Bahrain's daily water, electricity consumption rises

Bahrain's daily water consumption now tops 163 million gallons — a thirst that shows no signs of slowing as power usage ticks up by 2 per cent.

Official figures reveal the country's daily electricity demand has risen to 18.657 megawatt-hours, nudging up from 18.3 megawatt-hours in 2022.

Official data shows that Bahrain produced around 70 billion gallons of distilled drinking water last year, a healthy increase from 60.5 billion gallons the previous

Among consumers, households led the way in electricity use, clocking in at 9,142 gigawatt-hours, followed by the commercial sector at 6,240 gigawatt-hours.

Industry ranked third, drawing 3,221 gigawatt-hours, while agriculture accounted for a smaller share, consuming 53.36 gigawatt-hours.

The Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) nations, including Bahrain, Saudi Arabia, and the United Arab Emirates, issued a firm condemnation of Israel's recent military actions against Iran, calling for an urgent halt to hostilities to prevent further destabilization in the region.

The statements, released on Saturday, emphasized the shared concerns of GCC member states over the escalating tensions and the potential impact on Middle Eastern stability.

Ps have proposed a new law to provide benefits for Bahraini imams by including them in the public service wage scale under the Civil Service Bureau's shift sys-

The Parliament is now proposing incentives, including bonuses for those with PhDs and master's degrees, to attract youth into these roles as imams and muezzins, and address a growing shortage in the pro-

The goal is to make these positions more appealing, as they play a vital role in upholding community traditions and religious practices.

If passed, a full-time Bahraini imam with at least a bachelor's degree in Islamic studies or an equivalent qualification would be placed at grade eight on the public pay scale.

Qualifications

Likewise, a full-time Bahraini muezzin or caretaker with comparable qualifications would be positioned at grade seven.





On a more serious note, thousands of scientists and astrophysicists are employed in unravelling the mysteries of the universe – a career path limited to a chosen few till the 20th century. Even in the GCC, countries have set up space agencies and are sending their youth to training camps to understand the joys and risks of a career that involves going into outer space.

I was thinking of all this when I read the call by MPs to implement a law to nurture a new generation of fishermen among our youth who can take forward generations of hard-won fishing knowledge. It is commendable indeed but fishing too has changed. We have powerful motorized fishing fleets, wider nets that can trawl the bottom of the sea and catch more fish. The fishing boats have freezers which help keep the catch fresh till they reach the market.

What we need to do in order to pass on the true knowledge of fishing and the marine environment is teach the new generation to respect the sea. We must not overfish, we must not use damaging deep sea nets that catch marine life other than the fish we can consume. We must not pollute our seas by dumping sewage or oil, thereby saving our fish also. These lessons are far more important and are embedded in our Bahraini marine heritage. Let us respect our seas and pass that knowledge to our next gen.



Santner heroics seal historic New Zealand Test series win in India

New Zealand made history with their first Test series triumph in India as spinner Mitchell Santner inspired a 113run win in the second match yesterday to stun the Pune crowd.

The visitors bowled out India for 245 in their chase of 359 on day three to take an unbeatable 2-0 lead in the three-match

It is India's first Test series defeat at home since December 2012, when Alastair Cook's England beat them 2-1.

Before now New Zealand had never won a Test series on Indian soil dating back to 1955 and the Black Caps celebrated to stunned silence.

"Immensely proud to be in a position of winning two Test matches here. Proud of the group," skipper Tom Latham said of his history-makers.

"Lot of New Zealand teams have come over the past 69 years and 13 series, and to be the first team to win a series here is spe-
