

ChatGPT can now search for latest data on internet TDT | New York

The generative AI plat-form ChatGPT can now

fetch data directly from the internet and gather upto-date information in real-time, its creator OpenAI said Wednesday, in a major milestone for the software.

Until now, ChatGPT's responses to user queries were based on a vast database, which did not contain information from after August 2021.

"ChatGPT can now browse the internet to provide you with current and authoritative information, complete with direct links to sources," OpenAI said in a post on X, formerly Twitter. "It is no longer limited to data before September 2021."

Worth around \$3.5 billion (3.3 billion euros), the sale is the biggest ever deal for Israel's military industry.
