Brace for cold wave and strong winds in new year

A cold wave will hit Bahrain as the new year begins, driven by a high-pressure system bringing north-westerly winds and a cold air mass starting tomorrow evening.

This was announced by the Meteorological Directorate at the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications.

Wind speeds are expected to strengthen on New Year's Day, with north-westerly winds persisting across the Kingdom until early the following week.

These conditions will generate dust and raise sea wave heights to up to 6 feet.

Daytime temperatures are forecasted to hover around 20°C, while nighttime lows could drop to 12°C.

However, strong winds will make temperatures feel even colder.

He added that it is part of the NPRA development initiatives approved by the Cabinet.

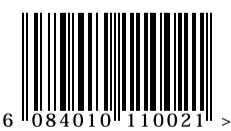
The undersecretary also affirmed that the new service will save time and effort, as beneficiaries could apply via Bahrain.bh.

Strengthening stability

Shura approves \$5 oil deduction for Future Generations Fund

Oil-export deductions for Bahrain's Future Generations Reserve are set to rise to \$5 per barrel, following the Shura Council's approval of a new law yesterday. The move links the deductions to oil prices above \$120, with the aim of shoring up resources for future generations and

strengthening Bahrain's financial stability. Parliament had already approved the bill earlier this month. The legislation amends Article 1 of Law No. 28 of 2006, adjusting the deductions taken from exported oil barrels. **Long-term growth** Khalid Al Maskati, a Shura Council member, explained that

the reserve acts as a sovereign fund designed to ensure long-term growth while allowing the kingdom to respond to crises when needed. "The reserve played a key role during the COVID-19 pandemic, helping the government meet urgent needs," he said, adding that the fund is crucial for protecting the rights of future generations. Under the revised law, deduc-

tions will be tiered: \$1 per barrel for prices above \$40 but below \$60, \$2 per barrel for prices above \$60 but below \$80, \$3 per barrel for prices above \$80, \$4 per barrel for prices above \$100, and \$5 per barrel for prices exceeding \$120.

Legal approval

These deductions are reserved exclusively for the 'Future Generations Reserve', with no adjustments or withdrawals permitted without legal approval. The Shura Council's Financial and Economic Affairs Committee said the reserve has been an essential tool for maintaining Bahrain's financial stability. "It's more than just a fund," a committee member noted. "It's a protection for the future, helping us weather economic storms and ensuring that resources are available

when they're most needed." Abdulla Al Nuaimi, another council member, called for a broader approach to what constitutes a reserve. He suggested that tangible assets, such as land or gold, should be prioritised over cash or liquid investments. "Land has enduring value," he said. "Instead of relying solely on money, we should earmark large plots for future use. These could support housing projects or other essential services without draining government finances." The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee echoed this sentiment, pointing out that such assets could preserve wealth over time while ensuring stability. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the reserve demonstrated its worth by enabling quick responses to national challenges, proving its flexibility in times of uncertainty.

Parliament financial committee approves multinational tax decree

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee of the Parliament approved Decree-Law No. (11) of 2024 on regulating tax on multinational companies during its twelfth meeting yesterday.

The meeting was chaired by MP Ahmed Al Salloom.

Beyond this significant decision, the committee also reviewed Decree-Law No. (10) of 2024, proposing amendments to Decree-Law No. (15) of 1977 regarding the issuance of development bonds.

Draft law

They also considered a draft law concerning tax exemptions for low-income individuals, based on a parliamentary proposal, and another draft law ratifying an agreement to amend the framework agreement for financing the second phase of a water distribution

improvement project from the Al Dur station, connected to Decree No. (68) of 2024.

A proposed law to amend Article 13 of the Commercial Register Decree-Law (Law No. 27 of 2015) was also on the agenda.

The committee's work further included reviewing the audited annual reports and financial statements of the Future Generations Reserve Fund for the fiscal years ending December 31, 2022, and December 31, 2023, both audited by the National Audit Office.

Opinions

The committee addressed requests for opinions from the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee.

They provided their financial opinion on a draft law adding a new article (15 bis) to the Civil Service Law (Decree-Law No. 48 of 2010), as amended by a parliamentary proposal.

Concrete solutions

MP calls for urgent action to stabilise construction material prices in local market

MP Ahmed Al Salloom has confirmed that the Council of Representatives is undertaking oversight to ensure stable prices for concrete and other construction materials in the local market.

Al Salloom revealed plans for a general discussion among MPs to clarify the government's policy on addressing the rising prices.

He emphasised that parliamentary tools are available to directly monitor this crisis with relevant authorities.

Widespread concern

His statements follow a recent and significant shortage of gravel in Bahrain's construction sector, which has driven up prices and caused widespread concern among contractors and real estate developers.

Speaking to our sister newspaper Alayam, Al Salloom, who is the head of the Council of Representatives' Financial and Economic Affairs Committee, attributed the price surge to several factors, including geopolitical situations affecting shipping and exports, and challeng-

es faced by supplying nations.

However, he noted that current supplier indicators suggest the crisis is temporary, with anticipated sufficient quantities for the market within the coming weeks, potentially leading to a partial price decrease.

Al Salloom stressed the need for a thorough study to ensure long-term market stability.

He advocated for collaborative efforts between the legislative and executive branches to develop strategic solutions aimed at bolstering strategic reserves of concrete and construction materials, ensuring their availability at reasonable prices and supporting the real estate and construction sectors.

As head of the Financial and

Economic Affairs Committee, Al Salloom plans an initial meeting with relevant public and private sector entities, suppliers, and contractors to formulate preliminary ideas for immediate price increase mitigation.

Strategic plans

He concluded by stating the need for comprehensive strategic plans to ensure market stability and prevent future crises that could impact the country's urban development.

The price of gravel has soared to over BD110 per ton, resulting in lengthy waiting lists for the essential building material.

Riyadh Al Barmi, a construction and contracting expert, attributed to The Daily Tribune

the shortage to difficulties faced by Bahrain's main supplier in providing the usual quantities.

Meanwhile, industry sources told The Daily Tribune that the recent gravel shortage affecting Bahrain's construction industry is expected to end gradually next month.

Shura Council supports Bapco's major reforms

Refinery upgrades, changes to share ownership, and a plan to preserve part of Bahrain's industrial heritage have been approved by the Shura Council as part of amendments to the Bahrain Petroleum Company's (Bapco) charter.

The changes, outlined in Royal Decree-Law No. (19) of 2023, aim to strengthen Bapco's position on the world stage and reinforce its economic contribution.

Shura Council member Khalid Al Maskati described the move as essential for Bahrain's energy ambitions.

“With these updates, Bapco's Articles of Association have been brought up to date, preparing the company to compete globally while boosting its role in Bahrain's economy,” he said, adding that the amendments also expand the company's scope of activities.

Dr Jihad Al Fadhel called Bapco “the backbone of Bahrain's energy sector” and commended its investment in Bahraini talent.

“The company has placed trust in local professionals, equipping them with the skills needed for the future,” she said.

Plans

Dr Al Fadhel also sought clarity on plans to offer shares on regional and international markets, as well as the possibility of expanding Awali Hospital's medical expertise to other parts of Bahrain.

“I would also like to know how legislative changes to Bapco's Articles of Association might affect its financial position,” she added.

Dr Ibtisam Al Dallal raised further questions about share ownership.

External investment

“The amendments open the door to external investment. What is the rationale behind this, and what percentage of ownership will be permitted for non-government contributors?” she asked, stressing that oil remains the cornerstone of Bahrain's economy.

Responding to these concerns, the Minister of Oil and Environment, His Excellency Dr Mohamed Bin Daina, detailed the company's progress and its impact.

The refinery's capacity is being increased from 265,000 barrels per day to 400,000, with 40,000 barrels sourced locally and the remainder imported from Aramco and other suppliers.

Jobs

“The expansion has created 500 jobs for Bahrainis, all trained to the highest standards to ensure smooth operations at the new facilities,” he said.

Dr Bin Daina explained that all revenue from crude oil, gas, and sales flows directly to the Ministry of Finance.

Tubli Bay, home to migratory birds and fish larvae, will serve as a focal point for the reforestation effort, central to Bahrain’s environmental strategy.

Initiative

His Excellency Dr Mohamed bin Mubarak Bin Daina, Minister of Oil and Environment and Special Envoy for Climate Affairs, described the initiative as a key step towards sustainability and fulfilling Bahrain’s international climate obligations.

He praised its focus on strengthening the Kingdom’s natural ecosystems while addressing global environmental challenges.

The mangroves, known local-

ly as “Qaram” and internationally as *Avicennia marina*, thrive in Bahrain’s coastal waters, particularly around Tubli Bay.

These plants stabilise coastal soil, provide shelter for marine life, and serve as nesting grounds for migratory birds.

Nature reserve

Tubli Bay, protected as a nature reserve since 1995, is recognised under the Ramsar Convention for Wetlands for its ecological significance.

The Bahrain Mangrove Initiative is part of a broader environmental strategy, including renewable energy projects and efforts to achieve carbon neutrality.

Under the guidance of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness

Tangible results

Bahrain at risk of deadly mosquito species: Expert

Khalid Bu Rshaid, a health pest control expert, has warned that Bahrain is at risk of the presence of dangerous mosquito species, including potentially deadly varieties.

He noted that the kingdom is home to approximately four types of these insects, which have become a major concern due to their association with diseases such as dengue fever, Zika virus, and malaria.

This situation necessitates the implementation of effective preventive measures.

Bu Rshaid highlighted that Bahrain has experienced a significant increase in mosquito populations over the past few years, primarily due to the negligence of concerned authorities in taking crucial steps before the rainy season.

Spraying campaigns

He emphasised the need for intensified spraying campaigns in areas where water collects, as this has exacerbated the issue.

The health pest control expert stressed that addressing this problem requires proactive measures ahead of the rainy season, which creates ideal conditions for mosquito breeding due to humidity and stagnant water.

He pointed out that the current rate of mosquito infestation cannot be compared to previous years, particularly noticeable during rainfall.

Strategies

Bu Rshaid underscored the importance of implementing effective strategies to limit the spread of these pests, such as improving drainage systems and eliminating stagnant water to ensure the health and safety of citizens.

He called for immediate spraying of stagnant water in areas like Tubli Bay, Al Lawzi, and Al Buhair, where such water collections are a primary cause of mosquito proliferation.

Additionally, Bu Rshaid

mentioned that favourable climatic conditions, such as rising temperatures and humidity, contribute to the breeding of these mosquito species, increasing the need for community awareness and education programmes on how to reduce associated risks.

Effective solutions

Regarding effective solutions to combat mosquito infestations in homes, Bu Rshaid stated that incense, ultraviolet light traps, and window screens have proven effective in repelling mosquitoes.

He noted, “It is impossible to completely eliminate mosquitoes, but we can reduce their spread. There are two types of mosquitoes: those that breed near damp surfaces and those that arrive from neighbouring countries via winds. We must tackle the mosquitoes that breed locally; otherwise, we will be unable to address the problem of those arriving from across borders.”

Man acquitted of narcotics importation

A Bahraini man has been acquitted of importing narcotics despite a positive drug test and the discovery of drugs in a package addressed to him.

The court instead convicted him on a lesser charge of possession for personal use, sentencing him to three months imprisonment with a three-year suspended sentence due to his lack of prior convictions.

The seized package was con-

fiscated.

The unusual case, detailed by the defendant’s lawyer, Abdulrahman Al Muawda, involved a postal package addressed to the defendant that was suspected of containing cannabis.

Following a warrant from the Public Prosecution, the defendant was apprehended, questioned, and subjected to a urine test.

The test confirmed the presence of cannabis and pregabalin (a psychotropic drug).

The Public Prosecution charged the defendant with importing, possessing, and holding cannabis and pregabalin in 2024 for personal use outside legally permitted circumstances.

However, Al Muawda argued for his client’s acquittal on the import charge, emphasising the defendant’s denial of any involvement in importing the package or prior knowledge of its contents.

The lawyer argued that it’s possible for someone to use an-

other person’s name and information to purchase goods online, and there was no definitive proof linking the defendant to the package’s importation.

“My client wasn’t aware of the shipment and its contents. He was surprised when he received the call requesting him to receive it. His complete lack of knowledge regarding the package’s origin and contents makes his involvement highly improbable,” the lawyer stressed.

B7,000 compensation for worker wrongfully fired after three months

The High Labour Court ruled in favour of a worker who was dismissed from his job after only three months of employment.

The court ordered the cleaning supplies company, the defendant in the case, to pay the plaintiff B7,000 in compensation for the wrongful termination.

The court’s decision, handed down during a public hearing, also included the company’s responsibility for court costs, legal fees, and the issuance of a work experience certificate to the dismissed employee.

Additionally, the court ordered the company to pay

BD53 in wages for three days (August 1-4, 2024), plus compensation for delayed payment at an annual interest rate of 6%, increasing by 1% per month after the sixth month of delay, with a maximum of 12% annually.

According to the plaintiff’s lawyer, Hussain Salem, his client began working for the company on May 1, 2024, under a two-year contract.

After three months, the company terminated his employment without cause.

Lawyer Salem argued that under Article 111 of the labour law, the company was obligated to compensate the worker for the remaining term of the contract.

Egypt tests new extension of the Suez Canal

Egypt has tested a new 10-kilometre (6.2-mile) extension to the Suez Canal as it tries to minimise the impact of currents on shipping and increase the key waterway's capacity.

Two ships used the new extension on Saturday, a statement from the Suez Canal Authority said.

Authority chief Osama Rabie said the development in the canal's southern region will "en-



hance navigational safety and reduce the effects of water and air currents on passing ships".

Vessels navigating the waterway have at times run aground, mostly because of strong winds and sandstorms.

In 2021, giant container ship Ever Given became wedged diagonally in the canal, blocking trade for nearly a week and resulting in delays that cost billions of dollars.

The new extension is set to boost the canal's capacity by six to eight vessels a day, Rabie said, and it will open after new navigational maps are issued.

In 2015, Egypt undertook an \$8-billion expansion to the

waterway, followed by several smaller development projects.

The Suez Canal has long been a vital source of foreign currency for Egypt that has been undergoing its worst ever economic crisis.

According to the International Monetary Fund, revenue from the canal has been slashed by up to 70 percent since last year because of attacks by Yemen's Iran-backed Huthi rebels on shipping in the Red Sea.

Before the attacks pushed companies to change routes, the vital passage accounted for around 10 percent of global maritime trade.

UK to tax private schools in £1.5 bn boost to public education

London, United Kingdom

The UK will end a tax exemption for private schools on Wednesday, the centre-left Labour government has announced, in a move set to raise over £1.5 billion (\$1.9 billion) for public education.

After years of worsening educational inequalities, from January 1, private schools will have to pay 20 percent value added tax on tuition fees, which will be used to fund thousands of new teachers and improve standards in state schools.

"It's time things are done differently", finance minister Rachel Reeves said in a statement on Sunday.

The funding will "go towards our state schools where 94 percent of this country's children are educated", she said. The policy was promised by Labour in its election campaign and officially laid out in its inaugural budget in October.

of passionate participants from across the corporate ladder. The championship trophy was bagged by the reigning champ, Commerce Comrade.

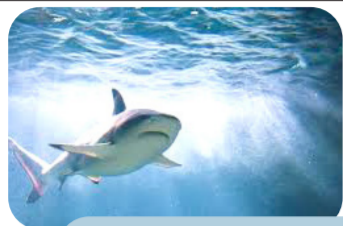

◆ **A shark attack off Egypt's Red Sea** coast killed one tourist and injured another, the country's environment ministry said yesterday. "Two foreigners were attacked by a shark in the northern Marsa Alam area, which led to the injury of one and the death of the other," a ministry statement said. The Egyptian government did not identify the victims' nationalities. Both tourists were moved to hospital in Port Ghalib, around 50 kilometres (30 miles) north of Marsa Alam, the environment ministry said. Authorities have closed the area to swimmers for two days following the incident, which the ministry said occurred in "deep waters outside the designated swimming area". The Red Sea is a major tourist destination whose marine life make it popular with divers. It is also a key employer and source of foreign currency for Egypt, a country of 107 million people trying to navigate out of its worst ever economic crisis.

◆ **Syria's new authorities** have arrested nearly 300 people, including informants, pro-regime fighters and former soldiers, in a crackdown on loyalists to ousted former president Bashar al-Assad, a monitor said Sunday. The security forces of the new administration launched a large-scale operation on Thursday against Assad's militias. "In less than a week, nearly 300 people have been detained in Damascus and its suburbs, as well as in Homs, Hama, Tartus, Latakia and even Deir Ezzor," said Rami Abdel Rahman, head of the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights war monitor. The official Syrian news agency SANA, also reported arrests this week targeting "Assad militia members" in Hama and Latakia provinces, where weapons and ammunition were seized. It did not provide any figures.

◆ **Qatar's prime minister** met a Hamas delegation in Doha on Saturday to discuss a "clear and comprehensive" ceasefire deal to end the war in Gaza, a statement said. Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al-Thani held talks with a Hamas team led by senior official Khalil al-Hayya, the foreign ministry statement said. It is unusual for Sheikh Mohammed, who is also Qatar's foreign minister, to be publicly involved in the mediation process that has appeared deadlocked for months. "During the meeting, the latest developments in the Gaza ceasefire negotiations were reviewed, and ways to advance the process were discussed to ensure a clear and comprehensive agreement that brings an end to the ongoing war in the region," the statement said. Earlier this month, the sheikh expressed optimism that "momentum" was returning to the talks following Donald Trump's election victory in the United States.

Trump sides with Musk in right-wing row over worker visas

Washington, United States

Donald Trump weighed in Saturday in a bitter debate dividing his traditional supporters and tech barons like Elon Musk, saying that he backs a special visa program that helps highly skilled workers enter the country.



"I've always liked the (H1-B) visas, I have always been in favor of the visas, that's why we have them" at Trump-owned facilities, the president-elect told the New York Post in his first public comments on the matter since it flared up this week.

An angry back-and-forth, largely between Silicon Valley's Musk and traditional anti-immigration Trump backers, has erupted in fiery fashion, with Musk even vowing to "go to war" over the issue.

Trump's insistent calls for sharp curbs on immigration were central to his election victory in November over President Joe Biden. Trump has vowed to deport all undocumented immigrants and limit legal immigration.

But tech entrepreneurs like Tesla's Musk -- as well as Vivek Ramaswamy, who is set to join Musk in co-chairing a government cost-cutting panel -- say the United States produces too few highly skilled graduates, and they fervently champion the H1-B program.

Musk, who migrated from South Africa on an H1-B, posted Thursday on his X platform that luring elite engineering talent from abroad was "essential for America to keep winning."

Adding acrimony to the debate was a post from Ramaswamy, the son of immigrants from India, who deplored an "American culture" that he said venerates mediocrity, adding that the United States risks having "our asses handed to us by China."

That angered several prominent conservatives who were backing Trump long before Musk noisily joined their cause this year, going on to pump more than \$250 million into the Republican's campaign.

"Looking forward to the inevitable divorce between President Trump and Big Tech," said Laura Loomer, a far-right MAGA figure known for her conspiracy theories, who often flew with Trump on his campaign plane.

"We have to protect President Trump from the technocrats."

179 dead in South Korea's worst plane crash

Plane was carrying 181 people from Thailand to South Korea

A Jeju Air plane carrying 181 people from Thailand to South Korea crashed on arrival Sunday, smashing into a barrier and bursting into flames, killing everyone aboard except for two flight attendants plucked from the wreckage.

A bird strike was cited by authorities as the likely cause of the crash -- the worst ever aviation disaster on South Korean soil -- which flung passengers out of the plane and left it "almost completely destroyed", according to fire officials.

Video showed the Jeju Air Boeing 737-800 landing on its belly at Muan International Airport, skidding off the runway as smoke streamed out from the engines, before crashing into a wall and exploding in flames.

"Of the 179 dead, 65 have been identified," the country's fire agency said, adding that DNA retrieval had begun.

What happened?

A Boeing 737-800 aircraft belonging to low-cost carrier Jeju Air, flying from Bangkok to Muan airport, was warned of a bird strike by the control tower, officials said, during its first attempt at landing shortly after 9:00 am (0000 GMT). Minutes later, with the pilot issuing a "mayday" warning, it tried to land again, with video showing it attempting a "belly landing" without its landing gear activated. Dramatic video shows the plane skidding along the runway with smoke trailing out, until it hits a wall at the end and bursts into flames.

to wait for news. An official began calling out the names of the 65 victims who had been identified, with each name triggering fresh cries of grief from waiting relatives. Only two people -- both flight attendants -- were rescued from the crash, the fire department said. "Passengers were ejected from the aircraft after it collided with the wall, leaving little chance of survival," a local fire official told families at a briefing, according to a statement released by the fire brigade. "The plane is almost completely destroyed," he was quoted as saying. Both black boxes -- the flight

data recorder and the cockpit voice recorder -- have been found, deputy transport minister Jo Jong-wan said at a briefing. Under floodlights, rescue workers used a giant yellow crane to lift the burned-out fuselage of the orange-and-white aircraft on the runway at Muan -- some 288 kilometres (about 180 miles) southwest of Seoul. Bits of plane seats and luggage were strewn across the field next to the runway, not far from the charred tail, offering a glimpse into the catastrophic impact of the crash.

What caused the accident?

Investigations have been launched, but officials suspect the accident could have been caused by bird strike and adverse weather conditions. When asked if the accident happened due to the runway being too short, one official said this was likely not a factor.

and the oldest a 78-year-old, authorities said.

"I had a son on board that plane," an elderly man waiting in the airport lounge, who asked not to be named, told AFP.

"My younger sister went to heaven today," a 65-year-old woman, who gave only her surname Jo, told AFP.

The accident took place in a matter of minutes as Jeju Air Flight 2216 tried to land -- with the control tower issuing a warn-

ing of a bird strike, and the pilot soon after calling "mayday".

"It took approximately three minutes from the control tower's mention of a bird strike warning to the aircraft's attempt to land on the runway again," an official said.

Azerbaijan says Russia shot at plane before crash, demands it admit

Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev accused Russia on Sunday of firing at an Azerbaijan Airlines passenger jet before it crashed and of initially trying to cover up the cause of the fatal disaster, demanding that Moscow admit guilt.

Aliyev made the accusation in an interview to state media at Baku airport four days after the AZAL plane crashed in Kazakhstan, killing 38 people of the 67 people on board.

Azerbaijani officials have suggested the aircraft was hit by a Russian air-defence system as it tried to land in Grozny, capital of the Russian republic of Chechnya. Aliyev's unusually forthright

accusation of his country's traditionally ally came a day after he spoke by phone to Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Azerbaijan's President Ilham Aliyev

A Kremlin statement on the phone call gave no indication that Putin had claimed responsibility for the crash.

"The facts are that the Azerbaijani civilian plane was damaged from the outside over Russian territory, near the city of Grozny, and almost lost control," Aliyev told state television.

"We also know that electronic warfare systems put our plane out of control... At the same time, as a result of fire from the ground, the tail of the plane was also severely damaged," he said.

Aliyev said that while "of course, our plane was hit by accident", Baku was angry that Moscow had apparently tried to hide the cause of the crash and demanded its ally admit what happened.

He said it was "regrettable and surprising" that Moscow "put forward theories" that, he said,

"clearly showed he Russian side wanted to cover up the issue".

"For the first three days, we heard nothing from Russia except some absurd theories," he said, adding that these included the plane hitting a flock of birds.

He called the theory "completely removed" from reality, pointing out that the plane's "fuselage is riddled with holes".

Russia has said Grozny was being attacked by Ukrainian drones the day the AZAL flight tried to land. Aliyev urged Moscow to issue a public apology to his country, saying Baku had made official "demands" to Russia two days ago. "First, the Russian side must

apologise to Azerbaijan.

"Second, it must acknowledge its guilt. "Third, those responsible must be punished, brought to criminal responsibility, and compensation must be paid to the Azerbaijani state, as well as to the injured passengers and crew members."

"These are our conditions," Aliyev said, in unusually strong language towards Moscow. The Kremlin said on Saturday that during their phone conversation, Putin had apologised to Azerbaijan over the "tragic incident".

Putin said Russian air defence was operating in Grozny on December 25 when the plane tried to land, before diverting and crashing in western Kazakhstan.

LEGAL VIEWPOINT

Legal points on corporate governance

A basic golden principle of corporate governance (CG) relates to the "Board of Directors" of the company, where-in the company shall always be headed by an effective, collegial and informative Board of Directors. If, not more.

In your company, you need to ask yourself, where do we stand in this? What about the whereabouts and the role of our Board of Directors?

To achieve the goal, all members of the Board of Directors should understand and comprehend the role and the responsibilities of the Board as stipulated \ provided for in the Company Law, the Articles & Memorandum of Association of the company, the corporate culture and, moreover, the corporate governance code.

This in particular clearly highlights that the role of the Board of Directors is totally different from the role of the shareholders of the company (whose interests the Board serves) and likewise the role of the officers \ staff working in the company.

In particular, in this respect, the members of the Board of Directors should understand and absorb the Board's fiduciary duties of care and loyalty to the company and the shareholders of the company.

Members of the Board of Directors, from legal perspective, are responsible both individually and collectively for performing such fiduciary responsibilities, which cannot be transferred or delegated to other persons or to other bodies related to the company.

When a new Board Director is appointed, the Chairman of the Board, assisted by the legal advisor of the company, should review the role of the Board and associated duties with all members of the Board of Directors, with particular interest to cover the legal and regulatory requirements, the Charter of the company and the Code of Corporate Governance.

The company should have a written appointment contract agreement with each member of the Board of Directors. This contract shall include the powers and duties of the Board member and other matters relating to his appointment including, among others, his term, the time commitment envisaged, the committee assignment if any, his remuneration and expense reimbursement entitlement, and his access to independent professional advice when and if needed.

The Board of directors should consider adopting a formal Board Charter or other statement specifying matters which are reserved to it, which should include but need not be limited to the specific items stated in the Company Law and the articles and memorandum of association. An alternative is a formal statement or by-law stating the functions and authority delegated to the executives \ officers as mentioned in the Company Law.

The Board of Directors should be collegial and deliberative, to gain the benefit of each member of the Board of Directors judgment and experience. The Chairman should take an active lead in promoting mutual trust, open discussion, constructive dissent and support for decisions after they have been made. The Board of Directors should meet frequently, usually more than the minimum required by law.

All members of the Board of Directors should attend the meetings, and the Board of Directors should maintain informal communication between meetings. Unexcused absence(s) is not welcomed as it may disturb the functions of the Board of Directors and indicates that the person is not the type of those needed for efficient Board of Directors as stipulated in the Corporate Governance Code. Regarding attendance, more control measures are required and continuous absence could lead to termination of membership.

Commitment and accountability reflect the effectiveness of the Board and are essentially required and should be observed by all members of the Board of Directors, taking in account that they are supposed to excel and give good example to all related parties in the company, the shareholders and community stakeholders.

If you are a Board member, you need to ask yourself where do you stand in this and are you fully eager and effective enough to make your Board of Directors more effective, as required for corporate governance purposes.

Membership in the Board of Directors has got its own legal and corporate benefits as well as more liabilities to be accountable for.

Be frank with yourself and other related parties, if you feel you are capable you can proceed in confidence, otherwise better to give the floor to others who can take care and shoulder the responsibility. Otherwise, bear the consequences.

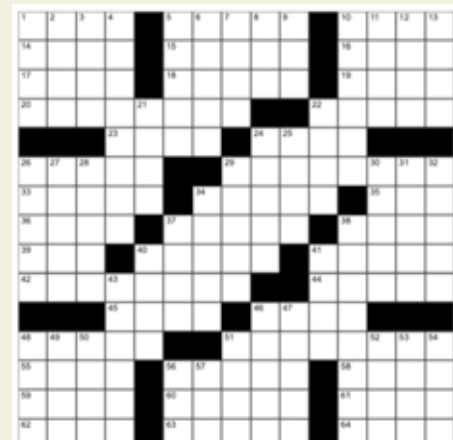

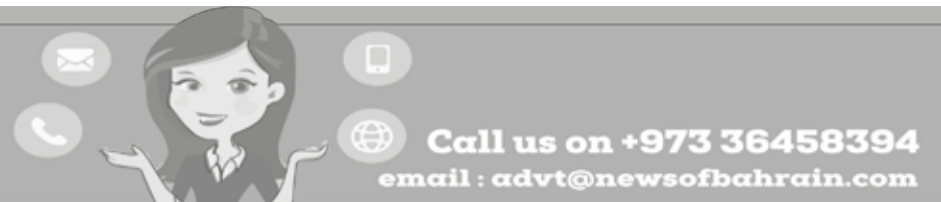

Novak Djokovic said yesterday he planned to keep playing for "years to come" -- with more tournaments on his schedule in 2025 -- as he looks to take down the new guard led by Jannik Sinner and Carlos Alcaraz.

The 37-year-old had a disappointing campaign last year by his standards, failing to win a Grand Slam and claiming just one title -- Olympic gold in Paris.

He has slipped to number seven in the world and said he wanted to get his ranking back to "where it should be".

"I'm looking for a good start to the season, I'm looking for more consistency across all the tournaments," he said as he prepared to play at the Brisbane International this week.

"I'm looking to play more tournaments this year than I played last season, so hopefully also my level is going to go up.

Man City stop the rot with victory at Leicester

Manchester City provided Pep Guardiola some relief with a 2-0 victory at Leicester to secure just a second win in 14 games for the crisis-hit English champions yesterday.

De Bruyne's fitness struggles have played a part in City's slump and he immediately showed what Guardiola's men have been missing for most of the season.

Rico Lewis picked out De Bruyne, who cushioned a cross into the path of Haaland but his low effort was well saved by Leicester's stand-in goalkeeper Jakub Stolarczyk.

Leicester have now lost their last four games after a bright start to Ruud van Nistelrooy's reign.

The Foxes were left to rue not taking their chances to inflict more misery on a City side still showing a clear lack of confidence. Any time the home side crossed into City territory in the first half they appeared a major threat.

Jamie Vardy would surely have won a penalty had he not strayed offside before being brought down by Stefan Ortega, while James Justin's header hit the post after a goalmouth scramble.

Indian seamer Jasprit Bumrah unleashed more destructive bowling but Australia stubbornly battled back to reach 228-9 yesterday, leading by 333 runs in an absorbing fourth Test.

Bumrah scythed through the middle order on day four in Melbourne to record figures of 4-56 off 24 overs and hand India an outside chance of victory in a match the home side have mostly dominated.

However, India's hopes were diminished by a stubborn, unbeaten final-wicket stand of 55 from 17.5 overs.

Nathan Lyon was at the crease on 41 while number 11 Scott Boland had seen off 65 balls to be 10 not out at the close.

Up by 105 runs on the first innings, Australia were rocked by losing four wickets for 11 midway through the second session to slump to 91-6.

Marnus Labuschagne and Pat Cummins responded with a vital partnership of 57, taking the steam out of Bumrah's assault.

A charmed Labuschagne scored 70, to back up his first-innings 72, while Cummins produced a captain's knock of 41 -- giving him a career-high combined 90 runs for the Test.

Both teams are seeking to go 2-1 up in the series heading into the fifth and final Test in Sydney.

The conditions were exploited brilliantly by Bumrah, who continued his dominance across a series in which he has claimed 29 wickets.

The 31-year-old powered past 200 Test victims and he boasts the lowest average at 19.45 of all 85 bowlers to have reached that milestone.

Labuschagne was beaten on numerous occasions by Bumrah's jarring deliveries but kept his nerve in a 139-ball knock.

The Australian number three was fortunate, on 46, to survive a straightforward dropped chance in the slips by Yashasvi Jaiswal.

Jaiswal also couldn't grasp a sharp chance under the helmet offered by Cummins in the final over before tea.

Labuschagne was trapped lbw by lively seamer Mohammed Siraj before Mitchell Starc was run out for five.

Spinner Ravindra Jadeja had Cummins caught behind, heralding the 10th-wicket stand which could yet prove pivotal to the outcome.

Siraj, who took 3-66, sparked the earlier collapse, dismissing first innings centurion Steve Smith for 13.

Bumrah was at his best when removing Travis Head, Mitchell Marsh and Alex Carey cheaply in rapid-fire fashion.
