



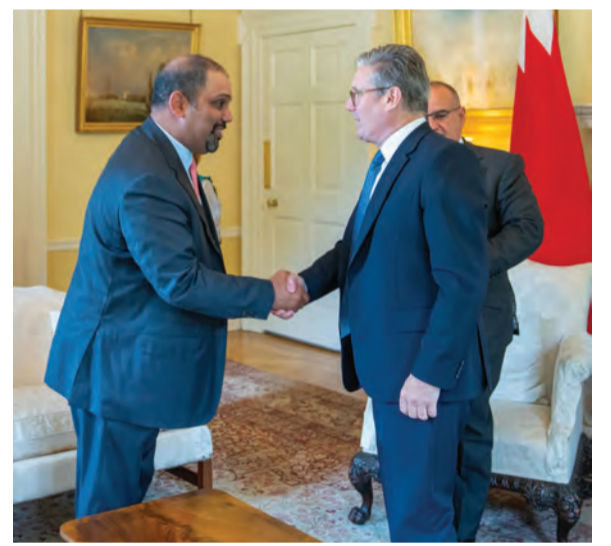

Israeli hostage rescued from Gaza tunnel

The Israeli military said a hostage was rescued yesterday from a Gaza tunnel, more than 10 months after the Israeli Bedouin man was seized during the Hamas attack that triggered a devastating war.

Talks aiming to secure a Gaza truce and hostage release deal, meanwhile, continued in Qatar, a US official said. Neither Israel nor Hamas have confirmed their participation.

The Israeli military said forces had found Kaid Farhan Alkadi, 52, in a tunnel in southern Gaza "when he was alone", despite a previous assessment that Hamas fighters "and explosives" were there.

He is one of 251 people abducted by Palestinian fighters during the October 7 attack on southern Israel, 104 of whom are still captive in Gaza including 34 the military says are dead.

EU sued over 'insufficient' climate goals

Green activists yesterday said they were taking the European Union to court over "insufficient" climate targets, accusing Brussels of violating a key global agreement.

CAN Europe and Global Legal Action Network (GLAN) said in legal written arguments to a top EU court that the 27-country bloc's targets for emissions from agriculture, waste, small industry and transport were "grossly inadequate".

"The EU's overall climate ambition remains alarmingly off-track from the 1.5-degree Celsius limit of the 2015 Paris climate accords," the groups said in a statement.

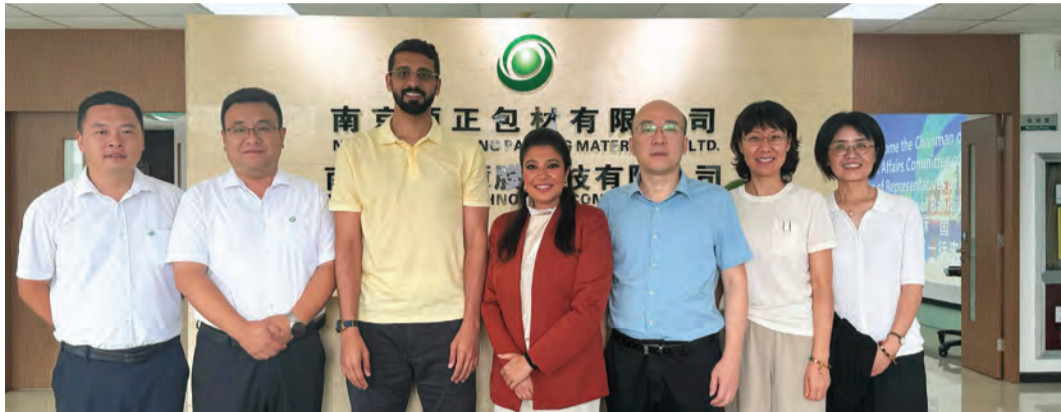

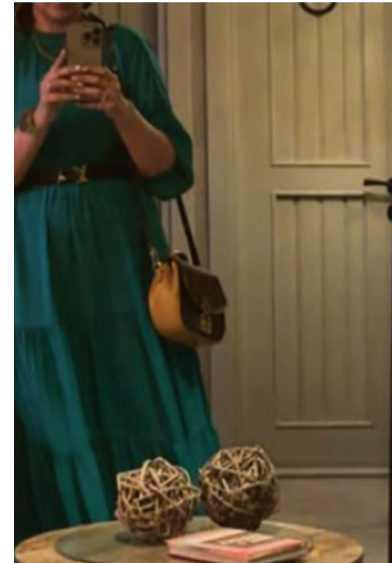

Another Bahraini tourist falls victim, loses valuable belongings and BD1,000

● Incident happens while dining at famous restaurant

● Notorious female gang used her credit and debit cards to make several transactions

A Bahraini woman on a personal trip to Turkiye became the latest victim of a notorious female robbery gang operating in Istanbul. During her visit on August 3, she lost valuable belongings, including over BD1,000 in cash, while dining at the famous Hafiz Mustafa Restaurant. "I was enjoying some baklava, with my bag on the table beside

me. Before I knew it, the bag was gone, hidden away in a large black bag by the thieves," she told The Daily Tribune in an exclusive interview. Within minutes, she received alerts for unauthorized transactions on both her debit and credit cards. Shockingly, the thieves bypassed OTP approvals and quickly drained her accounts. "They used my credit card for several transactions, stealing BD650 from it and BD300 from my debit card under the guise of a fake company named AKYAKA," she explained.

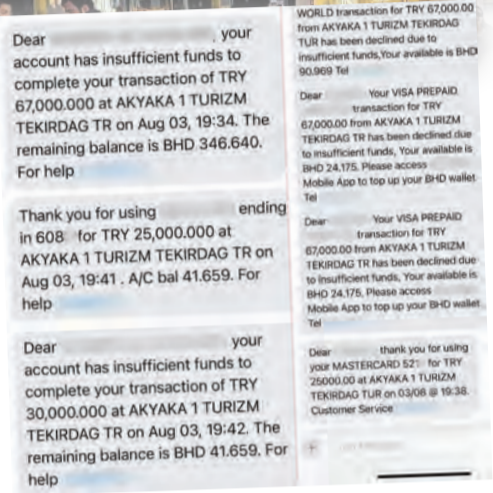
In addition to the money, she lost her luxury handbag worth around BD1,000 and \$400 in cash. Realizing what had happened, the woman immediately alerted the restaurant manager and reviewed CCTV footage. "I was horrified to see a young

girl, no older than 10, stealing my bag with two women in niqabs," she said. The incident was promptly reported to the Istanbul police, but the culprits have yet to be identified. While she managed to recover the stolen credit card amount, she had to pay a BD130 investigation fee and was unable to recov-

er the money taken from her debit card.

Similar fate

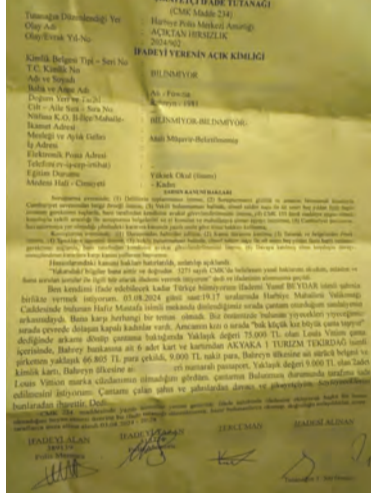
This alarming event comes on the heels of another incident we reported on August 26, where a Bahraini tourist in Istanbul narrowly escaped a similar fate, thanks to the swift intervention of Turkish police. That theft took place in the busy "Beyoglu" district, a popular shopping area in Istanbul. Turkish police investigations have revealed that the female gang behind these crimes has a long history of theft, with a staggering 368 reported cases to their name. As Istanbul remains a favored destination for travelers, incidents like these underscore the importance of vigilance and caution when visiting bustling tourist spots.

Pilgrimage nightmare ends

140 Bahraini pilgrims set to return home after unlicensed agency's deception

The holy city of Karbala, usually a place of pilgrimage and spiritual solace, turned into a nightmare for 140 Bahraini pilgrims who found themselves stranded, their passports held hostage by two hotels. The ordeal, which began with the promise of a spiritual journey, was marred by deceit, negligence, and desperation. The pilgrims had entrusted their travel arrangements to an unlicensed Bahraini travel agency, paying for a pilgrimage trip that promised a comfortable and pious experience. However, the reality was far from the promises made. Cramped buses, dilapidated hotels, and a disappearing organiser left the pilgrims stranded and desperate.

The hotels, owed thousands of dollars by the unlicensed agency, refused to release the pilgrims' passports, leaving them trapped in a foreign land. **Help** Their pleas for help echoed in the empty air, their faith tested, and their hope dwindling. Among them were children, their innocent faces etched with worry, and elderly individuals, their bodies wracked with pain and their medications running low. They were trapped in a labyrinth of despair, their hopes of returning home fading with each passing hour. Fortunately, the Bahraini Embassy in Iraq stepped in, working tirelessly to secure the release of the stranded pilgrims. The Iraqi Ministry of Foreign

Affairs, and relevant authorities played a vital role in highlighting the situation and bringing it to the attention of the authorities. His Excellency Khalid Al Mansour, the Kingdom of Bahrain's Ambassador to Iraq, personally visited the hotels, emphasising the illegality of the passport detention and holding the travel agency responsible for its actions. The Iraqi Ministry of Interior security personnel also intervened, ensuring the safe return of the pilgrims. **Swift action** Meanwhile, Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA) has taken swift action against the unlicensed travel agency, shutting down its operations and referring the case to the Public Prosecution.

The agency was found to be operating without a licence and engaging in illegal tourism activities, including making travel bookings to Iraq without proper authorisation and failing to fulfil its financial obligations to the hotels. The BTEA has reiterated its commitment to enforcing relevant laws and regulations, urg-

ing travellers to engage only with licensed and reputable travel agencies. **Warning** The authority has warned that any unlicensed entity will be held accountable for violating applicable laws and regulations. The BTEA's swift action and the Bahraini Embassy's tireless efforts have ensured the safe return of the stranded pilgrims, highlighting the importance of government agencies working together to protect the interests of citizens abroad. The pilgrims, now finally returning home, are expressing their gratitude for the efforts of the Bahraini Embassy and the Iraqi authorities. The ordeal, while a nightmare, has ended with a glimmer of hope, reminding everyone of the

importance of responsible travel planning and the power of collective action in times of crisis. **Ministry advisory** In response to instructions from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Embassy of Bahrain in Baghdad, through its Consular and Administrative Affairs and Consular Services Sector, has coordinated with the Iraqi Ministry of Interior to recover the detained travel documents of the Bahraini citizens. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs advised Bahraini citizens to verify the legitimacy of travel agencies and their licenses in accordance with Bahraini law before making any reservations or payments. This recommendation comes amid recurring incidents of fraudulent bookings and irresponsible agency practices.

Residential roadmap

New housing guide clarifies extensions, building heights, and parking regulations

The Housing Ministry has released a guide to clarify Decision No. (899) of 2024, which lays out new rules for residential projects.

This guide breaks down regulations for residential buildings, home extensions, and plots, alongside some general provisions.

Her Excellency Amna Al Rumaihi, Minister of Housing and Urban Planning, explained that the new rules are designed to help residents make the most of expansion opportunities and address ongoing building issues by legalising modifications under the Ministry's oversight.

The guide indicates that the decision permits adding flats, commercial shops, and extra facilities to residential houses.

These extensions, separate from the main unit, must not cover more than 15% of the land area and do not require engineering oversight.

Guidelines

Architectural guidelines ensure that new developments blend with their surroundings.

Building over covered parking spaces is allowed up to two storeys, with an additional single storey above housing facilities.

Lifts are permitted within housing units, with a maximum building height of three storeys

or 13 metres.

Original parking garages cannot be removed or repurposed.

Housing areas are divided into three zones: Zone A for plots over 300 square metres, Zone B for plots under 300 square metres, and Zone C for plots under 250 square metres.

Total area

Villas on smaller plots can expand, provided the total area

does not exceed 240% of the land, and no single storey covers more than 80% of the land.

Additional facilities can be added to a villa's roof, up to 30% of the roof area, and further extensions up to 15% of the land area can be added to the side of the villa. These additions must not exceed the height of the main storey.

Fences are limited to 2.5 metres in height, and new con-

structions must match the original facade.

Parking spaces can be added to the side or rear of villas, as long as they comply with regulations and do not interfere with public areas.

Facilities

Building over parking spaces is limited to two storeys, with additional storeys above housing facilities capped at 3.2 metres and 50 square metres per storey.

External Majlis constructions are allowed up to 10% of the land area without affecting the overall building percentage.

All construction above existing structures must ensure no damage to a neighbour's insulation layer, as required by building permits.

Candidate withdrawal deadline set for today

The deadline for candidates to withdraw from the by-election in the first constituency of Muharraq Governorate is set for today.

This was announced by the Supreme Committee for General Supervision of the Safety of the Election of Members of the Council of Representatives.

According to the law, candidates have the right to withdraw from the election by submitting a written notification on the designated form to the supervisory committee at least 10 days before the elec-

tion date.

This announcement comes after candidate for the Muharraq seat in the current by-election, Malallah Al Qahtani, announced his withdrawal from the race earlier last week.

Al Qahtani cited a lack of time to prepare a comprehensive electoral programme as the reason for his decision.

Al Qahtani indicated that he will participate in the 2026 elections, without specifying whether he will run for a municipal or parliamentary seat.

The by-election in the first constituency of Muharraq is scheduled to take place on September 7th.

BCDR posts strong revenue growth

The Bahrain Chamber for Dispute Resolution (BCDR) has released its annual financial report, showing that its total

revenue for the year ended 31 December 2023 was around 3.9 million dinars, with a surplus of 2.4 million dinars.

For the fiscal year 2023, the reward for the Chamber's Board

of Trustees fell by 50% compared to 2022. Last year's reward was 32,000 dinars, down from 64,000 dinars at the end of 2022.

Salaries, insurance contribu-

tions, and end-of-service benefits came to roughly 600,000 dinars, consistent with the previous year's figures. Administrative expenses for 2023 were capped at 398,000 dinars.

News in brief

China's army and air force began live-fire exercises Tuesday next to its border with Myanmar, local authorities said, following recent bilateral talks on security in the area. Myanmar's northern Shan state has been the site of repeated clashes since late June after ethnic rebel groups renewed an offensive against the military along a vital trade highway to China. The exercises "aim to test the command's reconnaissance, early warning, multi-dimensional control and strike capabilities", according to a spokesperson for the People's Liberation Army, quoted by state news agency Xinhua.

Watching a hungry lion pace in a small cage, Tanzania's president jokingly suggested naming the "mischievous" beast after one of the East African country's leading opposition politicians. President Samia Suluhu Hassan was visiting an annual fair in her hometown archipelago of Zanzibar on Saturday when she saw the furious feline at a National Wildlife Agency booth. In widely circulated clips online, a keeper tells her the animal was pacing because it had yet to eat, before saying the big cat had not been named. "Name it after my son Tundu Lissu," she suggested to laughter, playing off her popular nickname "Mama Samia" and opposition politician Tundu Lissu. On Sunday, Hassan further compared the "spirited and somewhat mischievous lion" to "unsettled" Lissu, who ran for the presidency in 2020 following an assassination attempt in 2017. "So, I suggested naming it Tundu Lissu because it was as restless as my son Tundu Lissu."

Tanzanian president names 'mischievous' lion after opposition leader



US National Security Advisor Jake Sullivan and China's top diplomat Wang Yi said on Tuesday they were hoping for productive talks as they met in Beijing, Sullivan said after he arrived in the Chinese capital on Tuesday afternoon that he looked forward to "a very productive round of conversations" with foreign minister Wang. "We'll delve into a wide range of issues, including issues on which we agree and those issues... where there are still differences that we need to manage effectively and substantively," he said. Wang told Sullivan he was keen for "substantive" and "constructive" talks during his visit, the first to China by a US national security adviser since 2016. He also said he wanted the two sides to "help China-US relations move forward towards the San Francisco vision", referring to a framework hashed out by Presidents Joe Biden and Xi Jinping during talks in the US city last year.

Chinese military stages live-fire drills by Myanmar border



China says 'no intention' of violating foreign airspace after Japan claim Beijing, China

China said yesterday it has "no intention" of violating foreign airspace after Japan accused a Chinese military aircraft of entering its skies.

Japan condemned Monday's incursion as a "serious violation" of its sovereignty, saying Beijing was becoming "increasingly assertive". Washington's closest ally in the region, Japan said it scrambled fighter jets after the two-minute incursion by the Y-9 surveillance aircraft on Monday off the Danjo Islands in the East China Sea.

Asked about Japan's claims, foreign ministry spokesman Lin Jian said "the relevant Chinese departments are in the process of gathering information and verifying the situation".

"The two sides have maintained communication through existing working channels," he said. "I would also like to emphasise here that China has no intention of intruding into the territorial airspace of any country," Lin said.

The uninhabited Danjo Islands are a group of small islets located in the East China Sea off Japan's southern Nagasaki region and are not disputed territory. Japan, staunchly pacifist for decades, has ramped up defence spending with US encouragement, moving to acquire counter-strike capabilities and easing rules on arms exports.

Top Chinese, US officials hope for productive talks in Beijing



Japanese scramble to buy beloved rice as shortages bite

The threat of a "megaquake", a series of typhoons, and a week-long national holiday have some Japanese scrambling to buy rice -- the nation's cherished staple food -- with the government warning yesterday against panic buying.

"We could only procure half the usual amount of rice this summer and bags of rice get quickly sold out," a clerk at a branch of the popular Fresco supermarket chain told AFP in the Japanese capital.

Rice shelves in some stores emptied or stocks were rationed after a government warning this month -- since lifted -- of a possible "megaquake", as well as several typhoons and the annual Obon holiday.

Other factors include lower harvests caused by hot weather and water shortages, as well as increased demand related to record numbers of foreign tourists.

At one food store in Tokyo, a sign seen by AFP read: "In order for many customers to be able to buy, we ask you to purchase one (bag of rice) a day per family."

A worker at another store in Tokyo said: "We can't purchase any rice at all, and there's no prospect of buying anytime soon".

The Fresco worker told AFP that daily stocks ran out by midday.

A new harvesting season has started with 40 percent of the crop available by the end of September, a farm ministry official told AFP.

Modi tells Putin he supports swift end to war in Ukraine

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi told Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday that he supports a swift end to the grinding conflict in Ukraine after visiting the war-hit country.

Modi, 73, said he had "exchanged perspectives on the Russia-Ukraine conflict" with Putin and shared "my insights from the recent visit to Ukraine", in a post on social media.

He said he had "reiterated India's firm commitment to support an early, abiding and peaceful resolution of the conflict".

Modi visited Kyiv on Friday and told President Volodymyr Zelensky that "no problem should be solved on the battlefield".

His chat with Putin comes a day after a call with US President

statement said. India is part of the Quad grouping, with the United States, Japan and Australia, that positions itself against China's growing influence in the Asia-Pacific region.

BETTER YOU KNOW Russia launched a full-scale invasion of Ukraine on February 24, 2022. The war has seen various phases, including battles for key cities like Kyiv, Kharkiv, and Mariupol. In 2023, Ukraine launched a counteroffensive to retake occupied territories in the east and south.

Deadly Russian strikes pound Ukraine for 2nd day

Russia fired a wave of attack drones and missiles at Ukraine that killed at least five people, authorities said yesterday, after a second night of heavy strikes across the war-battered nation.

Within hours of the barrage, Ukraine claimed new advances in its surprise assault on Russia's Kursk border region and reported taking nearly 600 Russian troops as prisoners in the past three weeks. "Crimes against humanity cannot be committed with impunity," President Volodymyr Zelensky said in a post on social media, saying that four people had been killed and 16 wounded on Tuesday. One woman later died in hospital, authorities said.

AFP journalists in the capital Kyiv heard air raid sirens echo over the city throughout the night as well as an explosion, likely from air defence systems.

Monday's attack was one of Moscow's largest ever on Ukraine, prompting Kyiv to push for permission from allies to use Western-provided weapons to strike

deep inside Russia.

Zelensky said in Kyiv that Ukraine had used Western-supplied F-16 fighter jets to counter the Russian barrages, and that Ukraine had successfully tested a domestically produced ballistic missile. Local authorities said three of the victims had been

killed in the southeastern Zaporizhzhia region and two died in the central city of Kryvyi Rig after a missile struck a hotel. Ukrainian forces have been pushing their offensive in Kursk, a surprise operation that has seen Kyiv gain swathes of territory in three weeks.

Spain to donate 500,000 mpox vaccines to Africa

Spain will donate 500,000 mpox vaccine doses to countries in central Africa suffering from a surge in cases, the government said yesterday. The doses amount to 20 percent of Spain's total mpox vaccine reserves, the health ministry said in a statement without specifying which nations in the region will receive the vaccines or when they will arrive. Spain also urged its European Union peers to follow suit and also donate 20 percent of their mpox vaccine stockpile, saying it "makes no sense to stockpile vaccines where there is no problem," the statement added.

France and Germany have both announced they will each donate 100,000 mpox vaccine doses to countries suffering from the emergency. Formerly known as monkeypox, mpox is an infectious disease caused by a virus transmitted to humans by infected animals that can also be passed from human to human through close physical contact.

At least 30 killed after Sudan flooding causes dam to collapse: UN

At least 30 people were killed in northeast Sudan after a dam collapsed due to flooding, the United Nations' humanitarian office has said.

The war-torn country has experienced an intense rainy season since last month, with intermittent torrential flooding mainly in the country's north and east.

"Thirty fatalities have been confirmed" following the Sunday collapse of the Arbaat Dam in Sudan's Red Sea state, the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) cited a government delegation as saying Monday.

"However, the number of casualties could be much higher," it said, adding that "scores of

UAE seeks consular services for arrested Telegram boss

The UAE said yesterday it had requested consular services for Telegram's Pavel Durov after the Dubai-based tech boss was arrested in France over alleged failings to curb criminality on the app.

"The UAE is closely following the case of its citizen Pavel Durov, founder of Telegram, who was arrested by the French authorities in Paris-Le Bourget Airport," the Gulf state's foreign ministry said in a statement.

"The UAE has submitted a request to the Government of the French Republic to provide him with all the necessary consular services in an urgent manner," it added.

Durov, the 39-year-old billionaire founder of the messaging platform, was arrested at the Paris airport late on Saturday.

He is accused of failing to curb the spread of illegal content on Telegram, which has more than 900 million users. The company has rejected the accusations.

French President Emmanuel Macron on Monday denied there was a political aspect to Durov's arrest as the internet

mogul spent a second day in French custody.

Late Monday, French authorities again extended his initial detention for questioning until Wednesday, according to a source close to the investigation.

Durov set up Telegram after leaving Russia a decade ago, and Forbes magazine estimates his current fortune at \$15.5 billion.

He holds a French passport in addition to Russian nationality. In its press information, Telegram says its founder has "dual citizenship of the United Arab Emirates and France".

Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said Monday Moscow had received no information from France about why he was detained, and "we do not know concretely what Durov is accused of".

Dubai-headquartered Telegram said on Sunday that "Durov has nothing to hide and travels frequently in Europe".

"Telegram abides by EU laws, including the Digital Services Act -- its moderation is within industry standards," it added.

"It is absurd to claim that a platform or its owner are responsible for abuse of that platform."

UN's Guterres issues 'global SOS' over fast-rising Pacific ocean

United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres sent out a global climate "SOS" at a Pacific islands summit yesterday, unveiling research that shows the region's seas rising much more swiftly than global averages.

"I am in Tonga to issue a global SOS -- Save Our Seas -- on rising sea levels. A worldwide catastrophe is putting this Pacific paradise in peril" he said.

Sparingly populated and with few heavy industries, the Pacific islands collectively pump out less than 0.02 percent of global emissions every year.

But this vast arc of volcanic islands and low-lying coral atolls also inhabits a tropical corridor that is rapidly threatened by encroaching oceans.

The World Meteorological Organisation has been monitoring tide gauges installed on the Pacific's famed beaches since the early 1990s. A new report released by the top UN climate monitoring body showed seas had risen by around 15 centimetres in some parts of the Pacific in the last 30 years.

The global average was 9.4 centimetres, according to the report. "It is increasingly evident that we are fast running out of time to turn the tide," said the forecasting agency's top official, Celeste Saulo.

Some sites, particularly in Kiribati and Cook Islands, measured a rise that matched or was just under the global average.

But other sites, such as the capital cities of Samoa and Fiji, were rising almost three times higher.

In low-lying Pacific nation Tuvalu, land is already so scarce that throngs of children use the tarmac at the international airport as their own makeshift playground.

Scientists have warned that, even under some moderate scenarios, Tuvalu could be almost entirely wiped off the map within the next 30 years. "It's disaster after disaster, and we are losing the capacity to rebuild, to withstand another cyclone or another flood," Tuvalu Climate Minister Maina Talia told AFP Monday on the summit's sidelines.

"For low-lying island states, it's a matter of survival for us."

Pakistan railway track hangs off bridge after attacks

The mangled track of a Pakistan railway line hung over a dry river bed on Tuesday, after it was targeted in a series of coordinated attacks that killed dozens of people.

The colonial-era bridge -- a key link between Balochistan province and the rest of the country -- was blown apart on Monday, with a section of a fallen tuck blocking a motorway below and another hanging from a damaged column.

Separatist militants killed dozens on Monday in several early morning attacks in the province which included taking control of a highway and shooting dead 23 people, mostly from Punjab province.

Six people travelling on the motorway near to the Kolpur bridge were also shot dead after militants checked their IDs, according to government

officials. "Explosives were used to attack our main bridge routes yesterday, which has stopped trains from travelling to other parts of the country," Muhammad Kashif, a senior railway official in Balochistan, told AFP.

"We're working to clear the road as quickly as possible to ease traffic for the public," he said.

"We do not know how much time it would take to restore the bridge in Bolan." The fallen tracks and rubble from the bridge that blocked the road below was being cleared by authorities.

"It's a steep mountainous area and fear is natural, but the journey has to go on. We often pass through here in a convoy of three or four vehicles," a truck driver from the neighbouring province of Sindh told AFP, while waiting for the road to reopen.

Zelensky says Ukraine used F-16s against Russian air attacks

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said yesterday that his military deployed Western-supplied F-16 fighter jets to down drones and missiles that Russia fired in recent attacks.

Zelensky announced earlier this month that Ukraine had received the first batch of the fighter jets promised by Western countries, declining to say how many had been delivered.

"We destroyed already some missiles and drones using the

F-16," Zelensky said in English at a press conference in Kyiv on Tuesday without elaborating.

He said at the press conference that Ukraine still needed more of the jets.

He told AFP in May that Kyiv needed at least 120 to achieve "parity" with Russia.

For more than two years, Ukraine had pleaded with its Western partners for the aircraft -- long considered the crown jewel in the sprawling list of military hardware Kyiv has sought.

Speaking to E! News, Kit shared: "I don't think they'll wanna watch 'Game of Thrones'. I absolutely guarantee you they'll probably

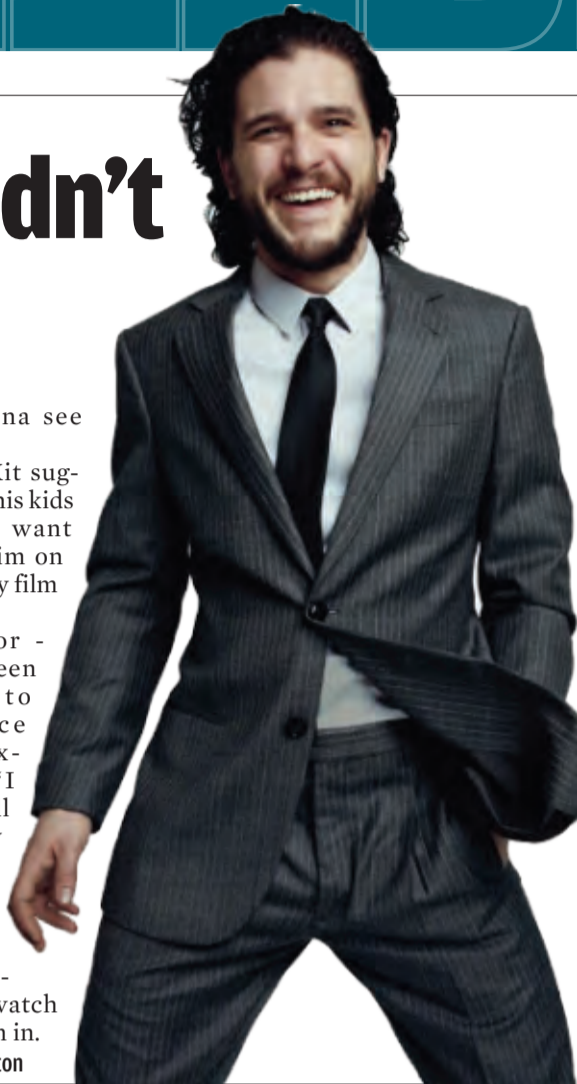
never wanna see that show."

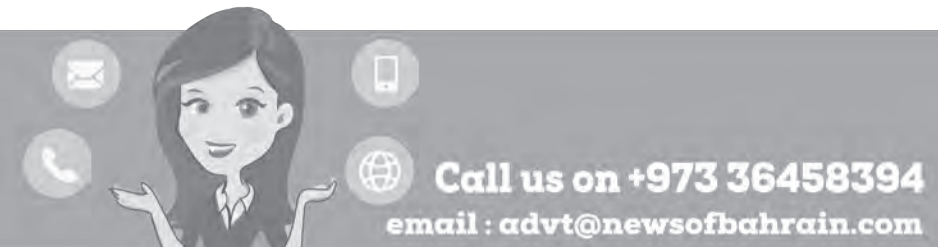

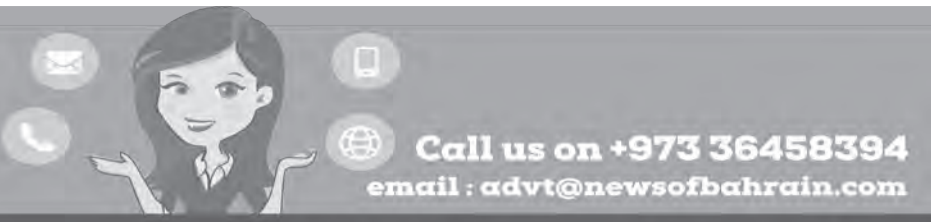

Djokovic shines under the lights, Gauff rolls at US Open

Djokovic wins record 78th match on Ashe, Gauff advances with dominant performance

● **Djokovic defeats Albot in straight sets**

Defending champion Novak Djokovic eased into the second round of the US Open with a straight-sets victory over qualifier Radu Albot on Monday as Coco Gauff launched her defence of the women's title with a convincing victory.

Djokovic, seeking his 25th Grand Slam title and his first since his victory at Flushing Meadows last year, wasn't his sharpest self.

But he was a more than

a match for 138th-ranked Albot, breaking the Moldovan six times on the way to a 6-2, 6-2, 6-4 victory.

He notched a men's record 78th match win on Arthur Ashe Stadium, where he said the "electric" energy of the night session was unlike any other.

"The night sessions here are best in the world," said Djokovic, who capped the action on a day that drew a record 74,641 spectators according to the US Tennis Association.

That included a day-session crowd of 42,886 and a record-setting night-session crowd of 31,775.

"There's an incredible energy, and with the new rule this year that the crowd can move around, there are a lot of things happening," the four-time champion said. Seeded second

and behind Jannik Sinner, Djokovic is vying to become the first man to repeat in New York since Roger Federer won five straight US Opens from 2004-2008.

He's coming off an emotional triumph at the Paris Olympics, but Djokovic has yet to capture a Grand Slam title this year.

He had 10 double faults among 40 unforced errors, but was nevertheless in full control throughout the two hour, seven minute contest that ended shortly before midnight.

Gauff, meanwhile, powered into the second round with a 6-2, 6-0 victory over France's Varvara Gracheva.

The 20-year-old American fired 10 aces and needed just 66 minutes to beat 66th-ranked Gracheva. She saved eight break points -- including two with aces in the final game.

"It is definitely a lot of pressure this tournament but I'm just enjoying it," said Gauff, who is seeded third behind world number one Iga Swiatek and Aryna Sabalenka.

"Last year was incredible, so I'm just bringing those vibes and whatever happens, happens."

Gauff has battled through an erratic season since capturing her maiden major last year and her tune-up tournaments saw

her fall in the third round at Toronto before she crashed out of her first match as the defending champion in Cincinnati.

A little tough

"The last few weeks have been a little bit tough," Gauff said. "But today was I think the best tennis I've played in a while."

American Ben Shelton opened the action on Ashe with a 6-4, 6-2, 6-2 victory over 2020 champion Dominic Thiem.

Shelton's triumph marked an end to Thiem's Grand Slam career, the Austrian having announced he would retire at the end of 2024 after several injury-plagued seasons.

"I just want to say thanks for all the support," Thiem told fans. "It's been 10 years since I first played here, I had my greatest

success on this court."

Fourth-seeded Alexander Zverev of Germany needed four sets to get past lucky loser Maximilian Marterer 6-2, 6-7 (5/7), 6-3, 6-2.

Sixth-seeded Andrey Rublev beat Brazilian Thiago Seyboth Wild 6-3, 7-6 (7/3), 7-5 and eighth-seeded Casper Ruud of Norway advanced with a 7-6 (7/2), 6-2, 6-2 win over China's Bu Yunchaokete.

Ruud next faces French veteran Gael Monfils, who beat Diego Schwartzman 6-7 (2/7), 6-2, 6-2, 6-1 in the Argentinian's final Grand Slam appearance as he heads into retirement.

Australian Open champion Aryna Sabalenka cruised into the second round with a 6-3, 6-3 victory over Australian qualifier Priscilla Hon.

Wimbledon champion Barbora Krejčíková, seeded



ed eighth, eased into the second round with a 7-6 (7/3), 6-2 victory over Spanish qualifier Marina Bassols Ribera.

Hasina's government was accused of widespread abuses, including the mass detention and extrajudicial killing of political opponents.

Hasina, former ministers and other ex-lawmakers are among those also accused.

Shakib has not spoken publicly about the case, but his teammates said they were offering him support.

for competition.

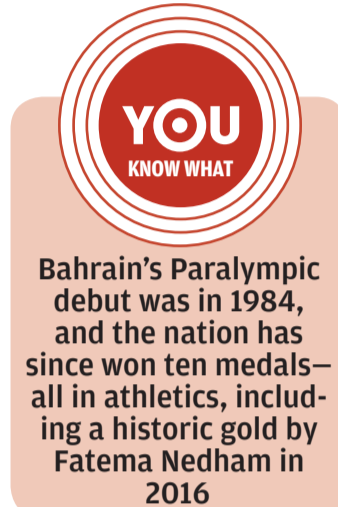
Athletes to Watch

In a country where the sport and politics go hand in glove, Shah is best known for being the son of home minister Amit Shah, the right-hand man of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Shah, the powerful Secretary of the Board of Control for Cricket in India since 2019, becomes the youngest ICC chairman.

Top cricketers in India enjoy superstardom with millions of die-hard fans, most lu-
