LuLu launches 'The Great Indian Festival'

Russia threatens to restart nuclear arms production

AFP | Moscow

Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday threatened to relaunch production of intermediate-range nuclear weapons if the United States confirmed its intention to deploy missiles to Germany or elsewhere in Europe.

"If the United States carries out such plans, we will consider ourselves liberated from the unilateral moratorium previously adopted on the deployment of medium- and short-range strike capabilities," Putin said during a naval parade in Saint Petersburg.

Putin added that now in Russia "the development of a number of such systems is in the final stages".

"We will take mirror measures in deploying them, taking into account the actions of the US, its satellites in Europe and in other regions of the world," the Russian president warned.

he United States on Sunday said it will support Israel against all threats supported by Iran.

Talking in the aftermath of the attack in Israeli-annexed Golan Heights that killed 12 youngsters, National Security Council Spokeswoman Adrienne Watson said in a statement, "Our support for Israel's security is ironclad and unwavering against all Iran-backed threats, including Hezbollah."

"We have been in continuous discussions with Israeli and Lebanese counterparts since the horrific attack," Watson added.



n a landmark case, a university student has successfully sued her father for refusing to provide her with financial

The court's decision, which was upheld on appeal, has set a precedent for similar cases involving parents who fail to financially assist their children.

The case, brought by the young woman, who was represented by lawyer Isa Al Widae, centered around her father's refusal to contribute towards her university expenses, despite his financial means.

The woman, who is unmarried and does not have a job, argued that her father, a government employee with a monthly salary exceeding BD900, was financially capable of providing for her needs.





Why Arbitration

Justice and rule of law are basic human rights and prime constitutional obligations. All can look for their rights (and duties)

which are preserved by the law. Courts are open for any one

to claim all rights and to get what is claimed if legally proved.

This is the main duty of the Judiciary and Courts are there to look into claims and litigations. However, by time, people started to look for alternative dispute resolutions (ADRs), due to many factors. Such factors, include among other things, the longtime taken by the Courts, in many places, to settle and give final judgments in the disputes, where time is of essence and justice shall be prompt.

Settlement of disputes, through Courts, could be delayed for many reasons. This is, of course, not accepted as "Delay of Justice is denial of Justice". Moreover, Justice should be seen in the right time, the right way, otherwise it is something else rather than justice. Due to this obstacle, people started to look around for other alternative dispute resolutions in lieu

The (ADRs), has been developed by time and they primarily include, arbitration, mediation, conciliation, adjudication... In practice, arbitration ranked as No. 1, among the ADRs and hopefully others to follow suit. In arbitration, time is the most important factor and the final award shall be given within certain limited time (in most laws, within 6 months) unless the parties agree to extend. Whereas, litigation before Courts could take years & years and by such time the taste of justice has been eroded and any ruling becomes tasteless and unen-

joyable. Taking this in consideration, many countries have started to revamp & renovate the judicial system to overcome the loopholes in the path of justice. However, within such steps, we find the issuance of arbitration laws, mostly, within the parameters of the UNIC-ITRAL Model Law.

In addition to the time factor hiderance, many litigation issues nowadays are of very technical nature, this technicality, requires technical know-how, which is mostly available in arbitration tribunals and adhoc arbitrators. Examples of technical issues are many, for example, engineering disputes through FIDIC,

banking, IP, IT, IICRA.... ETC. The appropraite place to settle such disputes in short span of time, is mostly through arbitration by experienced qualified arbitrators working under the umbrella of many international or regional institutional arbitration centers as in the ICC, LIAC, DIFC, or CODEX... ETC.

specialized centers as the WIPO arbitration center, The technical know-how, available to such specialized ar-

bitration centers are not, to a great extent, available to Courts. This point, encourages people to opt for arbitration rather than litigation before judicial Courts. Arbitration is the will of the contracting parties. In other

words, we can say, arbitration is a private Court chosen by the parties, in preference to the available "general" Gov. Courts. In such process, the parties, can opt to arbitration from the beginning by adding the "Arbitration Clause" initially in the contract, or by putting a clause, at any other time, to go for arbitration to settle their dispute. This could happen, even, after they start litigation before any Court provided that the case didn't reach the stage to give a final ruling.

Moreover, as per the law of arbitration, the arbitration process is effective, final & executable. This puts arbitration awards in the same rank of judicial decrees, therefore opting to arbitration could be the right appropriate alternative choice due to the special features and characteristics of arbitration.


