Our collaboration in regional and multilateral arena have also strengthened. In significant milestones last year, Bahrain joined International Solar Alliance as Member, and India joined Combined Maritime Forces (CMF), headquartered in Bahrain as Associate Partner.

With high level political, parliamentary, official and commercial engagements, we have an exciting year ahead. We also look forward to greater participation from Bahrain (as Dialogue Partner of SCQ) in various events being hosted by India as SCO Chair this year.

This was reflected in their participation, in large numbers, in the 17 Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention, held in Indore, Madhya Pradesh from 8-10 January 2023.
