

Absolutely, let's integrate the additional information into a continuous narrative without using numbers:

Personal growth involves letting go of the past and moving forward. This process can be challenging, requiring intentional commitment, the thoughtful processing of emotions, and the adoption of positive practices such as affirmations, mindfulness, meditation, and radical acceptance. Emphasizing that letting go is a gradual process of moving through, not just letting go, the article underscores the importance of patience and resilience.

Further elaborating on these strategies, positive affirmations become powerful reminders of one's commitment to change, actively challenging negative thought patterns. Incorporating meditation and visualization techniques into daily routines breaks the chain of holding on, actively imagining a future free from the constraints of the past. Exploring inner child and shadow work unveils hidden aspects of the psyche, contributing significantly to personal growth. Rediscovering passions and interests becomes a powerful way to reconnect with one's authentic self, reinforcing a sense of identity and purpose in the present.

# **COP28** president denies using climate talks to push oil deals

AFP | Dubai, United Arab Emir-

he Emirati host of the UN climate conference in Dubai denied yesterday reports that he used his presidency of the crucial talks on global warming to pursue fossil fuels deals.

The allegations against Sultan Al Jaber, who is also CEO of his country's oil giant ADNOC, have fanned long-running suspicions over the wisdom of a petrostate hosting the COP28 talks.

But Jaber, who also chairs a UAE-owned clean energy company, strongly denied reports that he used his position as COP president to pitch new oil and gas investments to governments.

"These allegations are false, not true, incorrect and not accurate," Jaber told reporters on the eve of the talks, which will draw world leaders and tens of thousands of delegates to Dubai over the next two weeks.

 Russia lost out yesterday in its bid for re-election to the decision-making body of the OPCW chemical watchdog, as Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky cheered Moscow's "isolation" on the world stage. Four Eastern European countries were competing for three seats on the OPCW Executive Council. warring neighbours Russia and Ukraine, plus Poland and Lithuania. Russia received the fewest votes, meaning it has no seat on the board for the first time in the organisation's history. "OPCW is a very reputable

international body and terrorists have no place in it," said Zelensky on X, formerly Twitter. He said Russia's exclusion from the global body's council was a "logical result" of its aggression against his country. "Its role in international affairs keeps diminishing and its isolation keeps growing," concluded Ukraine's president.

"Troops, supported by aviation and artillery fire, improved their positions along the front line and liberated the village of Artemovskoye," Russia's defence ministry said in a daily briefing, referring to the village by a previous version of its name. According to satellite images, the village of Khromove, located on the western edge of Bakhmut, consisted of a

few streets and several dozen houses before the Russian offensive. Russian Defence Minister Sergei Shoigu had said the capture of Bakhmut would open up the battlefield and allow Moscow's troops to mount further significant advances.

### 'The Hump': India honours US airmen downed in WWII China airlift

Tndia paid tribute yesterday to the hundreds of US servicemen killed during World War II with the opening of a museum near its strategic border with China honouring the dramatic Himalayan airlift dubbed "The Hump".

Telling the story of how Allied pilots flew the perilous route to supply Chinese forces, it includes 80-year-old rusting wreckage and machine guns of some of the 590 planes that crashed into the jungle hills and jagged mountains of India's northeast Arunachal Pradesh state.

Arunachal Pradesh chief minister Pema Khandu said it showcased "the remnants of aircrafts



Last-gasp Mbappe penalty earns PSG Champions League draw with **Newcastle Paris. France** 

98th-minute Kylian Mbappe penalty earned Paris Saint-Germain a ▲1-1 Champions League draw with Newcastle United on Tuesday that keeps the French club in a position to qualify for the last 16 and leaves their opponents in serious danger of a groupstage exit.

It looked as though Newcastle -- who won 4-1 when the sides met at St James' Park last month -- were going to leave Paris with all three points in the Group F encounter thanks to Alexander Isak's 25th-minute opener.

PSG had run out of ideas by the time they were gifted an opportunity to salvage a draw in injury time when the VAR decided a Tino Livramento handball in the box was worthy of a penalty.

Mbappe made no mistake, and PSG hold onto second place in the group behind Borussia Dortmund, who won 3-1 away to AC Milan and are through to the last 16.

The French champions will join them with a win in Dortmund in their final group game, while Newcastle now have to win at home to Milan and hope PSG slip up.
