On Saturday, Israel conducted air strikes on military sites in Iran in response to Tehran's October 1 attack on Israel, itself retaliation for the killing of Iran-backed militant leaders and a Revolutionary Guards commander.

Push for 'tighter' spending checks

Shura Council approves 2022 fiscal review with an eye on future budget discipline

The Shura Council approved Bahrain's 2022 Consolidated Final Account during its meeting yesterday, stressing the need for closer examination of spending.

While members supported the review, they raised concerns about recurring budget overruns and delays in the reporting process, calling for better oversight in future.

Financial and Economic Affairs Committee Chair Khalid Al Maskati pointed out procedural delays, stating, "By law, the Consolidated Final Account should be submitted to Parliament within five months."


Review


He noted that this deadline was missed, adding, "Parliament then took an additional seven months to complete its review."

Al Maskati explained that his committee received the final account in the penultimate session of the second convening period of the sixth term and worked hard to conclude the discussions.

He emphasised that "the account's approval should be by decision, not legislation," and stressed the importance of "taking the legislative authority's role and its observations seriously."

First Deputy Chairman Jamal Fakhro added that certain ministries had exceeded their spending limits, saying, "We cannot call this a final account. It only covers revenue and repeats observations we've seen before, while certain ministries went over their spending limits."

Had they not, we might have achieved a surplus."

Fakhro stressed the need to stay within spending rules, suggesting that the review process should ideally be completed within the fiscal year.

Yusuf Abdulla Alhumood, the Undersecretary for Financial Affairs at the Ministry of Finance and National Economy, responded to these points, assuring that the Consolidated Final Account is thorough and includes all necessary details on revenues, expenses, and related appendices.

Financial report

While the account is not responsible for every detail in supplementary documents, he affirmed it provides a full picture of the financial report, stating, "The final account reflects complete oversight of all areas covered in financial appendices."

On the topic of budget overruns, Alhumood noted that the Ministry has introduced measures to limit such incidents, requiring prior approvals for any purchase orders or financial actions.

an important step in supporting and promoting Bahraini expertise regionally, providing visibility for professionals across diverse fields and showcasing Bahrain's wealth of talent and best practices.

This collective effort, supported by the Information and eGovernment Authority and Bahrainouna's Executive Office, aims to strengthen Bahrain's national values and competencies.

The Ministry is also preparing for the launch of the For You initiative in December, which will honour private-sector workers in high-risk roles as a gesture of appreciation for their contributions to Bahrain's economy.

Public safety first

New stricter regulations for street advertisements prioritise 'life and property'

A new decree has been issued, detailing requirements, standards, and procedures for street advertisements, with provisions for the removal of those that pose a threat to life or property.

The new regulations are designed to enhance public safety and ensure strict adherence to engineering standards across the Kingdom.

Issued by the Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, His Excellency Eng. Wael bin Nasser Al Mubarak, the decree mandates that violators bear the cost of removing unsafe advertisements.

Safety requirements

These amendments strengthen safety requirements for advertisements affixed to the ground, walls, and surfaces, introducing stricter technical requirements to guarantee stability and adhere to public safety standards.

As per the new decision, a mandatory engineering certificate verifying the advertisement structure's ability to withstand wind forces throughout its duration is now required, along with a comprehensive liability insurance policy covering damages caused by the adver-



tisement, valid for its entire duration.

Moreover, a minimum 10-meter setback from the road edge to the advertisement is mandated, although this distance may be reduced based on the advertisement's type, size, and nature, and the land on which it is located, subject to approval from the relevant municipality or the Capital Municipality.

Support

Additionally, advertisements and their support must not interfere with or affect utility installations or rescue equipment.

The decision includes the necessity for the license applicant to commit to not leaving the advertisement empty of content for the duration or dura-

tions specified by the competent municipality, depending on the type of advertisement for which the license is requested.

Furthermore, the Capital Municipality and municipalities are empowered to remove any advertisement posing a threat to life or property, with violators bearing the removal costs.

Heights

Maximum advertisement heights are specified based on location and type, and supports and structures must be made of non-flammable materials.

Licenses are issued after payment of prescribed fees, valid for a maximum of one year and renewable fifteen days prior to expiry.

Advertisements must be re-



moved within one month of license expiry; otherwise, the municipality will remove them at the advertiser's expense, with no compensation for damage.

Precautionary measures

For unlicensed or non-compliant advertisements, the municipality will take precautionary measures to prevent potential damage, including license revocation and removal at the violator's expense.

Removal costs may be deducted from a security deposit, with any excess collected through legal channels.

The decree represents a significant tightening of regulations for street advertising in Bahrain, prioritising public safety and visual order.

Shura calls for review of translator regulation law

Mixed feedback from Shura Council members has led to a reconsideration of a proposed law to regulate Bahrain's translator profession.

During yesterday's session, concerns over the law's scope led members to call for further review and revisions to better fit the proposal with industry standards.

In a concluding vote, the Shura Council supported returning the draft law to the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee for further refinement.

The proposal seeks to establish rules governing translation work, reserving it for licensed translators and approved offices.

Supporters argue that "the translator profession is no less essential than other regulated trades", particularly as Bahrain requires Arabic for official transactions.

The law was put forward by members Redha Faraj, Dr Jehad Al Fadhel, Khalid Al Maskati, Dr Mohammed Al Khuzai, and Dr Abdulaziz Abul.

Doubts

However, some members raised doubts, suggesting the proposal is unnecessary and may even upset current practices in Bahrain and abroad.

They pointed out that translation is usually handled by mutual agreement, with alternate translations or expert input available in court when disputes arise.

Critics also noted that Bahrain already requires certified translations for government matters and has a translation office within the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission, which they believe meets many of the proposal's aims.

Concerns

Dalal Al Zayed, head of the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee, shared her concerns about creating new regulations for translators, observing that Bahrain's usual approach is to regulate only

where public health, safety, or a large pool of professionals is involved.

"If we start regulating some professions, we would then need to consider extending this to similar fields, such as legal translation," she explained.

She also noted that Bahrain's publications and publishing law already identifies translation offices as bodies responsible for language services, including real-time translation, with relevant standards set out in Articles 4 and 6.

Intentions

Shura member Dr Mohammed Ali Hassan praised the proposal's intentions but questioned the need for new rules, given existing laws.

He argued that translation agreements should be a matter of "mutual understanding between the parties involved".

He also highlighted that the draft overlooks translators working within government and business sectors.

Noting that 19 different laws and decisions already touch on translation issues, Dr Hassan suggested that "the idea has merit, but the draft lacks direction", and urged more discussions between the committee and supporters.

Global trade and investment

In reply, Redha Faraj defended the proposal, stressing the importance of reliable translations in global trade and investment.

He argued that a regulated translator profession would "ensure clear and legally sound documents", a move he believes would attract foreign investment by building trust.

Faraj concluded that such legislation would not only "boost Bahrain's global appeal but also protect consumers, lower legal and financial risks, and support adherence to international standards".

MP Al Dhaen: National Identity Vital for Development

MP Dr. Maryam Al Dhaen emphasized the importance of strengthening Bahrain's national identity as a cornerstone for the Kingdom's comprehensive development.

Speaking on the subject, she highlighted that fostering a strong sense of identity bolsters national loyalty and unity, enhancing the social fabric necessary for Bahrain's growth and stability.

Bahraini identity

This commitment, she noted, is reinforced by His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's recent address to the Shura and Representatives Councils, urging a nationwide effort to root the Bahraini identity.

Dr. Al Dhaen praised government-led initiatives, including the program led by the Ministry of Interior, which seeks to deepen national belonging and citizenship values.

She also called for integrating concepts of identity into legislation and government programs,

emphasizing the need for educational workshops to instill Bahrain's cultural and historical values in future generations.

Cultural events

Additionally, Al Dhaen underscored the role of cultural events in celebrating Bahrain's heritage and diversity, pointing to contributions by the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities (BACA) and the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA).

She concluded by urging collaboration across government, civil society, and the private sector to preserve and promote Bahrain's national identity for future generations.

Complaints over CR certificates requirement

MP Khalid Buanq has criticised the Ministry of Housing's request for applicants to obtain certificates confirming they do not possess a commercial registration.

Buanq stated that he has received numerous complaints regarding this requirement.

He noted that obtaining this

certificate involves several procedures and a BD10 fee.

Buanq highlighted that Bahrain's electronic interconnectivity allows access to the commercial registry system ("Sajilat") to verify the absence of a commercial registration using personal information. He argued that this eliminates the need for cumbersome procedures, fees, and visits to government offices

to obtain readily available electronic documents.

He believes the current process is unnecessarily burdensome for citizens.

Company fined for wrongful dismissal

A local company has been ordered to pay more than BD10,000 to a former employee who was wrongfully terminated without just cause and without adhering to the required notice period.

The dismissal occurred amid

the company's claims of financial difficulties.

The employee, who had not received his wages for two and a half years, filed a lawsuit to compel the company to settle the outstanding payments.

According to the plaintiff's lawyer Ali Al Qaseer, his client's employment began on Septem-

ber 1, 2021, a month before the formal contract was signed.

He had been hired under a permanent contract as a "Delivery Supervisor" with a monthly salary of BD500.

In March 2024, the company terminated his contract without justification and without following the notice period.

Tamkeen conducts over 4,300 inspection visits for beneficiaries of employment and wage support programs

● **Recognising the high cooperation in reporting violations through designated channels**

The Labour Fund, Tamkeen, reaffirmed its continued regulatory efforts to ensure that the program support objectives are met, and to detect any violations or misuse of public funds.

This is done through inspection visits for enterprises benefiting from employment and wage support programs, where the Tamkeen has conducted more than 4,300 inspection visits to beneficiaries of the employment and wage support programs since the launch of its enhanced programs bundle.

The updated inspection process includes implementing a new procedure with the Ministry of Labour for cases of unlawful dismissals, as well as continuous communication with beneficiaries of the employment and wage support programs during and after the support period.

As a result, over 32,400 ben-

eficiaries have been contacted.

Tamkeen's monitoring and follow-up operations revealed that the percentage of unlawful dismissal cases did not exceed 0.1% of the total beneficiaries contacted, while the number of violations related to individuals' programs stands at 18.

Tamkeen addresses each violation based on its nature; administrative violations, such as non-compliance with support conditions and program policies at Tamkeen are dealt with according to the Fund's violations regulations for suppliers and beneficiaries.

Support programs

According to the violation regulations, Tamkeen retains the right to reclaim the support funds or deny beneficiaries access to future support programs if the recipient was found in violation of the programs' terms and conditions.

Tamkeen can also refer cases to relevant authorities to take the necessary action in case of criminal suspicion such as ghost employment or wage manipulation.

Tamkeen also retains the right to impose administrative penalties mentioned earlier upon

receiving a decision from the relevant authorities.

Commitment and responsibility

The Labour Fund praised the efforts of the public in reporting violations using the designated channels, reflecting the community's commitment and responsibility to safeguard public funds. Tamkeen emphasized the need to adhere to all terms and conditions detailed in the program support approvals and encouraged transparency in communicating with Tamkeen for any required clarification.

In addition, Tamkeen empha-

sized the importance of cooperating with its representatives during inspection visits and providing accurate information and documents.

This will enhance the efficiency of regulatory operations and ensure directing support to its beneficiaries.

profitability reflecting excellent investment and underwriting performance for various types of insurance in Bahrain and Kuwait.

He also stated that BKIC and its subsidiary Takaful International Company B.S.C. are the only local Bahraini insurance companies that are listed, to be rated A-.

G7 agrees new steps to curb Russian sanctions evasion

New York, United States

Finance ministers of the G7 nations vowed Saturday to step up efforts to prevent Russia from evading sanctions imposed after its invasion of Ukraine.

"We remain committed to taking further initiatives in response to oil price cap violations," the group said in a statement following a meeting in Washington. Those further steps were not spelled out in detail.

In December 2022, the G7 together with the European Union and Australia agreed to pressure purchasers of Russian oil to not go above a certain price ceiling.

The agreement was intended to limit Russian petroleum sales and revenues without curbing exports so sharply that it would cause global oil prices to soar.

But some countries, notably China, have continued to import Russian crude oil without observing the price ceiling. The G7 finance ministers also said they would take additional measures aimed at "increasing the costs to Russia of using the shadow fleet to evade sanctions."

Saudi opens resort island at mega-city

Saudi Arabia's planned futuristic mega-city known as NEOM announced on Sunday the opening of its "first physical showcase": a luxury Red Sea island featuring restaurants, hotels and yachting berths.

The opening of the island, known as Sindalah, comes amid persistent doubts about NEOM's viability and ahead of a major investor forum sometimes referred to as "Davos in the Desert" which will begin in Riyadh on Tuesday.

"NEOM is committed to supporting the Kingdom's new era of luxury tourism, with the opening of Sindalah," chief executive Nadhmi al-Nasr said in a statement.

"NEOM's inaugural destination offers visitors a 'first glimpse' of what the future holds for our extensive portfolio of destinations and developments."

Sindalah is "spread over 840,000 square metres" (200 acres) and will be set to receive "up to 2,400 guests per day by 2028", the statement said.

NEOM is best known for The Line, twin mirror-encased 170-kilometre-long skyscrapers meant to extend inland from the coast.



Unveiling The Line in 2022, Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman said its population would exceed one million by 2030 before climbing to nine million by 2045.

However, Bloomberg reported earlier this year that under revised projections just 300,000 people would be living in The Line by decade's end, and only 2.4 kilometres of the project would be completed by then.

Work on NEOM is progressing alongside other major development projects launched as part of Vision 2030, Prince Mohammed's bid to position the world's biggest crude exporter for an eventual post-oil future. Last year the Gulf kingdom

emerged as the only bidder to host the 2034 football World Cup, meaning it now has a decade to build the necessary stadiums and boost its lodging and transport capacity.



In December Finance Minister Mohammed al-Jadaan said officials had decided to push the timeframe for some major projects past 2030, without specifying which ones.

India warns social media after airline bomb threats

India has warned social media platforms of "consequential action" after hundreds of hoax bomb threats to Indian airlines this month triggered travel chaos and terror it said threatened national security.

Some threats led to planes being diverted to Canada and Germany, and fighter jets scrambled to escort aircraft in the skies above Britain and Singapore.

The government called the spread of the threats "dangerously unrestrained".

It warned social media platforms of "consequential action as provided under any law" if they do not comply with the "prompt removal of misinformation".

"The instances of malicious acts, in the form of hoax bomb threats to such airlines, lead to a potential threat to the public order and security of the state," it said in a statement on Saturday.

"Such hoax bomb threats, while affecting a large number of citizens, also destabilises the economic security of the

country."

At least 275 bomb threats were made since mid-October, all reported to have been false, according to the Press Trust of India (PTI) news agency. Other Indian media suggest it could be as high as nearly 400.

"The exemption from liability for any third party information... shall not apply if such intermediaries do not follow the due diligence obligations," it added.

'Economic security'

Civil aviation authorities have had to check every flight that has been threatened, many by messages posted on X, formerly Twitter.

The government warning did not mention any social media company by name, but cited an advisory notice from the information technology ministry.

"The scale of (the) spread of such hoax bomb threats has been observed to be dangerously unrestrained due to the availability of the option of 'forwarding/re-sharing/re-posting/re-tweeting' on the social media platforms," the information ministry said.

News in brief

Japan's scandal-hit ruling party fell short of a majority for the first time since 2009 in snap elections on Sunday, media projections showed, in a blow to new Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba. Worse still, it was touch and go whether Ishiba's conservative Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) could secure a parliamentary majority with its long-term coalition partner, the Komeito party. "We are receiving severe judgement," Ishiba told national broadcaster NHK late Sunday. Voters "expressed their strong desire for the LDP to do some reflection and become a party that will act in line with the people's will," he said. Former defence minister Ishiba, 67, called the election after being narrowly selected last month to lead the LDP, which has governed Japan for almost all of the past 70 years. But voters in the world's fourth-largest economy have been rankled by rising prices and the fallout from a party slush fund scandal that helped sink previous premier Fumio Kishida.



Japan ruling party projected to miss majority in election

Rescuers in the Philippines searched a lake and scoured isolated villages on Sunday to locate dozens of missing people as the death toll from Tropical Storm Trami hit 110. Trami rammed into the Philippines on October 24, forcing over half a million people to flee their homes, while at least 42 people remain missing in the storm's aftermath, according to the national disaster agency. The agency announced Sunday night that at least 110 people were reported dead, though no provincial breakdown was provided for the death toll. Trami is the deadliest storm to hit the Southeast Asian country so far this year "especially with the reported number of casualties", Ariel Nepomuceno in the Office of Civil Defence - which oversees disaster management - told AFP. Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos vowed Sunday that help was underway for the residents of Camarines Sur province, located in the hardest-hit region of Bicol.

Donald Trump rallies supporters Sunday at an iconic New York arena while Kamala Harris goes neighborhood to neighborhood in Philadelphia just over a week before America votes in an extraordinarily close White House race.



Trump's gathering at the nearly 20,000-seat Madison Square Garden is expected to draw a blitz of coverage in the Republican's home metropolis, which is still very much a Democratic stronghold.

Both candidates are making closing pitches to voters in one of America's most divisive and suspense-filled electoral fights, with polls suggesting a dead heat ahead of the November 5 vote. Harris, 60, has planned a packed day of campaigning in the biggest city in must-win Pennsylvania, including stops at a Black church and barber-shop as well as a Puerto Rican restaurant.

A senior Harris campaign official said Sunday's visit will be the vice president's 14th trip to Pennsylvania since she jumped to the top of the ticket after President Joe Biden's shock withdrawal in July. Harris will go before supporters to make what her campaign called her "closing argument" on Tuesday in Washington at the park where Trump rallied supporters before the January 6 riot.

UN chief 'shocked by harrowing levels of death, injury and destruction' in N. Gaza

UN chief Antonio Guterres said Sunday he was "shocked by harrowing levels of death, injury and destruction" in north Gaza, where Israeli forces are carrying out attacks they say aim to prevent Hamas regrouping.

"The plight of Palestinian civilians trapped in North Gaza is unbearable," Guterres's spokesman Stephane Dujarric said. "The Secretary-General is shocked by the harrowing levels of death, injury and destruction in the north, with civilians trapped under rubble, the sick and wounded going without life-saving health care, and families lacking food and shelter."

"Repeated efforts to deliver humanitarian supplies essential to survive -- food, medicine and shelter -- continue to be denied by the Israeli authorities, with few exceptions, putting countless lives in peril," Dujarric said. "In the name of humanity, the Secretary-General reiterates his calls for an immediate ceasefire, the immediate and unconditional release of all hostages, and accountability for crimes under international law."

Israel pounds Gaza and Lebanon after Iran strikes

Jerusalem, Undefined

Israel bombed Hezbollah and Hamas targets in Lebanon and Gaza on Sunday, with no respite in the conflict one day after its strikes on Iran raised fears of a broader war.

The Israeli military said it had killed 70 Hezbollah fighters and struck 120 targets in southern Lebanon and carried out "precision strikes" on weapons factories and storage facilities in the Iran-backed group's southern Beirut stronghold over the past day. In Gaza, it said, it had eliminated "40 terrorists over the past day". Correspondents and witnesses in Gaza confirmed that the north of the Palestinian territory had been hit.

Iran calls on UN Security Council to condemn Israeli strikes

Tehran, Iran

Iran on Sunday called for an urgent United Nations Security Council meeting to condemn Israel's air strikes on the Islamic republic a day earlier. Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi sent a letter to the UN chief and the head of the Council "demanding an urgent meeting of the Security Council to take a decisive position in condemning this aggression", a ministry statement said.

In his letter, Araghchi said "most of the projectiles fired were intercepted by Iran's defence systems" but the attack led to damage at "the target points", as well as the death of four soldiers.

He said the Israeli attack was a "clear violation of the sovereignty" of Iran which "reserves the inherent right... to respond to this criminal aggression."

The Iranian military said it hit Iranian missile factories, missile installations and other systems in several regions, and warned Tehran against responding. Iran has downplayed the attack, saying it caused "limited damage" to a few radar systems, while media outlets dismissed the assault as "weak", signalling what analysts say is the Islamic republic's reluctance to escalate further.

Dozens hurt in Israel truck ramming

A truck driver rammed his vehicle into a crowd waiting at a bus stop in central Israel on Sunday, injuring at least 29 people, medics and police said.

In a separate incident, Israeli soldiers killed a man who tried to stab them during a "counterterrorism" operation near Jerusalem, the military said, describing it as a "terror attack".

Defence minister urges Israel make concessions to free Gaza hostages

Jerusalem, Undefined

Israeli Defence Minister Yoav Gallant warned yesterday that "painful concessions" would be needed to secure the release of hostages held in Gaza and that military action alone will not achieve the country's war aims.

"Not all objectives can be achieved through military operations alone... to realise our moral duty to bring our hostages home, we will have to make painful concessions," Gallant said, in a speech marking the Hebrew calendar anniversary of the Hamas attack on October 7 last year.

Gallant went on to name the country's military accomplishments in over a year of fighting. "In the south, Hamas has ceased to act as a military structure, in the north, Hezbollah continues to suffer blows and its leadership has been eliminated, the majority of its rocket arsenal has been destroyed and its forces have retreated from the border line," he added.

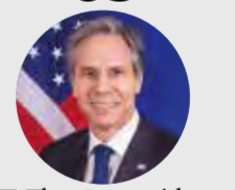

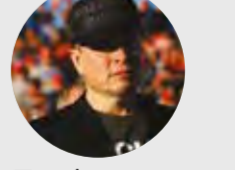

A security interest is an interest in personal property or fixtures that a creditor obtains to secure payment or performance of an obligation. This is generally called, secured transactions. One usually thinks, in such instances, of goods as being put-up as collateral. Whoever, the security interests are much broader as there are different classifications, which are important in determining how a creditor gets an enforceable security interest in a particular kind of collateral.

The classifications include, instruments which cover cheques, notes, drafts, stocks, bonds and other investment securities. Documents of title, which cover bills of lading, warrants, different receipts. Accounts which cover, rights of payment for goods sold or leased or for services rendered that are not evidenced by instruments or chattel paper but rather are carried on open account. Chattel paper which includes written documents that evidence both an obligation to pay money and a security interest in specific goods. General intangible rights that cover, patents, copyrights, royalty rights, franchises and others. Goods that are divided in several classes as consumer goods used or bought primarily for personal family or household use as cars, furniture and appliances. Equipment that includes the type of goods used or bought for use in business activities. Farm products which covers, crops, livestock. Or supplies used or produced in farming operations as long as they are still in the possession of a debtor who is engaged in farming. Inventory which are the goods held for sale or lease or to be used under contracts of service, as well as raw materials, work in process or materials used or consumed in business. Fixtures are the goods that will be affixed to real property or that which are considered a part of the real property.

Each of this could be considered and taken as security or collateral, whoever, this depends on the transaction and the merits of each case, the surrounding circumstances & the relation between the contracting parties. The goal of a creditor, normally, is to obtain a security interest in certain personal property that will be good against the debtor and, also, other creditors of the debtor or a person who might purchase the property from the debtor. In case the debtor defaults on the debt, the creditor wants to have a better right to claim the property than anyone else. Obtaining an enforceable security interest, to be effective, needs to be attached to a particular item or items of the debtor's property. You need to be careful and more vigilant when choosing the collateral and security, as they may be of no or less value, when you need to sell them to cover your entitled obligations. Don't accept any mortgage or pledge or lien or collateral or others unless their value is there fully intact and all through, as there are many legal and logistical problems that may appear later, when it is too late to go back.

Thousands turn out for Thai royal barge pageantry

Bangkok, Thailand



Thousands of well-wishers lined the banks of Bangkok's Chao Phraya River Sunday to watch King Maha Vajiralongkorn ride a glittering royal barge procession to mark his 72nd birthday. A flotilla of 52 ornately decorated boats, paddled by more than 2,000 oarsmen decked out in scarlet and gold, carried the king and Queen Suthida in formation through the heart of the Thai capital to a Buddhist ceremony at Wat Arun, the city's ancient Temple of Dawn.

The king, officially regarded as semi-divine but who came in for unprecedented criticism in street protests in 2020 and 2021, took his place on a century-old royal barge known as the "Golden Swan" to deliver robes to monks in a ceremony marking the end of Buddhist Lent. Royal barge processions date back hundreds of years, but are held rarely, saved for the most significant occasions -- most recently, the king's coronation in 2019. During the 70-year reign of the previous king, Bhumibol Adulyadej, only 16 barge processions were held. King Vajiralongkorn turned 72 in July, completing his "sixth cycle" in the 12-year astrological calendar -- a milestone regarded by Thais as important and auspicious.

Paris Motor Show 2024

Car lovers have descended on Paris' Porte de Versailles for a week of talking, previewing, and trying out the latest electric vehicle (EV) concepts and models.

The biennial event, which dates back to 1898, that is showcasing the world's latest cutting edge auto tech.

This year, in a return to form since the scaled-down 2022 show and a COVID-19 cancellation in 2020, automakers from Europe, the UK, Asia, and North America showed up in force to show off their latest designs.

European world debuts

The show started earlier this week with world debuts from Europe's biggest EV manufacturers.

France's Renault unveiled its 4 E-Tech Electric, an electric crossover SUV called a "voiture à vivre" (or "a car for living") with a 1,045-litre trunk that is "ready to go anywhere".

Citroen, the French make backed by Italian-American Stellantis, have started what they called "a new era" with four world debuts this week: the revamped C4 and C4X along with the new C5 Air Cross, a "multi-energy" family SUV that is streamlined to be more aerodynamic on the road.

From Germany, BMW revamped the MINI John CooperWorks, a classic car that got an energy boost with the "go-kart mode" that lets users put a 20 kilowatt boost of electric power so they can perform "overtaking manoeuvres" and accelerate.

Among BMW's fleet at the Motor Show was also the new electric NeueKlasse, a hi-tech EV that projects driving information on the lower part of the windshield and comes with a personal artificial intelligence (AI) assistant.

The first sedans with AI behind the wheel

The motor show also saw the unveiling of several car models, largely from Chinese manufacturers, that incorporate AI behind the wheel.

Stellantis' Leapmotor, founded in 2015, unveiled the



B10 - a compact cross-over electric-powered SUV, and the Chinese company's first global model.

The car uses an internal "Leap 3.5 architecture" that will provide features like "advanced driver assistance," a digital cockpit and intelligent driving capabilities.

Zhong Tianyue, Leapmotor's head of product planning, said

the car will be manufactured in Poland, adding a price will be announced closer to the car's launch in 2025.

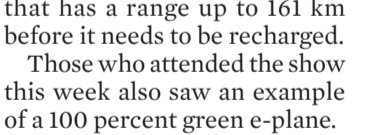
XPeng, a 10-year-old Chinese EV manufacturer, unveiled the P7+, which they claim is the world's first "AI-defined" vehicle.

Green energy delivery trucks, planes, and go-karts

The auto salon also saw some unique green technology that wasn't just for traditional EVs.

Some of France's biggest car manufacturers brought out their latest "license-free" electric microcars that people as young as 14 can drive without a driver's license.

Onlookers saw Renault's Duo and Bento cars, two-seaters a little longer than a metre-long



UK fines Volkswagen over mistreatment of customers



London, United Kingdom

A UK regulator on Monday said it had fined a division of German car giant Volkswagen £5.4 million (\$7 million) over its treatment of customers in financial difficulty.

Volkswagen Financial Services (UK) has also agreed to pay more than £21.5 million, shared among around 110,000 customers, after the Financial Conduct Authority showed it had been "failing to treat its customers in financial difficulty fairly".

The FCA said that between 2017 and middle of 2023 that Volkswagen Finance had failed to take into account the individual circumstances of customers or to provide support tailored to their needs.

"This meant that, in some cases, Volkswagen Finance took cars away from vulnerable customers without considering other options. This risked people being put in a worse position, particularly if they relied on their car to travel to work," the FCA said in a statement.

Volkswagen Financial Services on Monday acknowledged failings had been made and apologised to those affected.

"We recognise our shortcomings in these past cases and have made significant adjustments over recent years to ensure that we are always delivering the right level of service," it said in a separate statement.

"We are in the process of concluding our remediation efforts as we continue to provide goodwill payments to affected customers and apologise for any detriment caused," it added.

California Police Department Abandon Plans to Use Tesla Patrol Cars

The California police department may have scrapped plans to replace its fleet of internal combustion engine patrol cars with Tesla Model 3 sedans. According to reports, senior officials in various North California police departments confirmed that the Teslas they tested proved unsuitable as patrol vehicles.

Ukiah Police Department Chief Cedric Crook stated that the department had acquired two Model 3 sedans in August 2024, with each car, including



modifications, costing \$150,000. The modifications encompassed installing lights, sirens, a bullbar,

a partition, a gun rack, ballistic panels, and communication equipment.

In addition to the high expense, Chief Crook noted that Unplugged Performance was the only company capable of converting a Model 3 into a patrol car, resulting in a modification process that takes months. In contrast, Ford and Chevrolet vehicles can be modified much more quickly due to a broader network of third-party service providers.

Other drawbacks of using the Model 3 as a patrol car included its design limitations, such as a back seat that can only accommodate one prisoner, necessitating multiple vehicles for multi-

ple arrests. The limited driving range was also a significant concern. Chief Crook concluded, "I'm not ready to put an officer in a Tesla."

Similarly, Chief David Norris, who introduced three Model Y crossovers as part of a pilot program, reached the same conclusion as Crook.

In contrast, Fort Bragg Police Department Chief Neil Cervenk found better results with five F-150 Lightning vehicles, which appeared to perform more effectively than the Tesla models.



Tesla electric vehicles (EVs) come with a feature called "Sentry Mode," which uses the car's external cameras as a security system. When activated, Sentry Mode continuously monitors the surroundings for potential threats, such as break-ins or vandalism.

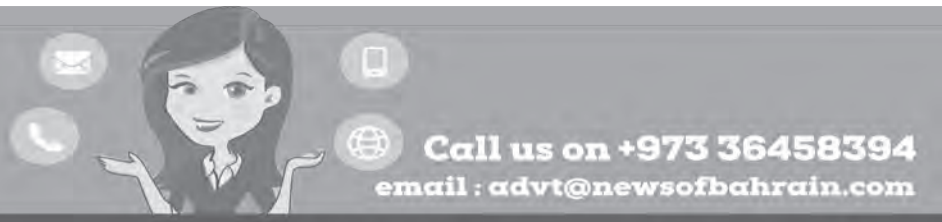

Barca shred Madrid in La Liga Clasico

Robert Lewandowski struck twice in two minutes as Barcelona crushed rivals Real Madrid 4-0 on Saturday, inflicting the Spanish champions' first La Liga defeat in over a year.

Teenage winger Lamine Yamal and Raphinha completed the rout, while Madrid superstar Kylian Mbappe had two goals ruled out for offside on a frustrating first Clasico appearance for Los Blancos, who now trail league leaders Barcelona by six points.

France captain Mbappe was consistently outwitted by the visitors' high defensive line to the chagrin of the exasperated Santiago Bernabeu crowd, whose mood darkened as Barcelona hit four second-half goals.

Barcelona snapped Madrid's 42-match unbeaten streak in

La Liga, one game short of the Catalan giants' all-time record,

adding further shine to their triumph.

"It's a hard moment, a tough moment when you lose a game, (especially after) so many unbeaten," admitted Madrid coach Carlo Ancelotti.

Ancelotti's game-plan was clear -- defend in numbers and try to spring Mbappe or Vinicius Junior with a long ball into the space behind Barcelona's defence.

It led to an intense but repetitive first half, with Barcelona's defence catching Madrid offside on eight occasions.

Mbappe hit the side-netting and lobbed over but was offside on both occasions, while Jude Bellingham forced a superb save from Pena, but it would also have been disallowed for offside.

"We always play with the back four very high, (regarding Mbappe's goals), it's always like that because the referees don't whistle, so it looks dangerous -- but it's not dangerous," said Flick.
