

### **Bahrain warns** citizens against Lebanon travel



### Damascus

he Embassy of the Kingdom of Bahrain in the Syrian Arab Republic underscored the importance of adhering to previous warnings issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to Bahraini citizens against traveling to the Lebanese Republic due to the current security situation and potential risks.

The embassy urges any Bahraini citizens in Lebanon to evacuate immediately for their safety. It stressed the need to exercise caution and comply with the instructions issued by the relevant local authorities until their departure.

### **US pledges new** \$1.7bln military aid to Ukraine AFP | Washington

The United States yes-L terday announced new military aid for Ukraine valued at around \$1.7 billion that features air defense munitions and artillery rounds that Kyiv's forces say they desperately need.

The aid includes \$200 million in equipment that will be drawn from existing US military stocks and will reach the battlefield quickly, as well as about \$1.5 billion in new orders that will take longer to arrive, the Defense Department said in a statement.





### Iran's new president warns Israel against attacking Lebanon Tehran, Iran

Tran's new President Ma-soud Pezeshkian yesterday warned Israel against attacking Lebanon as tensions soar over a deadly rocket strike in the Israeli-annexed Golan Heights blamed on Tehran-backed Hezbollah.

"The Zionist regime (Israel) will make a great mistake with heavy consequences if it attacks Lebanon," Pezeshkian said during a call with French President Emmanuel Macron, according to the Iranian president's website. Pezeshkian assumed official responsibilities on Sunday after official endorsement from supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamanei, and is to be sworn in to parliament on Tuesday. The Islamic republic has hailed Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel that sparked the Gaza war but denied any involvement.





The 38-year-old pop star sang 'Mon Truc En Plumes' on a set of stairs along the Seine River in Paris - but Maud le Pladec, the choreographer of all Olympics and Paralympics opening ceremonies, has now revealed that the performance was actually pre-recorded.

Speaking to Variety, Maud explained: "Unfortunately, it was the only [performance] that, for safety reasons, we had to pre-record late in the afternoon, once we knew for sure that it was going to rain - we had minute-by-minute updates, we had never watched the weather forecast so Lady Gaga during her performance closely in our lives.






