



**Bahrain braces for temporary weather relief**

Bahrain is expected to experience a temporary improvement in weather conditions towards the end of the week, with north-westerly winds beginning to sweep across the Kingdom starting today. This was announced yesterday by an official source from the Meteorological Directorate at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

The source added that the northwesterly winds will significantly reduce humidity levels, which have been high since the beginning of August following the retreat of the Al Bareh winds.

The northwesterly winds are also expected to continue until the middle of next week, reaching strong speeds by tomorrow, the source noted, leading to dust rising in certain areas and increased sea wave heights over the weekend, before gradually subsiding in the following days.

The Meteorological Directorate has urged the public, particularly those who frequent the sea, to stay cautious.

**Africa to secure nearly a million mpox vaccines**

The African Union's health watchdog yesterday said it was close to securing almost one million mpox vaccine doses, urging manufacturers to share the vaccine-making technology to battle the disease.

Africa is on the front line of the fight against mpox, with the World Health Organization (WHO) declaring an international emergency earlier this month over the viral disease's spread. Spain has pledged 500,000 doses to African countries hit by outbreaks.

Engineer Aasim Abdullatif Abdullah is the new Under-

secretary for Agriculture and Animal Wealth within the Ministry of Municipalities and Agriculture Affairs, based on the Minister's recommendation and Cabinet approval.

Fatima Ebrahim Khalifa Al Manai will serve as Undersecretary in the Ministry of Housing and Urban Planning, effective immediately, following the Minister's proposal and Cabinet endorsement.

Ebrahim Mohammed Abul has been named Chief Executive Officer of the Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA), with this appointment also recommended by the Prime Minister and approved by the Cabinet.

These appointments, effective from the date of issuance, will be formally published in the Official Gazette.

**Cycle of violence hits West Bank**

Israeli raids kill 'significant' number of Palestinians as Gaza war rages on

Israel launched a large-scale operation yesterday in the occupied West Bank, where the army said it killed Palestinian fighters, as the nearly 11-month-old Gaza war showed no signs of abating.

The military said its forces killed nine Palestinians while the Palestinian Red Crescent reported 10 deaths in the West Bank, where violence has surged during the war sparked by Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel.

The war has killed more than 40,000 people in Gaza, according to the Palestinian territory's health ministry, and caused widespread destruction and displacement.

Early yesterday, Israel launched coordinated raids across four northern West Bank cities - Jenin, Nablus, Tubas and Tulkarem - where the military has focused much of its recent operations against armed groups.

Columns of armoured vehicles entered two refugee camps, in Tulkarem and Tubas, as well as Jenin.

By midday, they were blocking entrances to the towns and

camps, AFP photographers said, with soldiers firing at the camps from which gunfire and explosions were heard.

The Red Crescent said Israeli forces killed 10 people and wounded 22 others in the raids. The medical organisation's

West Bank chief Younes al-Khatib said ambulances came under Israel fire and "one of our staffers was hit".

Palestinian president Mahmud Abbas cut short a vis-

it to Saudi Arabia and headed home to "follow up on the latest developments in light of the Israeli aggression", Palestinian official media said.

cycle of violence in the region", according to a royal statement.

Violence, meanwhile, raged in the Gaza Strip, where the civil defence agency reported at least 12 dead in Israeli strikes, and in Lebanon where the Israeli military said it killed a "significant" Palestinian fighters.

Mediation efforts seeking an end to the Gaza war continued in Qatar where an Israeli delegation was present yesterday, said a source close to the negotiations.

## Foreign Ministry hailed for securing return of stranded citizens in Iraq

MP Jalal Kazim Al Mahfoudh has praised the efforts of the Kingdom of Bahrain's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, particularly the Bahrain Embassy in Iraq, for successfully securing the return of 140 Bahraini citizens who were stranded in Karbala, Iraq.

The citizens had fallen victim to a scam perpetrated by an unlicensed travel agent.

Al Mahfoudh highlighted the swift and effective response of Bahraini diplomacy, emphasising the ministry's immediate action upon receiving news of the citizens' plight.

He expressed his appreciation for these tireless efforts, which reflect the Bahraini leadership's commitment to the well-being and protection of its citizens abroad.

The lawmaker stressed that this incident should serve as a valuable lesson for all citi-

zens, urging them to exercise caution and take necessary precautions before joining any travel group or making financial payments.

### Legitimacy and reliability

Al Mahfoudh underscored the importance of verifying the legitimacy and reliability of travel companies by ensuring they are properly licensed.

This, he said, is crucial to

avoid falling prey to similar scams. He further advised citizens to contact relevant government authorities if they have any doubts about a travel group.

He underscored that these precautionary measures are essential for ensuring a safe and hassle-free travel experience.

# Prison time

### Three convicted in major drug smuggling ring bust

The High Criminal Court has sentenced three individuals involved in a drug smuggling ring to prison terms.

They were apprehended attempting to smuggle a significant quantity of "CBD" (cannabis) into Bahrain via the King Fahd Causeway.

The ringleader, the first defendant, was sentenced to 10 years in prison and fined BD5,000.

The second and third defendants received one-year prison sentences each and fined BD1,000.

All seized evidence was ordered by court to be confiscated.

The incident unfolded when customs security officers at the King Fahd Causeway intercepted the three individuals arriving from Saudi Arabia.

After noticing the defendants' unusual behavior, the officers questioned them about any items they were carrying, but they denied having any-



thing to declare.

A thorough search revealed a stash of plastic containers containing "CBD" weighing 7.5 grams in the first defendant's possession.

An additional plastic piece containing 8.4 grams of the same substance was found in his pants pocket.

### Search

A search of the third defendant's bag uncovered two prohibited pills and an electronic shisha containing 90.1 grams of the same drug liquid.

Further investigation led to the discovery of eight plastic containers containing 1236.3 grams of the substance hidden

in a travel bag in the car's trunk, three containers weighing 238.9 grams concealed in the drawer between the front seats, and three containers weighing 84.3 grams hidden in the driver's door pocket. Prohibited pills were found in the back seat, along with six empty plastic containers used for packaging and a plastic piece containing 7.8 grams of the substance hidden in the trunk in a plastic bag.

### Ownership

The first defendant confessed to drug use during the Public Prosecution investigation and admitted ownership of the seized items.

Both the first and second defendants confessed to drug use. Toxicology and drug laboratory reports confirmed the seized items contained "CBD" (cannabis).

Analysis of the first defendant's phone by the Cybercrime Department revealed messages related to the sale and purchase of drugs and images of materials and tools used for consumption.

## Shura member Jamsheer dies

Abdulrahman Jamsheer passed away yesterday at the age of 80 after a prolonged illness.

Jamsheer was a distinguished figure in Bahrain, in both politics and business, serving as a Shura Council member before his death.

His career left a lasting mark across various sectors. He played a key role in shaping Bahrain's political landscape,

notably as Secretary-General of the National Action Charter of 2002, crucial to the charter's formation and approval.

Jamsheer began at the Ministry of Agriculture before moving to the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO). In 1973, he founded the National Import and Export Company, which evolved into Esterad Investment.

As General Manager and later Managing Director, he made significant contributions to the Investment Committee.

## Man sets fire to family home in act of revenge

A Bahraini man with a history of criminal offenses has been accused of setting fire to his family's home in a deliberate act of revenge.

The incident caused significant damage to the family's residence and a neighboring property.

According to the suspect's brother, the man had been exhibiting erratic behaviour in the days leading up to the fire.

He was reportedly seen destroying personal belongings in his apartment on the second floor of the family home.

On the day of the incident, the suspect's mother contacted his brother, informing him that the suspect was still breaking things and that she could smell smoke.

The suspect's sister also testified that she received a call from her brother informing her of the fire. Upon arriving at the scene, she witnessed firefighters extinguishing the blaze.



### Belief

She expressed her belief that her brother was responsible for the fire, citing his erratic behaviour and the fact that he was alone in the apartment where the fire originated.

A report by the Directorate of the Civil Defense confirmed that the fire had caused extensive damage to the second floor of the home, including the living room, bedrooms, and bathroom.

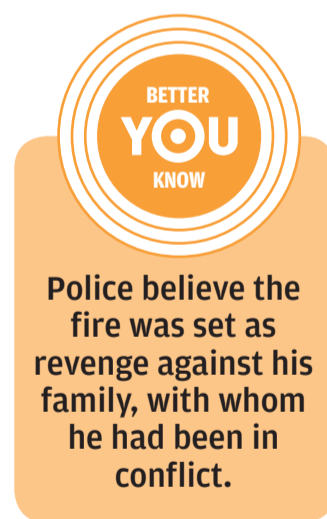
The fire also spread to the

second floor of the neighbouring house.

The official stated that the suspect was apprehended by police and questioned about the fire. He admitted to setting the fire using a lighter and insecticide to ignite furniture in the living room.

### Motive

Police investigations revealed that the suspect has a history of drug use and criminal activity.



They believe that the motive behind the fire was revenge against his family, with whom he had been experiencing conflict.

The defendant is standing trial before the High Criminal Court. He pleaded not guilty to the charges levelled against him, while his lawyer cited the defendant's mental struggles.

The next hearing has been scheduled for September 2nd.

## Ex-employee jailed for stealing company vehicle

A former employee of a Bahraini company has been sentenced to one year in prison for stealing a company vehicle and forging transfer documents.

The High Criminal Court also ordered the defendant's deportation from Bahrain after serving his sentence and the confiscation of the forged document.

The 43-year-old Asian national, who worked as a plumber for the company, was entrusted with the vehicle for

work purposes.

When the company closed in 2021 and the owner dismissed all employees, including the defendant, he was instructed to return the vehicle. However, the defendant refused to comply.

In January 2024, the company owner, through his lawyer, discovered that the vehicle had been transferred to another company.

A subsequent investigation revealed that the defendant had forged the transfer document, including the signature of the original owner and the company stamp.

## Bangladeshis held for commercial crab fishing in protected area

The Public Prosecution has initiated investigations into an incident involving the commercial fishing of crabs in a pro-

TECTED AREA.

Two Bangladeshi nationals have been arrested and remanded in custody.

The Public Prosecution received a report from the Coast

Guard, stating that the two individuals were apprehended while engaging in commercial fishing activities within a protected marine area.

They were using crab traps

(cradles) and had in their possession approximately 140 kilograms of crabs and 25 crab traps.

Upon receiving the report, the Public Prosecution immediately commenced investiga-

tions, questioning the suspects and presenting them with the seized evidence. The suspects have been remanded in custody pending further investigations.

The boat used for the illegal

fishing operation has been impounded, and the seized crabs will be auctioned off.

The proceeds from the sale will be deposited pending the suspects' trial.

The Royal Medical Services of the Bahrain Defence Force (BDF) has staged a medical evacuation drill at the Mohammed Bin Khalifa Bin Salman Al Khalifa Specialist Cardiac Centre. The drill focused on ensuring preparedness for managing accidents and emergencies by strengthening coordination with relevant authorities.

# Click, apply, approved!

LMRA slashes licence processing time and boosts efficiency with new digital upgrades

Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) CEO Nebras Talib has introduced a major digital upgrade to 50 services to enhance efficiency and user satisfaction.

Key updates include a more efficient process for licensing and renewals for recruitment agencies, improved online settlement procedures, and enhanced services for domestic and work permits.

Mr Talib pointed out that these changes are intended to increase efficiency and service quality by integrating digital solutions, reducing completion times, and simplifying procedures.

Many services are now available online, cutting down the need for in-person visits.

For example, the time to licence recruitment agencies has been reduced from 60 days to 20, and the required documents have been halved.

**Notifications**

Similarly, work abandonment notifications are now processed in 11 days instead of 30, and the work permit quota service has been shortened from 13 days to 3.

Mr Talib explained that these upgrades are in response to directives from His Royal Highness Shaikh Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

The changes, designed to speed up processing and improve digital solutions, align with Bahrain's goal of becoming a leading business hub.

Mr Talib outlined the authority's ongoing efforts to enhance its services and procedures to better the work environment

and user experience.

**Royal initiatives**

As part of HRH Prince Salman's directive to develop 500 services across 24 government entities, the LMRA has revamped 50 services — 26 for business owners, 16 for domestic employees, and 8 for expatriate workers.

This initiative supports Bah-

rain's broader development objectives under the guidance of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Mr Talib reiterated the LMRA's aim to keep improving, staying abreast of global digital trends, and supporting Bahrain's ambition to become a leading business and investment centre in the region.

## List updated for safe and reliable student transport options

With the new school year approaching for public schools and already underway in many private institutions, the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications has released an updated list of approved drivers and companies for student transport.

This revised list includes 498 licences — 423 for individual drivers and 75 for transport companies.

Parents are encouraged to select from these approved providers to ensure their children's safety.

The updated list is available on the Ministry's website.

The Ministry aims to regulate student transport services, offering safer and more reliable options for schools and families.

Parents should check that their chosen service holds the necessary licence to guarantee

both their children's safety and their own peace of mind.

**Regulations**

The Ministry also stresses the importance of following trans-

port regulations designed to protect students during their daily commute. Legal action will be taken against anyone found operating without a licence.

To support these measures, the General Directorate of Traffic has organised training sessions for school transport drivers in both public and private sectors.

These sessions cover safe driving practices, such as observing speed limits, staying in the correct lane, and maintaining the allowed number of passengers.

**Congestion**

Drivers have also been instructed to stop in designated areas to avoid congestion at school entrances.

Following directions from traffic police, community officers, and school security staff is crucial for smooth traffic flow.

The list of licensed transport providers will be updated regularly, ensuring that the information remains accessible to the public via the Ministry's official website.

# Stocks diverge as traders eye Nvidia earnings

US shares fell and European stock markets mostly closed higher yesterday as investors cautiously waited to see whether the latest earnings results from US chip giant Nvidia can justify the high valuations of tech stocks.

Traders are also waiting for key US economic data later this week that could provide clues about the extent of an expected interest-rate cut next month.

In late morning New York trading, the Dow was little changed while the wider S&P 500 and tech heavy Nasdaq were lower. In Europe, London's FTSE 100 Index closed little changed, with Paris and Frankfurt closing higher.

All markets were focused on the release of Nvidia's second-quarter results after the close of US markets Wednesday.

Nvidia earnings statements "have become an important macro event in their own right over recent quarters, with reactions that rival the sort of moves taking place after surprise jobs reports or CPI (inflation) releases," said Jim Reid, an analyst at Deutsche Bank.

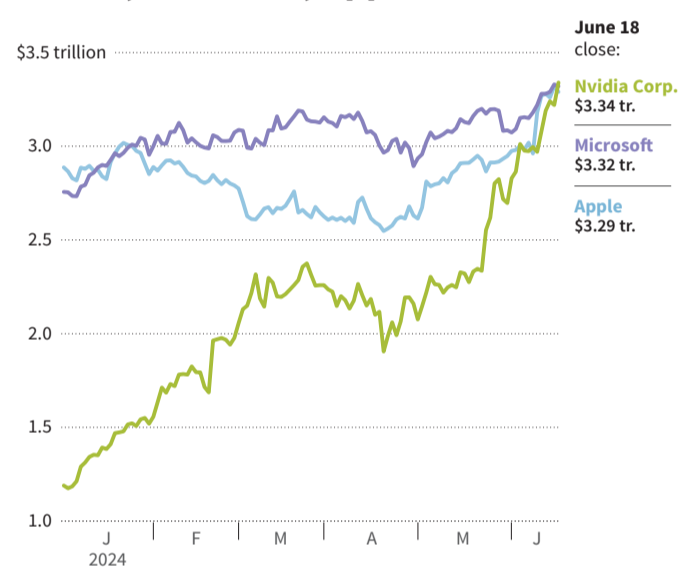
Nvidia is up about 160% year-to-date and has accounted for a third of the broad-based S&P 500 index's gains this year. But its shares were down 3.2% in late morning trading.

The market expects the company to post sales ranging between \$27 billion and \$32 billion, more than double from a year ago, said Swissquote Bank analyst Ipek Ozkardeska.

## Nvidia, Microsoft, Apple market value



The market has a "wait-and-see mentality", said Patrick J. O'Hare, an analyst at Briefing.com, because Nvidia "is primed to move. Everybody knows that. What they don't know is which way. So, the market is operating in a guarded fashion."

The market could be in for a rough ride if Nvidia disappoints, analysts said. "This is the one that could either lift all boats or sink the entire fleet," said analyst Stephen Innes in his Dark Side Of The Boom newsletter.

Nvidia has seen profits soar thanks to demand for its powerful GPU chips, which have set the industry's pace in pushing new advances in artificial intelligence.

Investors are also waiting for the release of US economic growth data on Thursday and the Federal Reserve's favoured gauge of inflation on Friday, followed by jobs figures next week.

Fed chief Jerome Powell said last week that the central bank was ready to cut rates, which were raised to a 23-year high in efforts to combat inflation, but he did not indicate by how much. The Fed's next rate decision will be made at its September 17-18 meeting, with investors divided over whether the cut will be 25 or 50 basis points.

The dollar firmed somewhat Wednesday after losing ground recently on expectations of the Fed's interest rate cuts, which reduces returns on US dollar assets. Oil prices slipped Wednesday, shedding some gains from earlier in the week.

## RIL eyes JioCinema as sole OTT platform post Star-Viacom18 deal

Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL), which will control the merged Star-Viacom18 entity once it receives regulatory approvals, is considering to consolidate its streaming services under a single platform, JioCinema, according to a report by The Economic Times.

Despite Disney+ Hotstar having more downloads than JioCinema, RIL is exploring the possibility of integrating Disney+ Hotstar with JioCinema post-merger. Disney+ Hotstar, owned by Walt Disney's Star India, boasts over 500 million downloads, whereas JioCinema, which is part of RIL-controlled Viacom18, has over 100 million downloads.

In February this year, RIL and Walt Disney reached an agreement to merge Star and



Viacom18, creating an \$8.5 billion media conglomerate that would encompass over 100 channels and two streaming platforms.

The company is also prepared to shut down channels in both Hindi and regional markets to address concerns from the Competition Commission of India (CCI) regarding the market dominance of the newly merged Star-Viacom18 entity. The final approvals from the CCI and the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) are still pending.

## Kremlin slams Kyiv decision not to extend Europe gas contract

Kyiv's decision to let lapse its contract with Gazprom to supply Russian gas to Europe will seriously harm European consumers, the Kremlin said yesterday.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky on Tuesday said his country would not extend the transit agreement via Ukraine beyond December 31.

"It's over," he said. Despite the ongoing conflict, Russia delivered more than 14 billion cubic metres of gas to Europe via Ukraine in 2023, although this was less than the 40 billion cubic metres provided for in the contract.

EU members Austria, Hungary and Slovakia still receive Russian gas in this way.

The three countries continue to rely on Russian gas despite an EU pledge to free itself of Russian gas by 2027 following Moscow's full-scale offensive into Ukraine launched in February 2022.

"Such a decision by Ukraine will seriously harm the interests of European consumers who still want to buy Russian gas," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said.

"They will simply have to pay much more, which will make their industry less competitive," he added.

◆ Donald Trump said Tuesday he had "reached an agreement" for a September 10 debate with Kamala Harris, two days after he threatened to pull out -- although there was no confirmation from the US vice president that a deal had been struck. Trump posted on his Truth Social platform that the rivals had agreed that the ABC showdown would run under the same rules as CNN's June 27 debate, with no studio audience and each candidate's microphone muted when the other is speaking. Calling ABC "by far the nastiest and most unfair newscaster in the business," Trump said the network had given him assurances that the debate in Philadelphia would be "fair and equitable. But the Harris campaign -- which had been pushing for a clash with mics switched on throughout -- responded by accusing Trump of moving the goalposts and was coy about whether it was accepting the terms.

◆ Donald Trump was embroiled in controversy Wednesday after a report that his entourage shoved staff during a politicized visit to the United States's most hallowed resting place for its war dead. National Public Radio reported late Tuesday that an Arlington National Cemetery official tried to prevent the Republican's aides from filming and photographing in a section reserved for those killed in recent wars -- and where filming is banned. Trump staffers responded by shoving and verbally abusing the employee, the report said. Arlington National Cemetery confirmed on Wednesday there had been an "incident" at the location, after the 78-year-old Republican presidential candidate's visit on Monday.

Telegram founder ordered to French court to face possible charges

● Durov also probed for 'serious acts of violence' against his child in France

Pavel Durov, the founder and chief of Telegram, was to appear in a French court Wednesday to face possible charges of failing to curb extremist and illegal content on the popular messaging app after his arrest at the weekend. Russian-born Durov, 39, was arrested at Le Bourget airport outside Paris late Saturday. After almost four days of questioning in detention by French investigators he was handed over to judicial authorities who will decide further measures, a source close to the case told AFP.

A Paris investigating magistrate will decide whether to press charges against Durov, and the judiciary would then rule on whether he will be remanded in custody or allowed to go free, possibly under judicial control with restrictions on his movements. As part of a probe that was confidentially opened on July 8, Durov is being investigated on suspicion of 12 offences related to failing to curb extremist and criminal content on Telegram, sources close to the investigation have said. The tech mogul founded Telegram as he was in the process of quitting his native Russia a decade ago. Its growth has been exponential, with the app now reporting over 900 million users.

Yemen floods leave 12 dead, 21 missing

Flash floods triggered by torrential rainfall have killed at least 12 people and left more than 20 others missing in rebel-held areas of Yemen, the Houthi-run Al-Masirah television reported yesterday.

The overnight floods in Al-Mahwit, a province west of the capital Sanaa ruled by the Iran-backed Houthis, triggered landslides that swept through several homes, according to Al-Masirah. Twelve bodies were retrieved in the province's Melhan district and at least 21 people remain missing, Al-Masirah said citing civil defence teams.

Houthi authorities said they have formed a committee tasked with coordinating disaster response, and have started to provide food and shelter to affected families, according to a statement carried by rebel media.

The mountains of western Yemen are prone to heavy seasonal rainfall. Since late July, flash flooding has killed 60 people and affected 268,000 across Yemen, according to the United Nations. Western and central provinces have been warned of worse to come. "In the coming months, increased rainfall is forecast, with the central highlands, Red Sea coastal areas and portions of the southern uplands expected to receive unprecedented levels in excess of 300 millimetres (12 inches)," the World Health Organization warned on Monday.

Vietnam police bust baby trafficking ring

Police in Vietnam have arrested more than a dozen people in connection with a baby smuggling ring that trafficked 16 newborns across several cities and provinces in the country, state media said yesterday. Sixteen men and women have been taken into custody for trading the babies aged between three days and three months old, according to the official newspaper of Ho Chi Minh City Police.

The gang targeted women through closed groups on social media, exploiting those who were struggling to provide and care for their children. They bought each baby at a cost of between \$400 and \$930, the report said. The gang then falsified adoption documents and resold them for between \$1,400 and \$3,000. Police have investigated 84 suspected baby trafficking cases that have occurred since the beginning of the year in 32 cities and provinces.

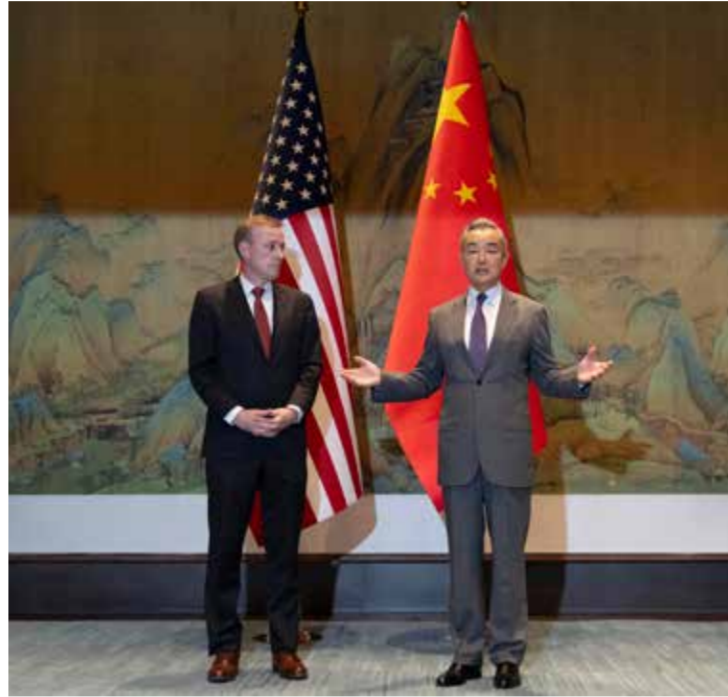
US, China trade warnings during tense visit

Top US and Chinese officials exchanged warnings against stoking regional tensions during a meeting in Beijing yesterday, after China became embroiled in security rows with American allies Japan and the Philippines.

US National Security Advisor Jake Sullivan, making the first such trip by someone in his role since 2016, and Chinese top diplomat Wang Yi met in Beijing for talks that they want to smooth over relations. But after their meeting, state

media reported that Wang cautioned Washington against supporting the Philippines in the disputed South China Sea. "The United States must not use bilateral treaties as an excuse to undermine China's sovereignty and territorial integrity, nor should it support or condone the Philippines' actions of infringement," Wang told Sullivan, according to state broadcaster CCTV.

Sullivan, who is US President Joe Biden's most senior security aide, doubled down on Washington's pledges to defend its regional partners. "Mr Sullivan reaffirmed the United States' commitment to defending its Indo-Pacific allies," the White House said in a readout

of their meeting. Sullivan also "expressed concern about the PRC's destabilizing actions against lawful Philippine maritime operations in the South China Sea", it said, using an acronym for the People's Republic of China.

Sullivan landed in the Chinese capital on Tuesday for a three-day trip, saying on arrival he looked forward to "a very productive round of conversations" with foreign minister Wang.

The visit follows a summit between Biden and Chinese President Xi Jinping in California in November 2023, and comes just over two months before elections in the United States.

But the meeting was shadowed by Washington's allies Japan and the Philippines blaming China in the past week for raising regional tensions.

Beijing said on Monday it had taken "control measures" against two Philippine Coast Guard ships that "illegally" entered an area of disputed reefs and waters. Wang stressed that Taiwan belonged to Beijing and that China will "certainly be unified".

He told Sullivan that the US should "put into practice its commitment not to support Taiwan independence" and stop arming Taiwan, according to CCTV. The White House said Sullivan

"underscored the importance of maintaining peace and stability across the Taiwan Strait."

The US and Chinese officials also discussed issues including Ukraine, the Middle East and the Korean Peninsula, both sides said. Sullivan had "emphasized concerns" about China's support for Russia's defence industry during Moscow's invasion of Ukraine, the White House said.

Wang countered that China was committed to "working towards a political solution to the Ukraine crisis" and warned Washington off imposing "illegal unilateral sanctions."



Sullivan and Wang have met five times over the past year-and-a-half -- in Washington, Vienna, Malta and Bangkok, as well as alongside US President Joe Biden and Chinese leader Xi Jinping at a November 2023 summit in California.

US announces new sanctions on Israeli settlers over violence

The United States yesterday announced new sanctions on Israeli settlers in the West Bank over violence against Palestinians, urging its ally Israel to bring greater accountability.

The sanctions were announced on the same day that Israel launched a wide-scale attack on the West Bank that it said killed nine Palestinian fighters, despite warnings by President Joe Biden's administration against expanding the war in Gaza. "Extremist settler violence in the West Bank causes intense human suffering, harms Israel's security and undermines the prospect for peace and stability in the region," State Department spokesman Matthew Miller said in a statement.

"It is critical that the government of Israel hold accountable any individuals and entities responsible for violence against civilians in the West Bank," he said. The latest sanction targets in-

cluded Hashomer Yesh, an Israeli group that has supported the unauthorized settler outpost of Meitarim Farm in the south Hebron Hills.

Volunteers from the group earlier this year fenced off a village whose 250 Palestinian residents had all been forced to leave, the State Department said.

Hashomer Yesh's website, using the biblical name for the West Bank, says the group helps "various farmers throughout Judea and Samaria, who bravely protect our lands and stand strong in the face of economic difficulties and frequent agricultural crime."

The State Department also imposed sanctions against Yitzhak Levi Filant, who was accused of leading armed settlers in setting up roadblocks and patrols with a goal of attacking Palestinians.

India floods kill 15 after heavy rains

Torrential rains in India caused heavy flooding that killed at least 15 people, local media reported yesterday.

Rivers across the coastal western state of Gujarat have broken their banks and more than 23,000 people have been evacuated from their homes, according to the reports.

The Business Standard newspaper said 15 people had been killed since Monday across eight of the state's districts.

Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea, chief minister Bhupendra

Patel said in a social media post that fishing crews had been told not to venture into rough seas.

Monsoon rains cause widespread destruction every year, but experts say climate change is shifting weather patterns and increasing the number of extreme weather events.

The northeastern state of Tripura was battered by floods and landslides last week, with more than 20 people killed.

Next door and downriver in Bangladesh, heavy floods killed at least 40 people over the same period with nearly 300,000 residents taking refuge in emergency shelters.

PetroSaudi execs get Swiss jail terms over \$1.8 bn IMDB fraud

Two Swiss court sentenced PetroSaudi executives to jail terms yesterday after finding them guilty over the embezzlement of \$1.8 billion from the Malaysian sovereign wealth fund IMDB.

Tarek Obaid, the Swiss-Saudi chief executive of the oil exploration and production company, was sentenced to seven years in prison by the Federal Criminal Court, Switzerland's Keystone-ATS news agency reported.

Patrick Mahony, a Swiss-British director at PetroSaudi, was given a six-year sentence, the agency said. Prosecutor Alice de Chambrier had sought a 10-year sentence for Obaid and a nine-year term for his right-hand man.

Obaid, 48, and Mahony, 47, were seen arriving separately at the court in the southern city of Bellinzona ahead of the verdict hearing.

The trial was heard by three judges at the court in April.

Obaid and Mahony were accused of involvement in a vast embezzlement orchestrated by Jho Low, an advisor to former Malaysian prime minister Najib Razak.

Noting the sums involved compared to Malaysia's GDP, Chambrier called it the "scam of the century" and branded the defendants as "calculative, manipulative and obscenely greedy". Keystone-ATS reported during the trial.

The defence pleaded for acquittal, arguing that no fraud had taken place.

UN extends Lebanon peacekeeping force's mandate

The United Nations Security Council yesterday extended the mandate of the UN peacekeeping force in Lebanon for a year, calling for a "de-escalation" of a recent surge in violence between Israel and armed group Hezbollah.

A unanimously adopted resolution said the council "decides to extend the present mandate of UNIFIL until 31st August 2025," referring to the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon.

With more than 10,000 personnel, the peacekeeping force has been stationed in Lebanon since 1978, with its role strengthened after a 33-day conflict between Hezbollah and Israel in 2006.

Tensions have risen again since the October start of Israel's war in Gaza, with Hezbollah supporting the Palestinian armed group Hamas with operations in southern Lebanon, including daily exchanges of fire with Israeli troops.

On Sunday, Hezbollah carried out a major drone and rocket attack against Israel, in retaliation for the death of one of its military leaders, Fuad Shukur, killed in an Israeli strike near Beirut on July 30.

In response, Israel launched air strikes into Lebanon on Sunday, saying it destroyed "thousands" of Hezbollah rocket launchers and thwarted a major attack. The UN Security Council resolution said the body "strongly urges that all relevant actors implement immediate measures towards de-escalation, including with a view to restoring calm, restraint and stability across the Blue Line," referring to the demarcation line between Israel and Lebanon. UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, in a letter to the council at the end of July, had supported Beirut's request to extend UNIFIL's mandate unchanged.

Woman dead as Viking ship replica sinks off Norway

One woman died and five other people were rescued after a replica of a Viking ship capsized off Norway's west coast overnight, authorities said yesterday.

Police said a woman was found dead in the water near the sunken ship, but did not provide any information about her identity or nationality. Norwegian media said she was an American citizen in her 20s.

"Five people have been picked up and are safe and sound," emergency services wrote on X.

Helicopters, rescue boats and several nearby ships battled high waves and strong winds overnight in the rescue operation.

The 10-metre (30-foot) open Viking ship, powered only with sails and oars, had sent

a mayday call earlier in the evening, but when boats and a helicopter arrived at the scene the call was deemed to have been a false alarm, the Verdens Gang (VG) daily said.

An hour later it sent another mayday call, and this time a large rescue operation was launched.

The five rescued were winched up by helicopter from a life raft.

The tragedy happened about 100 kilometres (60 miles) off of Norway's west coast.

According to VG, the wooden ship was on its way from the Faroe Islands to Alesund in Norway when the accident happened.

VG said those on board were adventurers from the Faroe Islands, Switzerland and the US attempting a voyage similar to one the Vikings would have done more than 1,000 years ago.

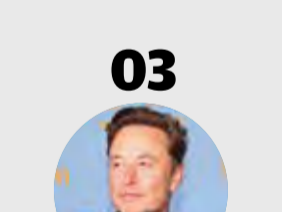

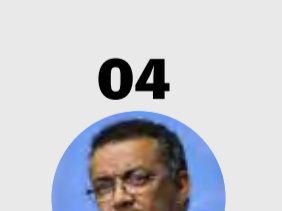

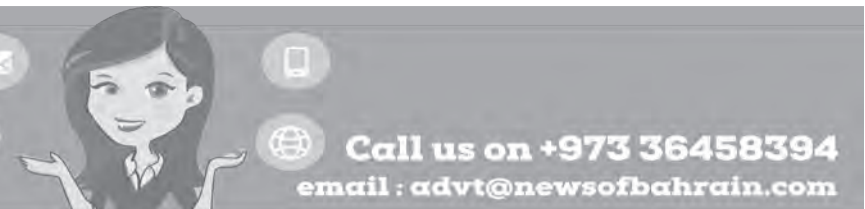

# Sinner, Alcaraz survive US Open wobbles as Osaka weeps on return

Top seeds battle back from first round wobbles as Tsitsipas, Wawrinka stunned in early exits

Jannik Sinner and Carlos Alcaraz survived US Open first round wobbles on Tuesday to stay on course for a semi-final showdown as two-time champion Naomi Osaka made a tearful and colourful return to Flushing Meadows.

World number one Sinner fought back from a set and break down to defeat 140th-ranked Mackenzie McDonald in his first match since being embroiled in a doping test controversy.

Alcaraz, the third seed and 2022 champion in New York, overcame a second set blip to defeat 186th-ranked qualifier Li

Tu of Australia 6-2, 4-6, 6-3, 6-1.

Italian Sinner battled to a 2-6, 6-2, 6-1, 6-2 win over American opponent McDonald on Arthur Ashe Stadium, racing away with 18 of the last 22 games.

The 23-year-old was returning to action just a week after it was revealed he had failed two drug tests in March.

However, he escaped a lengthy ban when officials decided he wasn't at fault for the presence of banned anabolic agent clostebol in his system.

"The response from fans, I feel it has been great, also throughout when the news came out, in the practice sessions, there was a lot of support," said Sinner.

"It's still a little bit not easy. You have to go

through day by day."

Alcaraz, who won the first of his four Grand Slam titles in New York in 2022, opened the night session against Tu who hasn't won a match on the main tour this year.

**'He surprised me'**

However, Tu thrilled the crowd as he went about his task of facing a player who is attempting to become only the third man in the modern era to win the French Open, Wimbledon and US Open in the same year.

After being outplayed in the opening set, Tu levelled the tie on a fifth set point in the second.

But Alcaraz crushed any hint of a shock result by running away with the clash to record his 15th successive Grand Slam match win.

"He surprised me a little bit. In the first set, he was nervous but after that he grew into it and played great

tennis," said the Spanish star.

Naomi Osaka, who missed last year's tournament after giving birth to her daughter Shai, stunned 10th seed Jelena Ostapenko.

Former world number one Osaka, now ranked 88, came through 6-3, 6-2 for her first top 10 win in four years.

The Japanese star crunched nine aces in her 19 winners and committed just five unforced errors to her opponent's 21.

Her tennis was as striking as her outfit. Osaka arrived on court with a brightly-coloured, giant bow on the back of her jacket and a frilly skirt over her playing dress.

To complete the ensemble, the 26-year-old attached small bows to the heels of both shoes.

"Last year I was watching Coco (Gauff) play and I so badly wanted to step on these courts again," said a tearful Osaka, a four-time major winner.

**'Means so much'**

World number one and 2022 champion Iga Swiatek defeated 104th-ranked Kamilla Rakhimova after having to save three set points in the second set.

French Open champion Swiatek, chasing a second New York title to add to her four triumphs in Paris, saw off the Russian lucky loser 6-4, 7-6 (8/6) to ex-

tend her season-leading record to 54 match wins.

However, it was an unconvincing display by the Pole who committed 41 unforced errors.

Fifth-seeded Daniil Medvedev, who shattered Novak Djokovic's dream of a calendar Grand Slam by claiming the 2021 US Open, went through with a four-set victory over Dusan Lajovic.

Greek 11th seed Stefanos Tsitsipas, who

has never made the second week at the tournament, was stunned 7-6 (7/5), 4-6, 6-3, 7-5 by Australia's Thanasi Kokkinakis.

Stan Wawrinka, the 2016 champion, failed in his bid to become only the third man in last 50 years to win a main draw match at the tournament at the age of 39 or over.

Wawrinka slipped to a 6-4, 7-6 (7/5), 6-3 loss at the hands of Italian qualifier Mattia Bellucci.

Two former women's champions were knocked out.

Bianca Andreescu, the 2019 winner, lost in three sets to sixth-seeded Jasmine Paolini while 2021 champion Emma Raducanu fell to 2020 Australian Open winner Sofia Kenin.

Britain's Dan Evans defeated 23rd seed Karen Khachanov 6-7 (6/8), 7-6 (7/2), 7-6 (7/4), 4-6, 6-4 in the longest match in US Open history, a five-hour, 35-minute epic.

## Champions League revamp: More teams, new format

● **Expanded competition introduces a league phase, increased games, and extra knockout round**

● **36 clubs, up from 32, now compete in the league phase**

Ahead of the draw for the 2024/25 UEFA Champions League which takes place on Thursday in Monaco, AFP Sport explains the format of the new, expanded version of Europe's elite club competition.

**More clubs, no more groups**

The updated version of the Champions League will see 36 clubs feature in the competition proper, an increase from 32 under the old format.

There is an extra place for the fifth-best European league according to UEFA's ranking, which means France's Ligue 1 now has three automatic qualifiers.

In addition, there is an extra berth for each of the two leagues with the highest coefficient ranking from last season in UEFA competition, which this year are Germany and Italy.



the trophies of the UEFA Champions League (L), the UEFA Super Cup (C) and the UEFA Europa League (R) displayed at the Palace of Culture and Science in Warsaw

The remaining extra slot goes to a national champion to emerge from the qualifying rounds, which will be completed this midweek.

Since 2003, the Champions League featured 32 clubs split into eight groups of four, with the top two from each section advancing to the last 16.

That has now changed radically, and from this season the 36 clubs will be pooled together in one league, in a so-called 'Swiss system' more commonly associated with chess.

**A lot more games**

Before, participating teams played six games in the group stage, facing each opponent home and away. Now clubs will

each have eight games.

The 36 teams will be split into four seeded pots of nine. Every club will play two teams from each pot, one at home and one away.

This "raises the prospect for fans of seeing the top teams go head to head more often and earlier in the competition," UEFA say, a nod to the fact this format was introduced at a time when the spectre of a breakaway

Super League hung over European football.

No team will come up against another club from the same domestic league as them, and every club can only face a maximum of two teams from any one country.

Whereas in past years the group stage ended in December, the expansion of the Champions League means the two extra matchdays will be staged in January.

The number of games is increasing from 96 in the old group stage, up to 144 in the new league phase.

**Extra knockout round**

The 36 clubs will be ranked together in the one league, with the top eight all progressing to the last 16 and the format of the competition from that point on remaining the same.

However, it will be seeded, taking into account positions in the league phase.

In addition, a play-off round will be introduced, with the teams finishing from 9th to 24th in the league phase going through to a two-legged knockout tie to decide the remaining spots in the last 16. These play-off ties will be seeded.

The bottom 12 teams in the league phase will be eliminated, with no access to the second-tier Europa League, as was the case in the past.

## Pope seeks Root advice on how to balance batting and captaincy

Ollie Pope has asked Joe Root for guidance on how best to balance the demands of batting and captaincy after an awkward first outing as stand-in England skipper against Sri Lanka.

Pope, in the first of three matches deputising for the injured Ben Stokes, led England to a five-wicket win over Sri Lanka at Old Trafford last week as they went 1-0 up with two Tests to play.

Nevertheless, No 3 batsman Pope was himself twice out for six in Manchester -- the second time to an ill-judged reverse sweep.

While Stokes may be absent, the England team still features star batsman Root, who led England in a record 64 Tests from 2017-2022.

Significantly, the 33-year-old Yorkshireman scored 14 hundreds during his period in charge of what was often a struggling side.

Now, as England head into the second Test against Sri Lanka at Lord's starting Thursday, it is no surprise Pope has turned

to Root for advice on how to be an effective batsman while captaining England.

"I really enjoyed the week," Pope told a pre-match press conference at Lord's yesterday. "The runs didn't translate for me but hopefully over the next two weeks, I can put aside my

"It's about having the two things separate. That's something I've spoken to Joe Root about. We just spoke about how it's more taxing in the field but it's finding a little routine and doing small things."

He added: "It's just finding a way to compartmentalise. Chatting to Rooty, he's obviously got a great cricket brain and is England's best batter, so we just bounced a few ideas off each other."

Since Stokes and coach Brendon McCullum joined forces, England have become known for their aggressive approach, particularly when batting.

But Root showed there was more than one way to win as his unbeaten 62 off 128 balls -- featuring just two boundaries -- anchored England's successful chase of 205 against Sri Lanka at Old Trafford on a slow pitch.

## Georgia goalkeeper Mamardashvili to join Liverpool in 2025

Liverpool announced the signing of goalkeeper Giorgi Mamardashvili from Valencia but the Georgia international will not arrive at Anfield until next season.

Mamardashvili shone during his nation's first ever major tournament at Euro 2024 as Georgia reached the last 16 before bowing out to eventual winners Spain.

"Liverpool have reached an agreement for the transfer of Giorgi Mamardashvili, subject to a work permit and international clearance --

with the Valencia goalkeeper set to move to Anfield ahead of the 2025-26 season," Liverpool said in a statement.

"The Reds have secured a deal for the 23-year-old that will see him stay in Spain for the remainder of the current campaign with Los Che before switching to Merseyside next summer."

Liverpool will reportedly pay 30 million euros (£25 million, \$34 million) plus a further five million euros in add-ons for their first signing of the transfer window.
