Keanu Reeves 'didn't write' new novel

eanu Reeves "didn't write Kany" of his new novel.

The 'John Wick' actor has teamed up with one of his favourite authors, China Miéville, on 'The Book of Elsewhere', which is inspired by his own 'BRZRKR' comic books and features the series' protagonist, immortal warrior Unute aka B, but he left penning the story to his collaborator.

He admitted to The Guardian newspaper: "I didn't want to write the book. I wanted another creator to take that journey. So, ultimately, China has written the novel. It's not, like, we could look at page eight and say, 'Oh, I wrote
