



man accused of assaulting another individual in a hotel in Juffair has been granted bail pending an appeal of his conviction, which was issued in absentia in 2020.

The bail was issued by the High Appeals Court which is reviewing the case.

The initial conviction stemmed from an incident in 2019 where the defendant, a Gulf national, was found guilty of striking another individual with a stick, resulting in a 20% permanent disability.

The court sentenced the defendant to imprisonment and ordered him to pay a compensation of BD5,001 to the victim. assistance from a bystander and






