**Bahrain welcomes
urgent ceasefire
deal in Lebanon**

The Kingdom of Bahrain welcomed the announcement of a ceasefire agreement in Lebanon, reached through constructive diplomatic mediation by the US and the French Republic.

Bahrain considers it as a pivotal step towards de-escalation and reducing regional military tension, preserving the lives of innocent civilians, returning displaced persons, and facilitating the delivery of necessary humanitarian and relief aid to alleviate their suffering.

In a statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bahrain stressed the need for full commitment to an immediate, comprehensive, and permanent ceasefire by all parties and the implementation of UN Security Council Resolution 1701 and relevant international resolutions.

It reiterated its unequivocal position calling for dialogue and peaceful means to achieve a just, comprehensive, and permanent peace in the Middle East.

This includes a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip, and resolving the Palestinian issue.

Sparking innovation, shaping Bahrain's future

The Prime Minister's Office (PMO) has announced the conclusion of the application period for the sixth edition of the Government Innovation Competition, known as 'Fikra', on Wednesday.

The initiative, launched under the directives of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, aims to empower Bahrain's national workforce to enhance government operations and achieve the Kingdom's broader aspirations.

Ideas That Transform

Fikra, meaning 'idea' in Arabic, was established to foster creativity and innovation within the public sector. The competition offers a platform for government employees to present proposals that can improve services and align with Bahrain's development goals. By focusing on sustainability, competitiveness, and fairness, Fikra reflects the guiding principles of Bahrain's Economic Vision 2030.



Spotlight on Proposals

This year's application window, which opened on October 27th, attracted strong participation from public sector employees and government enterprises. Participants, either individually or in groups of up to four, were encouraged to submit ideas designed to enhance government services and improve operational efficiency. The evaluation committee has begun reviewing the submissions, marking the next stage of the competition.

Legacy of Excellence

Fikra's previous editions have led to tangible advancements in government services. The fifth edition, concluded in February last year, spotlighted innovative projects such as the 'Motorcycle Ambulance (The Fast Responder)' from the Mohammed Bin Khalifa Bin Salman Al Khalifa Specialist Cardiac Centre and

the 'Legislation Laboratory' from the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission. Other notable entries included 'Circular Bahrain' by the Prime Minister's Office, 'Green Plastic' by the Supreme Council for Environment, and 'The Maintenance Apprentice' from the University of Bahrain.

Mawaeed's Success

A standout success from Fikra's second edition is the

'Mawaeed' app, a national unified system for booking government service appointments. Developed by the Information & eGovernment Authority (iGA) and launched in September, it supports Arabic and English, allowing users to manage bookings, receive notifications, and provide feedback. Since its pilot launch last November, 'Mawaeed' has been downloaded over 9,679 times and processed more than 50,000 booking requests, showcasing its transformative impact.

Citizens' Choice Matters

In January last year, Fikra introduced public engagement

through electronic voting for the "Public Vote" category, enabling citizens to participate in selecting innovative projects. This approach highlights the government's commitment to transparency and inclusivity.

Pioneering the Future

Fikra continues to drive innovation across government institutions. By aligning with the 2023-2026 Government Programme and Economic Vision 2030, it fosters a culture of progress. As submissions undergo evaluation, there is optimism for ideas that will benefit both citizens and residents, reinforcing Bahrain's dedication to excellence in governance.

Bahraini participation rises by 30% at Jewellery Arabia 2024

Rare Birds Steal Show at Mara'ee 2024

Among the highlights this year is a remarkable showcase of birds listed in Appendix I of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES).

Conservation Efforts

Engineer Yousif Alasfoor, President of the Bahrain Bird Society, shed light on this achievement during an interview at the event.

"Every new edition of Mara'ee brings something new, especially in the bird section," he said.

"This year, we've centred our efforts on CITES Appendix I birds - species that are not only rare but also incredibly challenging to breed. These birds are highly protected, and even exporting them requires multiple permissions."

CITES Appendix I includes species facing the highest threat of extinction, with international trade permitted only in exceptional circumstances, such as for scientific research or conservation breeding programmes.

Birds in this category include

some of the world's most remarkable creatures, from vividly coloured parrots to rare hawks and falcons, all of which are tightly regulated to prevent exploitation and ensure survival.

Alasfoor noted Bahrain's role in breeding these endangered birds.

"We are proud to rear these species locally, ensuring their numbers grow without compromising their quality. However, one key hurdle we hope to overcome soon is the formal registration of our birds with

CITES under Bahraini breeders' names. This would be a significant milestone in solidifying Bahrain's contributions to global conservation efforts."

Activities for Visitors

This year's bird section is not just about showcasing rare species - it's also about engaging the public.

An expanded activities area now features interactive exhibits with tamed, talking parrots, offering visitors a chance to play and interact with these charis-

matic creatures.

In a move to make the experience even more memorable, organisers have introduced a voting competition.


"Every afternoon, visitors can vote for their favourite bird," said Alasfoor. "Those who participate in the voting also enter a draw to win prizes. It's a fun way to involve the audience and foster a deeper appreciation for these magnificent birds."

Protecting family housing integrity

Penalties proposed for renting homes for non-residential use

Landlords breaking family-only housing rules could pay the price — literally — if Bahrain enacts new penalties for improper rentals.

A proposed amendment to the Property Rent Law would impose fines of up to a year's rent on property owners who lease family-designated homes for other purposes without official approval.

The proposal, brought forward by MP Mohammed Jassim Al Olaiwi and four colleagues, introduces fines of up to a year's rent for landlords who lease such properties without permission from the local municipality or relevant authority.

The measure would also require the minister responsible for municipal affairs to issue guidelines on when and how approvals can be granted.

Rules

Supporters of the proposal say it's about protecting family neighbourhoods and ensuring landlords stick to the rules.

"Despite restrictions, some landlords continue to misuse these homes, affecting the character of residential areas," the MPs explained in their accompanying statement.

The proposal has also been referred to the Muharraq Municipal Council to offer their views.

Feedback

This move is seen as a way to incorporate feedback from local authorities who deal directly with housing matters and community concerns.

The proposed change, supporters added, is necessary to preserve the purpose of family housing and prevent landlords from cashing in at the expense of communities.

The amendment is rooted in Article 9(a) of Bahrain's Constitution, which requires that housing laws strike a fair balance between economic needs and social justice.

By introducing penalties, the MPs hope to deter further breaches and address a problem that has grown noticeably in recent years.

Fines

Landlords who ignore the new rules would face fines set by the minister, up to a maximum of the annual rent of the property in question.

This, the MPs believe, will give teeth to existing laws and ensure stricter compliance.

The draft law has been sent to the Public Utilities and Environment committee for review, with a vote expected in the coming weeks.

Proponents say it's an overdue step to restore order to residential areas and protect the integrity of family housing.

Food trucks set to relocate for Mithaq Boulevard

About 50 food trucks in Buhaier are being relocated to make room for the Mithaq Boulevard project, the Southern Municipal Council Chairman has said, addressing concerns about stickers placed on the vehicles as notices of their removal.

Abdulla Ibrahim Abdullatif explained that the Southern Municipality had informed the truck owners of the need to vacate the site and advised them to coordinate with officials to secure alternative locations.

The current site is earmarked for the Mithaq Boule-

vard project, a development spanning 22,361 square metres, which aims to serve residents of the Southern Governorate, particularly those in the Third Constituency.

Monday saw meetings between food truck owners — or their representatives — and Engineer Eisa Abdulrahman Al Buainain, Director General of the Southern Municipality, along with Abdullatif.

An agreement was reached to relocate the trucks to other sites within the governorate.

Abdullatif assured that the process would be handled with care, ensuring that truck owners are not left at a disadvantage.

The exact locations for the food trucks will be decided later, following discussions with their owners.

New Procedures Simplify Travel Ban Checks, Offering Immediate Solutions for Bahrain Travelers

Travellers in Bahrain can now identify and resolve travel bans before reaching the immigration desk, thanks to new procedures introduced at the airport.

This change is aimed at ensuring smoother travel experiences while addressing potential issues early in the journey.

Previously, travellers only discovered travel bans after obtaining their boarding passes and arriving at immigration.

Under the new system, passport details are linked directly to the immigration database during check-in at airline counters.

This allows any travel bans or outstanding issues to be flagged immediately.

Resolving Issues Instantly

For those flagged with minor issues, such as unpaid fines or bills, a nearby immigration

counter provides a quick solution. Travellers can settle dues and return to complete their check-in without disrupting their plans.

This approach helps avoid last-minute complications, ensuring journeys proceed without unnecessary delays.

Authorities have emphasised the importance of clearing even minor financial obligations, such as unpaid utility bills, government fees, or fines, ahead of time.

This proactive measure reduces delays and prevents disruptions.

Online Checks for Convenience

Citizens, residents, and travellers can also check their travel status online before heading to the airport.

The government's online portal allows users to verify whether they have a travel ban and resolve issues instantly.

Travellers can access this



service via [Bahrain's eGovernment portal] (https://services.bahrain.bh/wps/portal/TravelBan_en), making it easier to ensure they are clear to travel.

Early Preparation is Key

Travellers are advised to arrive early for check-in, as these additional checks might take



some time.

Any delays in addressing flagged issues could result in the airline counter closing before a boarding pass is issued.

To avoid such setbacks, passengers are encouraged to clear all dues and obligations well in advance.

These updated procedures highlight Bahrain's commitment to enhancing travel efficiency while maintaining security and compliance.

With these improvements, passengers can enjoy a more seamless journey.

Future secured

MPs unanimously approve permanent status for laboratory technicians at Health Ministry

The Council of Representatives has unanimously approved an urgent proposal to confirm the status of laboratory technicians working under temporary contracts at the Ministry of Health.

The proposal, which was presented to Ahmed Al Musallam, Speaker of the Council by MP Mamdooh Al Saleh, highlighted the need for these technicians to be transitioned to permanent positions.

It referenced Article 68 of the Constitution and Article 128 of the internal regulations of the Council, which empower members to submit written requests to the government on public matters.

The accompanying explanatory memorandum detailed the challenges faced by laboratory technicians who have been employed on temporary

contracts for years.

Despite performing the same duties as their permanently employed counterparts, these technicians lacked access to critical benefits, including salary increases, promotions, and job security.

Satisfaction

MP Al Saleh expressed his satisfaction with the unanimous approval.

"These dedicated workers contribute significantly to our healthcare system, and it is only fair that they receive the same recognition and benefits as their colleagues," he stated.

The approved proposal aims to improve the working conditions of these technicians and motivate them by providing job security.

Equality

The MP believes that confirming their positions will foster a sense of equality and boost morale among all employees holding the same job title within the ministry.

This unanimous decision by the Council of Representatives marks a significant step forward in addressing labour conditions for healthcare workers in the region, contributing to a more stable and motivated workforce.

The implementation of this proposal is expected to create a positive ripple effect throughout the healthcare system, ultimately benefiting both employees and the public they serve.

Appeal ruling reduces sentence in ice-block stabbing case

The High Appeals Court has issued its ruling in the case of a fight stemming from a dispute over the sale of an ice block in the Manama Central Market.

The incident, which resulted in the defendant stabbing the victim, causing permanent injuries, has concluded with a reduced sentence for the 44-year-old defendant.

The High Criminal Court had

initially sentenced the defendant to seven years imprisonment, followed by deportation, and confiscation of the murder weapon.

However, the High Appeals Court, after reviewing the ap-

peal, has reduced the sentence to five years imprisonment. The deportation order and confiscation of the weapon remain in effect. The court's findings detailed an altercation that began with an argument.

Students Zap Weeds with AI-Powered Invention

Three students from Al Hekma International School have unveiled their innovative agricultural solution, the WeedWarden, at Mara'ee 2024.

The project, developed by Isa Alkhatat, Ali Fuad, and AbdulWadood Muzammil, aims to revolutionise weed management using advanced AI and electric currents.

The WeedWarden is an automatic weed removal system designed to autonomously identify and eliminate unwanted plants.

Unlike traditional herbicides, which face increasing resistance from weeds, the WeedWarden uses electric arcs to remove weeds effectively without harmful chemicals.

How it Works

The physical model is a culmination of creativity and engineering, incorporating wood, wires, servos, circuit boards, and advanced components.

The system's circuit board powers the WeedWarden's movement, while a potentiometer controls its forward motion and the direction of its laser targeting system.

Electric arcs, generated through a car ignition coil and oscillator, apply high-voltage currents to neutralise weeds.

Innovation in Action

The students' project addresses a critical challenge in agriculture - herbicide resistance.

By automating weed removal with electric currents, the WeedWarden eliminates the need for herbicides, offering a sustainable, eco-friendly solution for farmers.

Displayed in the agriculture section at Mara'ee, the WeedWarden has captured attention for its innovative approach and practical potential.

The project demonstrates how young minds can bring impactful solutions to real-world challenges, showcasing the future of smart farming.

Order in the streets

Muharraq's Municipal Council to propose tighter controls for unlicensed vendors

● Repeat offenders risk fines and could face prosecution

Unlicensed street vendors in Muharraq, often criticised for causing blocked walkways and hygiene concerns, may soon find their trade subject to tighter controls.

The Municipal Council is preparing a proposal to establish clearer rules and introduce standardised vendor carts in an effort to bring order to the streets.

Discussions on these measures are expected at the Council's upcoming meeting.

Street vending has long been a double-edged sword in Muharraq — offering a lifeline for many while presenting a headache for shopkeepers and residents.

Fair balance

The Council hopes to strike a fair balance, allowing vendors to earn a living while keeping public areas clean, accessible, and orderly.

Officials have pointed to issues such as market disruption, unfair competition, and safety risks as driving forces behind

the proposed changes.

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) has made it clear that expat workers are not allowed to engage in street vending, as no permits exist for this kind of work.

Foreigners found operating as vendors face fines of up to BD 5,000 and potential deportation.

Penalties

Employers who hire such workers without proper documentation are also liable for penalties.

For Bahraini vendors, unlicensed activity is a legal grey area.

Repeat offenders could face prosecution, and officials warn that such activity may even be classified as begging under Law No. (5) of 2007, which prohibits unauthorised selling of goods in public spaces.

The law also outlines reha-

habilitation measures for those caught, including assessments of their social and financial circumstances.

Inspections

The Ministry of Industry and Commerce has stepped up inspections to crack down on unlicensed sellers, particularly those trading outside registered premises.

Offenders risk fines and further legal action, as authorities aim to ensure all sellers operate with proper documentation.

A review of existing rules, specifically Decision No. (1) of 2009, has shown that current regulations fall short.

There is no clear guidance on where vendors can work, what they can sell, or how violations should be handled.

The rules also overlook disabled vendors, despite requiring all sellers to pass a health fitness

test. The Council's proposed changes seek to fill these gaps, with a focus on fairness and practicality.

By setting out clear boundaries and expectations, the new framework aims to give vendors a lawful and organised way to trade while ensuring public areas remain welcoming and safe for everyone.

Smart Irrigation Innovation Showcased at Mara'ee

Gulf University has unveiled an AI-powered smart irrigation system at the Bahrain Animal Production Show, Mara'ee 2024, blending cutting-edge technology with sustainability to tackle water wastage and optimise agricultural practices.

The project, developed collaboratively by the Interior Design and Electrical and Electronic Engineering Departments, introduces a moisture-sensitive irrigation system controlled by AI and Internet of Things (IoT) technologies.

The system, a prototype for now, uses an ESP32 microcontroller to monitor soil moisture levels and activate a water pump automatically when needed.

Dr. Walid Elfezzani, Head of the Electrical and Electronic Department at Gulf University, explained, "This system allows the soil to 'talk' to you. When the soil is dry, it sends a WhatsApp

notification, such as 'Plant two: soil dry, needs water.' The system can then either activate the water pump automatically or prompt the user to water the plant manually."

Addressing Global Challenges

This innovative system aligns with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals

"Unlike other systems in the market, this invention incorporates WhatsApp alerts, making it accessible and user-friendly," Dr. Elfezzani noted. "This is a truly Bahraini innovation, crafted with contributions from students and faculty. We hope to expand this prototype across the Gulf University campus in the future."

A Collaborative Effort

The project represents a fusion of multiple disciplines, combining interior design, AI, IoT, and electronics into a practical solution for real-world challenges.

With its potential to conserve water and reduce agricultural costs, the initiative is a significant step toward sustainability.

The prototype, displayed at Mara'ee, has attracted attention for its ability to bring innovation to everyday agricultural practices while promoting Bahrain's capabilities in technological development.

Adani Group says it lost nearly \$55 bn since US corruption charges

New Delhi, India

India's Adani Group conglomerate said Wednesday it had suffered a staggering loss of nearly \$55 billion since US corruption charges against top officials, accusations the company denies.

"Since the intimation of the US DoJ (Department of Justice) indictment, the group has suffered a loss of near \$55 billion in its market capitalisation across its 11 listed companies," it said in a statement.

The November 20 bombshell indictment in New York accused billionaire industrialist founder Gautam Adani and multiple subordinates of deliberately misleading international investors as part of the bribery scheme.

It said they had "devised a scheme to offer, authorise, make and promise to make bribes payments to Indian government officials".

Adani Group issued a stiff denial, describing the charges as "baseless".

A statement on Wednesday said Adani officials are "only charged" with securities fraud, wire fraud conspiracy and securities fraud.

The group said the action

had led to "significant repercussions", including "international project cancellations, financial market impact and sudden examination from strategic partners, investors and the public".

With a business empire spanning coal, airports, cement and media, Adani Group has weathered previous corporate fraud allegations and suffered a similar stock crash last year.

Coffee price hits highest since 1977 on Brazil crop fears

The price of Arabica coffee reached the highest level since 1977 in trading yesterday on concerns of limited supplies caused by drought in Brazil this year.

A pound of Arabica beans listed in New York hit 320.10 US cents, extending the commodity's rally over the past year and pushing past a nearly thirty-year high the day prior.

The all-time recorded high was 337.50 US cents in 1977.

Brazil, the world's largest



Coffee prices are influenced by the weather, especially in major coffee-producing countries like Brazil, Vietnam, and Colombia. For instance, coffee prices often spike when there are severe weather conditions, such as droughts or frosts, which damage crops. One of the most significant price surges in recent history occurred in 2021, when Brazil, the world's largest coffee producer, suffered a devastating frost, leading to a 50% increase in coffee prices globally within a few months.

coffee producer, faced a record-breaking drought this year which has raised significant concerns about the production potential for the crop in 2025/2026. The concerns come even after crops benefitted from "significant rains" that returned in October, leading to an "excellent flowering", according to Guilherme Morya, senior analyst at Rabobank.

Price rises have also been buoyed by geopolitical factors such as disruptions to shipping in the Red Sea, potential US tariffs and the future European Un-

ion regulation on deforestation, according to analysts.

While demand remains high, "farmers are choosing to sell only what is necessary, thus limiting the coffee supply in the local market", Morya added.

Vietnam has also faced supply concerns this year for its cheaper Robusta bean that's used for instant coffee, as the country faced dryness during the growing period. Robusta, listed in London, is trading at around \$5,200 per tonne, after reaching a record price of \$5,829 in mid-September.



News in brief

◆ Baltic and Nordic nations as well as Poland are ready to step up sanctions against Russia and backers of its Ukraine invasion, the countries said Wednesday at a summit in Sweden. Russia has been hit with hefty sanctions in the wake of the 2022 assault, which also prompted Western nations to provide billions of dollars in assistance for Ukraine to defend itself. The heads of government from Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Norway, Poland and Sweden voiced their intent on Russian sanctions after their meeting in Sweden. "We are committed to strengthening our deterrence, and defence... and to expanding sanctions against Russia as well as against those who enable Russia's aggression," their statement said. Lithuania, which is in the process of forming a new government, did not participate in the summit.



Nordics, Baltic states and Poland ready to expand Russia sanctions

◆ Russia yesterday said that it would expel two journalists from Germany's ARD national network in a like for like move after a Russian state broadcaster reported that its journalists had been ordered to leave Berlin. Germany denied closing the Russian channel's bureau, however, and said it would reject ARD journalists being expelled "in the strongest possible terms". Russian state-controlled media has faced broadcast bans and other restrictions since Moscow launched its Ukraine offensive, accused by Western regulators of spreading disinformation. Moscow has responded with what it calls tit for tat measures. ARD said that its two employees were told to hand over accreditations by December 16, saying that this "marks a new low point in relations with Russia" where "pressure on Western journalists... has continued to increase" since Russia began its Ukraine offensive in February 2022.

India, Germany strengthening partnership in green and sustainable development, says envoy Philipp Ackermann

India and Germany are strengthening their partnership for green and sustainable development and working to find new ways to reduce carbon emissions, German Ambassador to India, Philipp Ackermann said on Monday. He further said the two countries are celebrating 50 years of Indo-German scientific operation, adding that they are proud of it.

Speaking to ANI, the German envoy stated, "There's the partnership for green and sustainable development between India and Germany which is a well-funded partnership, where we spend more than a billion Euros a year on projects on common projects in India." "Tonight we are talking about scientific cooperation, how Germany and India can scientifically cooperate and try to find new ways and means to invest in renewables to find new techniques and new ways of reducing carbon emissions. And that's very important. We will celebrate tonight 50 years of Indo-German scientific operation which is a huge achievement we are very proud of," he added.

Meanwhile, German Chancellor Olaf Scholz was on a visit to India last month. This was Scholz's third visit to India since he became Chancellor in 2021. Last year, he visited India twice - for a bilateral state visit in February and to attend the G20 Leaders' Summit in September.

During his visit, Prime Minister Modi highlighted the growing cooperation between India and Germany in the defence and security sectors, citing it as a symbol of their deep mutual trust.

After meeting with PM Modi, German Chancellor Olaf Scholz called India an "important strategic region for India, both in terms of geopolitical relations and trade and investment and Germany is one of our most important partners. Indo-German strategic partnership completed 25 years in 2024 and this year has been historic and special for this partnership."

Notably, Germany is India's largest trading partner in Europe. It has consistently been among India's top ten global partners and was the seventh-largest trading partner in FY 2020-21 (10th during FY 2021-22 up to October 2021), as per the Embassy of India in Berlin, Germany.

World leaders react to Lebanon war ceasefire

UN peacekeepers in Lebanon say adjusting to 'new situation' after truce

World leaders have welcomed a ceasefire deal between Israel and Lebanese militant group Hezbollah, which came into force on Wednesday morning (0200 GMT). Here are key reactions from around the world.

United States and France

The ceasefire between Israel and Lebanon will protect Israel from the threat of Iran-backed militant group Hezbollah and create the conditions for a "lasting calm", US President Joe Biden and French President Emmanuel Macron said ahead of the truce coming into force. "The announcement today will cease the fighting in Lebanon, and secure Israel from the threat of Hezbollah and other terrorist organizations operating from Lebanon," the leaders said in a joint statement. The United States and France will work "to ensure this arrangement is fully implemented" and lead international efforts for "capacity-building" of the Lebanese army, they added.

Israel
Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu thanked the US president for his "involvement in securing the ceasefire agreement". He told Biden in a call that he appreciated the US leader's "understanding that Israel will maintain its freedom of action in enforcing it", according to Netanyahu's office. Ahead of Israel's approval of the deal, Netanyahu said the "length of the ceasefire depends on what happens in Lebanon" and the truce would allow Israel to "intensify" pressure on Hamas and focus on the "Iranian threat".

Lebanon
Lebanese Prime Minister Najib Mikati said the ceasefire was a "fundamental step" towards restoring stability in the region. Thanking France and the US for their involvement, Mikati also reiterated his government's commitment to "strengthen the army's presence in the south".

Iran
Iran, a backer of both Hezbollah and Hamas, welcomed the end of Israel's "aggression" in Lebanon, after the ceasefire came into force. "Welcoming the news of the end of Israel's aggression against Lebanon", foreign ministry spokesman Esmail Baghaei said, stressing Iran's "firm support for the Lebanese government, nation and resistance".

Israel conducts deadly strikes on Syria

Israel conducted strikes on the Syrian border with Lebanon that a war monitor said killed seven people, hours ahead of a ceasefire in the war with Hezbollah. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu warned Syria's President Bashar al-Assad he was "playing with fire" on Tuesday, as he announced the truce with Lebanese militant group Hezbollah. Assad is a key ally and backer of Hezbollah, and Syria has served as the main conduit of weapons for the armed group from Iran to Lebanon.

Hezbollah deployed fighters into Syria during its civil war, and played a key role in propping up Assad's regime during the revolt that erupted in 2011. The nighttime strikes hit border crossings between Syria and Lebanon, killing seven people including two Syrian soldiers, a child and a Syrian Red Crescent volunteer, according to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights. Syria's defence ministry said earlier that six people were killed in Israeli strikes on border crossings with Lebanon just after midnight on Wednesday.

Iran, a backer of both Hezbollah and Hamas, welcomed the end of Israel's "aggression" in Lebanon, after the ceasefire came into force. "Welcoming the news of the end of Israel's aggression against Lebanon", foreign ministry spokesman Esmail Baghaei said, stressing Iran's "firm support for the Lebanese government, nation and resistance".

China
China said it was "paying close attention to the current situation in Lebanon and Israel". "We support all efforts conducive to easing tensions and achieving peace and welcome the agreement reached by relevant parties on a ceasefire," foreign ministry spokeswoman Mao Ning said.

Qatar
"The State of Qatar welcomes the ceasefire agreement in the Lebanese Republic and expresses its hope that it will lead to a similar agreement to halt the ongoing war on the Gaza Strip and the Israeli assaults on the occupied West Bank," Qatar's foreign ministry said in a statement.

Jordan
Jordan's foreign ministry said the ceasefire was "an important step that must be followed by an international effort to end the aggression against the Gaza Strip and Israeli attacks in the occupied West Bank".

Palestinian Authority
"We hope that this step will contribute to stopping the violence and instability that the region is suffering from," the Palestinian presidency said in a statement, highlighting the need to enforce a UN resolution for a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip.

European Union
EU chief Ursula von der Leyen hailed the "very encouraging news" of the ceasefire, saying it would increase Lebanon's "internal security and stability". "Lebanon will have an opportunity to increase internal security and stability thanks to Hezbollah's reduced influence," she said.

United Nations
A top UN official welcomed the ceasefire agreement, but warned that "considerable work lies ahead" to implement the deal. "Nothing less than the full and unwavering commitment of both parties is required," said UN special coordinator for Lebanon, Jeanine Hennis-Plasschaert.

Tens of thousands in Lebanon head home as Israel-Hezbollah truce takes hold

Tens of thousands of Lebanese displaced by the war between Israel and Hezbollah headed back to their devastated towns and villages as a ceasefire took hold on Wednesday.

Under the terms of the deal that brought the war to a halt, the Lebanese military started reinforcing its presence in the country's south, where Hezbollah has long held sway.

The war escalated after nearly a year of cross-border fire initiated by the militant group in support of its Palestinian ally Hamas, whose attack on Israel in October last year sparked the war in Gaza. It killed thousands of people in Lebanon and triggered mass

displacement on both sides of the border. Israel shifted its focus from Gaza to Lebanon in September to secure its northern border the movement a series of heavy from Hezbollah attacks and dealt blows.

Iran-backed group has significantly weakened and still mourning the killing in an Israeli air

raid of its longtime leader Hassan Nasrallah. Hezbollah lawmaker Hassan Fadallah told AFP on Wednesday that his group was cooperating on the Lebanese army's deployment in south Lebanon. There is "full cooperation" with the Lebanese state in strengthening the army's deployment, he said, adding that the group has "no visible weapons or bases" there and that "nobody can make residents leave their villages". The road from the Lebanese capital to the south has been congested since the early hours, with thousands of people heading home. AFP journalists saw cars and minibuses packed with people

What happens next?

Israeli forces will hold their positions, but "a 60-day period will start in which the Lebanese military and security forces will begin their deployment towards the south," the official said. That will give them time to reach the Israeli positions, at which point Israel can begin a phased withdrawal without any vacuum forming that could see Hezbollah or others rush in, the

official explained. The withdrawal should take no longer than 60 days, the official said. Hezbollah must also withdraw from the southern border with Israel and move further north up the Litani River -- something it has not done despite a UN Security Council resolution calling for it in 2006 (UN Resolution 1701).

What if something goes wrong?

Biden said that the United States, with the support of France and other allies, would "provide the necessary assistance to make sure this deal is implemented fully and effectively." However, that does not mean US boots on the ground, he said. Instead, "if Hezbollah or anyone else breaks the deal and poses a direct threat to Israel, then Israel retains the right to self-defense consistent with international law," Biden stated.

The United States and France will join the tripartite mechanism created after the 2006 war between Israel and Hezbollah, bringing together the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL), Israel and

Lebanon. This mechanism, which going forward will be chaired by the United States, will be tasked with maintaining communication between the various parties and ensuring that whenever any violation is identified it is dealt with to avoid any escalation, the US official said. A military committee involving the armies of "several other countries" will also provide additional support to the Lebanese army in terms of equipment, training and financial resources. "We remain committed to be on the ground, day to day, watch what's happening and to let everybody know ... that the world is watching," the official said.

Hamas says 'ready' for Gaza truce

Gaza City, Palestinian Territories

Hamas is ready to reach a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip, a senior official in the Palestinian Islamist group said Wednesday, hailing the ceasefire that took hold in Lebanon.

"We have informed mediators in Egypt, Qatar and Turkey that Hamas is ready for a ceasefire agreement and a serious deal to exchange prisoners," the official told AFP, however accusing Israel of obstructing a deal. In a statement released later Wednesday, Hamas said "the enemy's acceptance of the agreement with Lebanon with-

out achieving its preconditions marks a significant milestone in shattering (Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin) Netanyahu's illusions of reshaping the Middle East through force". The group also praised the "pivotal" role of its ally Hezbollah in Lebanon. In the occupied West Bank, the Palestinian Authority expressed hope that the ceasefire would bring stability to the region, especially in war-torn Gaza. "We hope that this step will contribute to stopping the violence and instability that the region is suffering from," the Palestinian presidency said.




