## LMRA conducts 1,523 inspection campaigns, visits

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) announced the implementation of 1,523 inspection campaigns and visits, during the period of 20 to 26 October 2024, which resulted in the detention of 62 violating and irregular workers, while 208 violators were deported.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

## Israel's war in Gaza 'should end', says Biden

## Blasts in Red Sea off Yemen

# New safety net

New Labour Law amendments to safeguard private sector workers from trafficking

## 19,689 Bahrainis benefited from job opportunities

The Cabinet approved a memorandum submitted by the Government Executive Committee on a draft law amending the private sector's Labour Law to support the Kingdom's ongoing efforts in combating human trafficking.

It also approved a memorandum submitted by the Ministerial Committee for Community Services on labour market indicators until the third quarter of 2024.

The indicators revealed that 19,689 Bahraini citizens benefited from job opportunities, achieving 98% of the annual target of 20,000 jobs for Bahrainis outlined in the Kingdom's Economic Recovery Plan.

In this regard, the Cabinet — chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister — directed its gratitude and appreciation to all private sector companies and institutions that contributed to the employment of Bahrainis during the third quarter of 2024.

The report also showed the training of 13,679 Bahraini citizens until the third quarter of 2024, exceeding the annual target of 10,000 trainings for Bahrainis by 137%.

**Global standards**  
The Cabinet recognised His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's appreciation for the Minister of Interior's efforts and those responsible for the Kingdom's alternative sentencing programme, which has exceeded global standards.

## Participation

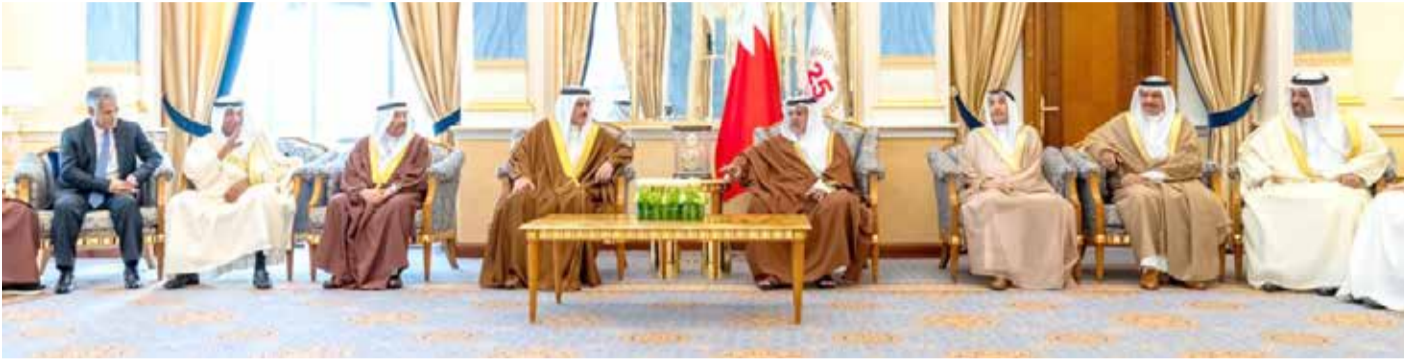
He emphasised that aligning national environmental plans with international goals reaffirms the Kingdom's commitment to being an active partner in global efforts aimed at achieving environmental security.

## Bahrain's accession to key traffic and legal conventions

The Foreign Affairs, Defence, and National Security Committee of the Council of Representatives gathered yesterday, under the leadership of MP Hassan BuKhammas, with fellow committee members in attendance.

The meeting focused on various issues referred from the Speaker of the Council.

Key among these was a draft law allowing Bahrain to join the 1949 Convention on Road Traffic, along with several proposals addressing immigration, identity cards, and amendments to both the Penal Code and the Traffic Law.

The committee also consid-

ered a proposal for Bahrain to accede to the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties.

In addition, several suggestions were examined, leading the committee to invite the proposer of a plan to exempt citizens from traffic service fees to provide further details.

They also agreed to seek input from the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee on this matter.

While a proposal concerning safety standards for swimming pools was rejected, the committee approved a plan to raise awareness about digital fraud and will present this report to the Bureau of the Council of Representatives.

## Insurance company to pay BD700,000 in fire damage claim

A Bahraini insurance company has been ordered by the Bahrain Dispute Resolution Centre to pay a commercial company BD700,000 in compensation for a fire that damaged its warehouses.

The ruling stems from an arbitration case managed by lawyer Zuhair Abdullateef on behalf of the commercial company.

The commercial company, which deals in building materials, plumbing supplies, and other equipment, held a one-year insurance policy with the

defendant insurance company, effective from May 22, 2021, covering various risks, including fire.

A fire occurred on July 13, 2021, causing extensive damage to the company's offices, warehouses, and inventory.

A report from the General Directorate of Civil Defence confirmed substantial damage to multiple warehouses, noting that the cause of the fire remains undetermined due to the extensive destruction sustained by the structures.

The insurance policy had a coverage of BDL08 million.

# Debate on worker protection rules

Private sector employers must notify authorities before suspending workers

● Longer compensation claims for dismissed workers on the table

Employers in Bahrain's private sector could soon need to notify authorities before suspending workers, and dismissed employees might get twice as long to file compensation claims, as Parliament debates new rules today.

The government's draft law, submitted to Council of Representatives Speaker Ahmed bin Salman Al Musallam, proposes two main updates to Bahrain's Labour Law, introducing added checks on employers' actions and extending protections for workers.

One proposal would require employers to notify authorities before suspending workers for serious misconduct.

### Discretion

Currently, employers have some discretion to temporarily suspend a worker in cases of harm or serious offences, but this adjustment would mean

they must inform relevant authorities first, limiting employers' ability to act independently in such cases.

Another proposed change

would extend the timeframe for workers to file a claim after losing their job, increasing it from 30 days to 60.

Supporters say this additional time could help workers prepare stronger cases, though the government cautions that delaying claims might make it harder to gather reliable evidence and could slow the resolution of disputes.

### Concerns

In its memo, the government expresses concerns that these changes may disrupt the balance between worker protections and workplace stability.

Officials argue that requiring employers to notify authorities for suspensions could make it harder to handle misconduct, which might unsettle the work environment.

They also warn that an extended claim period could affect evidence quality, as time may erode details and reduce clarity in witness accounts.

### Three-month cap

The government also questions the proposed three-month cap on investigations by the Public Prosecution, arguing that it may infringe on judicial independence by imposing a strict timeline on prosecutors.

While recognising Parliament's aim to strengthen worker rights, the government suggests a balanced approach that keeps workplaces steady.

Today's debate may bring about changes to Bahrain's employment laws, with these proposals potentially influencing how workplace disputes are handled in the future.

# Focus on timeshare legislation to boost investment

The Services Committee of the Shura Council met with representatives from the Ministry of Tourism, led by the Chief Executive Officer of the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority (BTEA) Sara Buheji, to discuss a draft law regulating timeshare in accommodation units.

The meeting focused on the draft law accompanying Decree No. (33) of 2023, aiming to establish clear legal frameworks pro-

tecting the rights and responsibilities of all parties involved in timeshare arrangements.

The ultimate goal is to stimulate investment in both the tourism and real estate sectors.

The committee reviewed the Ministry of Tourism's perspectives on the draft law, including proposed amendments and articles.

### Questions

Members of the Services Committee raised questions regarding specific clauses in the pro-

posed legislation.

The draft law seeks to provide greater flexibility in contractual agreements, making timeshare arrangements more attractive to investors.

A key objective is to build consumer confidence among citizens, residents, and tourists in Bahrain's timeshare sector.

### Shared ownership

The draft law explains that timeshare is based on the principle of shared ownership or usage of a property over time.

## Life sentence upheld for killing cold store worker

The High Appeals Court has upheld the life sentence of a Bahraini man convicted of causing the death of a cold store worker during a robbery.

The court heard the appeal on Monday, rejecting the defendant's challenge to the High Criminal Court's original ruling.

The incident occurred when the suspect allegedly assaulted the cold store worker while attempting to flee the scene after a robbery.

The injuries sustained by the victim led to his death several days later in hospital.

According to a police complaint filed by the deceased's

brother, the accused was a known customer at the shop with a history of theft.

### Critically injured

On the day of the incident, he allegedly attacked the victim

after stealing items, leaving him critically injured.

An eyewitness corroborated this account, describing the brother's distress upon discovering his sibling collapsed outside the store.

Despite being rushed to the hospital, the worker succumbed to his injuries.

Security camera footage from a nearby residence captured the defendant striking the victim, causing him to fall unconscious.

### Theft and assault

Further investigation revealed the defendant's history of theft and assault at other establishments.

## Bahrain Pushes for New Radio Opportunities with Fresh Bid for Indian Channel 87.6 MHz

Bahrain's vibrant radio scene is set to grow as the Tender Board invites bids for the operation of 87.6 MHz, an Indian entertainment channel that will run 24/7, building on the nation's commitment to cultural inclusivity.

This follows the recent awarding of 107.2 MHz to GO ALIVE MEDIA HOUSE W.L.L., which secured a bid of BHD 666,666 and is gearing up to provide Indian-focused programming over the next five years.

With roots in radio dating

back to 1940, Bahrain has steadily evolved its media landscape, offering programming from Bahrain Radio and Television Corporation (BRTC) as well as popular private channels like 104.2 FM, which was originally started in 2006 by Strategic Publicity & Advertising Co. (SPAC) W.L.L. and was the first one catering to the Indian community in the Kingdom.

The addition of 87.6 MHz, available under a five-year contract with a minimum bid of BHD 8,000 per month, will further enrich this tradition.

Published on October 22nd, the 87.6 MHz tender requires that bidders have a minimum

of three years in radio operations, with bids due by December 29th.

To promote local engagement, the Tender Board has also offered a 10% financial evaluation advantage for Bahraini SMEs, encouraging local businesses to be at the heart of Bahrain's expanding cultural radio environment.

Operators must meet rigorous criteria, including compliance with manpower laws, commercial registration, and financial bonding requirements.

The tender signals will deepen cultural connections, bringing high-quality Indian entertainment to the airwaves.

## Push to increase cranes for abandoned vehicle removal

The Northern Municipal Council yesterday agreed to recommend to the Minister of Municipalities and Agriculture, His Excellency Wael Mubarak, a proposal to increase the number of cranes used for removing abandoned and scrap vehicles for sale in the Northern Governorate.

The proposal from Deputy Chair Zainah Jassim aims to add these cranes to the current cleaning contract or to hire private firms, making it easier to enforce the law.

The reasoning behind this initiative is straightforward: with only one crane available for the Northern Municipality, it has become increasingly difficult to do the necessary work and enforce rules effectively.

There has been a clear rise in the number of abandoned vehicles, scrap cars, and those offered for sale in breach of the law throughout the Northern Governorate.

In response, Lamya Al Fadhala, the Director-General of the Northern Municipality, stated that five cranes have been arranged for the governorate for a two-month period in partnership with the cleaning firm.

Additionally, the council unanimously agreed to amend Article 18 of Law No. 13 of 1977, which governs building regulations.

# Delivery disruption

Muharraq Municipal Council committee recommends suspension of delivery company permits

The Finance and Legal Committee of the Muharraq Municipal Council has recommended suspending the permits of delivery companies until a regulatory legal framework is established.

This came as the committee held a meeting chaired by Ahmed Al Maqhawi and attended by council members Abdulqader Al Sayed, Mohammed Al Mahmoud, and Dalal Al Muqhawi, along with Mohammed Hussain, Head of the Executive Branch's Inspection Department, and Abeer Al Mahmeed, Head of the Licensing Department.

Council President Abdulaziz Al Naar was also present to discuss several points.

The committee stated that it will invite relevant authorities to discuss and find optimal solutions to the problems associated with these companies, addressing the concerns of residents and road users.

It stressed that the proposed measures will not include any increase in fees, thus preventing higher prices for consumers.

The committee invited the Ministry of Industry and Commerce to discuss the operational mechanisms of delivery companies, but the ministry declined to attend.

Al Maqhawi expressed the

committee's surprise at this absence, stating that the invitation aimed to gather preliminary information to determine each entity's responsibility in overseeing these companies.

The committee also discussed the investment opportunities for the Muharraq Grand Park following the departure of the previous investor.

Given the previous unsuccessful investment attempts, the committee proposed new conditions, most importantly ensuring the comfort of residents

near the park and protecting them from noise pollution often associated with recreational activities.

Furthermore, the committee deliberated on land acquisition procedures for public benefit to serve residents.

They also discussed the issue of street vendors within the Muharraq municipality, based on Resolution No. (1) of 2006.

The council believes it is necessary to regulate this activity to ensure public safety and health standards.

## Budget hike key to cities and villages development

The Northern Municipal Council unanimously urged the Municipalities Minister, His Excellency Wael Al Mubarak, yesterday to raise the 2025-2026 budget for the Cities and Villages Development Project, citing urgent needs to improve citizens' living standards amid rising demands and a growing backlog of maintenance requests.

Chairman of the Services and Public Utilities Committee, Abdullah Sherida, noted that the current budget for the project is not enough.

He explained that emergency cases, such as fires, are funded from the same budget due to the lack of a dedicated allocation.

This situation leads to longer wait times for requests and a growing backlog at the council, making it impossible to seek an increase in the approved annual budget.

Additionally, it limits the completion of routine maintenance requests included in the annual plan.

Sherida provided numbers on the Cities and Villages Development Project requests, stating there are 3,599 maintenance requests, some dating back to 2007.

Of these, 2,924 meet the criteria, with 1,080 completed, 12 currently in progress, and 1,832 still pending.

## Council seeks larger budget amid funding gaps

Facing expenses that other councils have covered by the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, the Northern Municipal Council has supported Zaina Jassim's call for a larger budget.

Unlike other councils, the Northern Municipality must manage its upkeep, security, and gardening costs independently, and Jassim's proposal aims to align the budget with the council's actual needs and income.

During the council's meeting yesterday, Jassim and the Financial and Legal Committee outlined several recommendations to address these funding challenges.

They proposed increasing the Northern Municipality's budget to reflect both its income and the support given to other councils, ensuring a fairer allocation of resources.

The committee also stressed the importance of Ministry-led shared contracts for common services across all councils.

This would stabilise service standards, with the Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture overseeing essential functions like rainwater drainage and the upkeep of green spaces, thereby alleviating some financial strain on the Northern Municipality.

Jassim highlighted that reduced funding has already led to significant cuts in key ser-

vices, including rubbish collection, sewage management, security, tree planting, and street cleaning.

She warned that this drop in service quality has harmed both the local community's experience and the council's reputation.

The committee further noted the need for adequate staffing levels, as current manpower falls short of the demands posed by the municipality's large population and extensive service area.

Fellow council member Abdullah Al Qubaisi echoed these concerns, pointing out that the Northern Governorate, given its size, should not be expected to operate on a budget similar to smaller regions.

## Push for return of Budaiya Vet Clinic with small service fee

Councillors are rallying to reopen the Budaiya veterinary clinic with a new plan to charge a small service fee, which many see as a lifeline for local farms and a boost for Bahrain's food security.

The reworked proposal aims to breathe life back into an earlier idea that had faced some resistance.

The original plan, proposed by Council member Mohammed Saad Al Doseri in a previous session, sought to reopen the only free veterinary clinic on Budaiya Highway, which closed in 2017.

Since the free clinic closed, livestock owners, like pet owners, have turned to private veterinary clinics, which they say are costly.

After discussions between the Northern Municipal Council and livestock breeders, Northern Municipal Council Vice Chairperson Zainah Jassim Ali resubmitted the plan, this time with a small fee, as requested by the breeders.

The move is intended to keep food supplies steady and support livestock farming in the long run. It has now been forwarded to the Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture for the next steps.

"Adding the small fee is meant

to help with high costs and limited access to key medicines," Al Doseri told The Daily Tribune. "Private pharmacies hold a monopoly on certain drugs, which has driven up prices and made it difficult for livestock owners to obtain essential medicines. By reopening this clinic,

we're not only addressing these monopolistic challenges but also ensuring that emergency treatment is available when it's needed most."

Supported by the Financial and Legal Committee, the plan was reviewed earlier this month.

It aims to expand public services, bring in government funds, and provide essential care for animals.

The clinic would also offer regular check-ups and advice on breeding, ensuring steady support for livestock owners through the Veterinary Health Centre.

The reopened clinic could make livestock care affordable and accessible, addressing the current shortage of veterinary services while securing Bahrain's food supply.

In response to concerns that the fees might discourage livestock owners from obtaining vaccinations, Zainah Jassim told The Daily Tribune, "The revised plan follows the breeders' own requests and reflects their wishes. Our goal is to preserve animal health and, by extension, Bahrain's food security, ensuring access to quality care without prohibitive costs."

company employees, and professional investors.

Earlier reports said the initial share sale includes 2,582,226,338 shares, representing 25% of the company's total issued shares, and is being sold by its shareholder, LuLu International Holdings Ltd.

Additionally, LuLu Retail has secured cornerstone investments from Bahrain Mumtalaq Holding Company, the Abu Dhabi Pension Fund, Oman Investment Authority, and the Emirates International Investment Company. Cornerstone investors commit to purchasing shares before the listing takes place.

## Spanish PM in India seeking to bolster trade ties

Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez was welcomed to India Monday with a flower-filled open-top parade alongside counterpart Narendra Modi, as Madrid seeks to boost investment in the world's fifth-largest economy.

The duo waved to crowds in a vehicle smothered in orange marigold garlands on their way to inaugurate a military aircraft factory, a collaboration between Tata Advanced Systems and Airbus, in Vadodra in Gujarat state. It is the first visit by a Spanish premier to India for 18 years, with co-operation agreements signed including on infrastructure, railways and renewable energy projects.

India's defence ministry agreed to a \$2.5 billion deal for 56 cargo and troop-carry-

ing C295 aircraft from Airbus Defence and Space in 2021.

While 16 will be assembled in Seville in Spain -- with the first deliveries made last year -- the 40 remaining will be built in India. The Indian plant in Vadodra will complete the first "Made in India" C295 aircraft in 2026.

"This factory will not only strengthen India-Spain relations, but also the 'Make in India and Made for the World' mission," Modi said at the inauguration. "It also reinforces India's position as a trusted partner in global aerospace manufacturing." Sanchez said Airbus had opened a new chapter in India's defence and space industry. "This project strengthens our industrial ties while underlying our country's deep commitment as a reliable and strategic partner," he said, speaking in English.

◆ **The once luxurious** palace of Bangladesh's autocratic ex-leader Sheikh Hasina will become a museum to honour the revolution that ousted her, the leader of the caretaker government said yesterday. "The museum should preserve memories of her misrule and the people's anger when they removed her from power," Nobel Peace Prize winner Muhammad Yunus said as he toured the battered Ganabhaban palace, the former official residence of the prime minister. The 84-year-old microfinance pioneer was appointed the country's "chief advisor" after the student-led uprising that forced Hasina to flee by helicopter to India on August 5. Hasina's 15-year rule saw widespread human rights abuses, including the mass detention and extrajudicial killings of her political opponents, and a Bangladesh court this month issued an arrest warrant for her arrest.



Bangladesh ex-PM palace to become revolution museum

◆ **NATO chief Mark Rutte** yesterday decried the deployment of North Korean troops to bolster Russia's war effort in Ukraine as a dangerous expansion of the conflict that signalled President Vladimir Putin's "growing desperation". Speaking in Brussels after a briefing with South Korean intelligence officials, Rutte said he could confirm that North Korean military units had been sent to Russia's western Kursk region. "The deepening military cooperation between Russia and North Korea is a threat to both the Indo-Pacific and Euro-Atlantic security," Rutte told a press conference. "The deployment (of) North Korean troops to Kursk is also a sign of Putin's growing desperation."

◆ **North Korea has sent** some 10,000 troops to train in Russia, the Pentagon said yesterday, raising Washington's previous estimate of 3,000 from last week. "We believe that the DPRK has sent around 10,000 soldiers in total to train in eastern Russia that will probably augment Russian forces near Ukraine over the next several weeks," Deputy Pentagon Press Secretary Sabrina Singh told journalists, using an abbreviation for North Korea's official name.

◆ **A manhunt was under way** in northern Austria Monday for an "extremely dangerous" gunman suspected of killing a local mayor and another person, authorities said. Police discovered the body of a man in a meadow in the village of Altenfelden in the Upper Austria province early on Monday. Local officials later identified the victim as the mayor of the nearby town of Kirchberg ob der Donau, adding that "a dispute over hunting rights" was likely behind the shooting.

Suit filed in Pennsylvania to halt Musk's \$1 mn giveaways

Philadelphia's chief prosecutor sued billionaire Elon Musk and his pro-Trump political action committee on Monday to halt his \$1 million giveaways to registered voters. The lawsuit against the SpaceX and Tesla CEO's America PAC was filed in a Pennsylvania state court by district attorney Larry Krasner, a Democrat. "The Philadelphia district attorney is charged with protecting the public from public nuisances and unfair trade practices, including illegal lotteries," Krasner said in a statement. "The DA is also charged with protecting the public from interference with the integrity of elections," he said. Last week, the Justice Department sent a letter to Musk's America PAC warning that its \$1 million giveaways may violate federal law, which prohibits paying people to register to vote.

Musk, 53, who also owns X, formerly Twitter, has thrown his millions, time and considerable influence into backing Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump since endorsing him in July. Musk has reportedly donated \$118 million to his personal pro-Trump political action committee, an organization which collects funds for elections. He's also appeared on stage with Trump at a campaign rally in Pennsylvania and hosted a series of town halls on his own in the battleground state, seen as critical in the November election. Musk, who previously supported Barack Obama but has become increasingly conservative in recent years, peppers his 202 million followers on X daily with messages championing Trump and denigrating his opponent, Democratic Vice President Kamala Harris.

Israel launches fresh strikes on Tyre after 7 killed in earlier raid

Israel launched fresh strikes yesterday on Tyre, Lebanese state media said, after the Israeli military told swathes of the southern city to evacuate and following an earlier raid that killed seven people.

The National News Agency (NNA) reported "a series of strikes" on the ancient coastal city, beginning with a raid on a residential apartment. An AFP video journalist reported thick clouds of smoke covering parts of Tyre, including rising from a building along the

seafront. The Israeli army had earlier told residents in parts of central Tyre to leave immediately, warning it would attack Hezbollah targets there. "Hezbollah's activities force the (Israeli military) to act against it forcefully," military spokesman Avichay Adrae said in a post

on X, urging residents to "head north". An accompanying map showed large swathes of the city marked in red, including an area abutting a UNESCO World Heritage site. The union of Tyre municipalities received a phone call in Arabic, apparently from the Israeli

military, urging residents to evacuate several streets in the area, a municipal source told AFP. The NNA said the union instructed the civil defence and emergency personnel to use loudspeakers to urge residents to leave, "which created a state of panic".

Iran foreign ministry vows to 'respond firmly' to Israeli strikes

Iranian foreign ministry spokesman Esmaeli Baghaei said yesterday that Tehran would "respond firmly and effectively" to deadly Israeli strikes on military sites over the weekend.

"We are using all available means to respond firmly and effectively to the aggression of the Zionist regime," Baghaei told a regular news conference. "The nature of our response will depend on the nature of the attack."

Middle East aid workers say rules of war being flouted

Flagrant violations of the laws of war in the escalating conflict in the Middle East are setting a dangerous precedent, aid workers in the region warn. Since Hamas's deadly October 7 attack on Israel from Gaza last year, humanitarians say the warring parties are flouting international humanitarian law (IHL). "The rules of war are being

broken in such a flagrant way... (it) is setting a precedent that we have not seen in any other conflict," Marwan Jilani, the vice president of the Palestine Red Crescent (PCRS), told AFP. Speaking last week during a meeting in Geneva of the 191 national Red Cross and Red Crescent societies, he lamented a "total disregard for human life (and) for international humanitarian law".

X suspends new account posting on behalf of Iran leader Khamenei

The social media network X yesterday suspended an account that published Hebrew-language messages on behalf of Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, just days after it was opened. The account had a short notice reading "X suspends accounts which violate the X Rules," though the Elon Musk-owned platform did not specify which rule had been violated. Khamenei's office runs several social network accounts in his name, broadcasting messages in different languages. The Hebrew-language account had launched on the weekend with a message that is a common greeting in the Islamic world: "In the name of Allah, the Benevolent, the Most Merciful."

Iron Dome offers short-range protection against missiles and rockets, such as projectiles fired from Gaza and Lebanon.

Trump, Harris enter final week of tense US election

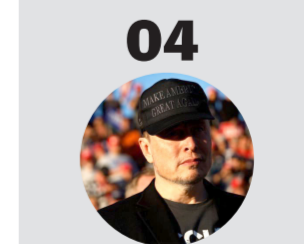

Kamala Harris crosses Michigan on Monday while Donald Trump heads to Georgia -- another of the decisive swing states in one of the closest US elections in history -- after presiding over a dark mega-rally aimed at whipping up his right-wing base. With only a week until November 5 Election Day, early voting has already seen more than 41 million Americans cast ballots -- joined by outgoing Democratic President Joe Biden on Monday, who will vote in his hometown Wilmington, Delaware. Tensions are soaring in a race that polls show too close to call, fueled by fears that Trump will again refuse to recognize a defeat, as he did in 2020. The Republican continues to claim he was cheated, and his rhetoric has become increasingly infused with violence and threats. Outrage erupted across the political spectrum when one of the warm-up speakers at Trump's Sunday rally in New York's Madison Square Garden likened majority-Hispanic Puerto Rico to a "floating island of garbage". The Trump campaign went into a rare bit of damage control, saying this "does not reflect the

views of President Trump." However, comedian Tony Hincheliffe was unrepentant, writing on social media that his critics "have no sense of humor" -- a comment reposted by Trump's son and advisor Don Trump Jr. Harris, 60, called Trump "increasingly unstable and unhinged" in an interview with CBS News and goaded the 78-year-old to undergo a cognitive test, saying she would "take the same one." As the clock ticks down, the challenge for Harris and Trump is both to energize core supporters and pull in the tiny number of persuadable voters who might still tip the balance -- especially in the seven swing states where polls show them running neck-and-neck. Harris, who spent Sunday in must-win Pennsylvania, will hold three events in Michigan, while Trump will hold two in Georgia -- a pattern set to be repeated around the country's other battlegrounds for the next seven days. On Tuesday in Washington, Harris will deliver what her campaign calls a "closing argument," in a nod to her career as a federal prosecutor. The Democrat will speak from the same spot on the Mall near the White House where then president Trump stoked his supporters on January 6, 2021, to launch a violent assault on Congress in an attempt to stop certification of his reelection loss to Biden. Trump -- the oldest presidential nominee ever and also the

most convicted of crimes -- was packed at Madison Square Garden for his own closing pitch on Sunday. Former US President and Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump and his wife Melania Trump

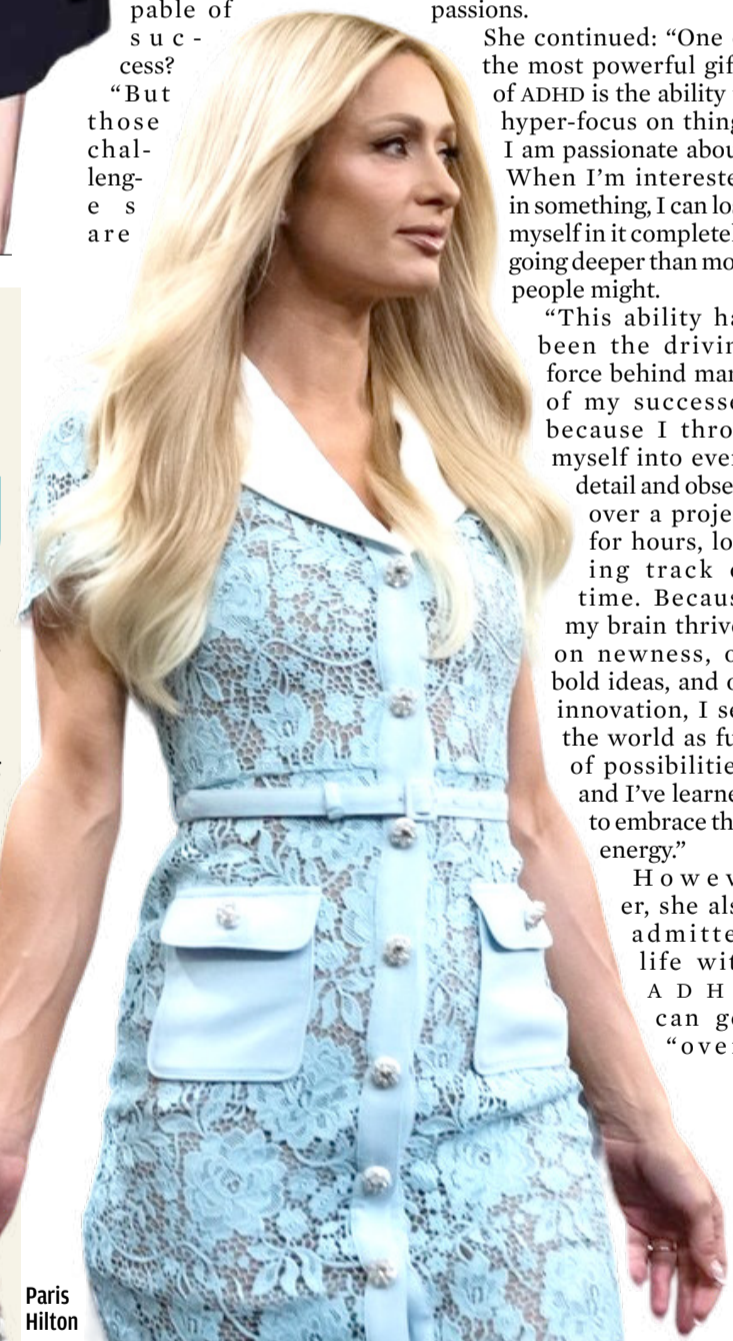

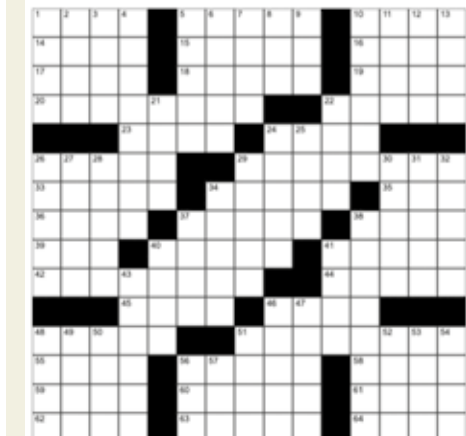

# Man United sack Ten Hag

Dutch boss pays price for disastrous start to season, Van Nistelrooy takes interim reins

● **Ten Hag sacked after winning only one of last eight games**

● **Southgate and Xavi among potential replacements**

Manchester United sacked manager Erik ten Hag yesterday after a disastrous start to the season with former Red Devils striker Ruud van Nistelrooy named interim boss.

United dropped to a lowly 14th in the table after suffering their fourth defeat in nine league games at West Ham on Sunday and have won only one of their last eight games in all competitions.

They are also 21st of 36 teams in the Europa League table, having drawn their three opening

fixtures. "Erik ten Hag has left his role as Manchester United men's first-team manager," said a club statement.

"Erik was appointed in April 2022 and led the club to two

domestic trophies, winning the Carabao (League) Cup in 2023 and the FA Cup in 2024. We are grateful to Erik for everything he has done during his time with us and wish him well for the future."

United added Van Nistelrooy, who returned to the club as Ten Hag's assistant in July, would now serve as interim manager while they went in search of a new full-time boss.

Ten Hag's position had been repeatedly called into question after United co-owner Jim Ratcliffe kept him on board after an internal review at the end of last season when the club finished eighth in the Premier League.

The 54-year-old was even rewarded with a one-year extension of his contract to June 2026 after a shock FA Cup final victory over rivals Manchester City in May.

Former Ajax boss Ten Hag, who joined United in May 2022, had fiercely defended his record in recent weeks after winning two trophies in his two full seasons in charge.

United ended a six-year wait for silverware by beating Newcastle in the 2023 League Cup

final.

The Red Devils also reached the FA Cup final and finished third in the Premier League in an encouraging debut season for Ten Hag.

However, the wheels came off in his second season as injuries to key players, the lack of a meaningful impact from big money signings and Ten Hag's failure to implement a clear style of play led to a number of embarrassing results.

## Real Madrid boycott Ballon d'Or over perceived Vinicius snub: club

Real Madrid said they will stay away from the Ballon d'Or ceremony in Paris on Monday as they are convinced that their striker Vinicius, the favourite to win the men's award, has been snubbed.

The club told AFP it questioned the methods behind the

selection of the Ballon d'Or winner, saying that defender Dani Carvajal, another of the 30 players nominated, had also been unfairly overlooked.

"If the award criteria doesn't give it to Vinicius as the winner, then those same criteria should point to Carvajal as the winner," the club told AFP.

"As this was not the case, it

is clear that Ballon d'Or-UEFA does not respect Real Madrid. And Real Madrid does not go where it is not respected."

The Ballon d'Or organisers decided to innovate this year by keeping the winner's identity a secret until the very end, to avoid any leaks to the press.

In previous years, the winner was revealed a few days before

the award ceremony.

All the nominees were invited to the ceremony in Paris this evening.

The absence of the Real players and the club's declaration suggest that neither Vinicius, Carvajal nor Jude Bellingham, the architects of the club's European triumph, will win the trophy.

The stewards took a dim view of Verstappen's aggressive driving, the Red Bull driver twice forcing his title rival Norris off the track.

Norris grabbed second from Charles Leclerc in the other Ferrari near the finish as the Briton enjoyed a major boost in his quest to deny Verstappen a fourth consecutive world championship.

The McLaren driver cut 10 points off the gap to Verstappen which now stands at 47 with four race weekends remaining.

Verstappen paid a heavy price for his show of ruthlessness with Norris commenting: "I knew what to expect from

Max. I respect him a lot as a driver and I expected it but it was not very clean driving in my opinion.

"It was a very tough race and I spent a lot of it just trying to avoid crashes."

It was the second week in succession that the two title-chasers had clashed following a penalty for Norris at the United States Grand Prix.

McLaren boss Zak Brown described this latest example of Verstappen's aggressive streak as "ridiculous".

# Porsche on top ahead of WEC finale

Porsche leads manufacturers' championship with 161 points ahead of Bahrain season finale

● **Toyota trails closely, just 10 points behind**

● **Ferrari holds third after Le Mans victory**

● **Jota clinches privateer title with Porsche**

With just a few days to go before the start of the 8 Hours of Bahrain, the final round of the World Endurance Championship, let's take a look at the championship-leading teams before the final round.

Porsche leads the manufacturers' championship with 161 points after their cars won three races: Qatar, Belgium, and America, and finished second in Italy and Brazil. It's worth noting that Porsche has been in the top five in every round of the season so

far. Toyota is in second place with 151 points, after winning three races: Italy, Brazil, and America, finishing second at Le Mans, and third in Qatar.

In third place is Ferrari with 134 points: after winning the

24 Hours of Le Mans and finishing second in both Belgium and America. The French Alpine team is in fourth place with 52 points, with their best result being a third-place finish in the 6 Hours of Fuji, Japan. BMW is in fifth place with 49 points, with

their best result being second in Japan.

Peugeot is in sixth place with only 34 points, their best result being fourth place in Japan. Although they have not achieved a win or a podium finish, it is to their credit that at least one

of their cars has finished in the points in all races of the season, except for the Qatar round which they finished outside the points. It is worth noting that the team is considering introducing an update package for its 9X8 car next season.

Cadillac is in seventh place with 30 points, with their best result being a third-place finish in America. Lamborghini is in eighth place with only 11 points, as the team's cars have finished in the points in only three rounds. In ninth place is the Italian team Isotta Fraschini, which has not managed to score any points and has announced its withdrawal from the championship after the fifth round.

In the privateer championship, the British team Jota, with the #12 Porsche 963, clinched the privateer championship, scoring 165 points, and winning its class in four rounds: Qatar, Belgium, Le Mans, and Japan. They are followed by the Italian team AF Corse with the #83 Ferrari 499P, with 122 points, after

winning their class in Italy and America.

Proton Competition is in third place, competing with the #99 Porsche 963, with 116 points, having reached the podium in six races in its class. The second Jota car, the #38 Porsche 963, is in fourth place with 115 points, after winning in Brazil and finishing second in four other rounds in its class.

### From Underdogs to Champions

Bahrain's history in the Gulf Cup is a tale of perseverance and ultimate success. For decades, the small island nation competed valiantly but fell short of claiming the coveted trophy.

Their journey in the tournament has been marked by four runner-up finishes (1970, 1982, 1992, 2003-04), three third-place finishes (1990, 1994, 2004),

and five fourth-place finishes (1976, 1979, 1988, 2002, 2013).

The turning point came in the 24th edition of the Gulf Cup in 2019. In a dramatic final against Saudi Arabia, Bahrain secured a 1-0 win thanks to a goal from Mohammed Al Rumaihi in the 69th minute. This historic win ended Bahrain's 49-year wait for the title and sparked nationwide celebrations

### One for the books

Bahrain's journey to their first Gulf Cup title in 2019 was nothing

short of remarkable. They overcame a 0-2 defeat against Saudi Arabia in the group stage, secured a frantic 4-2 win against Kuwait, won a nail-biting semi-final against Iraq in a penalty shoot-out (5-3) after a 2-2 draw, and clinched the title with a 1-0 win over Saudi Arabia in the final.

The victory parade from Bahrain International Airport to the Bahrain International Circuit saw tens of thousands of fans celebrating this historic achievement.
