Troubled waters

China and US spar over alarmingly contentious South China Sea issues at Laos talks

The top diplomats of China and the US sparred yesterday over the South China Sea, where Beijing is locked in a territorial dispute with US treaty ally the Philippines.

Secretary of State Antony Blinken and Chinese foreign minister Wang Yi met on the sidelines of a foreign ministers' meeting of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) in Laos.

The US hailed the meeting as "open and productive," after Blinken had criticised Beijing's "escalatory and unlawful actions" in the South China Sea.

Chinese and Filipino ships have clashed in the waterway, fuelling fears of a conflict that could drag in the US due to its mutual defence treaty with Manila.

Flames

The US should "refrain from fanning the flames, stirring up trouble and undermining stability at sea," Wang said at the meeting, according to a foreign

ministry statement.

"The risks and challenges facing China-US relations are still rising," he said.

Blinken also raised "US concerns about provocative actions" by China, including a simulated blockade of Taiwan following the May inauguration of President Lai Ching-te.

China claims the democratic island as its territory and slammed Lai's inauguration speech as "confession of independence."

"Whenever the promoters of Taiwanese independence will make a provocation, we will respond with a countermeasure," Wang said, according to Beijing's foreign ministry.

Concerns

During the meeting, which a State Department official said lasted one hour and twenty minutes, Blinken also raised US concerns over China's support for Russia as it wages war in Ukraine.

The two had had not arranged another meeting.

of dollars of trade passes annually - almost in its entirety despite an international court ruling that its assertion has no legal basis.

A Filipino sailor lost a thumb in the latest June 17 confrontation when Chinese coast guard members wielding knives, sticks and an axe foiled a Philippine Navy resupply attempt.

Deal

Yesterday, Manila said it had

successfully resupplied troops on the Second Thomas Shoal - the focus of clashes in recent months - under a deal agreed with Beijing.

According to a Chinese foreign ministry statement released later, Wang said the deal was a "temporary arrangement... to manage the situation," without giving details.

On Friday, Wang called on the Philippines to "honour its commitments" under the deal rather than "backtracking or creating complications", warning Beijing would "respond resolutely" to any violation.

Warning

Wang also warned the Philippines over deploying a US medium-range missile system on its soil, saying it would "create tension and confrontation in the region and trigger an arms race."

The US Army said in April it had deployed the Mid-Range Capability missile system in the northern Philippines for annual joint military exercises.

Philippines military officials later said the system would be removed from the country.

Worker safety success

Midday ban slashes occupational injuries by 60%

The latest strike was at least the eighth time since July 6 a school has been hit, leaving a total of more than 100 people dead.

Regulation positively impacts productivity

Since the introduction of the Midday Summer Work Ban in 2007, Bahrain has witnessed a 60% drop in occupational injury rates, particularly those related to sunstroke and heat exhaustion.

This regulation, prohibiting outdoor work during the peak heat of July and August, has not only safeguarded workers from the extreme summer conditions

but also led to a more than 40% decrease in occupational accidents and severe injuries over the past five years.

Mustafa Al Shaikh, Director of Inspection and Occupational Safety at the Ministry of Labour, pointed out that Bahrain has advanced in providing comprehensive protection and care for all workers.

The implementation of Ministerial Decision No. 3 of 2013, which bans work under direct sunlight and in open spaces during the hottest months, has been a key measure in mitigating the risks posed by high temperatures and humidity.

Al Shaikh noted that this regu-

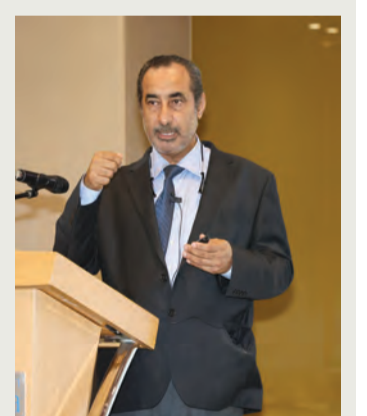
The event featured Mahmood Hasan as a special guest, who shared his extensive knowledge about Bahrain's rich history and culture under the theme "Dilmun in

Two Asian men charged with electronic fraud

Bank accounts

Two Asian men are facing charges of electronic fraud after allegedly stealing BD850 from a local resident's bank account.

The case is currently pending before the High Appeals Court, with a verdict expected on August 12.

The victim reported to the Public Prosecution that he received a text message impersonating the Benefit Company, which included a link to a website.

He was tricked into providing his personal and banking information, including his bank card verification code, on the website. He later discovered that BD850 had been withdrawn from his account.

During investigations, the victim said: "It was a very unsettling experience. I trusted the message, and I never thought I would fall prey to this kind of scam. I was shocked to find out that BD850 was withdrawn from my account after sharing my information. I tried to suspend the card as soon as possible, but it was too late, as my bank account was emptied before I even reached the customer service of my bank."

Investigations revealed that the money had been transferred to the bank accounts of the two suspects, who were identified through bank inquiries and investigations.

The suspects were found to have prior records of similar offenses and were part of a larger organised network operating outside of Bahrain.

Their role involved receiving stolen funds and transferring them out of the country.

The first suspect admitted to knowing the second suspect and claimed he had provided his bank account for receiving the money.

Stolen funds

Bank statements confirmed that the stolen funds had indeed entered the suspects' accounts.

The High Appeals Court has scheduled a hearing for August 12 to deliver its verdict.

The High Criminal Court had previously sentenced the two men in absentia to three years in prison and a fine of BD1,000 each, along with their permanent deportation from Bahrain after serving their sentence.

Beauty blunder

Court orders salon to pay customer BD300 compensation for hair damage

A young woman in her twenties was awarded BD300 in compensation after a salon damaged her hair, according to lawyer Shrefa Bouaraki.

The case was heard in the Fourth Civil Court of First Instance.

The woman had visited the salon to dye her hair. After the dye job, the salon employee advised her to return a week later for a protein treatment.

Worry

When the woman inquired about the potential for damage from the treatment, the employee assured her there was no need to worry.

The protein treatment lasted over 11 hours, during which the woman experienced burning sensations on her scalp and eyes.

The employee washed her hair, revealing significant damage and burns on her face, as well as a color change in her hair.

The woman said, "I was so excited to get my hair done, but it turned into a nightmare. I trusted the salon to take care of my hair, but they ended up ruining it."

The salon owner initially promised to resolve the issue



amicably and compensate the woman, but later failed to do so. The woman then filed a lawsuit demanding compensation for the damage caused.

The court ruled in favour of the woman, finding that the salon employee's negligence in applying the protein treatment

for an excessive duration led to the hair damage. The court acknowledged the woman's emotional distress and awarded her BD300 in compensation, deeming it sufficient to address the symbolic nature of the damage and provide her with a sense of justice.

Reckless truck driver faces probe



The Public Prosecution has commenced investigations into a video clip circulating on social media, which shows a waste collection truck driver endangering the safety of road users by driving against traffic. This was announced by the Deputy Head of the Traffic Prosecution. Following the incident, the General Traffic Department took immediate action and arrested the driver. During interrogation, the driver admitted to the charges. The Public Prosecution has ordered his pretrial detention pending the case, in preparation for referring the accused to criminal trial.

Man accused of assaulting hotel guest granted bail pending appeal

● Victim sustains 20% permanent disability

A man accused of assaulting another individual in a hotel in Juffair has been granted bail pending an appeal of his conviction, which was issued in absentia in 2020.

The bail was issued by the High Appeals Court which is reviewing the case.

The initial conviction stemmed from an incident in 2019 where the defendant, a Gulf national, was found guilty of striking another individual with a stick, resulting in a 20% permanent disability.

The court sentenced the defendant to imprisonment and ordered him to pay a compensation of BD5,001 to the victim.

The incident occurred at a hotel in Juffair when the victim was on his way to the cafe for breakfast.

Dispute

The defendant approached him and attacked him, allegedly after a dispute over who should take food first.

A group of people, including the defendant, then assaulted the victim, with one of them striking him on the head with a stick.



Hotel security intervened and removed the defendant and his companions.

Medical assistance

The victim received medical assistance from a bystander and was taken to a hospital.

A medical report confirmed that the victim sustained a 20% permanent disability.

The Public Prosecution charged the defendant with assault, alleging that he and unknown individuals attacked the victim, causing the injuries described in the medical report, which led to a 20% permanent disability.

Weapon

The prosecution claimed the

defendant struck the victim on the head with a weapon.

The defendant's release on bail allows him to challenge the initial conviction and present his defense before the court.

The case will now proceed with the appeal process.

Traffic relief in sight

Janabiya Highway project reaches 90% completion rate

The Janabiya Highway project is nearing completion, with progress exceeding 90%, according to Shaikh Meshaal Al-Khalifa, the Undersecretary of the Ministry of Works.

He emphasised the ministry's resolve to continue accelerating the work to finish it on schedule.

This update was shared during an inspection visit by the Undersecretary and several ministry engineers.

He noted that the project is part of the third phase of a

broader initiative to improve work, thereby enhancing the highway's capacity.

Expansion

The project involves expanding the highway to three lanes in each direction over approximately 4 kilometres and upgrading traffic intersections to handle 10,500 vehicles per hour.

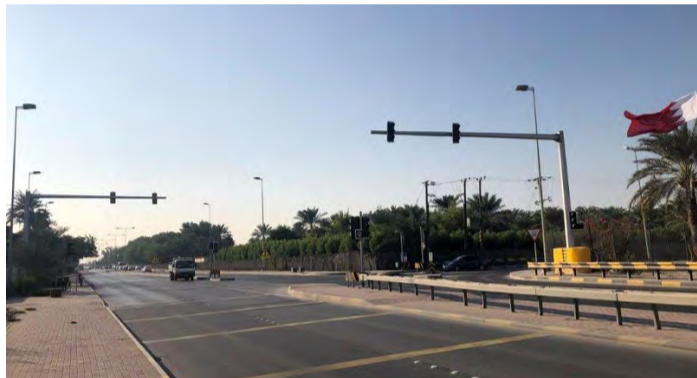
Eng. Shaikh Meshaal said that the work includes relocating and protecting services along the highway, reconstructing infrastructure, establishing a rainwater drainage network, creating service roads and parking spaces, and boosting safety

These methods often involve threats and coercion, pressing children to reveal sensitive information, transfer money, or engage in harmful activities that bring distress to themselves and their families.

To address these risks, it is vital for both children and parents to remain vigilant and take protective measures for protection.

Parents should regularly monitor their child's online activity and maintain open communication about the potential dangers lurking in the digital realm.

Online behaviour

Discussing appropriate online behaviour and stressing the importance of not sharing personal information with strangers is essential.

Sewage law violations down in first half of 2024

The Ministry of Works has reported nine breaches of Law No. (33) of 2006 concerning sewage and surface water drainage in the first half of 2024.

This marks a decline from the same period last year, which saw 16 breaches.

The Ministry pointed out that the judicial control system is integral to its efforts to uphold the integrity and health of the sewage system infrastructure.

This system is designed to detect breaches, instruct offenders to rectify the issues, and ensure they commit to preventing future occurrences.

The Ministry emphasized the need to increase awareness among users about proper usage guidelines, which significantly impact the efficiency and effectiveness of sewage transport and treatment.

According to Article (3) of Law No. (33) of 2006, connections to public sewage facilities or the discharge of surface water into these facilities require a permit from the relevant authority.

This permit outlines the conditions, including the specifications of the works, the type and quantity of materials allowed to be discharged, and the locations, times, and duration for such discharges.

Bahrain to witness partial lunar eclipse on September 18, 2024

● **Al-Hajri: Moon to conjunct with sun on August 4, 2024**

Bahraini astronomer Ali Al-Hajri has announced that the Kingdom will experience a partial lunar eclipse on September 18, 2024, during the full moon of Rabi' al-Awwal.

This eclipse will be visible for 22 minutes, from 5:05am to 5:27am, with approximately 3.22% of the moon's surface being eclipsed at moonset.

Al-Hajri also announced that the moon will be in conjunction with the sun on Sunday, August 4, 2024, at 3:26pm, Bahrain local time.

Islamic month of Safar

This astronomical event is a key indicator for determining the start of the Islamic month of Safar 1446 AH.

According to Al-Hajri, the beginning of Safar is anticipated to be observed on either August 5 or 6, 2024, depending on the method of calculation used.

The crescent moon may be visible on the evening of Mon-

day, August 5, though observation conditions are expected to be challenging.

Crescent

At sunset on August 5, the moon will be 26 hours and 55 minutes old, and the crescent will remain visible for approximately 51 minutes.

The moon's illumination will be at a mere 1.28%, with a thickness of 23 arc seconds. Successful observation will largely depend on weather conditions.

Al-Hajri noted that those following astronomical calendars might mark August 5 as the beginning of Safar, whereas those adhering to visual sighting calendars could observe it on August 6.

Italy PM in China on first official visit

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni arrived in Beijing yesterday, Chinese state media said, in her first visit to the country since she took office nearly two years ago.

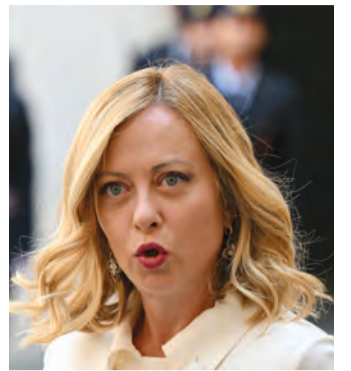
During the five-day trip she is due to meet President Xi Jinping and Premier Li Qiang, with boosting bilateral trade and ending the war in Ukraine topping the agenda.

"Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni arrived in Beijing on the afternoon of 27 July for an official visit," state broadcaster CGTN said in a post on the Weibo social network.

Meloni will be looking to "relaunch bilateral relations in sectors of common interest", an Italian official told AFP on condition of anonymity.

Talks will focus on "the main issues on the international agenda, starting with the war in Ukraine", the official added.

Meloni's administration withdrew from China's vast Belt and Road Initiative (BRI)

last year, having been the only G7 nation to sign up.

Before taking office, Meloni said joining the initiative -- a central pillar of Xi's bid to expand China's clout overseas -- had been a "mistake".

Italy's non-binding memorandum of understanding with China had contained broad undertakings for cooperation in logistics, infrastructure, financial and environmental sectors.

But details were scarce and the lack of transparency fuelled distrust among Italy's allies.

G20 pledges to work together to tax ultra-rich

AFP | Rio De Janeiro, Brazil

G20 nations have agreed to work together to make the super-rich pay their taxes, but stopped short of a more substantial deal, according to a declaration adopted Friday after a meeting of finance ministers in Rio de Janeiro.

The thorny topic of tackling tax-dodging billionaires dominated the two-day meeting in the Brazilian city, which will host the next G20 summit in November. The initiative is a key priority for Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva, who heads this year's grouping, which includes the world's major economies, the European Union and the African Union.

Lula was hoping for a minimum tax on the moneyed elite, but the final statement repre-

sents a compromise on a topic that divided member states.

"With full respect to tax sovereignty, we will seek to engage cooperatively to ensure that ultra-high-net-worth individuals are effectively taxed," said the statement.

"Wealth and income inequalities are undermining economic growth and social cohesion and aggravating social vulnerabilities." Brazil's Finance Minis-

ter Fernando Haddad said that "from a moral point of view it is important that the twenty richest nations consider that we have a problem, which is to have progressive taxation on the poor and not on the rich."

The United States and Germany dismissed the need for a global deal on taxing billionaires, an initiative which is backed by France, Spain, South Africa, Colombia and the African Union.

Time to go further'

International Monetary Fund chief Kristalina Georgieva hailed the G20's position on "tax fairness."

"The shared vision of G20 Ministers on progressive taxation is timely and welcome, as the need to rebuild fiscal buffers while also attending to

social and development needs involves difficult decisions in many countries," she said in a statement.

"Now it is time to go further," said Nobel Prize-winning economist Joseph Stiglitz on Friday, urging heads of state to coordinate minimum standards by November.

"The climate crisis is expected to cost trillions of dollars every year and it is outrageous to expect that the regular taxpayer should pay for it, while the super-rich evade taxes," said Camila Jardim of Greenpeace Brazil.

On the sidelines of the thorny tax discussions, US Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen and Brazilian Economy Minister Haddad announced on Friday the signing of a partnership on climate protection.

Trump offers tech sector policy flips ahead of election

Fiercely against social media platform TikTok, cryptocurrency bitcoin and electric cars during his presidency, Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump has recently flipped on several issues that are dear to Silicon Valley.

The presidential hopeful has, however, remained steadfast in some areas that are likely to be of concern to major US tech companies.

Here is a rundown of Trump's latest policy stance on five major tech sector issues.

Electric vehicles

"I love Elon Musk, I love him," Trump shouted Saturday during a campaign rally in Grand Rapids, Michigan, a state that is home to many US automakers.

That statement came after reports that Musk had pledged to donate \$45 million monthly to the Republican after he narrowly survived an assassination attempt -- reports Musk later denied.

Trump has, however, spent years ridiculing electric cars, bashing them as too expensive and impractical, and denying climate change concerns that have driven demand for them.

"I'm constantly talking about electric vehicles, but I don't mean I'm against them; I'm all for them," he said, adding that the cars are not for everyone.

If elected, however, Trump has said he wants to end federal subsidies that encourage buying electric cars.

The move is not likely to hurt Tesla, some of whose models are not eligible for the rebates, but would hit its US competitors.

TikTok

Trump tried in vain to ban Chinese-owned video app TikTok on national security grounds during his presidency, and spoke out against China routinely during his failed bid for reelection in 2020.

Trump expressed concerns -- echoed by political rivals -- that the Chinese government might tap into US TikTok users' data or manipulate what they see on the platform.

He even called for a US company to buy TikTok, with the government sharing in the sale price.

Now that US President Joe Biden's administration has signed a law to ban the app for the same reasons, unless it is sold, Trump has reversed course.

"Now (that) I'm thinking about it, I'm for TikTok, because you need competition," he recently told Bloomberg.

"If you don't have TikTok, you have Facebook and Instagram -- and that's, you know, that's Zuckerberg."

Facebook, founded by Mark Zuckerberg and part of his Meta tech empire, was among the social media networks that banned

Trump after attacks on the US Capitol on January 6, 2021, driven by concerns that he would use the platform to promote more violence.

Crypto

Trump's sudden support for cryptocurrencies appears to stem from a belief, expressed to Bloomberg, that "if we don't do it, China is going to figure it out -- or somebody else."

He has spun from calling bitcoin a "scam" and a disaster waiting to happen to saying in a post on his Truth Social platform that cryptocurrencies should be "MADE IN THE USA!!!"

The about-face, and his selection of crypto-industry proponent J.D. Vance as his running mate, has won Trump favor in an industry that feels it has been treated harshly by the Biden administration.

"A Trump presidency is the only path forward to help the US regulatory regime for crypto," said Digital Future founder Michelle Bond.

Trump has not explained how he intends to support the crypto sector.

Imported talent and tech

Trump took numerous measures that handicapped Silicon Valley during his time in the White House.

Among them was signing executive orders restricting visas for foreign workers whose skills

are key to US-based tech companies.

Trump also imposed high tariffs that penalized companies such as Apple that depend on China for their supply chain.

This policy, which has

largely continued under Biden, is likely to remain in place if Trump regains power.

On the campaign trail, Trump has suggested that he would expand his protectionist policies to include countries other than China as well.

On Tuesday, Musk said Tesla had put on hold plans to build a factory in Mexico because of concerns about potential tariffs under Trump.

Taxes

During his presidency, Trump's tax cuts mainly benefitted the wealthy, including tech titans.

In the run-up to the election, Biden -- and his successor as the presumptive Democratic nominee Kamala Harris -- said they wanted the rich to pay more in taxes.

Trump, however, says he wants to lower corporate tax-

US defends law forcing sale of TikTok app

San Francisco, United States

The Justice Department late Friday filed its response to TikTok's civil suit aimed at derailing a law that would force the app to be sold or face a US ban. TikTok's suit in a Washington federal court argues that the law violates First Amendment rights of free speech.

The US response counters that the law addresses national security concerns, not speech, and that TikTok's Chinese parent company ByteDance is not

able to claim First Amendment rights here. The filing details concerns that ByteDance could, and would, comply with Chinese government demands for data about US users or yield to pressure to censor or promote content on the platform, senior justice department officials said in a briefing.

"The goal of this law is to ensure that young people, old people and everyone in between is able to use the platform in a safe manner," a senior justice department official said.

Gaza health ministry says 30 killed in Israel strike on school

The health ministry in the Hamas-run Gaza Strip said an Israeli strike hit a school housing a field hospital yesterday, killing at least 30 people and wounding more than 100.

The Israeli military said it carried out a strike on the school targeting Hamas operating from there.

"A short while ago, the targeting of Khadija school, which had a field medical unit inside it, in Deir el-Balah area, resulted in 30 martyrs and more than 100 wounded," the health ministry in Gaza said in a statement.

Gaza's civil defence agency said that the school was housing about 4,000 displaced people who had taken refuge there.

Spacecraft to swing by Earth, Moon on path to Jupiter

A spacecraft launched last year will slingshot back around Earth and the Moon next month in a high-stakes, world-first manoeuvre as it pinballs its way through the Solar System to Jupiter.

The European Space Agency's Juice probe blasted off in April 2023 on a mission to discover whether Jupiter's icy moons Ganymede, Callisto, and Europa are capable of hosting extra-terrestrial life in their vast, hidden oceans.

The uncrewed six-tonne spacecraft is currently 10 million kilometres (six million miles) from Earth.

But it will fly back past the Moon then Earth on August 19-20, using their gravity boosts to save fuel on its winding, eight-year odyssey to Jupiter.

Staff at the ESA's space operations centre in Darmstadt, Ger-

many began preparing for the complicated manoeuvre this week.

Juice is expected to arrive at Jupiter's system in July 2031. It will take the scenic route. NA-

SA's Europa Clipper spacecraft is scheduled to launch this October yet beat Juice to Jupiter's moons by a year.

Long and winding road

Juice is taking the long way round in part because the Ariane 5 rocket used to launch the mission was not powerful enough for a straight shot to Jupiter, which is roughly 800 million kilometres away.

Without an enormous rocket, sending Juice straight to Jupiter would require 60 tonnes of onboard propellant -- and Juice has just three tonnes, according to the ESA.

"The only solution is to use gravitational assists," Arnaud Boutonnet, the ESA's head of analysis for the mission, told AFP.

By flying close to planets, spacecrafts can take advantage of their gravitational pull, which can change its course, speed it up or slow it down.

Many other space missions have used planets for gravity boosts, but next month's Earth-Moon flyby will be a "world first", the ESA said.

It will be the first "double gravity assist manoeuvre" using boosts from two worlds in succession, the agency said.

Juice will cross 750 kilometres above the Moon on August 19, before shooting past our home planet the following day.

The probe will leave Earth at a speed of "3.3 kilometres a second -- instead of three kilometres if we had not added the Moon", Boutonnet said.

As Juice whizzes past Earth and the Moon, it will use the opportunity to snap photos and test out its many instruments.

"Plate of spaghetti" "We are aiming for a mouse hole," Boutonnet emphasised.

The slightest error during its slingshot around the Moon would be amplified by Earth's gravity, potentially creating a small risk that the spacecraft could enter and burn up in Earth's atmos-

phere. The team on the ground will be closely observing the spacecraft -- and have 12-18 hours to calculate and adjust its trajectory if needed, Boutonnet said.

He mostly feared a scenario in which the amount of course corrections needed would erase the gains from the double-world slingshot, meaning they would be "doing all this for nothing".

If all goes well, Juice will head back out into interplanetary space -- for a little while at least. It will first head to Venus for another boost in 2025.

Juice will even fly past Earth twice more -- once in 2026, then a final time in 2029 before finally setting off towards Jupiter.

Then comes the really tricky part. Once Juice arrives at Jupiter, it will use a whopping 35 gravitational assists as its bounces around the planet's ocean moons.

8 dead in China after vehicle crashes into pedestrians

A vehicle crashed into pedestrians in a major city in central China early yesterday, killing eight people and injuring five, authorities said, without specifying whether the act was intentional or not.

The incident took place shortly after midnight in Changsha, capital of Hunan province, police said in a statement.

"A motor vehicle hit pedestrians," it said, adding that eight people had died in the tragedy and another five had been injured, at least some of whom had been hospitalised.

A 55-year-old suspect living in the area has been detained and the investigation is ongoing, the statement said.

Macron says Olympic opening ceremony made France 'extremely proud'

Paris, France



President Emmanuel Macron on Saturday hailed the opening ceremony for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, saying the bold showpiece on the River Seine had made France extremely proud.

Macron, who had long defended the concept of the first ever summer Olympics opening ceremony outside a stadium, congratulated the French security forces for ensuring it could happen.

"Everyone told us seven years ago that this was impossible to do. I remember it very well," he said at Paris police headquarters. "There were all those experts who said 'this is criminal madness' and 'this will never happen'... People said that with the terrorist risk it was impossible. But we did it thanks to your work over the last years," he said.

He said that the opening ceremony -- an eclectic mix of elements some of which angered the far right and Catholic church in France -- had "made our compatriots extremely proud".

He said that the artists and athletes had provided a "great spectacle".

France suffers second day of sabotage train delays

AFP | Paris, France

Tens of thousands of rail passengers struggled through a second day of cancelled trains yesterday as investigators tracked saboteurs who paralysed the network just ahead of the Paris Olympics opening ceremony.

The SNCF rail company chief Jean-Pierre Farandou said services would be back to normal by Monday. But deputy transport minister authorities acknowledged that 160,000 of the 800,000 people due to travel this weekend still faced cancellations.

Nearly one third of trains were cancelled in northern, western and eastern France. About a quarter of Eurostar high speed trains between London

and Paris also failed to leave. No claim of responsibility has been made for the meticulous- ly planned night-time attacks on cabling boxes at junctions

But Interior Minister Gerald Darmanin said the investigation was progressing.

"We have uncovered a certain number of elements that allow us to think that we will soon know who is responsible for what clearly did not sabotage the Olympic Games but did sabotage part of the holidays of the French people," Darmanin told France 2 television.

French authorities are on high alert for a terrorist attack during the Games, which run through August 11. Tens of thousands of police and troops are on Olympics security duties.

Some 250,000 people missed their train on Friday, according to SNCF, because of the attacks that dozens of investigators are now working on.

IOC apologises for South Korea gaffe in Olympics opening ceremony

The International Olympic Committee apologised Saturday for a gaffe during the opening ceremony of the Paris Olympics in which South Korean athletes were incorrectly introduced as North Korea.

As the South Korean delegation sailed down the Seine river in the French capital, they were introduced with the official name for North Korea: "Republique populaire democratique de Coree" in French, then "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" in English.

"We deeply apologise for the mistake that occurred when introducing the South Korean team during the broadcast of the opening ceremony," the IOC said in a

post on its official Korean-language X account.

The error sparked displeased reactions in South Korea, a global cultural and technological powerhouse that is technically still at war with the nuclear-armed and impoverished North.

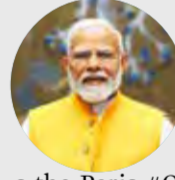

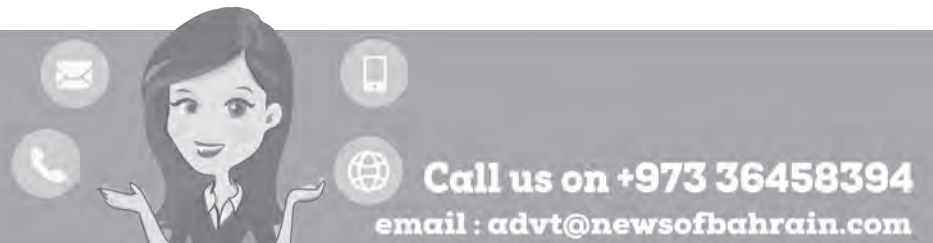

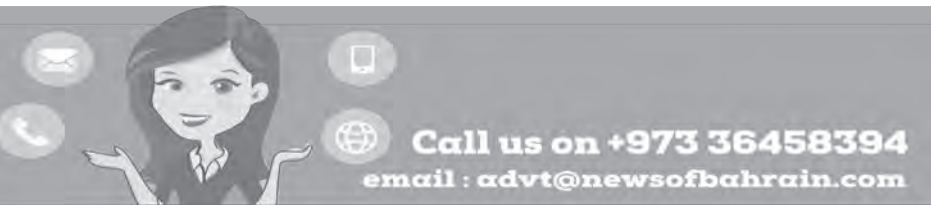

Leclerc starts on pole for Belgian GP

● Verstappen excels in tricky Belgian qualifying but Leclerc starts on pole

Max Verstappen, facing a 10-place grid penalty for taking a new engine, topped the times for Red Bull ahead of Ferrari's Charles Leclerc in a qualifying session run in mixed wet-and-dry conditions at the Belgian Grand Prix yesterday.

Leclerc will start Sunday's race from pole position as he did in 2023 with Sergio Perez alongside him in the second Red Bull, the Mexican having ended a nightmare run of qualifying failures amid reports that his future with the team is at risk.

Seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton qualified fourth for

Mercedes and will share the second row of the grid with McLaren's Lando Norris, who qualified fifth ahead of team-mate Oscar Piastri and George Russell in the second Mercedes.

Carlos Sainz was eighth in the second Ferrari in front of compatriot and two-time champion Fernando Alonso of Aston Martin, Esteban Ocon of Alpine and

Alex Albon of Williams -- who will be 10th on the grid ahead of Verstappen.

"It was a nice qualifying and luckily the weather was ok," said Verstappen, referring to earlier heavy rain that turned final practice into a washout. "It was raining a little bit, but we could do a decent session."

"I know I have to start 10 plac-

es back so this was the best I could do today and we'll go from there. I don't know quick we are going to be, but I hope we can be in the mix."

Verstappen will be bidding to win the Belgian race for the fourth consecutive year, having won previously after taking grid penalties, but his car this year lacks the same clear superiority. Last year, he won from sixth. This year he starts 11th.

"It's exactly the same as last year and, for me, it's good as I didn't expect that. We had tricky conditions and the rain helped

us a bit and it's good to be back at the front of the grid," said Leclerc.

In steady but light rain, Norris led a train of cars from the pitlane for Q1, followed by both Haas cars and his McLaren team-mate Piastri, who was forced to drop to fourth by an exit by Kevin Magnussen that he described as "dangerous".

Racing in the rain

A heavy shower was forecast by McLaren and this accelerated all 20 drivers to join the fray in pursuit of an early banker lap before the conditions deteriorated. All were on intermediates as Norris clocked 1:58.894 before being beaten by Piastri, in 1:57.411.

Verstappen then took over on top in 1:56.003 with Piastri threatening and taking second before rising to take command with five minutes to go in 1:55.549, before the Dutchman

regained the ascendancy.

He clocked 1:54.938 to go six-tenths clear of Piastri while Norris struggled to match him and Russell fought to survive, rising from 17th to third in the final seconds of Q1.

Taking advantage of a problem for Verstappen, who was involved in a blocking incident with Zhou Guanyu's Sauber, Piastri took top spot again in 1:54.835 ahead of Pierre Gasly.

The early departures were taken by the two Haas men, Nico Hulkenberg and Magnussen, RB's Yuki Tsunoda, who will start from the back of the grid after taking a penalty for new power unit parts, Logan Sargeant of Williams and Zhou.

Q2 began in similar fashion, with rain forecast and all 15 runners on track, Alex Albon setting the early pace for Williams before Norris took over in 1:54.459 and then Verstappen, in 1:53.857. All were on 'inters' again.

Djokovic sweeps into Olympics second round and potential Nadal clash

Novak Djokovic lost just one game in his Olympic tennis opener yesterday to set up a potential blockbuster clash against old rival Rafael Nadal.

Djokovic, chasing a first Olympic gold to add to his 24 Grand Slams, brushed aside Australia's Matthew Ebden 6-0, 6-1 in just 53 minutes under the roof of Court Philippe Chatrier.

Nadal, who has been carrying a thigh strain, will take on Djokovic for the 60th time if he gets past Marton Fucsovics

of Hungary on Sunday.

Top seed Djokovic, whose Olympic career has only yielded a

bronze at Beijing in 2008, holds a 30-29 head-to-head record over the Spaniard.

However, Nadal, who has won 14 of his 22 Grand Slams at the French Open, has an 8-2 head-to-head lead over the Serb at Roland Garros.

Yesterday Djokovic was barely pushed by 36-year-old Ebden, who only made the tournament as an alternate after a series of injury pullouts.

Without a singles ranking, doubles specialist Ebden had not played a singles match for two years before he got an unexpected Olympics call.

Palestinian Olympian wore shirt showing bombed children at opening ceremony

Suryakumar's India begin new T20 journey with Sri Lanka thrashing

Bahrain Olympic officials are confident they are sending their strongest team to the Paris 2024 Olympics, which began on Friday.

The National Olympic Committee Vice-President, Shaikh Issa bin Ali bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, expressed high hopes for Bahrain's 14 athletes competing in Paris, including eight runners, most of whom were born outside the country. "This time we have a special group of

in athletics. The Gulf nation's four Olympic medals, including golds by Ethiopian-born Maryam Yusuf Jamal in 2012 and Kenyan-born Ruth Jebet in Rio 2016, highlight its strength on the track. Winfred Yavi, also Kenyan-born, is a top contender in the women's 3,000-meter steeplechase, having been crowned world champion in 2023.

Expanding Horizons

Bahrain is also hopeful for its first medal outside track and field. Russian-born Akhmed

Tazhudinov, the reigning world champion in freestyle wrestling (97kg), is seen as a strong medal prospect. "Tazhudinov has prepared well for the Olympics and hopes to add an Olympic medal to Bahrain's haul," said Abdulredha Abdullhussain Haji, President of the Bahrain Wrestling Federation.

With a successful Asian Games record and a blend of seasoned champions and promising newcomers, Bahrain is poised for a remarkable Olympic performance in Paris.

China took the first gold of the Paris Olympics yesterday, as the rain that dampened the opening ceremony took its toll on the first full day of sporting action.

In a closely fought final of the mixed-team 10-metre air rifle,

teenage duo Sheng Lihao and Huang Yuting outscored Keum Ji-hyeon and Park Ha-jun from South Korea 16-12, Kazakhstan grabbing the bronze.

The rain already claimed one sporting casualty early yesterday as the wet weather which deluged Friday night's audacious festival on the River Seine continued to cause headaches.

The men's street skateboarding competition, due to take

place at the Place de la Concorde in the historic heart of Paris, was postponed until Monday due to rain overnight, organisers said.

The downpours also disrupted play at the opening rounds of tennis at Roland Garros, with no action on the 10 uncovered outside courts until 13:30 local time (11:30 GMT), organisers said.

Torrential rain had lashed participants and spectators in Friday's amphibious opening ceremony, where around 7,000 athletes paraded along the Seine in an armada of boats before a show-stopping finale which climaxed with a glittering light show at the Eiffel Tower and a performance from singer Celine Dion.

The ceremony received broadly favourable reviews, with France's centre-right Le Figaro daily describing it as "full of surprises but often disjointed."

The International Olympic Committee however was forced to apologise however for a gaffe during the ceremony that saw

South Korea's athletes incorrectly introduced as North Korean.

"We deeply apologise for the mistake that occurred when introducing the South Korean team during the broadcast of the opening ceremony," the IOC said in a post on its official Korean-language X account.

Swimming duel

Elsewhere on the sporting front, swimming, badminton, rowing, cycling, hockey and basketball get under way along with the surfing competition, nearly 16,000 kilometres (9,950 miles) kilometres away on the French Pacific island of Tahiti.

Swimming will take centre-stage at the La Defense Arena for the women's 400m freestyle -- one of the most-anticipated events of the entire Olympics involving three swimmers who have held the world record.

Australia's defending cham-

Summer McIntosh, also a former world record holder, completes the hotly favoured trio.

Other gold medals on offer on the first night of action in the pool come in the men's 400m freestyle and the men's and women's 4x100m freestyle relays.

Reigning French Open champions Iga Swiatek and Carlos Alcaraz are among the top draws on the first day of action on the clay courts of Roland Garros -- weather permitting.

Women's world number one Swiatek is first on court against Romania's Irina-Camelia Begu, with Alcaraz to follow against Lebanese world number 275 Hady Habib.

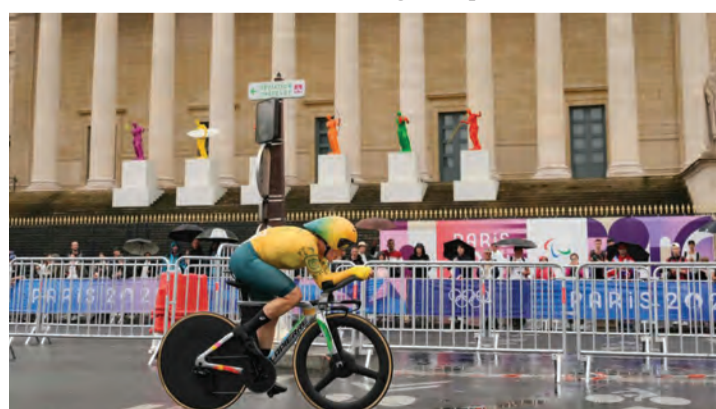
But the biggest focus will be on the men's doubles, with Alcaraz teaming up with 14-time French Open champion Rafael Nadal in a Spanish dream pairing.

Chinese shooters Huang Yuting and Sheng Lihao will start as favourites for the first gold of the Games after a dominant victory at last year's world championships in Baku.
