property owners to take the necessary steps within a period of 90 days to update their ownership documents for properties

situated within the following zoning maps:

- Detailed zoning map of the Southern part of Eastern Sanad region (745)
- Partial detailed zoning map for Al Hamriyah (1) - Block 611
- Partial detailed zoning map of the Jebel Hebshi area - Block 435
- Detailed zoning map of Shabatha and Al Farsiya - Blocks 636-952
- Approved detailed zoning map of North West A'ali (western part) - Block 742
- Detailed zoning map of North Tubli - Blocks 701-713

• Detailed zoning map of Dar Kulaib and Zallaq - Blocks 1048 - 1051 - 1052

- Detailed zoning map of Jid Ali and Tubli - Blocks 709-721
- Partial detailed zoning map of Jidhafs and Al-Musalla areas - Blocks 411-425
- Partial detailed zoning map of East Sanad - Block 743
- Detailed zoning map of the Northeast region of Sanad - Blocks 743 - 745 - 625

To initiate the update process, owners are required to submit a copy of the ownership document, a copy of the survey certificate (if the ownership docu-

ment is outdated), and a copy of their identity card. In case the applicant possesses a power of attorney, an approved power of attorney bearing the signature of the property owner should be provided, followed by completion of the application form.

These procedures can be carried out either by visiting the UPDA's customer service center located in the Survey and Land Registration Bureau building in Sanabis or by submitting an inquiry request regarding the land situation via email to ask@upda.gov.bh or through the UPDA's platform at www.upda.gov.bh.

'I found my stolen shoes at a thrift store'

Shopper stunned to find stolen shoes for sale at thrift store

Social media platforms are filled with accounts of people discovering hidden gems at their local thrift stores. Individuals often also share stories of finding items that turn out to be incredibly valuable, surpassing their listed price.

However, in Bahrain, one shopper had an astonishing experience when he unexpectedly came across his own stolen shoes for sale at a store in Gudaibiya. Recalling the incident, the

shopper disclosed that both his and his wife's shoes had been stolen.

"Recently, I was talking a stroll

through the street lined up with second-hand shoe stores near the sacred heart church.

"However, while passing by

one pair of shoes on display there stuck me, as it looks very familiar.

"Doubts began to creep in. "So yesterday, I went to the store to verify if those were really my shoes or just my imagination," he explained.

He said: "My suspicion was confirmed—they were indeed my stolen shoes."

However, when confronted, the store owner defended himself, claiming innocence and stating that he had obtained the shoes, along with other used footwear, from a garbage col-

lector.

The owner went further, mentioning that all the used shoes on sale had come from over a thousand garbage collectors.

"Although, there was no concrete evidence to accuse the shop owner directly, I persisted in requesting the return of his shoes. Initially hesitant, the store owner eventually relented."

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, the affected individual further claimed that this incident was not an isolated case.

He said that several residents in the area had reported similar occurrences of missing shoes, as well as incidents involving children's bicycles and occasionally even water bottles being taken from outside their homes.

They said they are compelled to leave their shoe racks outside during the summer months to avoid any unpleasant odours.

"But that is now proving a headache."

The community is now calling for proactive actions to ensure the safety of their belongings and deter future thefts.

The world stands aghast at the terrible accident of the adventure submersible, Titan, which is said to have imploded and taken the lives of the five people on board. As a former seaman myself and coming from a long line of people with close ties to the sea, this is a tragedy that strikes close to my heart. It replicates the horrific lessons of the original sinking of the Titanic – that no amount of boastful technology stands a chance against the inscrutable willfulness of the ocean and every encounter with Nature – whether by sea or climbing the high mountains on land

or zipping through air to set a new airplane record – every adventure is fraught with the unknown which we cannot prepare for.

Extreme sports are all the rage these days. People sign up to trek through desert wastes, to explore icy plains, sail across uncharted seas and climb sheer rockfaces as part of their vacation. The wise ones prepare for it with discipline and gruelling schedules, save up for the best equipment and seek the help of guides who have walked the path before. The unfortunate unwise ones approach the whole thing as a fun vacay project and try to do it on the basis of a neighbourhood practice run. This is disastrous if undertaken in a group because it endangers everybody involved.

The first rule of any extreme sport is that every rule has to be respected. You are not on the trip to prove that you are bigger than Nature. You are there to pay homage to Nature and find within yourself the strength, mental, emotional and physical, to fulfill your goal. But if you find yourself overwhelmed midway, the most courageous and clever thing to do is bow out.

Disasters are no respecters of wealth or status, as the original Titanic sinking and the recent Titan tragedy shows us. Every extreme sportsman or woman is to be admired for pushing the envelope of human endurance and physical and mental grit, regardless of whether they succeed, turn back halfway to fight another day or sadly, lose their lives.

We salute the victims of the Titan. May their spirit of adventure be a beacon for us all..

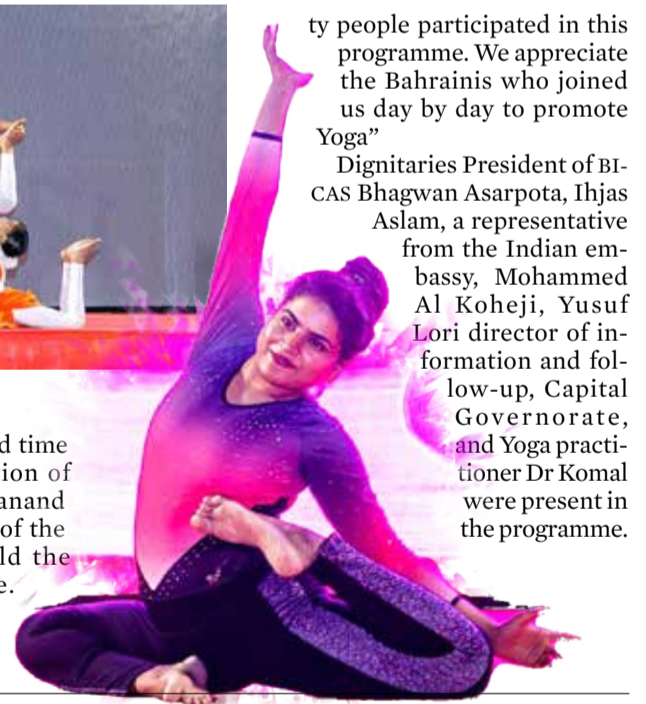

Aramco, TotalEnergies announce contracts for \$11bn Saudi complex

Saudi Aramco and France's TotalEnergies yesterday signed contracts to start building an \$11-billion petrochemicals facility in the Gulf kingdom, the two companies said.

A signing ceremony for the engineering, procurement and construction contracts for the Amiral complex took place at Aramco's headquarters in Dhahran, in Saudi Arabia's Eastern Province.

The move "marks the start of construction work on the joint petrochemical expansion", Aramco and TotalEnergies said in a joint statement.

Seven companies were awarded contracts for the construction of the project in Jubail, on

Saudi Arabia's east coast. The facility is slated to begin operations in 2027.

The project, first announced in 2018, represents an investment of around \$11 billion, of

which \$4 billion will be funded through equity by Aramco and TotalEnergies.

The complex will enable Saudi Arabia's SATORP refinery to convert internally produced off-gases and naphtha, as well as ethane and natural gasoline supplied by Aramco, into higher value chemicals.

It will have the capacity to produce 1.65 million tonnes per annum of ethylene and other industrial gases, Aramco said.

"As part of Aramco's growth strategy, the project is anticipated to contribute to value-addition opportunities in the kingdom's downstream ecosystem," Aramco president Amin Nasser said at the signing ceremony.

Biden vows to fight Republicans' 'extreme' anti-abortion agenda

President Biden denounces Republican agenda and calls for federal-level protections for abortion rights

A year after US Supreme Court scrapped the constitutional right to abortion in the United States, President Joe Biden yesterday vowed to fight against the "extreme and dangerous" effort by Republicans to curb access to the procedure nationwide.

The high court's decision to overturn the landmark Roe v. Wade decision passed the regulation of abortion back to individual states -- some of which have since moved to drastically restrict the procedure.

"State bans are just the beginning," Biden said in a statement on the anniversary of the ruling. "Their agenda is extreme, dangerous, and out-of-step with the vast majority of Americans."

Pro- and anti-abortion groups held rival events in the American capital yesterday and Vice President Kamala Harris addressed reproductive rights in a speech in the southern US state of North Carolina.

Biden warned that Republicans were working to enact a nationwide abortion ban. "Congressional Republicans want to ban abortion nationwide, but go beyond that, by taking FDA-approved medication for terminating a pregnancy, off the market, and make it harder to obtain contraception," the president said referring to the Food and Drug Administration.

They've also become an animating feature in Republican campaigns. Primary candidates are currently trying to outflank former president Donald Trump, the current frontrunner for the party's nomination, who has been criticized for flip-flopping on his position.

Speaking in Washington on Friday, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis hailed the six-week abortion ban he signed into law in his state, while ex-vice president Mike Pence challenged every candidate to back a nationwide prohibition.

"It was the right thing to do -- don't let anyone tell you it wasn't," DeSantis said in a veiled swipe at Trump, who has criticized the Florida law as "too harsh."

The same day, Biden won the endorsement from the nation's leading abortion-rights groups, including Planned Parenthood, NARAL and Emily's List.

Scots leader says independence to be 'front and centre' at next election

The Scottish National Party (SNP) will fight the next general election in the United Kingdom with independence "front and centre" of its campaign, First Minister Humza Yousaf said yesterday.

Addressing a conference of Scotland's governing party in the city of Dundee, Yousaf vowed he would seek fresh negotiations with the UK government about independence if the SNP wins the most Scottish seats in the election expected next year.

"Let me be clear, if the SNP does win this election, then the

people will have spoken," he said. "We will seek negotiations with the UK Government on how we give democratic effect to Scotland becoming an independent nation."

Yousaf's remarks come as public support wanes for the SNP after the arrest of its former leader and first minister Nicola Sturgeon, the key figurehead of the independence movement in recent years.

The Dundee meeting is the first in-person conference since Yousaf, 38, replaced her in March, and the party started to see a drastic slide in its popularity. Sturgeon, who came to power after the last -- failed -- 2014 referendum on Scotland breaking away from the UK, unexpectedly announced her resignation in February, saying she lacked the "energy" to carry on.

She was arrested and interviewed by police earlier this month over claims of mismanagement of SNP finances, weeks after her husband, the party's former chief executive, had also been detained.

No evidence Covid created in Chinese lab: US intelligence

The head of US intelligence said that there was no evidence that the Covid-19 virus was created in the Chinese government's Wuhan research lab.

In a declassified report, the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) said they had no information backing recent claims that three scientists at the lab were some of the very first infected with Covid-19 and may have created the virus themselves.

Drawing on intelligence collected by various member agencies of the US intelligence community (IC), the ODNI report said some scientists at the Wuhan lab had done genetic engineering of coronaviruses similar to Covid-19.

But the US "has no information" indicating they had done such work on the specific Covid-9 virus, known as SARS-CoV-2, or on any "close

progenitor, or a backbone virus that is closely related-enough to have been the source of the pandemic." The report, made for Congress and carrying an unclassified annex, came three months after lawmakers demanded a fuller explanation of US intelligence's information on the origins of the pandemic which erupted at the end of 2019.

Some lawmakers allege that the virus was created out of so-called gain-of-function genetic engineering research at Wuhan, and that Beijing had covered up evidence to show it was a man-made disease.

Air strikes, artillery, killings in Sudan as aid stalls

Artillery fire, air strikes and gun battles rocked Sudan's capital yesterday, witnesses said, as the UN urged a stop to "wanton killings" that have left decomposing bodies in Darfur.

While fighting rages, relief efforts have stalled after more than two months of fighting between rival generals. Houses in Khartoum shook from the fighting that continued unabated, residents said, with entire families sheltering in place, running low on vital supplies in the baking summer heat.

The United Nations says nearly 1.5 million people have fled the capital since violence erupted in mid-April, pitting the regular army against the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF).

Entire districts of Khartoum no longer have running water, and those who remain in the city have had no electricity at all since Thursday, several residents said.

The battle for power between army chief Abdel Fattah al-Burhan and his former deputy, RSF commander Mohamed Hamdan Daglo, has killed more than 2,000 people, according to the Armed Forces.

Around 40 missing in Italy migrant boat shipwreck: UN

Around 40 people are missing after a migrant boat capsized off the Italian island of Lampedusa, the UN said. The shipwreck took place on Thursday and at least one newborn baby is among those missing, said UNHCR representative to Italy Chiara Cardoletti.

The vessel left from Sfax in Tunisia and was carrying 46 migrants from Cameroon, Burkina Faso and Ivory Coast, said Flavio Di Giacomo, a spokesman for the UN migration agency IOM.

The boat capsized in strong winds and high waves, he said. "Some survivors were taken to Lampedusa and others were brought back to Tunisia."

"Among those missing were seven women and a minor. The survivors are all adult men", he added. "We have noticed more arrivals of migrants from sub-Saharan Africa than Tunisians" via the Tunisian route since November, he said.

He explained this was due to people from sub-Saharan Africa fleeing discrimination in Tunisia.

"It is unacceptable to continue counting the dead at the gates of Europe", Cardoletti wrote on Twitter.

"A coordinated and shared rescue mechanism at sea between

two states is now also a matter of conscience."

The southern Italian island of Lampedusa is one of the main entry points for migrants crossing the Mediterranean. Last year, more than 46,000 people arrived there, out of a total of 105,000 in Italy, according to the UNHCR.

Migrant boat shipwrecks have increased in recent months, while the number of migrants entering the EU via the central Mediterranean "more than doubled" in 2023 compared to the same period last year, according to the European border agency Frontex in mid-June.

Bangladesh arrests chief of Islamist militant outfit

Bangladesh police have arrested the leader of an Islamist organisation at his hideout in Dhaka, officers said yesterday, months after the launch of a crackdown against the group.

Shamin Mahfuz, the founder of Jamaat al Ansar fil Hindal Sharqia, is accused of helping to run militant training camps in the country's restive Chittagong Hill Tracts.

Police said Mahfuz was arrested late Friday along with his wife in an industrial suburb zaman of the Dhaka Metropolitan Police counter-terrorism unit told reporters. Lawyers for Mahfuz could not be reached for comment. Asadzaman said the Sharqia founder had first been detained in 2014 and came into contact with other outlawed extremist groups while in prison. He said Mahfuz had brokered a deal for the organisation to use training camps run by the Kuki-Chin National Front (KNF), a mainly Christian tribal insurgent group.

ICRF ORGANISE FREE MEDICAL CAMP FOR WORKERS



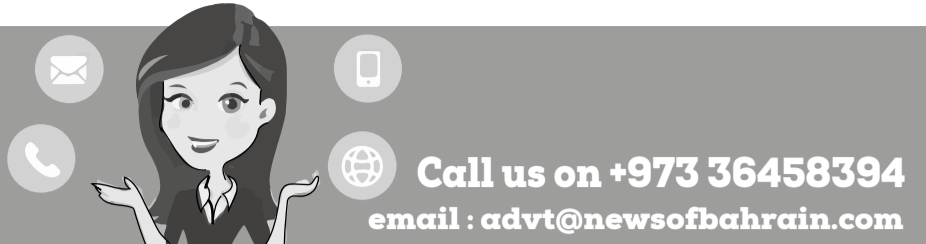

Zimbabwe stun Windies, Dutch knock Nepal out of World Cup qualifier

Zimbabwe stunned West Indies by 35 runs in a crucial World Cup qualifying triumph on yesterday while the Netherlands ended Nepal's hopes of reaching the global showpiece for the first time.

The Dutch side's seven-wicket win guaranteed a Super Sixes place and also meant that both Zimbabwe and two-time champions West Indies were assured of their places in the next round.

However, Zimbabwe will have the advantage of taking the two points from yesterday's win with them into the next stage which features the top three sides from the two groups of five.

Zimbabwe, put into bat, made 268 with Sikandar Raza top scoring with 68 from 58 balls, hitting six fours and two sixes.

Ryan Burl added a crucial 50 with five fours and a six after Zimbabwe had been 112-4 at one stage while skipper Craig Ervine made 47 at the top of the order.

In reply, West Indies were well-placed at 134-3 before

they lost seven wickets for just 99 runs.

Pole-sitter Marco Bezzecchi won the Dutch MotoGP sprint race at Assen yesterday ahead of world champion Francesco Bagnaia.

Fabio Quartararo completed the podium after third-placed Brad Binder was demoted to fifth following a penalty for track limits.

Bagnaia took command of the 13-lap dash around the classic motorcycling venue at turn one from Binder as pole man Bezzecchi was caught napping, dropping to third.

Bezzecchi bided his time and moved back to race second, leaving Bagnaia in his crosshairs.

Ten laps to go and Bezzecchi muscled past his good friend and compatriot to regain the lead, quickly opening up a half second gap.

At the midway point it was Bezzecchi's race to lose.

And the Italian, who dominated practice and set a record

lap time in qualifying, didn't disappoint, even extending his lead at the line to 1.294sec.

Kvitova ousts Garcia to reach Berlin semi-finals

Former Wimbledon winner Petra Kvitova edged Caroline Garcia 6-4, 7-6 (7/3) to seal her spot in the semi-finals of the rain-hit WTA German Open in Berlin yesterday.

The seventh-seeded Czech -- Wimbledon champion in 2011 and 2014 -- built on a solid first serve to defeat her third-seeded rival.

"I never played her on this surface and it was an advantage for me," said the 33-year-old Czech.

"It's sweet revenge after my defeat in the Cincinnati final (last year)."

The quarter and semi-finals are being played yesterday, after rain washed out play on Friday in the traditional Wimbledon warm-up.

France's Garcia, the world number four, had been in the game until conceding her serve in the seventh game of the first set which the Czech won in 52 minutes.

She saved break points in the second set, notably at 4-4, but was unable to match Kvitova in the tie-break with the Czech player sweeping 7 points to 3.

Kvitova next takes on 22nd-ranked Ekaterina Alexandrova who advanced to the last four after fellow Russian Veronika Kudermetova withdrew.

Croatia's Donna Vekic beat Russia's Elina Avanesyan 6-2, 7-6 (7/0) to reach her first grass-court semi-final in four years.

She next plays Greek sixth seed Maria Sakkari who battled past Czech Marketa Vondrousova 7-6 (9/7), 6-1 to reach her fifth semi-final of the year.

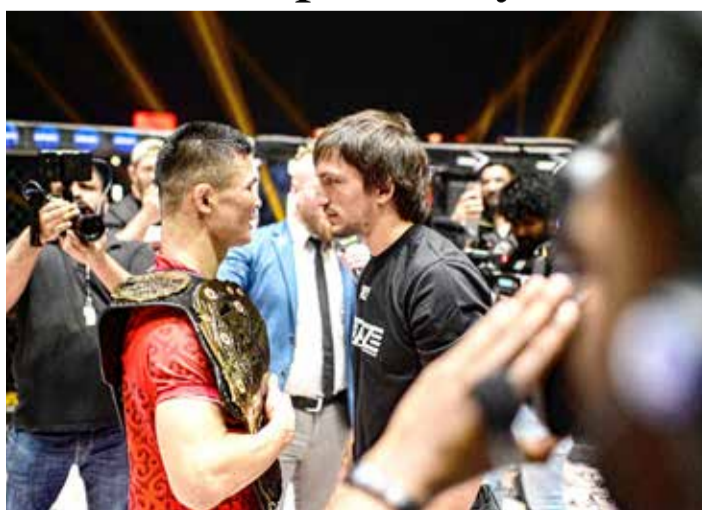

BRAVE Combat Federation has a new champion of the world. In a dogged performance in the main event of BRAVE CF 72, Nemat Abdrashitov flipped the script on its head by outlasting Roman Bogatov, widely expected to have the advantage in endurance. For Idrisov, his first professional defeat can be a learning moment, as he looks to go back to the drawing board and figure out his next steps. The IMMAF

European champion could very well reinvent himself at Bantamweight as the size difference was in his favour.

There are three other pools in this stage. Group I includes Ger-

many, Croatia, France and Tunisia; Group II consists of Portugal, the Faroe Islands, Spain and Brazil; and Group IV features Egypt, Iceland, Serbia and Greece.

The nationals need to finish in the top two to advance to the quarter-finals; otherwise, they will

play for ninth to 16th. That would be their best finish in the junior worlds, having been classified 17th overall the previous two times they played in the tournament in the 1995 and 2019 editions.

The remaining teams who did not advance to the main round are in the consolation pools where they will play for the President's Cup. Group I includes Poland, Algeria, Libya and the US; Group II features Kuwait, Japan, Angola and Costa Rica; Group III consists of Slovenia, Norway, Argentina and Greenland; and Group IV consists of Morocco, Saudi Arabia, Cuba and Chile.

The Bahrainis are coached by Essam Abdulla. Bublik beats Zverev to reach Halle final

Alexander Bublik eased past home hope Alexander Zverev 6-3, 7-5 to reach the final of the Halle ATP tournament yesterday.

Bublik, 26, will play his first final of the season in the Wimbledon warm-up grass-court event against either Spaniard Roberto Bautista Agut or Russian Andrey Rublev.

Kazak Bublik won his only title last year in Montpellier against Zverev and now holds a 3-1 record against the German.

On Saturday, Bublik took less than an hour and a half to dispatch the former world number two, firing down 14 aces with a strong service game.

In the first set, he quickly took the lead with a break in the fourth game (3-1), and then counted on his serve (6-4) to pull him through.
