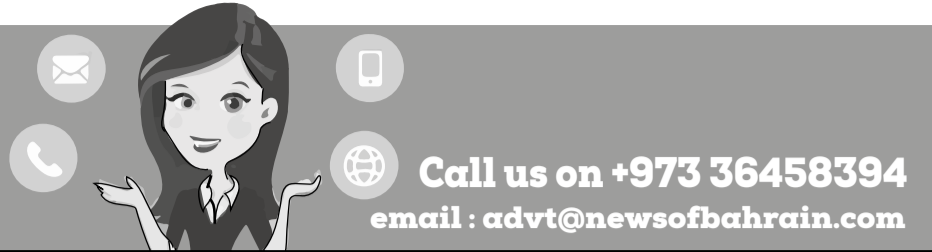

## Martin wins Thai MotoGP thriller with Bagnaia promoted to second

Spain's Jorge Martin won a thrilling Thailand MotoGP race yesterday to close the gap on Francesco Bagnaia to 13 points in the world championship, with three legs of the season to go.

Italy's Bagnaia crossed the line third, behind Brad Binder, but was awarded second place after the South African was penalised one position for exceeding track limits on the final lap.

The trio had been involved in a titanic tussle over the closing laps with the lead changing hands before pole-sitter Martin, on a Pramac-Ducati, pipped his rivals and celebrated wildly as he crossed the line.

"I'm so happy. This feeling is amazing because today I wasn't better than them," said Martin.

The Spaniard managed the race masterfully from pole position, conserving his tyres to leave him with enough grip to withstand the late onslaught

from the fast-finishing KTM rider Binder and factory-Ducati pilot Bagnaia.

Bagnaia, attempting to defend his world title, came into the weekend with a 27-point cushion in the championship but saw that slashed by Martin, who also won Saturday's sprint at the Buriram International Circuit.

## Hidd defeat East Riffa in football league

● Al Najma salvage late draw against Sitra with 90th minute equaliser

Hidd claimed a come-from-behind 3-1 victory over East Riffa last night in their week five match of the 2023/2024 Nasser bin Hamad Bahrain Premier Football League.

After East Riffa's Ahmed Kory opened the scoring in the contest, Hidd replied emphatically with goals from Kamil Al Azm, Mohammed Fares and Jacques Medina Iemopele.

Kory fired in East Riffa's lone goal in the 60th minute off a pass across the penalty area from Vincent Emmanuel Ani. Kory sent the ball into the net with his first touch.

Their lead was short-lived, however, as Hidd equalised just four minutes later through

Al Azm. His first attempt was blocked, but he had a second shot that found its way into the net through a crowd.

Hidd then went ahead in the 70th minute, when Fares sent in a cross from the left wing and the ball was helped into goal by East Riffa's Fares Ahmed.

Iemopele then ensured Hidd their three points with a fine solo effort in the 93rd minute, scoring from close range.

With the result, Hidd claimed their second win of the new season and improved to six points after five games. East Riffa were handed their second loss and

remained on nine points.

Meanwhile, in last night's other fixture, Sitra and Al Najma played to a 1-1 stalemate.

Sitra took the lead after Ali Abdulrasool Al Asfour was taken down in the box. Abdulwasi Al Matari stepped up to take the penalty, and he made no mistake with his shot, sending it into the top-left corner of goal in the 29th minute past Najma goalkeeper Ashraf Waheed

But Najma were able to equalise in the 90th minute when Edimar Ribeiro Da Costa Junior sent in a free-kick from several metres outside the area that was deflected into goal.

Sitra improved to three points with their third draw of the new campaign, while Najma went to 11 points with their second draw in five matches.

League play continues tonight with Manama taking on defending champions Al Khaldiya, and Busatteen playing Al Ahli. Both games are scheduled for 7pm kick-offs.

## Haaland scores twice as Man City cruise past Man Utd

Erling Haaland scored twice as Manchester City inflicted more pain on Manchester United with a 3-0 win at Old Trafford to close within two points of Premier League leaders Tottenham.

Haaland slotted home from the penalty spot midway through the first half and headed in a second just after half-time before setting up Phil Foden for City's third.

City began the match outside the top four after an indifferent

start to their title defence.

But Pep Guardiola's men remain the favourites for an undefeated fourth consecutive English top-flight title and showed they are a class apart from their local rivals as they moved up to third.

A fifth defeat in 10 league games this season leaves United down in eighth, 11 points off the top.

United great Bobby Charlton was again remembered before kick-off as legends from

both clubs that played with and against the 1966 World Cup winner were welcomed onto the pitch before a minute's applause.

But hostilities were restored once the action got underway.

After a miserable start to the season, United had won their previous three games but in unconvincing fashion against Brentford, Sheffield United and FC Copenhagen.

This was the real test of any renaissance by Erik ten Hag's men and they were found wanting despite City taking 45 minutes to hit their stride.

## Ferrari's Leclerc grabs surprise pole for Mexico Grand Prix

Surprised Charles Leclerc admitted he did not expect his success on Saturday after he secured pole position ahead of team-mate Carlos Sainz as Ferrari locked out the front row for yesterday's Mexico Grand Prix.

In a chaotic and confusing qualifying session that seemed set to see Max Verstappen on pole again, Ferrari emerged in Q3 with a surge of pace that surprised almost everyone.

The Monegasque clocked a best lap in one minute and 17.166 seconds to beat the Spaniard by 0.067 seconds, leaving newly-crowned three-time world champion Verstappen third for Red Bull.

"But once we put everything together it all went well. The new tyres gained a lot, but I am

already focusing on tomorrow's race. We may have pole position, but now we need to convert it into a win and obviously it is going to be very difficult."

Sainz admitted: "It was a strange one. This whole weekend I've struggled to put a lap together then the first lap I put together in Q3 was P1 and suddenly Charles beat me by half a tenth, one tenth..."

"I'm just struggling to understand where we can find half a second -- and then we go half a second slower in the next lap. It's very tricky with the tyres.

"The feeling with the car is very strange around this circuit, but we managed to put a good lap in when it counted," he added.
