Japan condemns Houthis' attack on BDF soldiers

Japan yesterday condemned Monday's attack on Bahrain Defense Force (BDF) soldiers in southern Saudi Arabia that left military personnel dead and several others wounded.

In a statement, the Japanese Foreign Ministry said: "The government of Japan condemns this attack and expresses its concern that it could run counter to the ongoing efforts of the political dialogue in Yemen to bring about a permanent peace from the current de-facto ceasefire."

"The government expresses its condolences to the victims and their families and prays for the early recovery of the injured."
