## Outdoor work ban begins on July 1; pledges zero tolerance for violations

Summer work ban effective from 1st of July to 31st of August

Ongoing projects will not be affected by the ban: minister

ahrain will enforce a twomonth summer outdoor work ban starting on the 1st of next month, announced Labour Minister Jameel Humaidan.

The minister also pledged a zero-tolerance policy towards those who violate the ban.

According to Article (192) of Law 36 of 2012, violators may face a jail term of up to three months and/or a fine ranging from BD500 to BD1000.

The ban, effective during July and August, will apply to work conducted under direct sunlight and in open areas from midday until 4 pm, as specified by the Ministry of Labour.

The objective is to safeguard workers, ensuring their safety by protecting them from heat al accidents during the hottest months of the year.

The ministry urged everyone provided guidance to health among workers about summer
