Bridge lane set for closure

The Ministry of Works, in coordination with the General Traffic Directorate of the Ministry of Interior, has announced upcoming maintenance work on the Shaikh Khalifa bin Salman Bridge, which connects the Capital Governorate and Muharraq Governorate.

This maintenance involves the repair of bridge joints and will necessitate the closure of the right lane in both directions. However, two lanes will remain open to facilitate traffic flow.

The maintenance is scheduled to commence tomorrow at 11pm and will continue until Sunday, August 4, 2024, at 5am.

During this period, drivers are advised to adhere to traffic rules and regulations to ensure the safety of all road users.

The Ministry urges all citizens and residents to cooperate and exercise caution while driving in the affected area.
